

#### **LAST TIME OUT: HAMPTON 64 ALABAMA 61**



**TUSCALOOSA, Ala**. – Junior Ariyah Copeland's layup with seven seconds remaining in the game tied it up at 61-61, however, a three-point basket at the buzzer lifted Hampton past Alabama 64-61, inside Coleman Coliseum on Wednesday night. With the loss, the Crimson Tide begins its season 0-1, while Lady Pirates starts their 2019-20 campaign 1-0.

Redshirt junior Jordan Lewis totaled 14 points and seven rebounds, while adding a team-high six assists in the game. Sophomore Brittany Davis scored 13 points off the bench in her first game for the Tide, while Copeland recorded a double-double, with 11 points and 11 rebounds.

#### From Coach Curry

"Credit to Hampton, they made a good shot right there at the end," said head coach Kristy Curry. "It just seemed like we could not find the basket. You can't shoot 27 percent from the floor and win. I thought we had good effort to outrebound them like we did, but again, you have to have enough toughness to make shots and for whatever reason we were just really cold tonight."

#### Quarter-by-Quarter

Hampton jumped out to a quick start, leading Alabama 12-5 with 2:44 left in the first. Lewis hit four consecutive free throws to cut into the deficit, but the Lady Pirates held the 17-11 edge at the end of the first period.

The Tide found its rhythm in the second period, going on an 11-4 run to take its first lead of the game at 22-21, with 3:42 remaining in the second. UA outscored Hampton 18-6 in the second period to take a 29-23 lead at the half.

The Lady Pirates cut into the Tide lead after halftime, trailing 37-35 with 2:58 to go in the third. After three periods of play, Alabama had the 39-38 advantage.

Hampton tied the game at 41-41 to begin the fourth quarter before UA responded with a 4-0 spurt to take a 45-41 lead. The two sides battled back-and-forth when the Lady Pirates hit a three at the 6:21 mark to

take their first lead since the second period at 47-45.

Alabama responded with Davis knocking down back-to-back three-pointers to give UA a 53-49 lead with just a little over three minutes to play. After a Tide free throw make, the Lady Pirates responded with a 5-0 run to tie the game at 54-54 with 2:08 on the clock.

Two possessions later, Johnson drained a corner three, before Hampton responded with a three of their own to even things up at 57 apiece with 50 seconds to play.

With the game tied at 59-59, HU knocked down a pair of free throws to take a two-point lead with 21.7 seconds to play. A layup by Copeland off the feed from Lewis evened the score at 61, with just seven seconds to play.

Makayla Timmons drained a three-pointer at the top of the key to give Hampton the 64-61 win at the buzzer.

#### Player Spotlight

Lewis led the team in points, assists and steals in her first game back since December of 2018. The Windermere, Fla., native also led the way by going 7-of-10 from the free throw line. Copeland totaled her sixth career double-double with her team-high 11 rebounds, and 11 points. The junior also went 5-of-6 from the charity stripe.

#### Stats of the Game

Alabama outrebounded Hampton 40-32, with 19 of those coming on the offensive end. The Tide bench contributed 25 points, while holding the Lady Pirates bench to only six.

#### **NEWS AND NOTES**

#### **OPENING TIP**

- Alabama will take to the road and match up against Clemson on Tuesday at 6 p.m. CT in Littlejohn Coliseum.
- The Crimson Tide is led by redshirt junior Jordan Lewis who was tops on the team in the season opener against Hampton with 14 points, while sophomore Brittany Davis contributed 13 points off the bench and junior Ariyah Copeland added a double-double with 11 points and 11 boards on Wednesday.
- The Tide and Tigers are both looking to bounce back after suffering losses in each of their last games.
- This is the sixth meeting between the two schools, with Alabama holding the 3-2 all-time advantage. The two teams met last year on Nov. 19 in Coleman Coliseum with the Tide trouncing the Tigers, 76-56. UA and CU have only played one time in Clemson, S.C. when the teams matched up on Dec. 19, 1992, with Bama coming out victorious, 85-79.

