## ACC NOTABLES

• The ACC is 47-14 against non-conference opponents including four wins over ranked foes - Syracuse's win over No. 20/21 Texas A&M, Miami's victory over No. 19/19 Marquette, Notre Dame's win at No. 15/15 DePaul, and Georgia Tech's victory over No. 14/13 Georgia.

• The ACC has five undefeated teams - Virginia Tech (5-0), Boston College (4-0), NC State (4-0), Notre Dame (3-0) and Louisville (3-0).

• Five ACC teams are ranked in both the AP and USA Today/Coaches polls - led by No. 1/1 Notre Dame. No. 5/4 Louisville follows, along with No. 14/15 Syracuse, No. 15/13 NC State, and No. 24/21 Miami.

• The ACC is the only conference to win national championships in football, men's basketball, women's basketball and baseball over the last four years.

• The ACC boasts five coaches who rank in the top 20 of winningest active coaches by percentage, the most of any league in the country - 6. Muffet McGraw (.767), 8. Jeff Walz (.759), 9. Wes Moore (.753), 15. Joanne P. McCallie (.728) and 20. Sylvia Hatchell (.721).

• Notre Dame's Arike Ogunbowale was named the ACC Player of the Week. Ogunbowale averaged 22.5 points in a 2-0 week for the Fighting Irish that included wins against Penn (75-55) and No. 15/15 DePaul (101-77). She began the week with 21 points, a career-high six assists, five rebounds and two blocks against the Quakers. She followed that by scoring 24 points and pulling down five rebounds at DePaul, where she had 19 of those points by halftime. It was her third straight game of at least 20 points. This is her third career ACC Player of the Week honor.

• With two double-doubles on the week, Yellow Jacket freshman Elizabeth Dixon, this week's ACC Co-Rookie of the Week, helped Georgia Tech go 2-0 with wins over Western Carolina and No. 14/13 Georgia. The Memphis, Tenn., native got the week started by notching her first collegiate career double-double with 13 points and a career-high 10 rebounds. Her 13 points were one point shy of matching her career-high of 14 points set in the season-opener. Dixon posted her second-straight double-double on Sunday against Georgia, pulling down a game- and career-high 11 rebounds with 10 points. It was the Yellow Jackets' first win over a ranked opponent since Jan. 15, 2017, and the first win over a ranked Georgia team since Dec. 5, 2010.

• Syracuse's Maeve Dialdi-Tabdi averaged 17.0 points and 9.5 rebounds for the Orange in a 2-0 week to earn ACC Co-Rookie of the Week honors. She played a critical role in Syracuse's win over No. 20/21 Texas A&M as she contributed 15 points, 11 rebounds and three blocks. She followed that with a career high 19-points on 7-of-10 shooting in a win over Bucknell. The Paris, France, native shot 61.9 percent for the week and was 8-of-11 from the free throw line.

• Miami redshirt junior forward Beatrice Mompremier scored a career-high 24 points and grabbed 21 rebounds in the Hurricanes' win over No. 19/19 Marquette on Nov. 15. She is the first ACC player to record at least 20 points and 20 rebounds in a game since Wake Forest's Dearica Hamby registered 36 points and 20 rebounds against Boston College on Feb. 12, 2015.

• Louisville senior guard Asia Durr and Notre Dame senior guard Arike Ogunbowale are among the five on the Associated Press Preseason All-America Team.

• The ACC leads all leagues with 11 players on the 2019 Citizen Naismith Trophy Watch List. Included on the list are Duke's Leonna Odom, Louisville's Asia Durr and Sam Fuehring, Miami's Beatrice Mompremier, North Carolina's Paris Kea, Syracuse's Tianna Mangakahia and Notre Dame's Marina Mabrey, Arike Ogunbowale, Jessica Shepard, Brianna Turner and Jackie Young.

• The ACC also leads all leagues with nine players on the John R. Wooden Award Preseason Top 30 Watch List and Wade Trophy Watch List. Included on those lists are Duke's Leonna Odom, Louisville's Asia Durr, North Carolina's Paris Kea, Syracuse's Tianna Mangakahia and Notre Dame's Marina Mabrey, Arike Ogunbowale, Jessica Shepard, Brianna Turner and Jackie Young.

