SERIES HISTORY VS. DETROIT MERCY

· Clemson and Colgate have never played a game against each other.

Head coach Brad Brownell, however, has coached against Mike Davis before, including just two seasons ago when Davis brought his Texas Southern team to Clemson - an 84-77 victory for the Tigers.

Brownell was 2-0 against Davis while Davis was coaching Texas Southern.

· Brownell also got the best of Davis in his second-tolast season at UAB.

• The Tigers topped the Blazers 70-52 in the First Four of the NCAA Tournament in 2011.

Clemson is 6-2 all-time against members of the Horizon League, including a 75-69 victory just last season in the first round of the NIT against Wright State (March 19, 2019).

TIGERS SWIPE 13 STEALS

· Clemson came away with 13 steals in its 81-68 win over Colgate on Nov. 10.

• The 13 steals were the most in a game for Clemson since swiping 15 in an 84-67 win over Lipscomb last season (Dec. 30, 2018).

The year prior in 2017-18, the Tigers stole 15 passes in a 74-69 overtime win over Louisville (Jan. 6, 2018).

 Besides those two instances, it is the third-most steals in a game for Clemson under head coach Brad Brownell since they notched 16 (the most under coach Brownell) against The Citadel on Jan. 1, 2013.

Tevin Mack came up with five steals against Colgate (Nov. 10) - his career-best to date.

Mack is the first Tiger to garner five steals in a game since Marcquise Reed stole five in a 67-55 win over Syracuse last season (March 9, 2019).

 Reed achieved five steals on three separate occasions last season.

· Mack is just the second Clemson player since the 2015-16 season to garner at least five steals in a game. · Avry Holmes stole six against Georgia Tech that season (Feb. 13, 2016).

AAMIR SIMMS IN THE POST

• One of Clemson's most versatile players captured his first career double-double in the season opener against Virginia Tech.

 Simms posted 12 points and 15 rebounds in a stellar performance to open the season.

• The 15 rebounds for Simms was a new career-best, outdoing his 10-rebound game last season at Duke (Jan. 5.2019).

• Simms posted yet another double-digit scoring game with 12 points against Colgate (Nov. 10). He narrowly missed a double-double with eight rebounds, however, of the eight boards, four were on the offensive glass - tying a career high.

• As of right now, Simms is averaging 10.3 rebounds per contest.

· The last Tiger to average double-digits on the boards was Sharone Wright (1993-94 - 10.6 rebounds per game).

 Wright was a 1994 NBA First Round Draft Pick. The highest in Clemson history at sixth overall - selected by the Philadelphia 76ers.

HELLO NEWMAN...

· John Newman III has gotten off to a lightning fast start this season posting career-highs in back-to-back games to open the year.

 Newman upped his previous career-best of 15 points against Virginia Tech (Nov. 5) and poured in 16 in a win against Presbyterian (Nov. 7).

The 16-point outing was Newman's second doubledigit scoring game of his career.

· Against the Blue Hose, Newman connected on a career-best six made field goals and three 3-point field goals. He also posted a career-high three assists.

· Newman connected on five made field goals and finished a perfect 4-for-4 at the foul line against Virginia Tech.

· So far this season, Newman holds the longest streak at the foul line - five made in a row.

CLEMSON TOUGH TO BEAT WHEN ALLOWING 50 OR LESS POINTS

 In Brad Brownell's tenure as head coach at Clemson. the Tigers are a combined 44-2 when they allow 50 or less points to its opponent.

• The Tigers have won their last 23 contests in which they have allowed 50 or less points (23-0).

• In just the Tigers' second game of the 2019-20 season, they held Presbyterian to just 45 points, marking the first time this season they have held an opponent under the 50-point threshold.

• Clemson went 4-0 during 2018-19 in such games.

 The Tigers topped Pittsburgh with a 62-48 victory on the road on Feb. 27.

· Clemson rolled Georgia Tech on the road on Feb. 6, 65-42, and clinching the fewest points allowed in consecutive ACC games in Clemson history.

 The Tigers dominated Wake Forest on Feb. 3, 64-37. holding the Demon Deacons to the lowest point total allowed in an ACC game under Brownell.

• The 37 points ties Georgia Tech from a Feb. 21, 2012, 56-37, Tiger victory.

· The 40th win came on Nov. 20 in the Cayman Islands

2019-20 THREE-POINT LINE

• The 3-point line will be extended by approximately 1 foot, 8 inches to the same distance used by FIBA for international competition (22 feet, 1.75 inches).

