LAST TIME OUT

JACKSONVILLE DOLPHINS

Jacksonville rolled into Presbyterian (2-9) and took care of business on Wednesday night, knocking down 13 triples while playing stout defense in the second half to run away with an 81-58 victory.

The scoring was paced by Destin Barnes who knocked down five triples, matching a season-high, and tallied what turned out to be a team-high 17 points, all before halftime. No to be upstaged, freshman guard Mo Arnold shook loose for a career-best 14 points off the bench to go with five boards. His night was highlighted by a 4-5 clip from long range.

The team shot 49.2 percent from the floor (30-61), matching a season-high for the third time. Oddly enough the previous two instances also saw the Dolphins shoot exactly 30-61 from the floor. Jacksonville 13 made triples on 31 tries are both season highs.

The 31 three-point attempts are tied for the seventh-most in a single game in program history and the 13 makes are tied for eighth-most in a single game in program history. Entering the 2019-20 campaign, the Dolphins had made 12 or more threes in a game on just 20 occasions all-time. The team has already accomplished that feat three times this season.

JACKSONVILLE ATHLETICS ANNOUNCES PLANS TO BUILD BASKETBALL PERFORMANCE CENTER



Jacksonville University Athletics announced Nov. 19 plans to begin construction of a basketball performance center on campus that will serve as the future home of Jacksonville basketball's day-to-day operations. Construction is set to begin in late spring of 2020 with completion scheduled for summer of 2021.

Senior Vice President and Athletics Director Alex Ricker-Gilbert has prioritized facility upgrades for the intercollegiate programs and the basketball practice facility, which will house both the men's and women's basketball programs, has been at the top of that list

"This project has been a top priority for our University and athletics department for several years," Ricker-Gilbert said. "Facilities matter, and in the sports of men's and women's basketball, the landscape is increasingly competitive. This facility is about our student-athletes and coaches. The Basketball Performance Center will provide a new home for our student-athletes, will enhance our ability to recruit quality individuals, and will allow them to be better prepared academically and athletically. This is a major component of a larger scale plan to chart our successful future in men's and women's basketball."

The 26,000 square foot practice facility will feature coaches offices, weight room, training room and a full court and a half of playing surface which will serve as the new practice venue for both programs. The building will be constructed immediately adjacent to Historic Swisher Gymnasium and will have direct access to the home game venue.

"This basketball facility will have a significant impact on our student-athletes' welfare and experience at Jacksonville University," men's basketball head coach Tony Jasick said. "Having a space with unlimited access for their individual growth as students and players is significant in creating a culture of improvement and development. Additionally, having a weight room directly off the practice floor for daily use will improve our performance and injury prevention programs as well."

"A new centrally-located facility will impact our programs' culture tremendously," women's basketball head coach Darnell Haney said. "A one-stop shop where we can train, build team camaraderie, and attract top recruits will help us compete at a high level and carry out the mission of our program to positively impact the lives of our student-athletes, the JU community, & the city of Jacksonville through winning basketball and quality education. This new facility will certainly allow us to do so."

In 2018, JU celebrated the successful completion of its ASPIRE Campaign, the largest, boldest fundraising initiative in the history of Jacksonville University. ASPIRE helped establish the Brooks Rehabilitation College of Healthcare Sciences; completed the 8,600 sq. ft. Jacksonville Lacrosse Center (JLC) and the 11,750 sq. ft. Frisch Welcome Center; introduced new scholarships; and enhanced students' residential experience by revitalizing living areas.

Additionally, a multi-million-dollar investment was made for improvements to D.B. Milne Field, Historic Swisher Gymnasium, Sessions Stadium, and the Pruitt Softball Complex including an updating of branded graphics throughout the campus. In recent years, Historic Swisher Gymnasium received a new roof, new playing surface, renovated locker rooms and new electronic video boards. Swisher Gym is quickly re-establishing itself as one of the toughest places to play in the ASUN.

"Since I began in spring 2016, our goal has been to find ways to enhance the experience of our student-athletes. From nutritional enhancements, to a new weight room, to an updated fieldhouse, to the Jacksonville Lacrosse Center, and now the Basketball Performance Center, we are finding innovative ways to create a high-level four-year experience for our student-athletes," Ricker-Gilbert concluded.

Jacksonville has been working with Balfour Beatty, a leading international infrastructure group, to develop this project. Balfour Beatty functions in the UK, US and Hong Kong with 26,000 employees worldwide.







SEASON-LONG 50TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION PLANNED FOR 1969-70 MEN'S BASKETBALL TEAM



The season that stands above all others in Jacksonville Athletics history, is that which belongs to the 1969-70 men's basketball team. With the 50th anniversary of that magical year set for this season, a multi-faceted celebration is planned throughout the year, culminating in a special event on Feb. 19, 2020.

