THREE POINTERS

- Colgate opens a tough road stretch against three straight Power Five opponents on Sunday at Clemson. This will be the second head-to-head meeting between the two teams and first since 1979.
- The Raiders got off to a strong start with an 80-75 victory over NJIT in their season opener Wednesday, avenging last year's season-opening 81-78 overtime loss to the Highlanders in Newark, New Jersey.
- Colgate's 80 points were its most in a season opener against a Division I opponent since scoring the same amount against Dartmouth in 1997. Four Raiders finished in double figures, led by senior forward Rapolas Ivanauskas, who posted a game-high 24 to go with eight rebounds.

A COLGATE WIN WOULD...

- » Give the Raiders their first 2-0 start under head coach Matt Langel and first overall since 2008.
- » Lead the Raiders to their first victory over a Power Five school since defeating Ole Miss 53-51 in 1995.
- » Be Colgate's first win over an ACC opponent since a 67-63 triumph over Syracuse on Feb. 24, 1962.

MATCHUP PREVIEW

- » Colgate heads to South Carolina for its first ACC matchup since Dec. 29 of last year at Pittsburgh. The Raiders also faced Syracuse in 2018.
- » This will be the first Colgate-Clemson meeting since 1979, when the Tigers claimed a 110-73 triumph on their home court. The Raiders are 52-148 all-time against ACC opponents, with 45 of those victories against Syracuse.
- » Colgate was the unanimous favorite to repeat in the Patriot League preseason poll.
- » The Raiders are coming off an 80-75 victory over NJIT in the season opener Wednesday. Rapolas Ivanauskas scored 24 points in the win.
- » Clemson, playing its third game in five days, was picked 11th in the ACC preseason poll.
- » The Tigers are 1-1 after a 79-45 triumph over Presbyterian on Thursday. Clemson opened its season with a 67-60 loss at home on Tuesday. John Newman III has led the Tigers in scoring in both games with 15 and 16 points, respectively.

PICKING UP WHERE WE LEFT OFF

- » Four Raiders finished in double figures in Colgate's season-opening 80-75 win over NJIT. The Raiders led by as many as 19 but the Highlanders came all the way back and claimed a late 69-68 lead.
- » The Raiders closed out the final four minutes on a 12-6 run to seal the deal. Rapolas Ivanauskas led the Raiders with 24 points, while Will Rayman had a double-double with 18 points and 12 rebounds.

DEFENDING CHAMPS

- » Colgate claimed its first Patriot League regular season and tournament titles since 1996 last season, setting program records in total wins (24) and league victories (13) while going 15-1 at home.
- » The Raiders started the season 5-5 in Patriot League play before rattling off eight straight wins in the regular season to earn a share of the regular-season title with Bucknell.
- » Colgate won the tiebreaker and No. 1 seed in the Patriot League Tournament, extending its winning streak to 11 with playoff wins over Boston U., Navy, and Bucknell. The Raiders put it all together in the championship game with a 94-80 thrashing of the two-time defending champion Bison.

DANCED OUR SHOES OFF

- » Dancing for the first time since 1996, Colgate made its presence known. The Raiders earned the No. 15 seed and squared off with sixth-ranked Tennessee in the first round in Columbus, Ohio.
- » The Vols led by as many as 16 points in the first half, but Colgate came roaring back on the strength of its 3-point shooting, as five different players knocked down a triple in a run that carried the Raiders to a 52-50 lead in the second half.
- » Tennessee regained a slight advantage but the Raiders were within striking distance, 67-64, until All-SEC guard Admiral Schofield hit back-to-back 3-pointers in the final two minutes to seal a 77-70 narrow decision.

BURNS, BABY BURNS

- » Jordan Burns was smoking hot over his last two games of last season, averaging 33.5 points between the Patriot League Championship and NCAA Tournament first round matchup.
- » He lit up Cotterell Court with a Patriot League record and career-high 35 points in the title game on 10-of-16 from the field and 6-of-9 from downtown.
- » Burns followed that up with a game-high 32 points against Tennessee on 12-of-20 from the field and a blistering 8-of-13 from beyond the arc.
- » His 32 points were the second-most in any NCAA Tournament game last season, and it landed him a clip on CBS' infamous One Shining Moment.