 The previous 3-point line was moved back prior to the 2008-09 season (20 feet, 9 inches).

• For 21 years, the 3-point line stood at 19 feet, nine inches from 1986-87 to 2007-08.

· The 3-point line was first introduced to college basketball during the 1982-83 season and stood at 17 feet, nine inches. The Tigers played with that distance in 15 ACC games and a game against Presbyterian.

• Also that season, the Tigers played three contests in the Alaska Shootout with an experimental distance of what would become the new 3-point line distance in 1986-87 (19 feet, 9 inches).

· The only losses on the record are losses to Virginia (49-47, Feb. 2, 2011) and Miami (45-43, Feb. 17, 2013).

FRESHMEN EMPHASIS

• Head coach Brad Brownell is starting an all-freshmen backcourt this season with Al-Amir Dawes and Chase Hunter.

• This marks the first time that Brownell has started a freshman since 2014-15 when Donte Grantham started his first career game as a Tiger.

• The year prior to Grantham, Brownell started Jaron Blossomgame as a rookie in 2013-14.

• Other recent instances of one freshman starting their rookie year: Demontez Stitt (2007-08), Trevor Booker (2006-07), K.C. Rivers (2005-06).

• The last time that Clemson had two freshmen primarily in the starting lineup was 2004-05 when guard Cliff Hammonds and forward Cheyenne Moore shared that privilege.

• The 1995-96 season was unique in Clemson history in that, then-head coach Rick Barnes started four freshmen and one sophomore. Among the freshmen starting that season, current director of player development and second all-time leading scorer Terrell McIntyre.

• You'd have to go all the way back to the 1943-44 season for the last time the Tigers primarily started freshmen in the backcourt.

• Eddis Freeman and Leonard Riddle started most of that season in the backcourt and combined for 18.4 points per game.

Dawes and Hunter combined for 18 points in their

debut as Tigers.

FIRST FRESHMEN TIGERS SINCE...

• As noted above, the last time freshmen primarily started in the backcourt was the 1943-44 season.

However, Clemson has started freshmen in the backcourt since then, but just not on a regular basis.
The last time the Tigers started both freshmen in the

backcourt was Feb. 27, 1991. A 79-62 loss at Duke.

• Jimmy Mason and Andrew Bovain started for the Tigers at Cameron Indoor Stadium.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

In addition to both freshmen in the backcourt, the Tigers start a sophomore, junior and a graduate transfer.
With the exception of a graduate transfer, the Tigers' bench is primarily made up of freshmen and sophomores.
According to Ken Pomeroy, the Tigers' boast an

experience ranking of 1.27 which stands 295th in the country (out of 351 programs). • This means that Clemeon is valued as one of the

• This means that Clemson is valued as one of the youngest teams in the country, including the fourth-youngest in the ACC.

• The experience value is in terms of years of college experience where a player's eligibility class is assumed to determine this.

• For the purposes of calculation, a freshman has zero years of experience, a sophomore has one year, etc.

• The experience also weights the experience of each player on the roster based on minutes played. Players that have played less than 10% of their team's minutes are not included.

BRAD BROWNELL ENTERS YEAR 10

• Head coach Brad Brownell will look to become Clemson's all-time wins leader this season.

• He needs just six victories to tie and seven to pass Cliff Ellis for the all-time leader at Clemson.

• Brownell won his 157th career game as the head coach at Clemson against Charleston Southern (Dec. 18).

"It's no secret that we needed to add depth to our backcourt and our staff is super excited about Al-Amir, Chase and Alex. They all bring unique skill sets to our team and we believe they will complement each other very well on the floor."

• Dawes is a 6-2 guard from Newark, N.J. and was rated as a four-star prospect according to both ESPN and 247Sports.

• ESPN has Dawes was ranked No. 95 in its Top 100 for the 2019 signing class when he signed with Clemson.

• He was rated the 5th-best prospect in New Jersey, 15th nationally at the point guard position and 24th overall on the east coast.

CLEMSON, S.C. - Clemson University men's basketball fell in its season opener to Virginia Tech, 67-60.

Aamir Simms led the charge for the Tigers with his first career double-double. Simms finished with 12 points and 15 rebounds.

The Tigers (0-1, 0-1) knocked down seven 3-pointers and shot 34.0 percent from the field, outscoring the Hokies (1-0, 1-0) 22-16 in the paint. Clemson also forced 13 turnovers, but Virginia Tech added 11 fast-break points.

