OPENING TIP: Quick Hits

- Davidson is in its 40th season and has collected 437 wins in program history.
- The 'Cats are in their fifth year in the Atlantic 10 after a 21-year run in the SoCon.
- Davidson was picked 11th in the A-10 preseason poll, while Justine Lyon was all-second team.
- 10 letterwinners return and three starters from a year ago, while three freshmen were added.
- Head coach Gayle Coats Fulks is in her second year (16-23) and has a 0-0 record against Clemson.

LAST GAME OUT AT ELON, DEC. 5 ...

- Despite overcoming deficits of 10 and eight points in the fourth quarter, Davidson was unable to overcome a four-point deficit in overtime and fell to Elon Wednesday, Dec. 5, in a 73-72 setback.
- Down 73-69 with 34 ticks left, Katie Turner canned a big three-ball from the left wing to get the 'Cats (4-5) within one with 19 seconds left. They then forced a turnover on Elon's possession and had a chance to win it, but missed two shots in the closing seconds.
- Davidson overcame deficits of 54-44 and 62-54 in the fourth quarter to force overtime.
- The 'Cats had a pair of double-doubles in the game coming from Justine Lyon (16 points/11 rebounds) and Sarah Donovan (16 points/10 rebounds).
- Turner scored a game-high 19 points and pocketed a career-best seven steals.

EARLY A-10 RANKINGS (12/10) ...

- Davidson currently ranks second in scoring (67.9), while holding down first place in free throw percentage (.731) and assists (14.2 per game), along with second place in three-pointers per game (7.0).
- Katie Turner (4th) ranks in the top-10 in scoring, while Sarah Donovan is tops in rebounding (10.3 per game), and Speight is second with 23 three-pointers and first at 2.6 per game.

WILDCAT ALL-TIME RECORD WATCH ...

- Justine Lyon became the 20th player in program history to reach 1,000 points last year and currently sits in 13th place all-time with 1,109. The senior ranks in the top-15 in five different categories, including field goal attempts (10th, 1,051), and free throws made (10th, 235) and attempted (10th, 340).
- Katie Turner sits in 11th place with 94 career three-pointers, while Kianna Speight is closely behind with 89 for her career for 13th place.

RANDOM NOTES ...

- Sarah Donovan has already set 12 single-game personal bests this year, including a 22-point outing vs. Appalachian State and a 15-rebound performance at Gardner-Webb.
- Donovan has five double-doubles already this season to give her eight on her career list.
- The sophomore is average a double-double on the year (13.1 ppg, 10.3 rpg).
- Davidson has dished out at least 18 assists in four of the nine games this season.
- Davidson pulled in a game-high 23 offensive rebounds at Elon, while hauling in a game-high 56 rebounds at Charl. Southern, 19 of which came on offense.
- The 56-rebound effort was the most since pulling in 55 at High Point, Nov. 24, 2015.
- Davidson drilled a season-best 11 three-pointers at Charl. Southern, the most since hitting 11 in a win at Virginia, Dec. 28, 2014. It also had 11 against Appalachian State.
- The 'Cats pocketed a season-high 18 steals at Elon, which was the most since a 20-steal game at Ga. Southern, 1/13/07.
- The Wildcats blocked nine shots at Charl. Southern, a personal-best three by Donovan.
- The 'Cats' 38-point win at CSU was its biggest since Jan. 23, 2013 in an 88-48 win over UNCG.
- The 34 points allowed at CSU was the least given up since a 38-point outing vs. Samford, 2/23/13.
- Davidson has had at least three double-digit scorers in eight of the nine games this year.

ALL-TIME SERIES VS. CLEMSON ...

- Davidson scored its first victory in the last meeting and is 1-3 since first meeting the Tigers in 1975.
- In the last meeting to open the 2013-14 season, Davidson earned its first win with a 77-57 road win behind Laura Murray's 22 points.

In the Last Meeting ... (Full Game Story)

CLEMSON, S.C. – Laura Murray, Hannah Early and Shneeka Center combined to score 60 points, and Davidson used a lengthy run in the second half to roll to a 77-57 season-opening win at Clemson Friday afternoon at Littlejohn Coliseum in women's basketball.

It was the Wildcats' first win over the Tigers in the series and their first season-opening victory since 2008-09 vs. Winthrop, all thanks to the trio of Murray, Early and Center.

Murray paced all scorers with a game-high 22 points, getting 12 of them at the charity stripe, which was a career-high.

Early had a career-best 20 points on 7-of-11 shooting, including a career-high 5-for-5 from behind the three-line. She helped the Wildcats drill home 10-of-15 triples for the game. Early did her damage in the first half, scoring 13 points including the first seven of the game for Davidson.

