ACC NOTABLES

• The ACC won the 12th annual ACC/Big Ten Challenge last week 8-6 to earn its ninth outright Challenge title. The ACC is 89-61 against the Big Ten in Challenge games.

• The ACC has three undefeated teams: Virginia Tech (9-0), Louisville (9-0) and NC State (9-0). Three ACC teams have one loss: Boston College (8-1), Florida State (8-1), Notre Dame (7-1).

• Five ACC teams are ranked in both the AP and USA Today/Coaches polls, including three in the Top 10 - led by No. 2/2 Notre Dame. No. 5/4 Louisville follows, along with No. 10/10 NC State, No. 15/14 Syracuse, and No. 25/23 Miami.

• North Carolina head coach Sylvia Hatchell needs one win to become the ACC's all-time wins leader. Hatchell, in her 33rd season at North Carolina, will pass former Virginia head coach Debbie Ryan on the ACC's all-time victories list (739) with her next win. Hatchell is 739-314 at North Carolina.

• Notre Dame senior guard Arike Ogunbowale leads the league in scoring with 24.3 points per game. She owns three 30-point performances this season and has scored 20-or-more points seven times. Eight-time ACC Player of the Week Asia Durr of Louisville follows with 21.8 points per game. Those scoring averages rank fourth and 18th in the nation, respectively.

• Virginia Tech redshirt senior forward Regan Magarity and Miami redshirt junior Beatrice Mompremier are both averaging double-doubles with 12.9 points and 14.4 rebounds for Magarity, and 15.2 points and 11.2 rebounds for Mompremier. Magarity's 14.4 rebounds per game rank second nationally.

• Syracuse junior guard Tiana Mangakahia, who set the ACC's single season assists record with 304 last season, leads the league again this season with 69 and 6.9 per game - an average that ranks eighth in the nation.

• Georgia Tech coach MaChelle Joseph earned her 300th career win on Sunday against Georgia State. Joseph, in her 16th year at Georgia Tech, is 301-193. Duke's Joanne P. McCallie, in her 11th year at Duke, earned her 300th win with the Blue Devils on Nov. 24 (against Ball State). The ACC has nine coaches with at least 300 career wins and five with 300-or-more at their respective institutions.

• The ACC is 107-32 against non-conference opponents, including 10 wins over ranked opponents. The ACC is 13-0 this week.

• Louisville senior guard Asia Durr is the ACC Player of the Week after she averaged 20.0 points, 4.7 assists and 4.0 rebounds, while shooting 51 percent from the floor, in home wins over Miami (Ohio) (95-73), Nebraska (85-68) and Tennessee State (107-52). During the week, she eclipsed both 1,900 career points - moving into fourth place all-time in program history - and 300 career 3-pointers, ranking second all-time among Louisville players. This is her second ACC Player of the Week honor, eighth of her career.

• Syracuse redshirt freshman forward Maeva Djaldi-Tabdi was named this week's ACC Rookie of the Week after she averaged 12.5 points and 5.0 rebounds per game in a 1-1 week for the Orange. For the week, she shot .524 percent from the floor on 11-of-21 shooting and averaged 21.5 minutes off the bench. This is Djaldi-Tabdi's second ACC Rookie of the Week honor of the season.

• The ACC is the only conference to win national championships in football, men's basketball, women's basketball and baseball over the last four years.

• The ACC boasts six coaches who rank in the top 20 of winningest active coaches by percentage, the most of any league in the country - 6. Muffet McGraw (.767), 8. Jeff Walz (.762), 10. Wes Moore (.754), 15. Joanne P. McCallie (.728), 17. Kenny Brooks (.722) and 20. Sylvia Hatchell (.719).

• Louisville senior guard Asia Durr and Notre Dame senior guard Arike Ogunbowale were among the five on the Associated Press Preseason All-America Team.

• The ACC leads all leagues with 11 players on the 2019 Citizen Naismith Trophy Watch List. Included on the list are Duke's Leaonna Odum, Louisville's Asia Durr and Sam Fuehring, Miami's Beatrice Mompremier, North Carolina's Paris Kea, Syracuse's Tianna Mangakahia and Notre Dame's Marina Mabrey, Arike Ogunbowale, Jessica Shepard, Brianna Turner and Jackie Young.

