SERIES HISTORY

Ohio is 0-3 all-time against Clemson. Ohio fell in the last meeting, 89-81, in overtime in 2009 at the Convocation Center in Athens.

OHIO IN THE WNIT

Ohio has appeared in the WNIT four times, coming in 2016,2017, 2019 and this season. The Bobcats are 4-3 in the WNIT, and made it the round of eight in the WNIT in 2019 after beating High Point, MTSU and Western Kentucky before falling Northwestern on the road.

ALL-AMERICA

Senior guard Cece Hooks was named Honorable Mention All-America by the Associated Press. Hooks is the first All-American from Ohio since 1986, when Caroline Mast won the honor.

Hooks produced one of the best individual seasons in

Ohio women's basketball history. The Dayton, Ohio native was named MAC Player of the Week a league-high five times this season and is currently ranked third in the nation in points per game at 25.9. Hooks had 19 games of 20 points or more and five with 30 or more. Hooks was the second player in program history to record a triple-double and one of just 12 players in the nation after scoring 31 points, 11 assists and 10 steals against Miami. Her 10 steals were a single-game school record. Hooks became the second 2,000 point scorer in program history when she posted 22 points at Ball State. Only Mast — the three-time Player of the Year — has reached the 2,000-point feat. Hooks who already owns the all-time single-game scoring record — posted the fourth-highest single-game mark with 38 points against Akron. During the regular season, Hooks averaged 26.3 points 6.3 rebounds, 3.7 steals and 4.1 assists. On the defensive side, Hooks has 84 steals this season and is averaging 3.8 steals per game, her highest game average in her four-year career.

MAC PLAYER AND DEFENSIVE OF THE YEAR

Cece Hooks was named MAC Player and Defensive Player of the Year. Hooks is the first player to win the Player of the Year award for Ohio since Caroline Mast won the honor for three-straight seasons from 1984-86. Hooks has now won the Defensive Player of the Year award for the third-straight season and is one of just two players in league history to have won the award three

THREE ON THE ALL-MAC TEAM

Cece Hooks, Gabby Burris and Erica Johnson were all All-MAC. Hooks was on the first team, Johnson third team, and Burris was honorable mention.

TRIPLE-DOUBLE, STEALS RECORD

Cece Hooks posted the second triple-double in program history in Ohio's regular season finale against Miami. Hooks had 31 points, 11 assists and 10 steals, and the 10 steals were a program record for steals in a game. Hooks joins Erica Johnson as the only players who have posted a triple-double.

SECOND 2,000 POINT SCORER

When Cece Hooks scored 22 points in the win over Ball State, Hooks became the second player in program history to hit 2,000 points in her career. Hooks is currently second in scoring with 2,139 points, behind Caroline Mast.

FOURTH-HIGHEST SINGLE GAME SCORER EVER

In Ohio's comeback win over WMU, Cece Hooks tied the fourth-highest scoring output in program history with 38 points on 14-of-23 shooting. Hooks tied Kiyanna Black. Hooks is also tied with Marlene Stollings for highest scoring output ever at 41, which she set last season at Akron.

THIRD IN THE NATION

Cece Hooks is third in the nation and first in the MAC in points per game at 25.9 this season. Anastasia Hayes from Middle Tennessee State leads the nation at 26.7 points per game.

FILLING IT UP

Ohio is first in the MAC and 14th in the nation in scoring offense. Ohio is averaging 78.5 points per game. Ohio's high is 93 points, which they scored at Central Michigan.

TWO PLAYER OF THE WEEK AWARDS, AVERAGING 30

Hooks averaged 30+ for the second-straight week and was named player of the week for the second-straight week. Against Akron, Hooks had 31 points in just three quarters on the floor while knocking down her first four three-pointers. Against EMU, Hooks pulled in a season-high 11 rebounds for her first double-double of the season after adding 29 points. Hooks averaged 30 points, eight rebounds, 4.5 assists and 2.5 steals per game against Akron and EMU.

