KE FOREST AT CLEMSO

DEACS MAKE QUICK TURNAROUND TO VISIT CLEMSON

- The Demon Deacons conclude their only stretch of two games in three days of ACC play with a visit to Clemson on Tuesday night
- It is the first of two meetings with the Tigers in an 11-day span as Wake hosts Clemson on Feb. 1
- A victory tonight would be the Deacons' 100th all-time victory over Clemson, becoming the second opponent that Wake Forest has posted 100 wins against (NC State - 106)

SERIES HISTORY

- Wake Forest leads 99-63 (Clemson leads 42-35 at home, 28-19 at Littlejohn Coliseum)
- The Tigers have won the last six meetings in the series
- Clemson won last year's meeting at Littlejohn Coliseum 64-37
- Wake's last win in the series was 62-57 victory in 2014 in Winston-Salem
- The Deacs last won at Clemson in 2009, a 78-68 victory at Littleiohn Coliseum

LAST TIME OUT

- Wake Forest recorded its second ACC win of the year with an 80-62 victory over Boston College
- The Demon Deacons used a 24-4 run spanning the end of the first half and the start of the second half to break open a tie game
- Brandon Childress scored a game-high 20 points on 5-7 shooting from 3-point range, his fourth 20point game of the season
- Olivier Sarr finished with 14 points and 13 rebounds after becoming the first Deac since 2013-14 to post a first-half double-double (10 points and 10 rebounds)
- Ody Oquama set career highs of 16 points and 10 rebounds to post his first career double-double
- Ismael Massoud tied his career highs with 14 points and six rebounds
- The Deacs tied a season high with 10 3-pointers

INTERVIEW POLICIES

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

HEAD COACHES: Both head coaches will appear in the media room following brief cool-down periods. In most cases, the visiting head coach will appear first, followed by Wake Forest coach Danny Manning. WAKE FOREST PLAYERS: Requested players will be available in the media room following both head coaches' press conferences. The Wake Forest locker room is closed to the media.

OPPONENT PLAYERS: Please see the visiting SID. If that team's locker room is closed to the media, interviews are usually held outside in the hallway near the entrance to the visitors' locker room.

PRE-PRACTICE INTERVIEWS

All interviews with head coach Danny Manning and/or Demon Deacon players should be arranged through Steve Kirkland in the Athletic Communications Office. Interview requests should be made at least 24 hours in advance.

Interviews will be arranged to accommodate players' academic and basketball schedules. Players will not do interviews on gameday, except for postgame interviews. At the conclusion of select practices, Coach Manning and players will be available for interviews after media is permitted to watch the end of practice. Contact Steve Kirkland for the schedule of practices with media availability.

ACC TELECONFERENCE

The 15 ACC basketball head coaches will be featured on a weekly teleconference each Monday. The teleconferences will begin on Jan. 6, 2020 and conclude on Mar. 2, 2020. Each coach will have 10 minutes to answer questions.

PRESS CREDENTIALS

Media credentials for Wake Forest home games should be requested by contacting Steve Kirkland in the Wake Forest Athletic Communications Office. Please make your requests at least 48 hours prior to tip-off.

Credential requests are contingent on available space. Priority is given to daily newspapers, radio/TV sports directors and other media who cover the Demon Deacons and their opponents on a regular basis, in addition to national print and electronic media.

Credentials will not be mailed if the credential request is received one week or less prior to the game. Credentials can be shipped overnight if a FedEx or UPS shipping number is provided.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

Photographers are restricted to either baseline area and are not permitted along the sidelines during game activity. Photographers will be assigned areas on the baseline.

The facility is lighted by 42 LED lamps with a vertical illumination of 102 footcandles and a horizontal illumination of 139 footcandles

MEDIA WILL CALL/MEDIA ENTRANCE

The media entrance to the Coliseum is located at the rear of the facility in close proximity to the media parking area. Media members can enter there and follow the hallway to the media workroom. This also serves as the primary exit for media staying to file stories.

The main media parking lot is located off of Deacon Boulevard in the McCreary Tower Lot. The secondary media lot is located off Deacon Boulevard in the BB&T Field Gold Lot. Only media with valid parking passes or who are on the media parking list will be allowed to park in these areas.

There is a media will call desk for credentials located at the media entrance.

MEDIA BAG POLICY

Wake Forest has instituted a clear bag policy for fans at LJVM Coliseum. There are no bag restrictions for credentialed media who enter through the media entrance, but bags will be subject to search.

MEDIA SEATING

Media will be assigned seats at the press row tables along the baselines or in the five rows of seating in Section 113. Please check the media seating assignments posted in the media workroom.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pre-game statistics, game notes and roster cards are provided prior to tip-off. Final stats, play-by-play and postgame quotes will be available in the media workroom.

Statistical monitors will be provided for live TV and the home and visiting team radio crews.

Wireless internet access is available in the media workroom and on press row. For user name and password information, check the posted signs in the workroom or ask a member of the Wake Forest Athletic Communications staff.

