Facts Maybe Only We Find Interesting: This will be the first meeting between the Eagles and the Tigers . . . This is the second of three games against teams from the Palmetto State this season (South Carolina State, Coastal Carolina) . . . Georgia Southern is 1-9 all-time against current members of the ACC (1-4 vs. Miami; 0-2 vs. Georgia Tech, North Carolina and NC State; 0-2 vs. Florida State) . . . The Eagles are 26-12 all-time playing in the state of South Carolina and 63-24 against teams from the Palmetto State . . . Georgia Southern has lost its last 11 road non-conference games since shocking Florida 26-20 in The Swamp to end the 2013 season . . . GS has yet to win a road non-conference game as a member of the FBS, which the Eagles joined in 2014 . . . Tight end Ellis Richardson's father, Chuck, played linebacker at Clemson on the 1981 national championship team and his brother, Chris, played defensive end for Clemson's football team from 2007-2010 . . . Defensive coordinator Scot Sloan was a defensive back for the Tigers from 1988-91, winning an ACC title in 1991.

- 10 This will be the **10th** game Georgia Southern has played against a ranked FBS opponent since 1984.
- 9 The Eagles have scored **nine** touchdowns this season (seven rushing, two passing).
- 8 Georgia Southern (six FCS) and Clemson (two FBS) have combined to win **eight** NCAA national titles in football.
- 7 The Eagles have **seven** players from the state of South Carolina on their roster.
- 6 Quarterback Shai Werts has accounted for **six** touchdowns this season (four rushing, two passing).
- 5 Georgia Southern has been assessed just **five** penalties in two games this season.
- 4 The Eagles have not allowed a point in the **fourth** quarter this season.
- 3 This is the second of **three** games against teams from the Palmetto State this season (SCSU, Coastal Carolina).
- 2 Georgia Southern equalled its win total from 2017 in **two** games this year after taking 11 games to reach that total last year.
- 1 The Georgia Southern defense has allowed just **one** explosive play (20+ yards) this season.

HEAD COACH CHAD LUNSFORD

• The 2018 campaign marks the 10th season overall, and sixth in his current stint at Georgia Southern for head coach Chad Lunsford. Lunsford was promoted from assistant head coach to interim head coach on Oct. 22, 2017. He was named the 10th full-time head coach in the modern era on Nov. 27, 2017.

• After working with the wide receivers in 2013, Lunsford worked two seasons with the tight ends and served as recruiting coordinator in 2014 and 2015. In 2017, Lunsford coached the Eagle slot receivers and H-backs and again served in the role of special teams coordinator, a title he added in 2016. He was also named the program's assistant head coach in 2017.

• In 2016, Lunsford was named a Broyles Award nominee, given to the nation's top assistant coach, as the Eagles blocked seven kicks and featured a Lou Groza Award finalist in Younghoe Koo, who went on to play with the Los Angeles Chargers.

• On the recruiting side, Lunsford helped engineer signing classes which featured 22 players and ranked in the top half of the Sun Belt in 2015, also ranked near the top of the Sun Belt in 2014 and in 2016. He was named the Sun Belt's Best Recruiter in 2016 by Scout. His 2018 class was rated the top in the Sun Belt by 247Sports.

• Lunsford returned to Statesboro as wide receivers coach and recruiting coordinator in June 2013 after four years in an administrative position with the Auburn football program. He served in consecutive roles as the Tigers' Director of Scouting and Director of Player Personnel, assisting with the day-to-day operations of Auburn football, with an emphasis on recruiting, organizing and prospect evaluation.

• Lunsford coached the slotbacks in his previous three seasons (2003-05) on the Georgia Southern staff, including the Eagles' eventual all-time receptions leader Raja Andrews, who finished his career with 127 catches and as the record holder for receiving yards in a single season with 873.

• After departing Georgia Southern in 2006, Lunsford spent a year at Griffin High School as a special education teacher and served as the outside linebackers coach.

• Two years back at Georgia Military College followed his time at Griffin with Lunsford taking a familiar place as linebackers coach and adding responsibilities as special teams coordinator.

• He played at Elbert County High for legendary coach T. McFerrin. During his high school career, Elbert County made four straight appearances in the state playoffs and posted a 20-3 record in his junior and senior years.

• Lunsford graduated from Georgia College in May 2000 with a degree in biology and minor in mathematics, and earned a master's of sport science degree from the United States Sports Academy in 2002.

• He and his wife, Tippy, have a son, Rhett, and two daughters, Sophie and Josie.

• Lunsford and his family pledged to donate \$200,000 over the next four years in honor of his coaching staff to the Coaches Continuity Fund through the Georgia Southern Athletic Foundation in April of 2018.