DOWN 11 AND WON

Ohio was down 11 with less than three minutes and stormed back to beat Buffalo, 84-81. ESPN's win probability had Ohio with a 0.02 % chance to win the game. Kaylee Bambule hit the go-ahead three-pointer with 12 seconds left to put Ohio up 82-81. Cece Hooks made a layup with two seconds left to seal the three-point victory for the Bobcats.

NINE-STRAIGHT FREE THROWS TO WIN

In Ohio's 85-70 win over Kent State, Gabby Burris posted a season-high 22 points and five rebounds. Burris was 6-of-12 from the field and 9-of-10 from the free-throw line. Burris made nine-straight free-throws down the stretch to seal the game for the Bobcats.

GETTING TO THE LINE

Cece Hooks is 6th in the nation in free-throws attempted and 17th in the nation in made free-throws. Hooks is 121-of-182 from the charity stripe this season.

RANKED WIN

Against Notre Dame, Ohio grabbed its second-ranked win in program history and first in the Boldon era when OU took down No. 22 Notre Dame, 86-85. The win was Ohio's first win over Notre Dame.

BACK-TO-BACK OHIO HIGHS FOR KROLL

In back-to-back games, Caitlyn Kroll has posted her scoring high. In Ohio's win over Toledo, Kroll knocked down four threes and had 14 points, her largest scoring

output since transferring to Ohio. Against Ball State on Jan. 13, Kroll answered with 20 points and an Ohio-high six threes made.

90+ FOR FIRST TIME THIS SEASON

Ohio scored 90 or more for the first time this season in Ohio's 93-84 win over Central Michigan. Both Erica Johnson and Cece Hooks had 26 points in the win.

ANOTHER MAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Cece Hooks was named MAC Player of the Week for this second time this season on Jan. 12. Hooks filled up the stat sheet in both of Ohio's wins last week. She started the week with 26 points on 9-of-15 shooting and 8-of-12 from the free-throw line in OU's 72-63 win at Miami while adding five rebounds, five steals, two blocks and two assists. In the Bobcats' 85-66 win over Toledo, Hooks had 24 points, six steals five rebounds, four blocks and three assists. For the week, Hooks averaged 25.5 points, five rebounds, 5.5 steals, three blocks and 2.5 assists over the two games.

BATTLE OF THE BRICKS WIN

Ohio got back in the win column against Miami on the road, 72-63. Hooks had 26 points on 9-of-15 shooting, while Gabby Burris poured in 19 points on 7-of-10 shooting. Ohio shot 50.0% for the first time since taking down Toledo last season.

FIVE IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Ohio had five players with double-digit points and one player with nine points in Ohio's 77-67 win at Northern Illinois. Cece Hooks led the way with 26 points, while Erica Johnson, Gabby Burris, Peyton Guice and Madi Mace all had 10 or more points.

Both Guice and Mace had 10 points in the win, both career highs.

HOOKS NAMED MAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Cece Hooks was named MAC Player of the Week her performance over No. 22 Notre Dame. Hooks registered 32 points in Ohio's win over No. 22 Notre Dame on Friday (Nov. 27). Hooks went 10-of-23 from the floor and 10-of-14 from the free-throw line, while knocking down two threes. Hooks added eight rebounds and two assists in the win. In the Bobcats' season-opening victory over Liberty, Hooks had 18 points, seven rebounds and two steals.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE IN GAME ONE

In Ohio's season-opening win over Liberty, 76-72, Erica Johnson had 31 points and 10 rebounds. Johnson's 31 points mark the fourth time she's scored 30 or more in a single game

PRESEASON ALL-MAC

Senior guard Cece Hooks and junior guard Erica Johnson were named Preseason First-Team All-MAC for the second-straight season. Ohio finished second in the coaches poll with 128 points, behind favorite Central Michigan.

