HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE

- Wednesday's match will be the 60th in series history.
- The last time the two sides met on Nov. 18 was in 2001, when Clemson defeated Virginia, 1-0.
- The most common scoreline in the series is 2-0, as it has happened 14 times.
- Clemson is 6-3-1 when entering a match in the series after losing the previous two meetings against Virginia. Virginia hasn't won three consecutive matches since Oct. 20, 1996.
- This is just the second time the two sides will meet in the ACC Semifinals.
- Clemson is 1-2-1 in ACC Tournament matches played in Chapel Hill, N.C.
- Clemson is 0-0-1 in ACC Semifinal matches played in Chapel Hill, N.C., with Clemson advancing over NC State in the PK's in 1992.

- On Sept. 22, 2020, Clemson's men's and women's soccer teams moved into its new Soccer Operations Complex. The new facility cost nearly \$8 million and became the nation's finest soccer-only facility in the nation.
- The men's soccer team joined the Clemson community on June 13 by partaking in a peaceful demonstration organized by Clemson student-athletes and members of the surrounding community. Justin Malou, George Marks and Quinn McNeill were some of the team members present at the event.
- George Marks currently serves as Clemson's SAAC President and is joined by Enrique Montana III and John Martin as members of SAAC. Marks has been instrumental in helping to guide Clemson's student-athletes through the recent discussions surrounding social injustice and has been instrumental in helping student-athletes have their voice heard on social media and on the field of play.
- On Oct. 28, Clemson learned of the passing of former head coach, Trevor Adair. Adair was the program's third head coach and amassed a record of 174-91-26 across 14 seasons leading the team (1995-2008). Adair led the program to the 2005 College Cup, two ACC Championships, nine NCAA Tournament appearances, six NCAA Tournament Quarterfinal appearances, 14 All-America honors and 47 All-ACC selections.

- Clemson's two losses were the fewest in a single season since 1998.
- The Tigers' six wins during the ACC portion of the regular season is tied for the most during a season with Noonan at the helm. The first occurrence was in 2015.
- Clemson ranked sixth-best in the nation in win percentage.
- A total of 26 players saw playing time for the Tigers, while 21 players participated in five or more games.
- Three goalies saw action in multiple games during the season.

- In **Noonan's** 11 years at Clemson, his side scored three or more goals in 51 matches.
- In the 51 matches, **Noonan** is undefeated.
- When **Noonan's** side scores three or four goals in a match, they are 38-0-2.
