

CLEMSON MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

CLEMSON VS. PURDUE

NOVEMBER 26, 2020

Player Notes

- » **PJ Hall** finished with 10 points and seven rebounds in his collegiate debut to help lead the Tigers to victory over Mississippi State.
- » Hall finished 5-for-6 from the floor and led the team with three offensive rebounds.
- » **Alex Hemenway** finished with a career-high four rebounds against Mississippi State.
- » Clemson's depth came through in game one with 26 points off the bench. With **Aamir Simms** fouling out and playing just 7:34, it was all needed.
- » In his debut, **Nick Honor** finished with eight points and hit two threes and finished +13 on the floor.
- » In total, four Tigers made their Clemson debuts in the season opener: Hall, Honor, **Olivier-Maxence Prosper** and **Lynn Kidd**.
- » **Hunter Tyson** led the Tigers in rebounding, finishing with eight boards. Tyson finished the game with five points, eight rebounds (two offensive) and a block.
- » **Jonathan Baehre** scored his first points as a Tiger, finishing with two points and adding a rebound and two assists. Baehre joined the team during the 2018 offseason from UNC Asheville. The senior has suffered two torn ACLs and had managed just two games played to this point.
- » **Al-Amir Dawes** finished with 10 points, tying Hall for the team lead in the season opener. It was Dawes' ninth double-digit scoring game of his career.
- » **Clyde Trapp** finished with five points, four rebounds and four assists against the Bulldogs. Trapp has achieved four or more assists seven times in his career.

Team Notes

- » Clemson moved to 4-1 all-time against Mississippi State and avenged its loss from the 2018-19 season, an 82-71 loss in the 2018 Never Forget Tribute Classic.
- » Head Coach **Brad Brownell** won his 186th game at Clemson with the 53-42 win over Mississippi State and is now just 14 victories shy of the 200 mark.
- » Coach Brownell is now 10-1 in season openers during his Clemson tenure.
- » The Tigers held the Bulldogs to just 42 points in the season opener – marking the 48th time that has happened during the **Brad Brownell** Era. Clemson is 46-2 in such games and has won its last 25 contests allowing less than 50 points (25-0). The streak dates back to Feb. 17, 2013 (45-43 loss to Miami (Fla.)).
- » The last time the Tigers won its last game of a season and also its first game of the next season was 1945-46 and 1946-47.
- » Clemson is 3-2 all-time against Purdue.
