CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has a 4-0 home record, defeated East Tennessee State 7-3 at home on Tuesday behind two home runs by Caden Grice.

- The Tigers are averaging 5.7 runs per game and hitting .265 with a .370 on-base percentage, .435 slugging percentage and seven steals.
- The pitching staff has a 3.05 ERA, .240 opponents' batting average and 6.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio and Clemson is fielding .968.

NOTRE DAME OVERVIEW

- Notre Dame, who has played all three games on the road, is led by second-year Head Coach Link Jarrett.
- The Fighting Irish won two of three games at Wake Forest last week. They are hitting .243 and have a 4.85 ERA and 1.000 fielding percentage.
- Jared Miller is hitting .538, David LaManna is batting .444 and Niko Kavadas is hitting .333 with two homers and five RBIs.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson is 4-0 when committing less than two errors and 0-2 when committing two or more errors.
- Dylan Brewer and James Parker have reached base in all six games.
- Clemson's Rob Hughes and Notre Dame's John Michael Bertrand were teammates at Furman in 2019 and 2020.

POLLS

- Clemson fell out of the rankings this week after being ranked as high as No. 22 in the nation by Collegiate Baseball last week.

SCORING STREAK

- Clemson has scored at least one run in 129 consecutive games.
- The last time Clemson was shut out was March 16, 2018, when No. 10 NC State blanked the Tigers 4-0 at Doug Kingsmore Stadium.
- The 129-game streak is the third-longest active scoring streak in the nation.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

- Eastern Kentucky (182) and Oklahoma State (160) have the two-longest active scoring streaks.
- The Clemson record for longest streak scoring at least one run is 232, set between May 10, 1982 to May 3, 1986.

TIGER PITCHERS MISSING BATS

- The 2020 Tiger pitching staff set the school record for strikeouts per nine innings pitched (10.85).
- The 2021 Clemson pitching staff is ahead of that figure, with 78 strikeouts in 56.0 innings pitched, good for a 12.54 mark.
- Tiger pitchers have only allowed 13 walks (6.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio). The school record in that category is 3.93, set by the 2017 team.
- Clemson combined for 21 strikeouts against three walks in 10.1 innings pitched against No. 16 South Carolina at Greenville, S.C. on Feb. 27.
- The Tigers combined for 17 strikeouts against one walk in 9.0 innings pitched against East Tennessee State on March 2.
- Clemson combined for 15 strikeouts against one walk in 9.0 innings pitched against Cincinnati on Feb. 19.
- Davis Sharpe has 19 strikeouts in 9.0 innings pitched, while Geoffrey Gilbert has 13 strikeouts in 5.1 innings pitched.

TWO TIGERS NAMED CAPTAINS

- Junior and graduate righthander Evan Estridge and sophomore catcher Adam Hackenberg were named team co-captains.
- The two were voted co-captains in a vote by the players in the preseason.
- Estridge played two years at Newberry, then transferred to Clemson, where he walked on and sat out his first year (2019) due to NCAA rules.
- Hackenberg is in his third year in the program and won the 2020 Tiger Baseball Award as the team's best leader.

BREWER GETTING ON BASE

- Freshman outfielder Dylan Brewer has a .552 on-base percentage thanks in large part to nine walks in six games in 2021.
- He is hitting .368 with two doubles, a homer, five RBIs, seven runs and three steals.
- In his career, he is hitting .279 with seven doubles, two homers, 11 RBIs, 18 runs, a .457 on-base percentage and six steals in 22 games.

PARKER SOLIDIFYING INFIELD

- Sophomore James Parker has continued his role as the starting shortstop in 2021 after leading the team in starts at shortstop in 2020.
- He is hitting .435 with two doubles, two homers, six RBIs, four runs and a .536 on-base percentage in six games in 2021.
- He has a .947 fielding percentage in 19 chances.
- He had a 12-game hitting streak, which included the last seven games of 2020 and the first five games of 2021.
- He hit a home run and later added a walkoff single in the 10th inning in the 8-7 win over Cincinnati on Feb. 21.
- In his career, he is hitting .292 with seven doubles, four homers, 21 RBIs, 20 runs and four steals in 46 games (34 starts).
