Marcus Parker Notes

- Enrolled at Clemson in January as mid-year transfer from Eastern New Mexico University
- Tigers' top short sprinter; leads teams in both 100m and 200m dashes this season
- Ranks first in ACC in 200m (20.33) and fourth in the 100m (10.28)
- His time of 20.33 in the outdoor 200m is good for sixth in program history
- Placed fourth in prelims at 2019 ACC Indoor Championships in the 200m (21.22) before being disqualified in finals
- Typically runs second leg of 4x100m, which ranks second in ACC and 25th in Division I

- Competed as a freshman on the Tigers' 4x400m relay at 2018 NCAA Outdoor Championships
- Member of 2018 ACC Indoor Champion 4x400m team as a freshman
- Has earned All-ACC status on four occasions (First Team 1x, Second Team 3x) in three meets

- PR'd in the 60mH to earn runner-up status at the 2019 ACC Indoor Championships

- Clemson's program record holder in both the indoor and outdoor long jump
- Five-time All-ACC recipient (3x First Team)

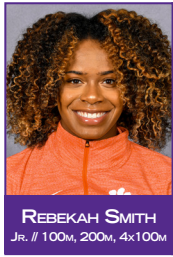

- Ranks second all-time in CU history and achieved Clemson's best throw since 1982

- Ranks inside Clemson's top-10 in the 60m, 100m, and the indoor 200m dashes.
- Her PR of 11.22 seconds in the 100m dash is second all-time in program history
- Finished in third in both the 100m and 200m dashes at last year's ACC Championship
- 2017 ACC 60m dash champion
- Has typically run second leg of the Tigers' 4x100m relay

- Has been nursing an soreness in her achilles all season long

- [Had open-heart surgery](#) in high school due to lack of blood flow



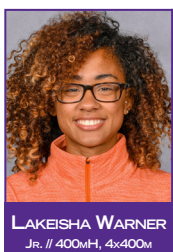

- Ranks second in both the indoor and outdoor shot put in program history
- Redshirted 2017-18 season after transferring from New Mexico Highlands (Division II)