BECKY HAMMON MID-MAJOR PLAYER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

Redshirt junior guard Erica Johnson (Mansfield, Ohio) and senior guard Cece Hooks (Dayton, Ohio) have been named to the 2021 Becky Hammon MidMajor Player of the Year preseason watch list, Her Hoop Stats announced. Ohio is joined by San Jose State as the only other team with two players on the watchlist. In the Mid-American Conference, Hooks and Johnson are joined by Micaela Kelly of Central Michigan and Dyaisha Fair of Buffalo.

CHERYL MILLER AWARD WATCH LIST

Redshirt junior guard Erica Johnson has been named to the 2021 Cheryl Miller Award watch list, the Basketball Hall of Fame announced The Cheryl Miller Award recognizes the top small forward in NCAA Division I basketball.

NANCY LIEBERMAN AWARD WATCH LIST

Ohio Women's Basketball senior guard Cece Hooks (Dayton, Ohio) has been named to the 2021 Nancy Lieberman Award watch list, the Basketball Hall of Fame announced.

Hooks also appeared on the list last season. Hooks is one of two players in the MAC to appear on the list.

LAST YEAR'S HONORS

For the second-straight year, Cece Hooks was named MAC Defensive of the Year. Hooks was also named to the All-MAC First team and MAC All-Defensive team.

Joining Hooks was Erica Johnson on the All-MAC first team. Johnson was MAC Freshman of the Year, Sixth Player of the Year and All-MAC third team two years ago. Johnson averaged 21.4 points per game in conference play last season.

1,000 POINT SCORERS

Three Bobcats - Gabby Burris, Erica Johnson and Cece Hooks - are all 1,000 point scorers for Ohio.

Burris averaged 9.9 points per game last season.

Johnson scored her 1,000th point in Ohio's win over Western Michigan in the MAC Tournament.

Hooks averaged 18.2 last season.

Bob Boldon enters his eighth season as head coach of the Ohio women's basketball program in 2020-21.

Boldon is the winningest coach in program history at 149 victories heading into the 2020-21 season at Ohio. Boldon broke the program record in 2018-19 in a win at Miami and reached the 100-win mark faster than any coach in Ohio history. OU has taken down seven Power Five teams in his time at Ohio, including one win over Big Ten teams in each season since 2015.

The 2015 Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year. Boldon has coached two MAC Freshman of the Year winners, three MAC Defensive Plaver of the Year winners, one MAC Sixth Player of the Year winner and 13 players on the All-MAC first, second or third team.

Boldon's players have rewritten the Ohio and MAC record book. Kiyanna Black (2012-16) holds the MAC and Ohio record for threes made in a season (126) and is second in the MAC and first in Ohio for threes made in a career at 329. Six of Ohio's 10 top three-point field goal makers played under Boldon. Current guard Cece Hooks set the career steals record (316) as a junior and also sits atop the single-season steals list with 110 in 2018-19

Boldon's teams are some of the highest-scoring teams in program and MAC history. The 2014-15 Bobcats made a program-high 296 three-pointers, the second-most in MAC history. The highest-scoring team in program history (2,746) came under Boldon in 2018-19, while three of the top-five highest-scoring seasons in program history happened under Boldon.

Boldon himself currently holds the fifth-highest all-time coaching winning percentage in MAC history at .668.

The 2019-20 season saw Boldon's Bobcats put three on the All-MAC team in Cece Hooks, Erica Johnson and Amani Burke. Hooks and Johnson were First-Team All-MAC, while Hooks won MAC Defensive Player of the Year for the second-consecutive season after becoming the all-time steals leader in OU history as a junior. Ohio finished the season with a win in the MAC Tournament Semifinals before the tournament and season were canceled due to the COVID-19 crisis. Ín non-conference play, Ohio took down Ohio State, 74-68, for the first time in program history on the road in Columbus. Ohio's team became the first in program history to have four 1,000-point scorers on one team (Erica Johnson, Cece Hooks, Amani Burke, Gabby Burris) when Erica Johnson scored her 1,000th point in the MAC semifinals win over Western Michigan.