• Wake Forest has been hit with more injuries and illness this season than in recent years

• The Deacs have **man-games lost to injury/illness in 2019-20, more than the last three years combined, with five different players missing time

• Tariq Ingraham has missed all 17 games this season after an achilles tendon injury suffered in preseason practice, Sunday Okeke has missed the last 15 games after an achilles tendon injury suffered in the home opener vs. Columbia, while Chaundee Brown (5), Sharone Wright, Jr. (4), Isaiah Mucius (1) and Olivier Sarr (1) have also missed time this season due to injury or illness

BENCH PRODUCTION

- On average, Wake Forest is outscoring opponents 26.9-15.7 this season off the bench
- Wake has had eight games this season with at least 30 bench points (just one last year)
- The Deacs have had 17 double-figure scoring games off the bench this year, led by 11 from Olivier Sarr
- Ismael Massoud (2), Ody Oguama, Chaundee Brown, Torry Johnson and Sharone Wright, Jr. have also had double-figure scoring games off the bench this season
- The Demon Deacons only had 16 total double-figure games off the bench in all of last season, while Sarr's 11 double-figure games off the bench are the most since Keyshawn Woods had 15 in 2017-18

GETTING TO THE LINE

- Wake Forest leads the ACC in free throw attempts (24.5 per game) and is second in free throw percentage (73.8 percent)
- The Deacs' free throw rate of 43.2% (FTA/FGA) ranks 3rd nationally and is the highest for a Wake Forest team since 2014-15 (50.1)
- Olivier Sarr ranks second in the ACC with 98 free throw attempts, already eclipsing his 2018-19 free throw attempt total (61)
- Sarr's 6.1 FTA/game is the highest rate of getting to the line by a Deacon since 2017 when John Collins averaged 6.7 FTA/game
- Olivier Sarr (78) and Brandon Childress (73) rank first and second in the ACC in free throws made this season and are the only power conference teammates to each have at least 70 made free throws this season
- 24.8% of Wake Forest's points this season have come from the line, the second highest percentage nationally

FREE THROWS AGAINST THE BEACH

- Wake Forest went 24-of-25 from the free throw line against Long Beach State in the semifinals of the Wooden Legacy
- The Deacs' 96% was the second-best singlegame average in school history (min. 20 attempts), trailing only the ACC record 32-of-32 Wake had against North Carolina in 2005

SHARP-SHOOTING VS. UNC ASHEVILLE

- In the 98-79 win over UNC Asheville on Nov. 13, the Deacs shot 70.2% from the floor (33-47), the second-highest field goal percentage in program history
- The performance only trailed a 73.5%(36-49) shooting night against Fairleigh Dickinson in 1979-80
- Against UNCA, the Deacs shot 70.4 percent in the first half and 70.0% in the second half, the first time in school history that Wake shot at least 70% in both halves of a game
- It marked the first time since the 2009 game at Duke that the Deacs shot at least 60 percent in both halves of a game
- The 70.2% from the floor is the second highest FG% against a Division I team this season

CHILDRESS SCORES 30 VS. THE PACK

- Brandon Childress scored a career-high 30 points against NC State on Dec. 7
- It was the first 30-point game by a Demon Deacon since John Collins had 31 points at Duke in 2016-17
- It was the most points by a Demon Deacon at the LJVM Coliseum since Devin Thomas scored 31 points vs. Louisville in 2014-15
- Childress was 10-13 from the floor, including 5-6 from 3-point range

CHILDRESS CLIMBS THE CAREER CHARTS

• Brandon Childress enters the game ranking T-8th in Wake history with 167 career 3-pointers, 11th in Wake history with 383 career assists, 20th in Wake history with 124 steals and 34th in Wake history with 1,208 career points

LIKE FATHER. LIKE SON

- Randolph and Brandon Childress are the highest scoring father-son duo in ACC history with a combined 3,416 career points
- Randolph (1991-95) scored 2,208 career points (2nd most in Wake Forest history), while Brandon has scored 1,208 career points
- They are the sixth father/son duo in Division I history to combine for 3,000 career points at one school

DEACON NOTES

THE BIG FRENCHMAN

- Olivier Sarr has established himself as one of the most improved players in the ACC this year
- Sarr is averaging 12.8 points per game this season, more than double of last year (6.2)
- With 150 boards, Sarr has already eclipsed his rebounding total of last season (137)
- Sarr posted a career-high 21 points vs. UNC Asheville and vs. Arizona, a career-high 14 rebounds vs. Charleston, a career-high five blocks at Charlotte and his first six career double-doubles (Davidson, Charleston, Arizona, Penn State, North Carolina A&T, Boston College)
- Against Boston College, he had 10 points and 10 rebounds before halftime, the first first-half double-double by a Deac since 2013-14
- His free throw rate of 81.0 (100*FTA/FGA) leads the ACC, ranks 13th nationally and is the best by Deacon since KenPom began tracking the stat in 2004

SARR SHINES AT WOODEN LEGACY

- Olivier Sarr had three strong performances at the Wooden Legacy to earn All-Tournament Team honors
- Sarr was also named ACC Player of the Week on Dec. 2 for his play in Anaheim
- He averaged 17.0 points and a tournament-leading 11.7 rebounds per game at the event
- Sarr had 14 points and a career-high 14 rebounds in the first round vs. Charleston
- He had 16 points and eight rebounds vs. Long Beach State in the semifinals
- Sarr tied a career high with 21 points and had 13 rebounds vs. No. 14 Arizona in the final
- He shot 16-27 (.593) from the floor and 19-24 (.792) from the line in the three games

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

- Chaundee Brown, who missed the last four games due to injury, has four 20-point games this season
- He scored a career-high 26 points in the Dec. 14 win over Xavier and 25 points in the Dec. 21 win over North Carolina A&T, marking the first time a Deacon scored at least 25 points in consecutive games since John Collins in 2016-17 (at Clemson, at Duke)
- He has two double-doubles this season (23 pts/11 rebs vs. UNC Asheville & 25 pts/10 rebs vs. NC A&T) as all four of his career double-doubles have been 20-and-10 games