• The ACC also leads all leagues with nine players on the John R. Wooden Award Preseason Top 30 Watch List and Wade Trophy Watch List. Included on those lists are Duke's Leaonna Odum, Louisville's Asia Durr, North Carolina's Paris Kea, Syracuse's Tianna Mangakahia and Notre Dame's Marina Mabrey, Arike Ogunbowale, Jessica Shepard, Brianna Turner and Jackie Young.

Defending NCAA champion and four-time Atlantic Coast Conference champion Notre Dame is again the ACC Women's Basketball preseason favorite, according to separate polls of the league's Blue Ribbon Panel and its 15 head coaches.

This marks the fifth consecutive season that the Fighting Irish have been rated the ACC preseason favorite since joining the conference prior to the 2013-14 season.

WEEKLY/SEASON AWARDS

The Atlantic Coast Conference's "Blue Ribbon Panel," consisting of national and local media members, as well as school representatives, will vote for the league's preseason poll, weekly honors and postseason All-Conference team for the 2018-19 season.

The ACC, with nominations from its 15 member institutions, will designate approximately 35 media members who cover ACC Women's Basketball regularly to the panel. In addition to the 35 members, the league's communications office will invite additional national and selected persons to the panel, including ACC television broadcasters.

Finally, all 15 league head coaches will receive one ballot to vote on preseason and postseason accolades; however, they will not be permitted to vote on a weekly basis or for their own student-athletes.

Following the conclusion of the regular season, the Blue Ribbon Panel will select a 10-member All-ACC First Team, a five-member All-ACC Second Team, an eight-member All-Freshman Team, as well as Player of the Year, Rookie of the Year and Coach of the Year. The league head coaches will also select their own 10-member All-ACC First Team, an eight-member All-ACC Second Team, an All-Freshman Team, Player of the Year, Rookie of the Year and Coach of the Year, as well as, the All-Defensive Team, Defensive Player, Sixth Player and Most Improved Player of the Year.

2019 ACC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT AND NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP REGIONAL



Greensboro, North Carolina and the Greensboro Coliseum will be the epicenter for women's basketball during the month of March as the ACC and the city of Greensboro will host the 2019 ACC Women's Basketball Tournament and a 2019 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship Regional.

The ACC Tournament will be held at the Greensboro Coliseum, for the 19th time in 20 years, on March 6-10, 2019. The Coliseum, with assistance from the Tournament Hosts of Greensboro, Greensboro Sports Commission and Convention and Visitors Bureau, is now set to play host to the tournament through 2023. Every attendance record for the 40-year-old tournament has been set at the Greensboro Coliseum, including the overall attendance mark of 73,187 in 2009. Overall attendance at the Greensboro Coliseum has exceeded 60,000 eight times since 2006.

The winner of the ACC Women's Basketball Tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. The tournament seeding and Conference Champion are determined by the 16-game regular-season ACC schedule.

The ACC and the Greensboro Coliseum will also host the 2019 NCAA women's regional on March 30-April 1. The Regional Semifinals are set for Saturday, March 30 at 11:30 and 2 p.m., and the Regional Final for 7 p.m. on Monday, April 1. The ACC was also awarded a NCAA Regional in 2022.

2018 ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE

The Atlantic Coast Conference women's basketball teams combined for eight wins over the Big Ten to win the 2018 ACC/Big Ten Challenge, 8-6. The Challenge title is the ninth in league history as the ACC owns a 9-0-3 advantage in the Challenge.

It's the third straight outright title for the ACC as the league owns a 89-61 advantage against the Big Ten in Challenge games.

This year's Challenge marked the 12th straight year of the event that pits the two perennially strong conferences against each other.

The ACC/Big Ten Women's Basketball Challenge matches teams from each conference in head-to-head competition, traditionally on the first Wednesday and Thursday after Thanksgiving following the ACC/Big Ten Men's Basketball Challenge.

The ACC and Big Ten conference offices determine the schedule each season, and the official title of the Challenge rotates each year. The 2018 event will be referred to as the ACC/Big Ten Women's Basketball Challenge and will continue to mirror the official title of the conferences' Challenge agreement for men's basketball.
