CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has an 8-2 home record, was defeated at home by College of Charleston 11-2 on Wednesday.

- The Tigers are averaging 3.6 runs per game and hitting .243 with a .348 on-base percentage, .345 slugging percentage and 19 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 2.64 ERA, .206 opponents' batting average and 2.47 strikeout-to-walk ratio and Clemson is fielding .962.

BOSTON COLLEGE OVERVIEW

- Boston College is led by 10th-year Head Coach Mike Gambino.
- The Eagles won two of four games in North Carolina last weekend. They are hitting .326 and have a 5.71 ERA and .971 fielding percentage.
- Joe Suozzi is hitting .439 with 12 RBIs, Jack Cunningham is batting .429, Cody Morissette is hitting .405 and Brian Dempsey is batting .390.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson is 6-0 when outhitting its opponent and 3-3 when not outhitting its opponent.
- Clemson has started at least three players at every position with the exception of catcher. Adam Hackenberg has started all 12 games there.
- Kier Meredith is the only Tiger in the 2020 season to start in the same spot (No. 2) in the batting order in all 12 games.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,365 fans per home date (10), the ninth-highest figure in the nation and first in the ACC (through games of March 4).
- Entering 2020, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 26 straight seasons and a top-15 figure 18 years in a row.

POLLS

- Clemson entered the rankings for the first time on March 2 and is ranked as high as No. 21 in the nation by Perfect Game.

The locker room is closed following games, therefore, postgame interviews are conducted in the auditorium of the player facility. See the opposing contact for opponent interview procedures.

- The Tigers were ranked in the top 25 by at least one poll for 55 straight weeks from May 9, 2016 to April 15, 2019.

SCORING STREAK

- Clemson has scored at least one run in 118 consecutive games.
- The last time Clemson was shut out was March 16, 2018, when No. 10 NC State blanked the Tigers 4-0 at Doug Kingsmore Stadium.
- The 118-game streak is the third-longest active streak in the nation.
- Eastern Kentucky (171) and Oklahoma State (148) have the two longest active streaks.
- The Clemson record for longest streak scoring at least one run is 232, set between May 10, 1982 to May 3, 1986.

ARMS CARRYING TIGERS

- Clemson's 9-3 start to the season is due in large part to its performance on the mound.
- Clemson has a 2.64 ERA, .206 opponents' batting average and 141 strikeouts in 109.0 innings pitched.
- Clemson has allowed only 17 extra-base hits (10 doubles, one triple, six homers).
- The staff has a 11.64 strikeout-per-nine-innings-pitched mark and 2.47 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- Clemson is holding opponents to .164 with runners on base, .157 with runners in scoring position and .050 with the bases loaded.
- Tiger pitchers have allowed just seven of 37 inherited baserunners to score.
- Clemson has pitched three shutouts and has held the opponent to three runs or less in nine of the 12 games.
- The Tigers are 3-0 in one-run games and 3-1 in two-run games.
- Over four games from Feb. 19-23, Clemson held opponents scoreless for 33 consecutive innings, its longest streak since May 3-9, 1967 (38).
- Clemson has been aided significantly by the return of righties Carter Raffield and Spencer Strider, who missed last season due to injury.

HENDERSON SPARKING THE TIGERS

- Sophomore outfielder and infielder Elijah Henderson only had 32 at-bats in 2019, but he has emerged as one of the Tigers' top hitters.
- He has made four starts in left field, four starts in right field and four starts at second base.
- He is hitting .302 with four doubles, five RBIs, seven runs, a .436 on-base percentage and three steals in 12 games in 2020.
- He has nine walks and two hit-by-pitches against only four strikeouts.
- He hit a walkoff single in the 10th inning in the 1-0 win over Stony Brook on Feb. 22. He reached base in all five plate appearances.
- In his career, he is hitting .240 with four doubles, a homer, 10 RBIs, a .370 on-base percentage and three steals in 31 games (20 starts).