Center caught fire in the second half, scoring 14 of her 18 total points in the half. She canned a career-high four triples, three of them coming during the Wildcats' big run.

Dakota Dukes rounded out Davidson's double-digit scorers with 11 points and just missed a double-double, hauling in nine rebounds.

Clemson's Quinyotta Pettaway had a double-double with 17 points and 15 rebounds to pace the Tigers, while Chelsea Lindsay added 12 points.

After the Tigers erased Davidson's 37-31 lead early in the second half, both teams went back-and-forth trading the lead.

Then tied at 45-all in the second half with 12:27 to go, Center sparked the game-changing run when she canned a three-pointer on the right wing. The scoring continued for the senior as she scored 11 of the next 12 Wildcat points and 14 overall in a 20-3 run, capped off by another trey from Center, as Davidson opened up a 64-48 lead with 5:38 remaining.

Murray put the game away by scoring 12 of Davidson's final 15 points when it pushed the lead out to as many as 20 points.

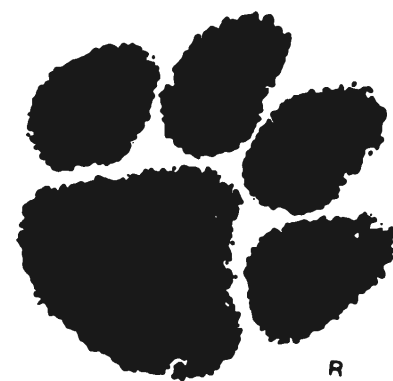
Davidson shot 52.2 percent in the second half, outscoring the Tigers 46-29, while turning the ball over just six times. The 'Cats' defense held the Tigers without a field goal for nearly 10 minutes in the second half as Clemson mustered just three free throws during Davidson's game-winning run.

Behind a pair of runs, the Wildcats grabbed a three-point lead (31-28) after the first half. Down 15-7 at the 11:10 mark, Davidson rattled off a 10-1 spurt in five minutes to take a 17-16 lead at the 6:03 mark to force Clemson into burning a timeout.

The Tigers responded, retaking the lead later at 24-17 on a Lindsay layup, but the Wildcats used their second big run of the half to grab the advantage at the break. Sparked by Early's second triple of the half, the 'Cats went on a 14-4 run in the final 3:30. The junior sharp-shooter canned her third three-pointer during the run and Alex Long capped it off with the Wildcats' fifth three-ball of the half to make it 31-28 heading into

the locker room.

GAME NOTES: Davidson improved to 9-26 in season openers all-time ... the Wildcats have opened the season on the road or at a neutral site 19 times, going 6-13 in those games ... Murray is 15 points away from moving into fifth place all-time in scoring with 1,285 points ... the win was Davidson's first against an ACC opponent since it defeat Wake Forest on the road, 82-75, Nov. 17, 1998.

HEAD COACH GAYLE COATS FULKS



On May 10, 2017, Davidson College Athletic Director Jim Murphy announced the hiring of Gayle Coats Fulks as the head coach for the Wildcat women's basketball program. She is the 12th head coach in the program's 38-year history.

Quick Highlights...

- Doubled Davidson's win total from previous season in first year as a head coach, going 12-18 in 2017-18 and a program-best 7-9 in the A-10.
- Earned her first career coaching victory with a 70-57 triumph at Western Carolina, Nov. 10.
- She became the third Wildcat head coach in the program's 39-year history to start a career with a win.
- Davidson set a new road winning streak mark in A-10 games, running off a three-game streak with wins at Richmond, St. Bonaventure and Rhode Island.
- During first year at Davidson, Mackenzie Latt earned A-10 All-Third Team honors and Katie Turner was named to the league's All-Rookie Team.
- She was recognized as one of WBCA's Thirty Under 30 honorees after fourth season at Wake Forest in 2015-16. The award is given annually to up-and-coming coaches 30 years old and younger, to recognize their involvement in community service, mentorship and impact on others' professional manner and attitude as well as association involvement.
- During tenure at Wake Forest, the Demon Deacons earned back-to-back postseason bids to the Women's NIT in 2016 and 2017, reaching the second round both seasons.
- Graduated from Fairleigh Dickinson in 2007, where she was a four-year letterwinner for the Knights.

Coach History...

It was a solid first year for Coats Fulks as a head coach at Davidson during the 2017-18 season. The Wildcats doubled their win total from the previous season by going 12-18 overall and a program-best 7-9 in Atlantic 10 play. Coats Fulks earned her first career coaching victory with a 70-57 triumph at Western Carolina, Nov. 10. She became the third Wildcat head coach in the program's 39-year history to start a career with a win. It was also Davidson's 10th straight win in the series vs. the Catamounts.

