Boston College (12-10, 5-6 ACC) | Clemson (7-16, 3-9 ACC)

Clemson, South Carolina | Littlejohn Coliseum | Noon

THE GAME

- Boston College (12-10, 5-6 ACC) will travel to South Carolina to play at Clemson (7-16, 3-9 ACC) on Sunday. Tip is at noon on the ACC Network.
- BC is coming off a tough 89-79 loss at Conte Forum to rival Syracuse on Thursday night.
- The Eagles were led by senior **Emma Guy** with 23 points, while sophomore **Taylor Soule** added 15 points. The Eagles shot just 25 percent from the floor in the first quarter and fell behind 8-1 early. BC never recovered as it had 23 turnovers and gave up 50 points in the paint against Syracuse.
- Clemson (7-16, 3-9 ACC) has lost five consecutive games, including a 70-54 loss at Virginia on Thursday.
- The Tigers are led by Kobi Thornton offensively (12.7 ppg.) and on the boards (6.0). Amari Robinson is averaging 11.2 points and 6.5 boards a game for the Tigers.
- The Tigers three ACC victories have been at Notre Dame (71-55), vs Pittsburgh (75-67 OT) and vs Duke (62-58).

THE SERIES

- BC and Clemson have played 16 times. The first meeting took place in 1996 at the Dartmouth Invitational on Dec. 28, 1996.
- The Eagles lead the overall series vs. the Tigers, 10-6. Last season, Clemson defeated BC, 91-58, at Conte Forum last year despite 19 points from **Emma Guy**.
- Clemson is led by second-year head coach Amanda Butler.
- Kobi Thornton leads Clemson in scoring with a 12.7 points per game average. She is shooting 45 percent from the floor and averages 6.0 rebounds a game. Amari Robinson averages 11.2 points and a team-high 6.5 rebounds. Kendall Spray is the Tigers outside threat as he has hit 59 three-pointers (33.5%).
- The Tigers have lost five consecutive games but has ACC wins over Notre Dame, Pittsburgh and Duke.
- Clemson averages 61.3 points, 40.7 rebounds but 20.2 turnovers a game.

NEED TO KNOW

- Senior **Emma Guy** is averaging 16.2 points while shooting 58.6 percent from the floor in the last five games. She has led BC in scoring in three of the last five games, including 23 vs Syracuse on Thursday.
- Sophomore **Taylor Soule** scored 18 points vs. Syracuse. She needed eight points to reach the 500 point mark prior to the game.
- **Emma Guy** and **Taylor Soule** have tallied double-doubles in two games - W at Notre Dame, W vs. Wake.
- Boston College has five ACC victories. The last time BC won five conference games was in 2014-15. The BC record is seven, which was accomplished in '07-08 and '08-09.
- BC has won four ACC road games. It is the first time since the 2010-11 season BC has more than three ACC road wins.
- Sophomore **Marnelle Garraud** had three steals vs. Syracuse. She is first in the conference in steals (51) and 55th in the country.
- BC is 5-1 when sophomore **Taylor Soule** records a double-double.

Coach Joanna Bernabei-McNamee

- This is Coach Mac's second season at the Heights as she was hired in April 2018 after a two-year stint at Albany.
- Prior to Albany, Coach Mac was a Pikeville. She is not a stranger to the ACC or Boston. She was an assistant coach at Maryland when they won the 2005-06 NCAA Tournament in Boston. After working as an assistant at West Virginia, she took a four year hiatus to have a family. Once the two boys were old enough (Luke and Caden), Coach Mac return to coach at Pikeville.
- Assistant Coach George Porcha coached at Virginia Tech as well as West Virginia. He was at Ole Miss before arriving at the Heights.
- Coach Yolanda Griffith is an WNBA legend. Griffith played professionally for 11 years, won the WNBA title with the Monarchs in 1999, and has two gold medals. She was with Coach Mac at Albany.
- Coach AJ Cohen is a graduate of the University of Louisville. He started his women's basketball career as a practice player then turned to the video department. Cohen started coaching with Coach Mac at Pikeville, then Albany before coming to Boston College.

LAST TIME OUT

- Senior **Emma Guy** scored 23 points while sophomore **Taylor Soule** added 18 but it was not enough as Syracuse stole a game at Conte Forum 89-79, on Thursday night.
- Boston College had 23 turnovers and gave up 50 points in the paint. BC's back court combined for 16 of the 23 turnovers.
- Guy shot 7-for-12 from the floor and 9-for-11 from the foul line. She also grabbed six boards. Soule shot 5-for-7 from the field and 8-for-12 from the foul line in just 25 minutes of action.
- Boston College fell behind 22-17 in the first quarter but it was the tough second quarter that BC fell behind, 44-31, at the half. The Eagles were looking up the rest of the way.
- Kiara Lewis led the Orange with 23 points, eight boards and three steals, while Teisha Hyman had 16 points and seven steals.