EYES ON IVANAUSKAS

- » Senior Rapolas Ivanauskas after being named an honorable mention AP All-American last year was recently placed on the Lou Henson Watch List.
- » The reigning Patriot League Player of the Year averaged 16 points and eight rebounds per game with 10 double-doubles.
- » Ivanauskas is off to a strong start in 2019-20 with his 12th game of 20 or more points in a Raider uniform. He scored a game-high 24 and hauled in eight rebounds against NJIT on Nov. 6.
- » Ivanauskas has scored in double figures in 13 of his last 14 games, with the lone outlier a scoreless outing in the NCAA Tournament in which he was forced to leave early with an eye issue.

EVERYBODY LOVES RAYMAN

- » Will Rayman has helped rebuild the Colgate men's basketball program during his tenure.
- » The New York native followed up Patriot League Rookie of the Year honors in 2016 with back-to-back All-Patriot League seasons.
- » He currently finds himself closing in on a pair of Colgate program records, sitting in the top 10 in both career scoring and 3-pointers made.
- » He became Colgate's 34th member of the 1,000-point club on Nov. 14 of last season.

- » Jordan Burns and Rapolas Ivanauskas were both named to the five-player preseason All-League Team, which was announced Oct. 16.
- » Bucknell was picked second in the poll with 130 points, while American was third with 126.

WHO'S RETURNING?

- » Colgate returns its top five leading scorers from a season ago, and the Raiders add junior Bowling Green transfer Nelly Cummings who is coming off his one-year hiatus due to NCAA transfer regulations.
- » Those returning scoring leaders include Jordan Burns, Will Rayman, Tucker Richardson, Rapolas Ivanauskas, and Jack Ferguson. The first four were starters and earned All-League honors last season.
- » Zach Light is back for his sophomore campaign after seeing action in 15 games as a freshman last season. Light shot 50 percent from the field (6-for-12) in limited time, averaging 1.1 points per game.
- » Other returners include David Maynard and Milan Williams, who were both sidelined all of last season with Achilles tears. Both of their injuries occurred in the spring of 2018, but they are expected to make a full return this season.

TRIP OF A LIFETIME

- » Colgate got to experience the trip of a lifetime with 10 days in Italy Aug. 8-17. The Raiders during their tour spent days in Rome, Florence, Pisa, Cinque Terre, and Siena as part of their first tour since Spain 2015.
- » Players, coaches, staff, and family members experienced panoramic guides, landmark tours, and a unique culture through various daily activities.
- » The Raiders capped the trip off with a perfect 3-0 record on the court with dominant victories against local semi-professional programs.
- » Colgate opened its tour with three days in Rome Aug. 9-11. While in Rome, the Raiders visited the Sistine Chapel in Vatican City and the Rome Colloseum to go with a pair of victories on the court.
- » Two days in Florence followed, which mostly consisted of guided tours and free time around the city.
- » The Raiders continued their trip with two days in Pisa, highlighted by visits to the Leaning Tower of Pisa and the Pisa Baptistery. The team climbed the 300-plus staircase to soak in the sights from the top of the imposing tower.
- » A free day in Cinque Terre came next, before the Raiders capped off their trip with a one-day visit to Siena.
- » Coach Langel said the most important thing he learned about his team and the trip was how meaningful experiences like this can be in the growth of a group.

SCHEDULE AT A GLANCE

- » Colgate has another difficult non-conference schedule, featuring three Power Five opponents and three teams coming off NCAA Tournament Appearances. The Raiders right out of the gates open a three-game road swing at Clemson, Syracuse, and Final Four participant Auburn Nov. 10-18.
- » Later in December, Colgate visits two-time defending AAC Champion Cincinnati, who was with the Raiders in the Columbus region of last season's NCAA Tournament.
- » The Raiders for the first time are competing in the Legends Classic presented by Old Trapper, and will play two games in Green Bay, Wis., against Cal State Northridge and the host Phoenix (Nov. 24-26).