#### J-LEW BACK FOR THE TIDE

- After only playing eight games last year due to a season-ending wrist injury in December, Jordan Lewis made a splash in her season debut, putting up a team-high 14 points, 6 assists and two steals, while also hauling in seven rebounds.
- Lewis is currently No. 9 all-time in assists at Alabama and in the top 15 among the SEC active career leaders in several categories, including points (No. 10), rebounds (No. 15), steals (No. 5) and assists (No. 2).

#### **DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE**

- Ariyah Copeland started the season with her sixth career double-double, three of which coming in the month of November.
- Copeland totaled 11 points and 11 rebounds in the opener against Hampton. The double-double tied her the for the most on the team with Jasmine Walker.

#### **ABOUT CLEMSON**

- Clemson is 1-1 this season after a season-opening 77-71 win over Furman on Wednesday, Nov. 6 and the Tigers fell at home to Navy, 65-52, on Saturday, Nov. 9.
- The Tigers return five players from its 2018-19 NCAA Tournament team, including senior forward Kobi Thornton. Thornton leads the team with 16.5 points in her first two contests of the season.
- Head Coach Amanda Butler is entering her second season at the helm. In her first year, Butler led the Tigers to their first NCAA appearance since 2002. CU won its first round matchup against South Dakota before falling in the second round against No. 1 seed Mississippi State.

- Alabama senior Cierra Johnson was voted to the Preseason All-SEC Second Team by the Southeastern Conference coaches on Oct. 26.
- Johnson is the first Crimson Tide player since Ericka Russell in 2011 to be named to a SEC Preseason Team. Last season, Johnson scored 457 points on the season which is the most by an Alabama player since 2010-11 and became the second player to score 450-plus points since the 1999-00 season.

#### **JORDAN LEWIS PLAYS IN USA BASKETBALL 3X3 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS**

• Jordan Lewis was selected to participate in the 2019 USA Basketball 3x3 National Championship at the Downtown Las Vegas Events Center, on May 3-4. Prior to the national championship, Lewis took part in a minicamp from May 1-2 before getting assigned to a 3x3 team. She led her team to the semifinals, before being elimated from the tournament.

#### THREE NEWCOMERS ADDED TO CRIMSON TIDE ROSTER

- Alabama added Ahriahna Grizzle, a 5-9 guard from Toronto, Ontario, Canada. During her career, Grizzle put up strong nuimbers after averaging 13.6 points, 5.6 assists, four rebounds and 3.7 steals per contest.
- Brittany Davis, a 5-9 guard from Manchester, Ga., joins the Tide as a sophomore. Davis is a transfer from Gulf Coast State College, where she led her team to a NJCAA National Championship last season. Davis averaged 16.4 points and 4.4 rebounds per game in 32 contests in her lone season with Gulf Coast State. In the 2018-19 season, Davis was tabbed the Panhandle Conference Freshman of the Year, along with being named First Team All-Conference and to the NJCAA All-Tournament Team.
- Destiny Rice is a 5-9 guard from North Caddo Magnet High School. The Shreveport, La. native, was named First Team All-State, First Team All-District and First Team All-City in 2018. Rice is coming off of a torn meniscus suffered in her state championship game in March. She is ranked as the No. 78 recruit in 2019 class according to ESPNW 100.

#### **ALABAMA OVERSEAS SUCCESS**

- Five players who have signed professional contracts since 2018. Quanetria Bolton, Ashley williams, Alana da Silva, Hannah Cook and Shaquera Wade.
- Quanetria Bolton finished up her first season with Sport Lisboa Benfica in Lisbon, Portugal. Bolton averaged 17.7 points, 7.9 rebounds and 1.3 assists per game in her first season.
- Ashley Williams was a solid contributor for TSV 1880 Wasserburg in her first season in Wasserburg am Inn, Germany. Williams averaged 10.2 points and 6.4 rebounds per contest.
- Hannah Cook was an all-around star for U.M.F Grindavik in her first season in Grindavik, Iceland. Cook averaged 24.1 points and 10.6 rebounds per contest for the season.




