ACC NOTABLES

• The ACC has four No. 1-ranked teams in men's and women's basketball and football at the same time: Men's Basketball - Duke (AP), Virginia (Coaches); Women's Basketball - Notre Dame (AP & Coaches) and Football - Clemson (AP & Coaches).

• The ACC is the first league since 2015 to have the No. 1 team in the AP Polls in football (Clemson), men's basketball (Duke) and women's basketball (Notre Dame) at the same time.

• The ACC has won the most national titles (six) in football, men's basketball, women's basketball and baseball since 2015. The next closest is the SEC with four. The ACC is the only conference to win one of each of the four titles over that stretch.

• The ACC enters the week with the No. 1 RPI in the nation. 10 ACC teams are in the top 50 of the RPI through games played on Jan. 14 (the most of any league - next closest SEC with eight).

• Syracuse's Tiana Mangakahia earned USBWA National Player of the Week and ACC Player of the Week honors after recording the first points-rebounds-assists triple-double in Syracuse program history with a season-high 34 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists in Orange's 90-77 win over North Carolina on Sunday. It was the first triple-double in ACC play since former Louisville guard Mariya Moore registered 11 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists in a win over Syracuse on Dec. 29, 2016, and just the 29th overall in ACC women's basketball history.

• Mangakahia owns 128 assists for the season and is averaging 8.0 assists per game, which ranks third nationally. Mangakahia set the ACC's single season assists record last season with 304 assists.

• Clemson is 3-1 in ACC play, which includes road wins at RV/23 and 22/18 Florida State. The Tigers have not started the conference slate with a 3-1 record (or better) since the 1997-98 season when Clemson went 4-0 to open conference play.

• Five from the ACC have been named to the Wooden Award Midseason Watch List - Louisville's Asia Durr, Syracuse's Tiana Mangakahia, and Notre Dame's Arike Ogunbowale, Jessica Shepard and Jackie Young.

• With a 17-0 record, NC State is off to its best start in program history. The Wolfpack is the only undefeated team in NCAA Division I.

• Four ACC teams are ranked in both the AP and USA Today/Coaches polls, with all four in the top 12. Notre Dame is the top ranked team in both polls for the second consecutive week, followed by No. 4/4 Louisville, No. 8/8 NC State and No. 12/12 Syracuse. Florida State is No. 21 in the USA Today/Coaches Poll, giving the ACC five ranked teams this week.

• The ACC has two active 2,000 point scorers - Louisville's Asia Durr and Notre Dame's Arike Ogunbowale. Ogunbowale owns 2,142 points for her career, which ranks 15th all-time on the ACC's career scoring list, while Durr's 2,086 points are good for 21st all-time.

• Notre Dame senior guard Arike Ogunbowale leads the league in scoring with 21.5 points per game. She owns five 30-point performances this season and has scored 20-or-more points 11 times. Nine-time ACC Player of the Week Asia Durr of Louisville follows with 21.4 points per game. Those scoring averages rank 11th and 12th in the nation, respectively.

• The ACC owns 158 non-conference wins, the most of any league, and the third best non-conference winning percentage (.793). The ACC's has 10 teams with double-digit win totals, the most of any league.

• The ACC owns 12 wins over non-conference ranked opponents with eight teams winning at least one game versus a Top 25 foe.

• Notre Dame's Muffet McGraw earned her 900th career win on Sunday, Dec. 30, against Lehigh. McGraw is the ninth coach in NCAA women's basketball history (all divisions) to reach 900 wins. She is one of 16 men's or women's coaches with at least 900 career wins.

• North Carolina head coach Sylvia Hatchell set the ACC's all-time wins record with the Tar Heels' victory over UNCG on Dec. 14. Hatchell, in her 33rd season at North Carolina, passed former Virginia head coach Debbie Ryan (739) on the ACC's all-time victories list. Hatchell is 742-317 at North Carolina.

Defending NCAA champion and four-time Atlantic Coast Conference champion Notre Dame is again the ACC Women's Basketball preseason favorite, according to separate polls of the league's Blue Ribbon Panel and its 15 head coaches.

WEEKLY/SEASON AWARDS

The Atlantic Coast Conference's "Blue Ribbon Panel," consisting of national and local media members, as well as school representatives, will vote for the league's preseason poll, weekly honors and postseason All-Conference team for the 2018-19 season.

The ACC, with nominations from its 15 member institutions, will designate approximately 35 media members who cover ACC Women's Basketball regularly to the panel. In addition to the 35 members, the league's communications office will invite additional national and selected persons to the panel, including ACC television broadcasters.

Finally, all 15 league head coaches will receive one ballot to vote on preseason and postseason accolades; however, they will not be permitted to vote on a weekly basis or for their own student-athletes.

Following the conclusion of the regular season, the Blue Ribbon Panel will select a 10-member All-ACC First Team, a five-member All-ACC Second Team, an eight-member All-Freshman Team, as well as Player of the Year, Rookie of the Year and Coach of the Year. The league head coaches will also select their own 10-member All-ACC First Team, an eight-member All-ACC Second Team, an All-Freshman Team, Player of the Year, Rookie of the Year and Coach of the Year, as well as, the All-Defensive Team, Defensive Player, Sixth Player and Most Improved Player of the Year.

2019 ACC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT AND NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP REGIONAL



Greensboro, North Carolina and the Greensboro Coliseum will be the epicenter for women's basketball during the month of March as the ACC and the city of Greensboro will host the 2019 ACC Women's Basketball Tournament and a 2019 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship Regional.

The ACC Tournament will be held at the Greensboro Coliseum, for the 19th time in 20 years, on March 6-10, 2019. The Coliseum, with assistance from the Tournament Hosts of Greensboro, Greensboro Sports Commission and Convention and Visitors Bureau, is now set to play host to the tournament through 2023. Every attendance record for the 40-year-old tournament has been set at the Greensboro Coliseum, including the overall attendance mark of 73,187 in 2009. Overall attendance at the Greensboro Coliseum has exceeded 60,000 eight times since 2006.

The winner of the ACC Women's Basketball Tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. The tournament seeding and Conference Champion are determined by the 16-game regular-season ACC schedule.

The ACC and the Greensboro Coliseum will also host the 2019 NCAA women's regional on March 30-April 1. The Regional Semifinals are set for Saturday, March 30 at 11:30 and 2 p.m., and the Regional Final for 7 p.m. on Monday, April 1. The ACC was also awarded a NCAA Regional in 2022.

2018 ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE

The Atlantic Coast Conference women's basketball teams combined for eight wins over the Big Ten to win the 2018 ACC/Big Ten Challenge, 8-6. The Challenge title is the ninth in league history as the ACC owns a 9-0-3 advantage in the Challenge.

It's the third straight outright title for the ACC as the league owns a 89-61 advantage against the Big Ten in Challenge games.

This year's Challenge marked the 12th straight year of the event that pits the two perennially strong conferences against each other.

The ACC/Big Ten Women's Basketball Challenge matches teams from each conference in head-to-head competition, traditionally on the first Wednesday and Thursday after Thanksgiving following the ACC/Big Ten Men's Basketball Challenge.

The ACC and Big Ten conference offices determine the schedule each season, and the official title of the Challenge rotates each year. The 2018 event will be referred to as the ACC/Big Ten Women's Basketball Challenge and will continue to mirror the official title of the conferences' Challenge agreement for men's basketball.