Additionally, **Zack Copeland** and **RJ Murray**, who had their careers cut short by injury and are serving as student assistants, have also graduated.

• Five more seniors - **Ian Bush**, **Wesley Fields**, **Monteo Garrett**, **Drake Grall** and **Joshua Moon** - are scheduled to graduate in December and seniors **Jay Bowdry**, **Kado Brown**, **Deshon Cooper** and **Jeremiah Culbreth** are on track to graduate in May 2019. **Sean Freeman**, **Logan Hunt** and **Alex Smith** are on track to graduate in summer of 2019.

• In addition, junior **Lane Ecton** has already graduated, juniors **Jake Edwards** and **Colby Ransom** are scheduled to graduate in December and juniors **Tyler Bass**, **Jakob Cooper** and sophomore **Will Browning III** are slated to graduate in May 2019.

• Junior **Obe Fortune** is on track to graduate in the summer of 2019.

HISTORY IN THE MAKING

• When redshirt freshman **Shai Werts** started at quarterback at Auburn last year, he made history as just the third Georgia Southern freshman (true or redshirt) quarterback to start the opening game of the season.

• Werts enjoyed quite the rookie campaign, starting 11 of the Eagles' 12 games. He caught fire late, earning Sun Belt Offensive Player of the Week after leading the Eagles to a 52-0 win over South Alabama.

• The Clinton, South Carolina, native finished his freshman year with 929 passing yards, a new school record for freshman quarterbacks. Hall of Famer Tracy Ham previously held the school record for freshman passing yards with 886 in 1983.

• Werts finished with 1,486 yards of total offense (929 pass, 722 rush), setting a new freshman record for total offense in a season by a quarterback with 1,651 yards. Kevin Ellison previously held the record with 1,642 yards (886 run, 756 pass) set in 2013.

• He had four 100-yard rushing games last year, the first time a GS freshman has had at least that many since Jermaine Austin had seven in 2002.

• Against Coastal Carolina in last year's finale, Werts became the first FBS player to lead his team in passing (57), rushing (108) and receiving (30) yards in a game since Keenan Reynolds of Navy accomplished the feat against Pitt in 2015.

• So far this season, he has rushed for 246 yards and four scores while throwing for 183 yards and two scores. For his career, he's rushed for 1,112 yards and seven touchdowns while throwing for 968 yards and nine scores.

HAVE A FIELD(S) DAY

• Senior running back **Wesley Fields** has shared the carries with former Eagle Matt Breida, who is with the San Francisco 49ers, and L.A. Ramsby during his time here, but it's his backfield now.

• A threat to go the distance, on the goal line and in the passing game, Fields had a standout freshman campaign for the Eagles. The Americus, Georgia, native rushed for 682 yards and seven touchdowns on 101

attempts, averaging 6.8 yards per carry. He also had four receptions for 105 yards and one touchdown, including a 60-yard scoring reception against New Mexico State.

• Last season, he led the Eagles with 811 rushing yards and scored five times.

• He has 2,158 rushing yards and 16 touchdowns for his career to go along with 27 catches for 365 yards and four scores. He became the 18th player in school history to eclipse the 2,000-yard mark for their career against South Carolina State in the opener.

• Fields has also stepped it up in the classroom, earning a perfect 4.0 GPA last spring to earn a spot on the President's List and will graduate in December.

HOME-GROWN TALENT

• Of the 115 players on the Eagles' roster, 79 players are from the state of Georgia (68.7 percent).

THE DYNAMIC WK3

• Sophomore slot receiver Wesley Kennedy III has proven to be a dynamic threat in several areas of the game. The Savannah native has 26 yards rushing, 100 yards receiving, 47 yards on punt returns and 143 yards on kickoff returns for a total of 316 all-purpose yards.

YOUNG TALENT

• Of the 115 players on the Eagles' roster, 52 are freshmen, either true or redshirt (45.2 percent).

Unofficially, only Minnesota (53.1 percent), Virginia (50.0 percent), Wake Forest (49.1 percent), UCF (48.0 percent), Penn State (47.5 percent) and Iowa (45.9 percent) have higher percentages of freshmen making up their roster in the FBS.

• Another 30 are listed as sophomores, meaning 71.3 percent of Georgia Southern's roster is made up of sophomores or younger.

SWAG LIKE CHAD

• Senior quarterback **Kado Brown** has made quite the name for himself as a budding rap star, but his track "Swag Like Chad," which debuted in August, has become the anthem for the 2018 Eagle squad.

• Brown, who hails from Ventura, California, and performs as KollegeKado, has put out several songs and wants to move back to California after football is over to give his musical talents a shot at a full-time career.

