## ACC NOTABLES

- The ACC is the only conference to win national championships in football, men's basketball, women's basketball and baseball over the last four years.

- The ACC boasts five coaches, who rank in the top 20 of winningest active coaches by percentage, the most of any league in the country – 6. Muffet McGraw (.767), 9. Jeff Walz (.758), 10. Wes Moore (.753), 14. Joanne P. McCallie (.728) and 18. Sylvia Hatchell (.721).

- The ACC is 35-8 through the first week of the season with a 23-2 home record, including Syracuse's win over No. 20/21 Texas A&M and Miami's victory over No. 19/19 Marquette.

- Five ACC teams are ranked in both the AP and USA Today/Coaches polls - led by No. 1/1 Notre Dame. No. 5/4 Louisville follows, along with No. 17/16 NC State, No. 18/18 Syracuse and No. 24/24 Miami. Duke stands at No. 20 in the USA Today/Coaches Preseason poll (no poll available this week), giving the ACC six ranked teams this week.

- Louisville senior guard Asia Durr and Notre Dame senior guard Arike Ogunbowale are among the five on the Associated Press Preseason All-America Team.

- Asia Durr earned the first ACC Player of the Week honor of the season after she averaged 28.5 points in a 2-0 week for the Cardinals that included wins at Western Kentucky (102-80) and at Chattanooga (75-49). She opened her season by scoring the first 11 points for Louisville as it began the game at WKU with an 11-2 lead. She finished with 33 points, which set a school record for points in an opener, on 12-of-21 shooting, 7-of-15 from deep, in just 21 minutes of action against the Hill-toppers. It marked the seventh ACC Player of the Week honor of her career.

- Florida State freshman forward Valencia Myers earned the league's first Rookie of the Week honor after averaging 13.3 points, on 53.8 percent shooting from the floor, and 8.7 rebounds to help Florida State to three straight wins over Troy (103-67), North Florida (74-53) and Florida (63-56). She led Florida State in field goal percentage and blocked shots (9) in those three wins, including five blocks in her Seminole debut against Troy. She also keyed FSU's big win over Florida with a personal 6-0 run in the second half to give the Noles the lead for good, while finishing the game with 13 points and eight rebounds.

- Miami redshirt junior forward Beatrice Mompremier scored a career-high 24 points and 21 rebounds in the Hurricanes' win over No. 19/19 Marquette on Nov. 15. She is the first ACC player to record at least 20 points and 20 rebounds in a game since Wake Forest's Dearica Hamby registered 36 points and 20 rebounds against Boston College on Feb. 12, 2015.

- The ACC leads all leagues with 11 players on the 2019 Citizen Nismith Trophy Watch List. Included on the list are Duke's Leonna Odom, Louisville's Asia Durr and Sam Fuehring, Miami's Beatrice Mompremier, North Carolina's Paris Kea, Syracuse's Tianna Mangakahia and Notre Dame's Marina Mabrey, Arike Ogunbowale, Jessica Shepard, Brianna Turner and Jackie Young.

- The ACC also leads all leagues with nine players on the John R. Wooden Award Preseason Top 30 Watch List. Included on the list are Duke's Leonna Odom, Louisville's Asia Durr, North Carolina's Paris Kea, Syracuse's Tianna Mangakahia and Notre Dame's Marina Mabrey, Arike Ogunbowale, Jessica Shepard, Brianna Turner and Jackie Young.

## NCAA Success

- Led by ACC Champion Louisville, eight league teams were selected to the 64-team. 2018 NCAA Women's Basketball Championship field. The eight teams matched a league record (2014 and 2015), and were the most of any conference last year. It was also the fourth time in the last five years that at least seven ACC teams have earned berths in the Big Dance, and the 11th time in the last 14 years that at least six teams were selected.

- Notre Dame won the 2018 NCAA Championship following wins over No. 1 seed Connecticut (91-89 in OT) in the semifinals and No. 1 seed Mississippi State (61-58) in the championship game. Arike Ogunbowale hit the game-winning shot in both the semifinal and championship games and was named the Women's Final Four's Most Outstanding Player.