LAST THREE GAMES

- BC is 2-1 in the last three games. The Eagles had a 65-56 win over No. 14 Florida State on Jan. 30, followed by a home win vs. Wake Forest, 67-54 on Feb. 2. The Eagles sole loss was at home vs. Syracuse (89-79).
- In the three game run, BC averaged 70.3 points, 37.3 rebounds while shooting 44 percent from the floor. The Eagles won the battle of the boards in the two wins in the stretch. Opponents are averaging 66.3 points, 35.0 rebounds while shooting 40.7% from the floor.
- After keeping turnovers under control (12 vs FSU, 17 vs. Wake), BC had 23 turnovers vs. Syracuse.
- Senior **Emma Guy** is averaging 21.3 points, 7.7 rebounds while shooting 66 percent from the floor in the three game run.
- Sophomore **Taylor Soule** is shooting 48.3 percent while averaging 14.7 points and 8.7 rebounds a game.
- Sophomore Marnelle Garraud is averaging 13.3 points, while shooting 56% from the floor and 61.5% from the arc.

SENIOR STATUS

- **Emma Guy** is coming off her most successful season as an Eagle. She led the team in points (14.1 ppg.) and rebounding (6.7 rpg.) last year. She shot a career-high 59% from the floor.
- A native of Penfield, New York, Guy tallied double-figures in scoring in 23 games last season, including the final five games.
- Guy, who started every game, led the Eagles in scoring in 12 games and on the boards in 11 games. She scored her career-high (30 pts. & 14 rebs.) at Syracuse on Feb. 10.
- Guy opened this season with her ninth career double-double (20 pts.-10 rebs.) vs. Lowell.
- She has reached double-figures in 17 games, including 23 points vs. Syracuse.
- Guy became the 27th player to tally 1,000 career points vs. Wake. She also had 12 boards

for her third double-double of the season.

- She is currently second in FG percentage (58.6%) the ACC. She is 17th in the country in field goal percentage (2.2.20).
- Guy picked up Co-ACC POW honors after leading BC two wins at FSU & vs. Wake Forest. She averaged 20.5 points, 7.5 rebounds while shooting 69 percent from the floor.

HEART AND SOULE

- Anyone watching the Eagles knows that sophomore **Taylor Soule** has evolved into a threat on both ends of the court.
- She has tallied double-digits in points in 15 games, including her career-high 24 vs. St. Francis and ACC high 22 at Duke. She has double-figures in 8 ACC games.
- The New Hampshire native is dominating on the glass. She has led the team in rebounding in 13 games, including five straight games at mid-season. She became the first player since Carolyn Swords '11 to tally double-figures on the boards in 5 straight games.
- Soule grabbed her career-high 16 vs. Delaware State and ACC high 12 at Notre Dame. She has had double-digits on the boards in nine games.
- Soule had 15 points with 11 boards vs. Wake Forest for her sixth double-double of the season. Her first career double-double came vs. Delaware St (23 points, career-high 16 rebounds).

HONORING A LEGEND

- The women's basketball team will wear a CI patch on their uniforms to honor former BC Head Coach **Cathy Inglese**, who passed away in July, 2019. The program honored Inglese on Alumni Day (Jan. 12 vs. UVA).
- Inglese was the head coach for BC for 13 seasons from 1993-2008. She guided the Eagles to a 239-151 record during her tenure.
- She led the BC to 7 NCAA Tournament appearances, including 3 trips to the Sweet 16.
- She was inducted into the Boston College Varsity Hall of Fame in 2014.

ACC BIG TEN CHALLENGE

- Boston College lost to Northwestern, 66-63, in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge on Dec. 4
- Northwestern leads the overall series, 4-2.

