### STORIED RIVALRY

- South Carolina is Clemson's most-common opponent in history, as the two have played 321 times dating to 1899.

- The two have met at least one time every year since 1945, with the exception of 1984.
- South Carolina leads the series 10-4 at Founders Park (opened in 2009).
- The season matchups went to a three-game, weekend-series format in 2010 after the two teams played four midweek games for decades.
- Clemson is 5-4 against the Gamecocks in regular-season, neutral-site contests since 2010.
- Saturday's game marks the first time the teams play a neutral-site contest in Columbia.
- Clemson leads the series 52-29 at Doug Kingsmore Stadium (opened in 1970).

### CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has played all eight games at Doug Kingsmore Stadium in 2020, fell to East Tennessee 5-3 on Tuesday.
- The Tigers are averaging 3.0 runs per game and hitting .243 with a .357 on-base percentage, .326 slugging percentage and 15 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 1.23 ERA, .189 opponents' batting average and 2.68 strikeout-to-walk ratio and Clemson is fielding .954.

### SOUTH CAROLINA OVERVIEW

- South Carolina is led by third-year Head Coach Mark Kingston.
- The Gamecocks defeated North Florida 6-5 at home on Tuesday. They are hitting .288 and have a 2.83 ERA and .974 fielding percentage.

### ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,260 fans per home date (8), the 10th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of Feb. 26).
- Entering 2020, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 26 straight seasons and a top-15 figure 18 years in a row.

### SCORING STREAK

- Clemson has scored at least one run 114 consecutive games.
- The last time Clemson was shut out was on March 16, 2018, when No. 10 NC State blanked the Tigers 4-0 at Doug Kingsmore Stadium.
- The 114-game streak is the fourth-longest active streak in the nation.
- Eastern Kentucky (167), Oklahoma State (144) and Kentucky (127) have the three-longest active streaks in the country.
- The Clemson record for longest streak scoring at least one run is 232, set between May 10, 1982 to May 3, 1986.

### ARMS CARRYING TIGERS

- Clemson's 7-1 start to the season is due in large part to its performance on the mound.
- Clemson has allowed 13 runs (10 earned) and has a 1.23 ERA, .189 opponents' batting average and 102 strikeouts in 73.0 innings pitched.
- Clemson has allowed only eight extra-base hits (seven doubles, one homer)
- The staff has a 12.58 strikeout-per-nine-innings-pitched mark and 2.68 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

- Clemson is holding opponents to a .132 batting average with runners on base, 0-for-16 with bases loaded and has allowed three two-out RBIs.
- Opponents are 8-for-80 (.100) with runners in scoring position.
- Tiger pitchers have allowed just three of 25 inherited baserunners to score.
- Clemson has pitched three shutouts and has held the opponent to three runs or less in seven of the eight games.
- The Tigers are 3-0 in one-run games and 3-1 in two-run games.
- Over four games from Feb. 19-23, Clemson held opponents scoreless for 33 consecutive innings, its longest streak since May 3-9, 1967 (38).
- Clemson has been aided significantly by the return of righties Carter Raffield and Spencer Strider, who missed last season due to injury.

### HENDERSON SPARKING THE TIGERS

- Sophomore outfielder Elijah Henderson only had 32 at-bats in 2019, but he has emerged as one of the Tigers' top hitters in 2020.
- He has made four starts in right field, three starts in left field and one start at second base.
- He is hitting .407 with four doubles, four RBIs, four runs, a .528 on-base percentage and three steals in eight games in 2020.
- He has six walks and two hit-by-pitches against only three strikeouts.
- He has a team-high five multiple-hit games.
- He hit a walkoff single in the 10th inning in the 1-0 win over Stony Brook on Feb. 22. He reached base in all five plate appearances.
- In his career, he is hitting .271 with four doubles, a homer, nine RBIs, a .397 on-base percentage and three steals in 27 games (16 starts).

### MEREDITH GETTING ON BASE

- Sophomore outfielder Kier Meredith is doing what he has always done best...finding a way to get on base.
- He has a .571 on-base percentage thanks in large part to four walks and four hit-by-pitches against only four strikeouts.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in all eight games.
- He is hitting .444 with a double, two RBIs, five runs and two steals in eight games (eight starts).
- He is hitting .643 with runners on base and .714 with runners in scoring position.
- He went 4-for-5 with with a double, RBI and run against East Tennessee State on Feb. 25.
- In his career, he is hitting .300 with four doubles, a triple, homer, eight RBIs, a .475 on-base percentage and eight steals in 30 games.
- He was hampered by injury in each of his first two seasons (2018,19), playing a total of only 22 games (20 starts) those two years.

### SPIERS CLOSING THE DOOR AGAIN

- Senior righthander moved into the closer role in 2019 and is in the same role in 2020.
- He is one of only two seniors on the 2020 team, joining righthander Sheldon Reed.
- He is 1-0 with three saves, an 0.00 ERA, .074 opponents' batting average and 10 strikeouts against two walks in 8.0 innings pitched.
- He has made a team-high five relief appearances in 2020.
- He has allowed just one of his five inherited baserunners to score in 2020.
- In his career, he is 5-7 with 18 saves, a 2.65 ERA and 96 strikeouts against 37 walks in 102.0 innings pitched over 67 relief appearances.

# NOTES

- His 18 career saves are tied for fourth most in Tiger history. The school record is 34, held by Scott Winchester (1993-95).
- He has allowed just 67 hits in his career, good for a .184 opponents' batting average.
- His 5.91 hits-per-nine-innings-pitched mark in his career is third in Clemson history.
- He has allowed just 14 of his 79 inherited baserunners to score in his career.