Along the way, other highlights included a home opening win vs. UNC Asheville, a thrilling win at Quarter Point by overcoming a 19-point third-quarter deficit and a victory against cross-county rival Charlotte that snapped an eight-game losing streak in the series. Davidson set a new road winning streak mark in A-10 games, running off a three-game streak with wins at Richmond, St. Bonaventure and Rhode Island.

During Coats Fulks first season, she saw senior Mackenzie Latt go over 1,500 career points and end her career third all-time in scoring to go with a second place finish in rebounds and made field goals. Latt was named to the A-10 All-Third Team, while Katie Turner earned a spot on the league's all-rookie team. Turner also set the single season record for made three-pointers with 75. Justine Lyon became the 20th Wildcat to reach 1,000 career points during Coats Fulks first season as well.

Coats Fulks came to Davidson from Wake Forest University, where she spent the five years as an assistant coach under Jen Hoover. The last two years (2015-16 & 2016-17) Wake Forest earned at-large bids to the Women's NIT, reaching the second round both seasons during Coats Fulks tenure.

During the 2016-17 season, the Demon Deacons went 17-16 overall and earned a win over Bethune-Cookman in the first round of the WNIT before falling to Middle Tennessee State to end their season. Guard Alex Sharp became the second student-athlete under Coats Fulks to be named to the Atlantic Coast Conference All-Freshman Team, joining fellow teammate Ariel Stephenson who garnered the award a year ago from the Blue Ribbon Panel and the league's coaches.

In addition to helping the Demon Deacons to consecutive NIT appearances the last two seasons, Coats Fulks was recognized during the 2015-16 campaign as one of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's (WBCA) Thirty Under 30 honorees. The award is given annually to up-and-coming coaches 30 years old and younger, to recognize their involvement in community service, mentorship and impact on others' professional manner and attitude as well as association involvement.

While on the bench for head coach Hoover for five seasons, Coats Fulks assisted in all aspects of the program, from academics to recruiting, where she served as an integral part to the Demon Deacons putting together ranked recruiting classes each year on staff.

In her first season with the Deacs, she helped guide one of the top-scoring backcourts in the Atlantic Coast Conference. Point guard Chelsea Douglas led the team in scoring at 14.6 points per game, while Lakevia Boykin was right behind her at 14.4 points. The two combined to make 134 three-

pointers on the season, with Douglas' 72 ranking as the third-most for a single-season in school history.

Coats Fulks joined the Wake Forest staff after one season as an assistant coach at UNC Greensboro in 2011-12. With the Spartans, Coats Fulks assisted with academics, recruiting, scouting, game preparation and practice planning, along with player development. She also served as the team's academic liaison.

Coats Fulks broke into the coaching ranks at Longwood University, where she was on staff from 2007-11. In her first season with the Lancers, they went 16-13, notching the program's best win total in its Division I era at the time.

Prior to her first collegiate job, Coats Fulks served as the Assistant Video Coordinator during the 2007 season for the WNBA's New York Liberty, where she assisted with scouting reports and film exchange.

A four-year letterwinner at Fairleigh Dickinson, Coats Fulks was a co-captain and member of the Northeast Conference All-Academic squad. She graduated in 2007 with a Bachelor of Science degree in business management.

Davidson made it five straight wins in the series vs. High Point after taking a 71-62 home win, Nov. 26. The Wildcats moved to 8-5 in the series behind a 19-point, 12-rebound effort from Sarah Donovan.

Balanced Offense Guides 'Cats To Win vs. W&M

Davidson snapped a three-game skid with a well-balanced offense behind five double-digit scorers in taking a 76-65 victory at home against William & Mary Saturday, Nov. 24.

Justine Lyon led the way with 17 points off the bench for the 'Cats (3-3), while Ally Welling and Kianna Speight each dropped in 14 points. Sarah Donovan had her third double-double of the season with 10 points and 10 rebounds, while adding five assists and three steals. Katie Turner rounded out the five double-figure scorers with 11 points.

Speight and Turner broke up a close game with back-to-back triples to turn a 65-63 lead into a 71-63 advantage with under two minutes to go.

Double Digits in the Books

For the first time this year, Davidson put five players in double figures in the points column during a home win vs. William & Mary, Nov. 24.

Twice this year Davidson has put four players in double figures in points in games against vs. Appalachian State, Nov. 17 and the season opener vs. Queens.

Friendly Helpers

Davidson had its fourth game of the season with over 15 assists when dished out 18 dimes vs. William & Mary, Nov. 24. Cassidy Gould had a season-best seven dimes, while Sarah Donovan had a career-high five.

The other three games this year were against Queens (19), Charleston Southern (19) and Appalachian State (19).

Double Digit From 3-Land

Davidson had its second game this season with double-digits from behind the arc when it drilled 11 threes at home vs. Appalachian State. The first double-figure game this season was at Charl. Southern with another 11 made three's. It was the most since the 'Cats hit 11 in a win at Virginia, Dec. 28, 2014.