• He works with a childhood friend who goes by Donté, to produce his music and these are a few of the lyrics from "Swag Like Chad" as provided by Brown:

KICKIN' BASS

• Junior **Tyler Bass** had quite the season in 2017 as he took over for Lou Groza Award Finalist Younghoe Koo. He made the Sun Belt's second-team after hitting 15 of 19 field goals on the season, with nine of them being 40 yards or longer. He kicked a season-long 48-yard field goal against Georgia State and had a 61-yard punt against South Alabama. Handling the kickoffs, he had 46 touchbacks on 54 kickoffs and he only missed one PAT on the season.

• His nine field goals of 40-yards or longer were the second-most in a season behind only Tim Foley's 10 in 1985. He will now set his sights on moving up the school's all-time list for field goals of 40 yards or longer:

ODDS AND ENDS

• Offensive lineman **Jeremiah Culbreth** was born in North Dakota and lived in Japan for three years growing up as a military child; both of his parents attended Georgia Southern ... Quarterback **Shai Werts'** family home in South Carolina was burned down after a grease fire, destroying everything, this pre-season; Eagle Nation rallied around the sophomore by donating money through approved NCAA avenues to help the family ... Outside linebacker **Jay Bowdry's** uncle, Guy McIntyre, played offensive line for 12 seasons in the NFL, with three Super Bowl and five Pro Bowl appearances for San Francisco ... Sophomore long snapper **Ryan Langan** had never played football when there are 22 players on the field before he got to Statesboro as he played six-man football at Riverside High in Nebraska; his first collegiate snap came against Auburn in 2017 in front of 87,451 fans ... **Mitch Matthews Jr.** is the son of Mitch Matthews Sr., who is in the GS Athletics Hall of Fame for his play as an All-American defensive lineman ... **LaBaron Anthony** has two cousins who played or play in the NFL: Brynden Trawick for the Tennessee Titans and Dez Bryant, formerly of the Dallas Cowboys ... **Obe Fortune's** sister, Sephora, played softball at Spelman College ... Quarterback **Kado Brown** doubles as a rapper, putting out several songs and albums while attending school ... **Shai Werts** is the second cousin with Chicago Cubs pitcher Carl Edwards Jr., who played a pivotal role coming out of the bullpen as the Cubs won the 2016 World Series ... Running back **Monte Garrett** played football in 2013 at Munford High in Alabama and didn't play again until last year; he came to GS and redshirted and then was academically ineligible for two seasons, but got things in line and made the Dean's List in Spring of 2017 and played in all 12 games last season ... Receiver **Dexter Carter Jr.** is the son of Dexter Sr., who was a Florida State standout and San Francisco 49ers and New York Jets running back who won a Super Bowl with the 49ers ... **Lane Ecton's** father, John, played football at Oklahoma State ... Punter **Magill Bauerle's** father, Jack, is the head coach of the national champion University of Georgia swim teams and was also the United States' women's swimming team coach for the 2008 Olympics in Beijing, China ... **Scoobie Ford's** father, Glenn, played defensive back at Georgia in the mid-1990s; Scoobie's birth name is Christian ... **Ellis Richardson's** father, Chuck, played linebacker at Clemson on the 1981 national championship team and his brother, Chris, played defensive end for Clemson's football team from 2007-2010 ... Nose tackle **C.J. Wright** was a state champion in the shot put and the discus on the track & field team at Screven HS ... Head coach **Chad Lunsford** credits his year as at Griffin High School where he was a special education teacher in 2007 as "probably one of the more valuable experiences in my life, teaching me patience." ... QBs coach **Justin Wood** served as a stunt double on "The Longest Yard" movie remake starring Adam Sandler ... The starting left tackle (Joel Bitonio) and starting right guard (Austin Corbett) for the Cleveland Browns were both coached by Eagle OL coach **Ron Hudson**.



QUITE THE ROUNDABOUT JOURNEY

• Senior **Ellis Richardson** has taken quite the route to get from his hometown of Atlanta to Statesboro. Upon graduating from Douglas County High in 2013, where he was a first-team all-region and all-county selection at quarterback, he enrolled at prep school in Virginia.

• He then transferred to Los Angeles Valley College in the fall of 2014 as a true freshman and then transferred to Alabama State in the spring of 2015. Richardson played in nine games in 2015 at Alabama State, throwing for 739 yards and six touchdowns while rushing for 550 yards and eight scores.

• After transferring to Georgia Southern in January 2016, he had to sit out per NCAA transfer rules and used it as a redshirt season.

• In the spring, he was moved to tight end and has thrived at the new position.

• He came on late in 2017, finishing the season with three TD catches to lead the team. He had nine catches for 185 yards on the season and was a preseason selection to Athlon's First-Team All-Sun Belt squad this year. He

has already graduated with a degree in interdisciplinary studies.