This Jacksonville team is one of, if not the original "Cinderella" in NCAA Tournament history. The team is the winningest in program history, having secured a 27-2 record, including five wins against nationally ranked, Top 15 opponents, four of which came in succession on the road to the NCAA Final Four and National Championship game opposite UCLA. St. Bonaventure and New Mexico State joined UCLA and Jacksonville in College Park, Md. at Cole Field House that year. That Final Four remains to this day the only one to feature three programs that later became commonly referred to as "mid-majors."

On Feb. 19, 2020 the 1969-70 men's basketball team, coaches and support staff will welcome fans and benefactors to a special celebration of that season at Brick and Beam on N. Main Street in Jacksonville. Additional event details and ticket pricing will become available at a later date. The following night, the current men's basketball team will don throwback jerseys similar to those worn during that magical 1969-70 season for its matchup with defending ASUN regular season champion and 2019 NIT Finalist, Lipscomb. The dates for these events were chosen in conjunction with the anniversary of the team's historic upset of No. 8 Florida State on Feb. 18, 1970 in front of a capacity crowd at the Jacksonville Coliseum; a win that put Jacksonville and the Dolphins on the national radar.

The team became the first to be fully inducted into the Jacksonville Athletics Hall of Fame on Oct. 19, and its roster already boasts five Hall of Fame players, including Naismith Basketball Hall of Famer, Artis Gilmore. Head Coach Joe Williams and Assistant Coach Tom Wasdin are former inductees in the Jacksonville Athletics Hall of Fame as well.

Coached by Joe Williams (1964-70, 92-61) and led by Gilmore (23.2 ppg, 22.2 reb) and Rex Morgan (18.2 ppg, 6.4 reb), the team established multiple records that stand to this day including FG Made in a season (1,118), Most 100 Point Games in a season (20), Most Points in a season (2,811), Scoring Average (100.4), Rebounds in a season (1,561), Rebounds Per Game (55.8), and Assists (699). The team also achieved the best end-of-season ranking of any program in school history when it was ranked 4th in the final AP poll.

In conjunction with the year-long celebration of this historic team, the Athletic Department once again partnered with Joe Bosack & Co. to create special 50th anniversary logos for use throughout the year. There is a set of logos with the current colors but also a set paying homage to the colors worn by those 1969-70 Dolphins and so many others in the past. Also, JUDolphins.com has added the 1969-70 schedule and roster to the website and created a twitter account @JAX_1970MBB which will chronicle that season in real time as if it were occurring today.

The Athletic Department and new on-campus bookstore vendor Barnes & Noble have partnered with apparel company 19nine to re-create the shorts worn by that team in the Final Four and National Championship game. 19nine also created a pair of t-shirts that pay homage to the jerseys and warm-up shirts worn by that team. Details on where fans will be able to pick up this exclusive merchandise are forthcoming.

There will be special recognition paid to the team throughout the season inside Historic Swisher Gymnasium with exclusive printed materials and giveaways. The 1970 Regional Champion and Runner-Up trophies will be on display in the lobby, as they always are, for photos, and season ticket holders receive a specially branded credential with the 50th anniversary logo on it.

NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK

The ASUN Conference announced its weekly awards on Monday afternoon and for the second-straight week, the Dolphins have the Newcomer of the Week. This time around, on the heels of a career-best performance, freshman Diante Wood takes home the honor. Wood posted seven points off the bench during Saturday's matinee victory over Middle Georgia State but it was his 11 rebounds that set him apart. Wood's 11 boards made him just the fourth Dolphin this season to secure 10 or more rebounds in a single game. This recognition makes Wood the third different JU player to earn weekly recognition from the ASUN. Destin Barnes was named Newcomer of the Week last week and Bell was named the Player of the Week on Dec. 2. Wood added in a pair of assists and it's worth noting that five of his 11 boards came on the offensive end during a career-high 25 minutes of court time. The freshman is averaging 4.6 points per game and 2.2 rebounds off the bench for JU this season.

DESTIN BARNES

Junior Destin Barnes has provided steady scoring in the starting lineup for the Dolphins all season long and following his best week to date, he was rewarded by earning ASUN Newcomer of the Week honors. He paced the scoring effort for Jacksonville at Marquette, scoring 12 points and pulling down two rebounds. He was seeing red from long range against Bethune-Cookman. His 19 points came on 5-8 from long range and 4-4 from the stripe while also collecting a career-best eight rebounds. He has sinced followed all of this up with 17 points against Middle Georgia State.