FOUR GAMES TO AIR NATIONALLY ON CBS SPORTS NETWORK

- » Colgate's four nationally-televised games matches Army for the most in the league. The two teams meet for the first CBS Sports Network game of the conference season on Monday, Jan. 6, in West Point.
- » CBSSN is coming to Hamilton for the Raiders' date against Bucknell on Monday, Jan. 20, in what will be the first matchup since the Raiders knocked off the Bison 94-80 in the Patriot League title game on March 13.
- » Colgate road games at Holy Cross (Feb. 1) and Boston University (Feb. 10) will both be aired on CBSSN. The Patriot League also announced a flex game on the final day of the regular season on Saturday, Feb. 29.
- » The Patriot League Tournament semifinals and championship will both be aired on CBSSN for the ninth consecutive season.

Building a Winning Culture

Matt Langel continues to establish a winning tradition for a Colgate Basketball program that is competing for Patriot League championships.

Since arriving in Hamilton in 2011, Langel has mentored a Patriot League Player of the Year, Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year, two Patriot League Rookies of the Year, 13 All-Patriot League picks, four Patriot League All-Rookie members, four All-District honorees, and an AP All-American honorable mention.

The Raiders are 54-36 against Patriot League competition over the last five seasons. Colgate has finished in the top half of the Patriot League in each of the last five seasons, including a first-place finish in 2018-19 and two second-place finishes.

Professional Development

Langel has aided in the development of 13 professional basketball players, including recent student-athletes Alex Ramon '16, Austin Tillotson '16, Tom Rivard '18, Dylan Whitbread '18, Jordan Swopshire '18, Sean O'Brien '18, Jordan Robertson '18, and Francisco Amiel '19.

Colgate has rewarded Langel with back-to-back contract extensions after repeating as the Patriot League Coach of the Year and adding NABC District 13 and ECAC Coach of the Year honors in 2018-19.

Magical 2018-19 Season

The new deal comes after Colgate set program records in 2019 in wins (24), league wins (13), and home wins (15) on its way to its first Patriot League title since 1996. Langel, who is entering his ninth season at the helm, is now under contract through the 2026-27 season.

Colgate's magical 2018-19 season finished 24-11 overall and 13-5 in the Patriot League. Langel led Colgate back to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 23 years with eight straight wins to claim the Patriot League regular-season title and No. 1 seed in the conference tournament.

Colgate went on to sweep the Patriot League Tournament, rallying the Hamilton community with triumphs over Boston University and Navy before dethroning two-time defending champion Bucknell 94-80 in front of a capacity Cotterell Court crowd in the championship game. The Raiders earned their highest seed ever in the Big Dance and took Tennessee to the wire in a 77-70 first round decision.

Championship Background

Langel was named the 20th head coach in the 114-year history of Colgate basketball on April 25, 2011. Langel came to Colgate after spending five seasons as an assistant coach at Temple University (2006-11).

Langel worked under the tutelage of Fran Dunphy, who is one of the all-time winningest coaches in Philadelphia Big 5 history and has twice been named Eastern College Coach of the Year.

Langel was also a two-year member of Dunphy's Penn staff and helped guide his alma mater to consecutive Ivy League championships.

College Playing Career

A 2000 graduate of Penn's Wharton School of Business, Langel helped lead the Quakers to two Ivy League titles and NCAA Tournament appearances during his four-year playing career (1996-2000). The Quakers went 27-1 in Ivy League action in his junior and senior campaigns and sported a 42-14 overall record. Langel was named Ivy League and Big Five Player of the Week numerous times and received the Big Five's Most Improved Player Award.

Langel etched his name in the Penn record books in several different categories. He is a member of the 1,000-point club with 1,191 points in a Red and Blue uniform. He stands second all-time in Penn basketball history in three-pointers made in a game with eight, is eighth in three-pointers made in a season with 70, and fourth in career three-pointers made with 201.

Professional Playing Career

Langel after graduation was drafted by Atlantic City of the USBL in 2000 and worked out in the Seattle SuperSonics camp. He then went overseas to play professionally in Europe, for Chene BC in Switzerland and ALM Evreux Basket in France.

The Moorestown, N.J., native participated in the Philadelphia 76ers summer camp in 2001, but returned to Europe to play for the MBC and Hagan in German Bundesliga I. His last professional stop before returning to Penn as an assistant coach was with the Eiffel Towers in Holland.