Boldon led the Bobcats to a historic season in 2018-19, becoming the first head coach to win 30 games in one season at Ohio University in either the women's or men's program. The 30 win total has only been reached four times by a MAC team. Boldon guided his team to the Round of Eight in the Women's National Invitation Tournament, the farthest Ohio has ever reached in a postseason tournament. Ohio rewrote the record book in 2018-19, scoring more points (2,746), making more field goals (980) and making more threes (341) than any other team in program history. Ohio's Erica Johnson won Mid-American Conference Sixth Player and Freshman of the Year, while Cece Hooks - who broke the single-season steals record (112) - won MAC Defensive Player of the Year. Hooks ended up making first-team All-MAC, while Johnson and Amani Burke were placed on the third team.

In 2017-18, Cece Hooks won MAC Freshman of the Year as Ohio advanced to the MAC Quarterfinals. The Bobcats placed four on the Academic All-MAC team and picked up a road win against Purdue on the road in West Lafayette.

Ohio followed their 26-win season in 2015-16 with a 22-10 season and a trip to the WNIT in 2016-17. Ohio had a Big Ten win over Illinois, 80-68 in non-conference play. Boldon placed one player — Quiera Lampkins — on the All-MAC Second Team while Jasmine Weatherspoon made the All-MAC Defensive Team. Four players landed on the Academic All-MAC team.

Boldon and the Bobcats had their third 26-win season in program history in 2015-16 and their second MAC regular-season title. The team saw its fourth postseason appearance in program history, where the Bobcats took down Marshall and Virginia Tech to advance to the third round of the WNIT. In the 2015-16 season, junior guard Quiera Lampkins was named the 2016 Mid-American Conference Defensive Player of the Year and earned a spot on the All-MAC Second Team and the All-Defensive Team. Senior guard Kivanna Black was named to the All-MAC First Team for the second-consecutive season. Senior forward Lexie Baldwin was named All-MAC Honorable Mention and junior forward Jasmine Weatherspoon was also named to the All-Defensive Team.

Boldon and the Bobcats set a then-program record for most wins (27) in a season in 2014-15. Boldon led the `Cats to a MAC Regular Season and Tournament Championship and a berth in the NCAA Tournament, Ohio's first since 1995. Boldon was named MAC Coach of the Year after winning both the regular season and MAC Tournament title, when they defeated Eastern Michigan, 60-44. Ohio's 2014-15 team had the second-highest winning percentage in program history and was the fourth-highest scoring team in program history (2,233). Kiyanna Black earned First-team All-MAC honors after averaging 16 points per game and four rebounds per game. Quiera Lampkins also found herself on the All-MAC squad earning third-team honors averaging 12.5 points per game along with 6.7 rebounds per contest. Mariah Byard was also earned All-MAC honorable mention posting 9.7 points per game. Byard and Sophomore quard Yamonie Jenkins garnered Academic All-MAC honors as well.

The 2013-14 season brought the implementation of Boldon's motion offense, and Boldon grabbed his first win of his Ohio Career with a 94-88 win in over Xavier inside the Convocation Center.

Ohio University Director of Athletics Jim Schaus named Boldon as the 10th head coach in program history on March 28, 2013.

Boldon came to Athens after spending the previous three years of his head coaching career at Youngstown State. The Northeast Ohio native inherited a program that had posted an 0-30 record during the 2009-10 season and turned it into a Women's National Invitational Tournament (WNIT) participant at the end of the 2012-13 season, posting two double-digit win seasons and one 23-win campaign along the way.

Boldon, a native of Louisville, Ohio, graduated from Walsh in 1997 with a bachelor's degree in elementary education. As a student-athlete, he was a two-time All-America selection as a point quard and helped lead the Cavaliers to the Final Four of the NAIA Tournament. A four-year starter, he remains the school record holder in assists (775) while also ranking fourth in scoring with 1,694 points. Boldon was a 2008 inductee to Walsh's Wall of Fame, and his accomplishments were celebrated as one of the program's top 50 players in its 50-year history in 2012. He earned his master's degree in liberal studies from