BIZARRE STAT

Take this stat for what it's worth - entering the Middle Georgia State game Destin Barnes had made exactly five triples in a game three times this season. In no other game had he hit more than one, yet led the team with 21 makes from range at the time. He made three opposite Middle Georgia State, thus sending this interesting stat to the abyss - only to bring it back from the dead against Presbyterian by knocking down ... you guessed it ... five threes.

ON ANOTHER LEVEL

Bell has been a revelation on both ends of the floor for the Dolphins this season. The redshirt-senior has posted six double-doubles, is averaging 11.5 points, 10.0 rebounds and 1.6 blocks per game across just 23.7 minutes and is only getting better. During his stretch of four consecutive double-doubles, the Cleveland, Ohio native averaged 15.0 points and 13.3 rebounds. Marquette managed to hold him in check but he more than made up for it against Bethune-Cookman, scoring a career-best 22 points while grabbing what is quickly becomming a pedestrian 15 rebounds.

DOUBLE MCCALLUM

DeAnthony McCallum started each of the first eight games of the season for Jacksonville, then came off the bench for a pair before returning to the starting lineup opposite Bethune-Cookman. The senior made the most of that matchup by scoring a then-season-high 13 points but also by collecting a career-best 10 rebounds and his first double-double. His previous career-high rebounding total was just four. He followed that up with a new season-high 16 points agaisnt Middle Georgia State.

DOLPHIN DEFENSE

The Jacksonville defense is off to a historic start this seaosn. Through the first 10 games, the Dolphins are holding opponents to just 66.8 points per game but have already held two opponents (Dartmouth, North Carolina A&T) south of the 50-point plateau. Dartmouth was held to a program-record low (vs. a Division I opponent) 37 points on Nov. 16 on a neutral floor and North Carolina A&T managed just 45 points on its home floor on Nov. 30. Its already the first time since 2012-13 that multiple opponents have been under 50 in the same season. The feat hasn't occurred three times in a single season since 2001-02. It happened five times in 2000-01.

SANTOS CLUTCH

In a tie game at UMass Lowell, Santos drove the lane, drew a foul and earned two free throws. With three seconds left on the game clock, the Dorchester, Mass. native, playing in front of large crowd of friends and family, buried both tries to put the Dolphins ahead for good. A half court heave at the buzzer was not near the mark for the River Hawks. Santos finished with 16 points and six assists over 38 minutes of action – his third double digit effort of the season after accomplishing that just four times in all of 2018-19.

THAT'S MY QUARTERBACK

Jacksonville freshman guard Trey Sides comes to campus with plenty of pedigree, now just as a superb guard that can shoot it from anyone on the floor, but as an all-around athlete that experienced success on all fields in high school. Most notably, the Phillipsburg, Kansas native led his school to a pair of State Championships on the football field as the starting quarterback. To cap his senior season, Sides completed 10 of 15 passes for 156 yards and two touchdowns in the title game.

TEAMMATES AGAIN

The Dolphins boast a two pairs of individuals that came from the same high school and one pair that actually played together. David Bell and Donovan Forte both came from Garfield Heights but never played together. Kevion Nolan and Diante Wood on the other hand, paired up as one of the best backcourt duos in the state of Alabama at Sacred Heart Catholic HS in 2016-17. Upon Nolan's graduation, Wood went on to have a stellar high school career, earning four-star recruit status.

JASICK OFFENSE

Tony Jasick is entering his sixth season as Jacksonville head coach and in doing so has built one of the best offensive philosophies in the rich history of this program. He's responsible for four of the top ten most prolific scoring season in program history including 10th best effort in 2018-19.

JUCO SUCCESS

There is a pair of newcomers for Jacksonville that experienced extreme success on the Junior College circuit. Kevin Norman, out of Alexandria, La., joins the Dolphins after a successful career at Angelina College. Norman averaged 15.6 points per game during his two-year stretch with the Roadrunners which includes a 19.2 points per game clip as a sophomore. He also averaged 7.3 rebounds and 1.6 assists as a sophomore en route to earning First Team All-Region and Third Team All-American honors.

Destin Barnes was a First Team All-Suncoast Conference selection following the 2018-19 season, averaging 8.8 points and 4.1 rebounds per game for FSW. The 6-7 forward played in all 33 games for FSW, starting 32 of them, while shooting 39 percent from the three-point line. He came up big down the stretch for the Bucs, scoring in double figures in 9 of FSW's final 12 games during their run to a Suncoast Conference Championship and ultimately a fifth-place finish at the NJCAA National Tournament.