### NCAA Success

• Led by ACC Champion Louisville, eight league teams were selected to the 64-team 2018 NCAA Women's Basketball Championship field. The eight teams matched a league record (2014 and 2015), and were the most of any conference last year. It was also the fourth time in the last five years that at least seven ACC teams have earned berths in the Big Dance, and the 11th time in the last 14 years that at least six teams were selected.

• Since the 2015 NCAA Tournament, the ACC owns the most tournament wins (55) of any conference. The ACC's .671 winning percentage in the tournament during that time is the best among the Power 5 conferences.

## WEEKLY/SEASON AWARDS

The Atlantic Coast Conference's "Blue Ribbon Panel," consisting of national and local media members, as well as school representatives, will vote for the league's preseason poll, weekly honors and postseason All-Conference team for the 2018-19 season.

The ACC, with nominations from its 15 member institutions, will designate approximately 35 media members who cover ACC Women's Basketball regularly to the panel. In addition to the 35 members, the league's communications office will invite additional national and selected persons to the panel, including ACC television broadcasters.

Finally, all 15 league head coaches will receive one ballot to vote on preseason and postseason accolades; however, they will not be permitted to vote on a weekly basis or for their own student-athletes.

Following the conclusion of the regular season, the Blue Ribbon Panel will select a 10-member All-ACC First Team, a five-member All-ACC Second Team, an eight-member All-Freshman Team, as well as Player of the Year, Rookie of the Year and Coach of the Year. The league head coaches will also select their own 10-member All-ACC First Team, an eight-member All-ACC Second Team, an All-Freshman Team, Player of the Year, Rookie of the Year and Coach of the Year, as well as, the All-Defensive Team, Defensive Player, Sixth Player and Most Improved Player of the Year.

## 2019 ACC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT AND NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP REGIONAL



Greensboro, North Carolina and the Greensboro Coliseum will be the epicenter for women's basketball during the month of March as the ACC and the city of Greensboro will host the 2019 ACC Women's Basketball Tournament and a 2019 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship Regional.

The ACC Tournament will be held at the Greensboro Coliseum, for the 19th time in 20 years, on March 6-10, 2019. The Coliseum, with assistance from the Tournament Hosts of Greensboro, Greensboro Sports Commission and Convention and Visitors Bureau, is now set to play host to the tournament through 2023. Every attendance record for the 40-year-old tournament has been set at the Greensboro Coliseum, including the overall attendance mark of 73,187 in 2009. Overall attendance at the Greensboro Coliseum has exceeded 60,000 eight times since 2006.

The winner of the ACC Women's Basketball Tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. The tournament seeding and Conference Champion are determined by the 16-game regular-season ACC schedule.

The ACC and the Greensboro Coliseum will also host the 2019 NCAA women's regional on March 30-April 1. The Regional Semifinals are set for Saturday, March 30 at 11:30 and 2 p.m., and the Regional Final for 7 p.m. on Monday, April 1. The ACC was also awarded a NCAA Regional in 2022.

# 2018-19 ATLANTIC COAST CONFERENCE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

## 2018 ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE

The Atlantic Coast Conference and the Big Ten Conference announced the matchups for the 2018 ACC/Big Ten Women's Basketball Challenge. This year's Challenge will mark the 12th straight year of the event that pits the two perennially strong conferences against each other.

The ACC and Big Ten conference offices determine the schedule each season, and the official title of the Challenge rotates each year. The 2018 event will be referred to as the ACC/Big Ten Women's Basketball Challenge and will continue to mirror the official title of the conferences' Challenge agreement for men's basketball.

All 14 Big Ten tea.m.s and 14 of the 15 ACC tea.m.s will participate in the 2018 Challenge.

This year's event will be played in a two-day format beginning on Wednesday, Nov. 28. A year ago, ACC women's basketball tea.m.s combined for a record 10 wins over the Big Ten to win the 2017 Big Ten/ACC Challenge, 10-4. The outright title was the eighth overall for the ACC. The ACC owns an 81-55 record against the Big Ten in Challenge ga.m.es.

After a closely contested first day of ga.m.es in which the ACC held a slim 3-2 edge, the ACC claimed seven wins last Nov. 30, to clinch the title.