Another 50-Rebound Effort

For the second game in a row, Davidson crashed the boards for a game-high 50 rebounds at Gardner-Webb, Nov. 14. It had 17 of the rebounds on offense on its way to 12 second-chance points.

The Wildcats were coming off a 56-rebound effort at Charleston Southern, which was the most since pulling in 55 boards at High Point, Nov. 24, 2015.

Davidson has three games now with over 40 rebounds, getting 47 in a season-opening win vs. Queens, Nov. 7.

Last year saw the Wildcats reach the 40-rebound mark 12 times.

13-Game Streak Halted for Turner
Sophomore Katie Turner had her personal-best 13-game streak of scoring in double figures come to an end at Gardner-Webb, Nov. 14, after a six point effort.

During the streak, which carried over from the final 11 games of the 2017-18 season, Turner averaged 14.8 points (192) and shot an impressive 42.3 percent (41-97) from behind the arc. She also dished out 49 assists (3.8 per game) and averaged 3.8 rebounds a game (49).

2-0 Start With BIG Win at Charleston Southern
Davidson had its first 2-0 start to the season for the first time since the 2013-14 campaign after scoring a 72-34 win at Charleston Southern, Nov. 11.

The 38-point win was the Wildcats biggest since a 40-point (88-48) victory against UNCG, Jan. 23, 2013. In addition, the 34 points allowed was the least given up since holding Samford to 38, Feb. 23, 2013.

'Cats Start Season With Win Over Queens, 80-47

Sophomore Katie Turner led four Wildcats in double figures with a game-high 21 points and the Davidson women's basketball team won its season opener, 80-47, for the second straight year, Nov. 7.

The 33-point win was the biggest since a 40-point triumph vs. UNCG, Jan. 23, 2013.

Joining Turner in double digits was Kianna Speight (14 points), Cassidy Gould (12) and Kelly Fitzgerald (11, career-high). Sarah Donovan crashed the boards with a game-high 12, one off her personal best. She also dished out a career-high five dimes.

Davidson used a 13-0 run in the first quarter to go up 15, led 35-25 at the half, then pulled away with a 29-9 advantage in the third quarter, which included 11 straight

Wildcat points and a 1-of-12 shooting effort by the Royals.

20-Plus Made Free Throws
Davidson reached the 20-free throw mark for the first time this year by going 21-of-28 in a win vs. Queens, Nov. 7.

Five times last year the Wildcats hit at least 20 free throws in a game.

Home Openers
In the program's 39-year history, the Wildcats are now 19-19 overall in home openers (two of the year's results are incomplete) after scoring a 80-47 win vs. Queens, Nov. 7. Davidson improved to 9-4 the last 13 years in home openers.

Season Openers
During the Wildcats' 39-year history, they have gone 12-28 in season-openers after opening the 2018-19 campaign at home vs. Queens, Nov. 7. The Wildcats rolled to an 80-47 win behind Katie Turner's 21 points.

Since the program was restarted in 1992-93, they have gone 10-17 and played some pretty tough competition. The 'Cats have faced the likes of top programs in North Carolina (three times), Duke, Vanderbilt, Nebraska, Michigan State (twice), Boston College, Arkansas-Little Rock and Clemson (twice).

During that time period ('92-93), Davidson has opened on the road or at a neutral site 23 times with a 8-15 record in those games.

A-10 Preseason Honors For Lyon

The Atlantic 10 Conference released its annual women's basketball preseason rankings as well as all-conference and defensive teams, Oct. 23. For the third year in a row, the Wildcats placed a player on the preseason team with senior guard Justine Lyon earning her second straight preseason all-

Junior Justine Lyon became the 20th player in program history to reach the 1,000-point mark when she went off for a game-high 22 points in a regular season finale win at home vs. VCU, Feb. 24. She reached the mark when she swished home her first basket, a three-pointer, in the first quarter.

It marks the 11th year in the past 12 that a Wildcat has scored 1,000 points for their career. Last year saw Mackenzie Latt reach the milestone to become the 19th player.

Hall of Famer Jennifer O'Brien's Jersey Retired During Dayton Game

Former Wildcat great and a Davidson Hall of Famer Jennifer O'Brien had her jersey retired during halftime of the Dayton home, Jan. 27. O'Brien becomes the second player in the program's history to have their jersey retired, joining Sarah Womack.

At the time of graduating, she was the school's all-time scoring leader and is now currently third with 1,510 points. A first-team All-Southern Conference pick in 1998 and 2000, O'Brien still owns the school's all-time marks for assists (588) and steals (368), while holding single-game records for steals (11) and assists (13).