MEREDITH GETTING ON BASE

- Sophomore outfielder Kier Meredith is doing what he has always done best...finding a way to get on base.
- He has a .556 on-base percentage thanks in large part to five walks and five hit-by-pitches against only four strikeouts in 2020.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in all 12 games in 2020.
- He is hitting .455 with two doubles, a homer, four RBIs, nine runs and two steals in 12 games (12 starts).
- He is hitting .571 with runners on base and .600 with runners in scoring position.

- He went 4-for-5 with a double, RBI and run against East Tennessee State on Feb. 25.
- He went 4-for-5 with a homer, double, two RBIs and two runs at South Carolina on Feb. 28.
- He was named ACC Player-of-the-Week on March 2, as he was 11-for-18 (.611) with two doubles, a homer and three RBIs in four games.
- In his career, he is hitting .327 with five doubles, a triple, two homers, 10 RBIs, a .482 on-base percentage and eight steals in 34 games.
- He was hampered by injury in each of his first two seasons (2018,19), playing a total of only 22 games (20 starts) those two years.

SHARPE PROVIDING DUAL ROLE AGAIN

- Sophomore utility player Davis Sharpe is continuing his dual role from his freshman season by doing the same in 2020.
- He is 1-1 with a 2.51 ERA, .250 opponents' batting average and 16 strikeouts against three walks in 14.1 innings pitched over three starts.
- He is hitting .345 with two homers, two doubles, five RBIs, four runs, a .486 on-base percentage and a steal in nine games on offense.
- In his first two starts of 2020 (against Liberty and Stony Brook) in February, he pitched 11.0 scoreless innings with 12 strikeouts.
- In his career, he is 8-5 with a 3.10 ERA and 100 strikeouts against 36 walks in 98.2 innings pitched over 18 appearances (17 starts).
- In his career, he is hitting .278 with six doubles, five homers, 23 RBIs, a .398 on-base percentage and four steals in 47 games (43 starts).

SPIERS CLOSING THE DOOR AGAIN

- Senior righthander moved into the closer role in 2019 and is in the same role in 2020.
- He is one of only two seniors on the 2020 team, joining righthander Sheldon Reed.
- He is 1-0 with four saves, an 0.00 ERA, .088 opponents' batting average and 11 strikeouts against three walks in 10.0 innings pitched.
- He has made a team-high six relief appearances.
- He has allowed just one of his five inherited baserunners to score in 2020.
- In his career, he is 5-7 with 19 saves, a 2.60 ERA and 97 strikeouts against 38 walks in 104.0 innings pitched over 68 relief appearances.
- His 19 career saves are tied for third most in Tiger history. The school record is 34, held by Scott Winchester (1993-95).
- He has allowed just 68 hits in his career, good for a .183 opponents' batting average.
- His 5.88 hits-per-nine-innings-pitched mark in his career is third in Clemson history.
- He has allowed just 14 of his 79 inherited baserunners to score in his career.

WEATHERLY STORMING BATTERS

- Junior lefthander Sam Weatherly has emerged as Clemson's Friday starter on the mound in 2020.
- He is 2-0 with an 0.53 ERA, .077 opponents' batting average and 33 strikeouts against 10 walks in 17.0 innings pitched over three starts.
- He has allowed just four hits (three singles, one double).
- He is holding opponents to 0-for-20 with runners on base and 1-for-16 (.063) with two outs.
- He earned national player-of-the-week honors by Collegiate Baseball in back-to-back weeks in late February and early March.
- He pitched 6.0 scoreless innings of two-hit ball with 14 strikeouts (most by a Tiger since 1996) against Stony Brook on Feb. 21.

NOTES

- He pitched 7.0 hitless and scoreless innings with 11 strikeouts to earn the win at South Carolina on Feb. 28.
- He received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the South Carolina series.
- In his career, he is 4-0 with a 3.65 ERA and 96 strikeouts in 66.2 innings pitched over 32 appearances (eight starts).
- He has given up just 45 hits in his career, good for a .200 opponents' batting average.