HEAD COACH TONY JASICK

Tony Jasick, the 2014 Mid-Major National Coach of the Year, enters his sixth season leading the Dolphins. Jasick's first season rebuilding the program saw a complete overhaul of the roster with only one of the eight top scorers returning from the previous season. In his second season he led Jacksonville to its most non-conference wins in 24 years, secured the first winning season for the program in five years, and had a 13-game home winning streak, the longest in 42 years. In Jasick's third season, the coaching veteran again improved upon his win total from the previous year, making him one of only two coaches in the nation (Michigan's John Beilein (at the time) the other) over the last six years to improve their win total over a three-year span twice.

The 2018-19 Dolphins faced guite a bit of turnover on the roster from 2017-18 to 2018-19 and welcomed nine newcomers. The team posted a 12-20 record but gave the top teams in the ASUN everything they could handle, playing eventual NIT runner-up Lipscomb within 12 points combined across two games. Freshman guard Tyreese Davis averaged over 10 points per game and went on to be named to the ASUN All-Freshman team. JD Notae was selected as an All-Conference honoree while Jace Hogan earned All-Academic Team recognition.

2017-18

The 2017-18 edition of the Jacksonville Dolphins men's basketball program finished with an overall record of 15-18 but does little to tell the whole story about this season. The Dolphins went on to post an 8-6 mark in ASUN play to finish third in the standings and then advanced to the ASUN semifinals before falling to eventual champion Lipscomb on the road. Devin Harris was chosen as the ASUN Defensive Player of the Year and named to the All-Conference Second Team, freshman guard JD Notae was honored as the ASUN Freshman of the Year, Jalyn Hinton joined Notae on the All-Freshman Team and Cody Helgeland was selected to the ASUN All-Tournament Team and All-Academic Team.

2016-17

His 2016-17 Dolphin squad had a resurgent non-conference season, finishing 12-4 in games outside of ASUN Conference play. That tied JU with Baylor, Creighton, Florida State, Gonzaga, Louisville, Maryland, Minnesota, North Carolina and Villanova for the secondmost non-conference wins in the country. The Dolphins then capped a 17-15 regular season by hosting a national postseason tournament for the first time at Swisher Gym, the Hugh Durham Classic game of the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. After the season ended, Jasick had seven members of the team graduate, and five of those former Dolphins then signed professional contracts overseas. Only three other schools in the country had four or more players graduate and sign pro contracts.

2015-16

Kori Babineaux earned All-ASUN honors for the second time in his career in the 2015-16 season, and became the fifth Dolphin ever to score over 1,000 points in just two years. The Dolphins had several other memorable moments, including a 31-point outburst from Darien Fernandez in the ASUN Conference Tournament's first round, the most a Dolphin has ever scored in an ASUN playoff game. 2015-16 was also the first time JU has hosted an ASUN men's basketball conference tournament game.

2014-15

The Dolphins finished Jasick's first campaign strongly, winning three of thier final five games. The 2014-15 Dolphins also garnered wins over three of the top four teams in the final ASUN Conference standings. As a result of their on-court success, two Dolphins earned postseason honors. Junior Kori Babineaux was voted the ASUN Newcomer of the Year in addition to earning All-Conference second team honors. Freshman Antwon Clayton was named to the conference All-Freshman Team. Jasick was hired as the 16th head coach in Jacksonville men's basketball history on April 9, 2014. Jasick comes to JU after spending three seasons as the head coach of Indiana-Purdue Fort Wayne (IPFW). In all, Jasick spent the past nine seasons as a member of the IPFW coaching staff.

Jasick was named the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year by CollegeInsider.com as the top Division I Mid-Major coach in college basketball in 2014. A nine-year veteran of the IPFW program, Jasick oversaw the Mastodons as the school transitioned from a Division I independent into one of the Summit League's elite.

In late March 2014, he was named one of 15 finalists for the Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award, given annually to a head coach who achieves success on the court while displaying moral integrity off it. Other finalists for the year's award include such coaching luminaries as Mike Krzyzewski of Duke, Phil Martelli of Saint Joseph's and Jay Wright of Villanova.

Prior to IPFW

Before joining the staff at IPFW in 2005-06, Jasick spent the 2004-05 season at Middle Tennessee State, coaching two All-Sun Belt Conference selections and helping the Blue Raiders to 19 wins. In 2003-04, he was an assistant at Newberry (S.C.) helping the team to the South Atlantic Conference title game for the first time in program history. Jasick began his coaching career as a volunteer assistant at North Alabama.

A 2000 graduate of Mars Hill (N.C.) with a Bachelor of Science in Biology Education, Jasick went on to earn his Master's in Education from Lincoln Memorial (Tenn.) in 2002 before entering the coaching field. A native of Whitehall, Mich., Jasick attended Whitehall High School. Tony and his wife, Melissa, have two daughters, Rohen and Reece.