- Since the 2015 NCAA Tournament, the ACC owns the most tournament wins (55) of any conference. The ACC's .671 winning percentage in the tournament during that time is the best among the Power 5 conferences.

- Since 2006 current ACC membership combines for nine NCAA title game appearances, the most of a single conference. Seven different institutions have represented the ACC in the Women's Final Four (current membership).

## WEEKLY/SEASON AWARDS

The Atlantic Coast Conference's "Blue Ribbon Panel," consisting of national and local media members, as well as school representatives, will vote for the league's preseason poll, weekly honors and postseason All-Conference teams for the 2018-19 season.

The ACC, with nominations from its 15 member institutions, will designate approximately 35 media members who cover ACC Women's Basketball regularly to the panel. In addition to the 35 members, the league's communications office will invite additional national and selected persons to the panel, including ACC television broadcasters.

Finally, all 15 league head coaches will receive one ballot to vote on preseason and postseason accolades; however, they will not be permitted to vote on a weekly basis or for their own student-athletes.

Following the conclusion of the regular season, the Blue Ribbon Panel will select a 10-member All-ACC First Team, a five-member All-ACC Second Team, an eight-member All-Freshman Team, as well as Player of the Year, Rookie of the Year and Coach of the Year. The league head coaches will also select their own 10-member All-ACC First Team, a eight-member All-ACC Second Team, an All-Freshman Team, Player of the Year, Rookie of the Year and Coach of the Year, as well as, the All-Defensive Team, Defensive Player, Sixth Player and Most Improved Player of the Year.

## 2019 ACC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNA.M.ENT AND NCAA CHA.M.PIONSHIP REGIONAL



Greensboro, North Carolina and the Greensboro Coliseum will be the epicenter for women's basketball during the month of March as the ACC and the city of Greensboro will host the 2019 ACC Women's Basketball Tourna.m.ent and a 2019 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Cha.m.pionship Regional.

The ACC Tourna.m.ent will be held at the Greensboro Coliseum, for the 19th time in 20 years, on March 6-10, 2019. The Coliseum, with assistance from the Tourna.m.ent Hosts of Greensboro, Greensboro Sports Commission and Convention and Visitors Bureau, is now set to play host to the tourna.m.ent through 2023. Every attendance record for the 40-year-old tourna.m.ent has been set at the Greensboro Coliseum, including the overall attendance mark of 73,187 in 2009. Overall attendance at the Greensboro Coliseum has exceeded 60,000 eight times since 2006.

The winner of the ACC Women's Basketball Tourna.m.ent receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Cha.m.pionship. The tourna.m.ent seeding and Conference Cha.m.pion are determined by the 16-ga.m.e regular-season ACC schedule.

The ACC and the Greensboro Coliseum will also host the 2019 NCAA women's regional on March 30-April 1. The Regional Semifinals are set for Saturday, March 30 at 11:30 and 2 p.m., and the Regional Final for 7 p.m. on Monday, April 1. The ACC was also awarded a NCAA Regional in 2022.

# 2018-19 ATLANTIC COAST CONFERENCE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

## 2018 ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE

The Atlantic Coast Conference and the Big Ten Conference announced the matchups for the 2018 ACC/Big Ten Women's Basketball Challenge. This year's Challenge will mark the 12th straight year of the event that pits the two perennially strong conferences against each other.

The ACC and Big Ten conference offices determine the schedule each season, and the official title of the Challenge rotates each year. The 2018 event will be referred to as the ACC/Big Ten Women's Basketball Challenge and will continue to mirror the official title of the conferences' Challenge agreement for men's basketball.

All 14 Big Ten tea.m.s and 14 of the 15 ACC tea.m.s will participate in the 2018 Challenge.

This year's event will be played in a two-day format beginning on Wednesday, Nov. 28. A year ago, ACC women's basketball tea.m.s combined for a record 10 wins over the Big Ten to win the 2017 Big Ten/ACC Challenge, 10-4. The outright title was the eighth overall for the ACC. The ACC owns an 81-55 record against the Big Ten in Challenge ga.m.es.

After a closely contested first day of ga.m.es in which the ACC held a slim 3-2 edge, the ACC claimed seven wins last Nov. 30, to clinch the title.