OFF THE TOP ROPE

• Defensive line coach Victor Cabral, who was a standout defensive lineman for the Eagles from 2000-2004, took a unique approach to fundraising this past offseason. Wanting to help Athletes in Action raise money for their annual Spring Break Mission Trip, Cabral trained with American Premier Wrestling - a professional wrestling organization - before taking to the squared circle on Aug. 29 as part of Summer Steam held on campus.

• Cabral teamed with "Big Country" Clay Teston to take on the Roman Empire and after getting slammed through a table at his signing ceremony, Cabral came back to exact revenge a week later, picking up the win all while raising money for a good cause.

OVERCOMING ADVERSITY

• Adversity is a word **Todd Bradley** doesn't want to hear after what he went through in 2015 and 2016. As a senior in high school, he was diagnosed with Dermatofibrosarcoma Protuberans (DFSP) in his right shoulder. He was going in to have some scar tissue removed when the doctors diagnosed him.

• DFSP is a rare type of cancer, a soft tissue sarcoma that develops in the deep layers of skin cancer. He had several surgeries to remove the mass and then had a skin graft in which they took skin from his groin and placed it on his shoulder.

• The cancer caused him to miss most of his final season, but he was cleared on a Thursday and played the next night, returning for the final five games of his season. He signed with Georgia Southern in February 2016.

• In 2016, Bradley was contributing as a true freshman at both linebacker and special teams before suffering a torn ACL in pre-game warmups at Arkansas State and missed the rest of the season. He underwent rehab in

the offseason and returned to full strength last season, finishing with 25 tackles, including 5.0 tackles for loss.

• The injury bug bit him again this year and he underwent a successful meniscectomy in that same left knee after suffering a non-contact injury on the second day of preseason camp. He had the surgery on Aug. 16 and missed the first game of the season, but returned to play 38 snaps against UMass.

HONORING EDWIN

• Head coach Chad Lunsford announced in February that the walk-on tryouts for the GS program moving forward will be named in honor of Edwin Jackson, who died Feb. 4, 2018 in an automobile accident in Indianapolis. Jackson went through the tryout process at Georgia Southern to earn a spot on the team and worked his way up to eventual starter before moving on to start in the NFL with the Indianapolis Colts.

• As a junior in 2013, Jackson totaled a team-best 92 tackles, including a team-leading 13 stops in a 26-20 upset win against Florida in The Swamp. He was voted team captain by his teammates and recorded a career-high 100 tackles as a senior in helping the Eagles win the Sun Belt Conference Championship in the school's inaugural year competing at the FBS level in 2014. He was awarded first-

team All-Sun Belt honors for his performance on the field.

• He was an undrafted free agent who went to the Arizona Cardinals' camp, but was one of the final cuts. He joined the Indianapolis Colts' practice squad in late 2015 and went on to start eight games at linebacker in 2016 for the Colts. He did not play in 2017 season due to an injury.

• Jackson created the Edwin Jackson 53 Foundation, which holds football clinics, fitness camps and after-school programs for disadvantaged youth, and supports student athletes who do not have scholarships. The Eagles will wear a "EJ40" sticker on their helmets this season — Jackson wore No. 40 at GS — to honor his legacy with proceeds from hat sales with the same logo going toward his foundation.

LET FREEDOM RING

• In what has become one of the most popular traditions at GS, "Freedom," a male American Bald Eagle, takes flight before each home football game. Freedom is a Southern Bald Eagle that was found knocked out of the nest in Maitland, Florida. Only weeks old and appearing like a "brown ball of fuzz", it was discovered that the young eagle had an injury to its beak and suffered from an infection. Rushed to the Florida Audubon Center for Birds of Prey, Freedom made a complete recovery from the infection but the injury to the beak was permanent, preventing his release into the wild.

• With the permission of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, GS acquired Freedom in 2004. Through the Georgia Southern University Center for Wildlife Education and Lamar Q. Ball Jr. Raptor Center, thousands of visitors young and old are embraced by the Power of Freedom.

• Under the supervision of Steve Hein, Director of the Center for Wildlife Education, Freedom is on the sidelines of all GS home games, and select road games.

• He will be in attendance at Saturday's game against Clemson after both athletic directors agreed to amend the standard game contract disallowing live mascots on the sidelines at Memorial Stadium.

- South Carolina State finally got on the board late in the third quarter with a time-consuming 18-play drive that ate up over 9 minutes off the clock, but the PAT was blocked by Raymond Johnson III.
- Shai Werts scored his third touchdown of the game late in the fourth quarter, keeping on the option and scampering 14 yards for the score.