JUST THE FACTS

- Boston College is 6-3 at home and averaging 77.9 points while shooting 45.8 percent from the floor at Conte Forum. The Eagles averaged 67.8 points while shooting 40.5 percent from the floor on the road.
- In ACC action, BC is 1-4 at home and 4-2 on the road. The Eagles averaged 65.3 points per game while shooting 40.6% from the floor.
- Against Pitt, BC pulled out a win after being down with five minutes left in the game. It was the first time the Eagles came from behind. BC went on a 13-4 run in the final 3:44 to play.
- BC has used seven different starting lineups. **Emma Guy** is the lone player to start every game this season. She became the 27th player to reach the 1,000 point milestone (2.2).
- The win over No. 14 Florida State was the first victory over a ranked team since the 2015 season when BC beat No. 13 Duke at home. It was also the first win over FSU since the 2010 ACC Tournament.
- Marnelle Garraud** has swiped a career-high six steals in two games this season - vs. Lowell, vs. Tulane. She is one of three ACC players to record six steals this season, though she has done it twice.
- BC set a new program record with 63 points at the half vs. St. Francis. The old record was 61 points set by last year's team vs. Rider and the 1997 team vs. Marist.
- BC scored 106 points vs. St. Francis. The last time the Eagles scored over 100 points was at the St. Joseph's Thanksgiving Tournament in the 112-61 victory vs. Rider in the 2018-19 season. The program record is 113 points in

an OT win vs. Penn State in 2010.

- BC had 19 steals vs. Lowell, one away from tying the program record (20) set against Holy Cross (11.26.02).
- BC is 9-5 in season openers since the Eagles joined the ACC in 2005-06. The program is 33-14 in season openers since the 1972-73.

FRESH FACES

- BC welcomed two freshmen - **Jaelyn Batts** and **Akunna Konkwo** - and sophomore transfer **Cameron Swartz**.
- In the summer, Konkwo tore her Achilles and will miss the season.
- Batts, a native of South Riding, Va, is a 6-foot off guard with athleticism and length.
- She opened up her career with an impressive 4-for-4 from the floor with eight points before fouling out vs. Lowell.
- The rookie picked up her seventh start of the season vs. Louisville and posted a career-high 10 points (5-for-10 from the floor).
- She is averaging 2.7 points, 2.3 rebounds in 14.8 minutes per game.
- Swartz, a native of Marietta, Ga., played 7 games with Colorado before arriving at the Heights in January, 2019.
- She scored a career-high 27 points vs. Tulane at the Puerto Rico Clasico. She has reached double-figures 11 games. Swartz missed 2 games with an injury only to return vs. Georgia Tech (9 points.)

INCOMING CLASS

- Jo Jo Lacey**, **Kaylah Ivey** and **Sydney McQuietor** will join the Eagles in 2020. The class is ranked 31st in the country and 6th overall in the ACC by the Blue Star Basketball Report.
- Jo Jo Lacey**, a 6-foot-1 guard, averaged 12.3 points, 6.9 rebounds and 2.2 steals a game at Westtown as a junior. She is a three time Friends League First Tam honoree.
- A member of the AAU program, the Philadelphia Belles 17U EYBL team, Lacey played for the team that won the 2019 Indianapolis section of the EYBL Championship.
- She is ranked 39th in the country and sixth in her position according to The Blue Star Basketball Report. She is 55th overall and sixth in her position as reported by ESPN.
- Kaylah Ivey** plays both point and shooting guard at Riverdale Baptist in Maryland.
- As a junior she averaged 13.8 points and 3.8 rebounds a game. A native of Forestville, Maryland, Ivey plays AAU for Boo Williams 17-U EYBL team.
- The Blue Star Basketball Report ranks Ivey 14th in her position and 75th nationally.
- Sydney McQuietor**, a 6-foot-2 forward, plays at Keller in Texas. She compiled 533 points, 497 rebounds and 98 blocks last year.
- She was an All-District 6A First Team honoree.
- The Texas native is ranked 167th overall and 17th in per position according to The Blue Star Basketball Report.

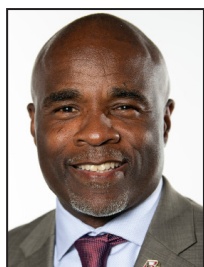

BC IN THE ACC - ACC HISTORY

- Boston College finished the 2019-20 season at 14-16 and 3-13 in the conference. Since joining the ACC in the 2005-06 season, BC is 63-161 (2.2.20).
- In the 1st season BC went 6-8 for a 7th place finish.
- The best finish for the Eagles took place in 08-09 and 09-10. The team finished with identical 7-7 records and in fifth place.
- In 2008-09, BC won its first ACC Tournament game vs. Virginia Tech (57-47).
- The first ACC victory in program history took place on Jan. 26, 2006 as the Eagles defeated Virginia at Conte Forum, 57-43. That was the start of a 6-game ACC win streak, the longest in program history.
- The 2012-13 team was the first to win two ACC road games - The Eagles defeated Virginia Tech, 53-46 on Jan. 10 and followed it up with a 66-43 win at Clemson on Jan. 13. The 2018-19 team repeated that feat by beating Wake Forest on Jan. 10 and Pittsburgh on Jan. 13.