With a career-high 15 rebounds to go along with his 12 points, Simms notched a double-double for the first time in his career. Four different Clemson players reached double figures on the night. John Newman III scored a career-best 15 points and freshman Al-Amir Dawes and graduate senior Tevin Mack scored 12 and 11 points, respectively, in their Clemson debuts.

A true freshman, Dawes made an emphatic introduction to the Littlejohn faithful by knocking down a trey for the game's opening points. 3-pointers by Mack on back-to-back possessions placed Clemson ahead 26-22. The Tigers led by as many as eight points in the first half and led 37-34 at the intermission. The evenly matched first half saw both teams shoot 44.0 percent from the floor and corral 19 rebounds apiece. The Hokies' Landers Nolley II was the contest's leading scorer with 30 points.

Newman braced the Tigers with 11 second-half points. A defensive war of attrition gave way to a frenetic ending to the second half. Not long after Clemson's intense pressure forced a backcourt turnover, Newman knotted the score at 57-57 with 1:11 remaining, but the Hokies outscored the Tigers 10-3 the rest of the way.

CLEMSON, S.C. – Taking Presbyterian College to task from beyond the arc, Clemson University men's basketball knocked down 14 3-pointers and won 79-45 at Littlejohn Coliseum on Thursday. The Tigers were led by John Newman III, who scored a career-best 16 points on a career-high six made field goals.

The Tigers (1-1) went 14-of-34 on 3-point shots and shot 46.0 percent from the floor. Ten different Tigers scored on the evening, with 32 of Clemson's points coming from its bench. The Tigers also scored 32 points in the paint, making for a well-rounded offensive showing.

In addition to Newman's career night, his three deep balls also marked a career high. Curran Scott made a splash with 13 points and a trio of treys. Tevin Mack added 14 points and Chase Hunter went 3-for-5 from 3-point land in a 13-point performance. Hunter also finished an ultra-impressive +40 on the floor. Chris Martin was the Blue Hose's (0-1) leading scorer with 11 points.

Newman sparked the Tigers with two early 3-pointers, as Clemson used a 4-0 run to go up 21-5 at the 10:01 mark of the first half. An 8-0 Clemson run to close out the first half was capped off by a thunderous dunk from Newman that resulted in the Tigers boasting a 43-21 lead at the intermission.

Among others, center Trey Jemison, who corralled four total rebounds, provided a lift off the bench for the Tigers in the second half with solid rebounding and defensive play. Parker Fox, O'Neil McBride and Paul Grinde, all walk-ons, were able to get minutes. Fox scored two points and McBride tallied his first career rebound.

Clemson was able to coast to victory out of halftime, outscoring Presbyterian 36-24 en route to winning by a 34-point margin.

CLEMSON, S.C. – In a game of runs, the Clemson University men's basketball team used a late 19-6 run to pull away away from Colgate at Littlejohn Coliseum on Sunday. Clemson won 81-68 in a non-conference matchup that featured four different Clemson players scoring in double figures.

The Tigers (2-1) were efficient on offense in the victory, shooting 51.6 percent from the floor and making the most of Colgate's 18 turnovers. The Tigers amassed 30 points off turnovers and racked up 46 points in the paint. Clemson also outrebounded Colgate by a margin of nine boards.

Tevin Mack was the leading scorer on the afternoon with 17 points on 7-of-11 shooting. Mack was a force to be reckoned with on the glass too, corralling a gamehigh nine rebounds. Freshman Al-Amir Dawes scored 16 points to go along with his four assists, and Aamir Simms tallied 12 points and eight rebounds. In addition, John Newman III scored nine points and accrued a career-best seven rebounds, and freshman Chase Hunter finished with 10 points. Colgate's leading scorer was Tucker Richardson, who registered 16 points.

Clemson's first three baskets of the game were three consecutive 3-pointers from Mack. The Tigers used a 9-0 run to take a 28-19 lead at the 5:47 mark of the first half, a half that contained several runs. Colgate put together a 7-0 run to cut its deficit to two points before Clemson closed out the first half on an 8-2 run.

The Raiders (1-1) were able to battle back after trailing 38-30 at the intermission and took the lead during the course of the second half. Clemson remained composed, though, and relied on fast-break buckets and post play to retake the lead and pull away from Colgate. A corner 3-ball from Dawes effectively iced the game, putting the Tigers ahead 74-66 with 1:53 remaining.
