PARTICIPATION

- Clemson saw 14 players make an appearance during Saturday's match against NC State.
- Six players earned 90 minutes in the match.
 - >> George Marks, Oskar Agren, Justin Malou, Hamady Diop, Charlie Asensio and Isaiah Reid.
- Two players have started in each of the Tigers' 14 matches this season.
 - >> Justin Malou and Charlie Asensio.
- Charlie Asensio leads the team in minutes played (1,296) this season.
- George Marks continues to lead the nation in goalkeeper minutes (1,236) played this season.

MILESTONE MOMENTS

- George Marks registered the 11th solo shutout of his career and third of the 2020-21 season.
 - >> This places Marks into a tie for 9th most all-time at Clemson.
 - >> Marks is now tied with Joe Bendik and Cody Mizell.
- Marks earned his 40th career appearance and 39th career start at Clemson during Saturday's match.
- Oskar Agren made his 35th start in the center of Clemson's defense.
- Charlie Asensio and Justin Malou earned their 14th starts of the season on Saturday.
 - >> The pair of outside-backs are the only two players on Clemson's roster to have earned the start in each match this season.
- Hamady Diop scored his first career goal and first career point against the Wolfpack.
 - >> Diop is the second player on this year's roster to have scored their first goal at Clemson from the PK spot.
 - >> Callum Johnson was the first to accomplish this in 2021 and did so against South Carolina (Oct. 1).

SERIES HISTORY

- Clemson improved to 41-15-7 against NC State with Saturday's victory.
- Clemson improved to 21-7-1 during home matches in the series.
- Head coach Mike Noonan improves his career record against NC State to 11-1.
- NC State's George Keifer is now 1-7 against Clemson, including a 1-4 record while leading the Wolfpack.
- Clemson has outscored NC State, 167-75.
- This was the fifth match which Clemson played NC State as the No. 1 ranked team.
- This was the 21st shutout in series history and the fourth consecutive match that Clemson blanked the Wolfpack.

CLEMSON AS NO. 1...

- Clemson improved to 56-10-3 when it played a match ranked No. 1.
- Clemson improved to 40-3-1 when playing at home while ranked No. 1 nationally.
- The Tigers are 4-1-0 under head coach Mike Noonan when ranked No. 1.

PROGRAM MILESTONES...

- Clemson improved its all-time record to 697-277-93 across 61 seasons of competition.
- Saturday's contest was the third consecutive match which Clemson has held its opponent to under 10 shots.
- Noonan moved into a tie for 10th amongst active NCAA Div. I head coaches for most all-time wins with 345.
- Noonan earned his 75th victory at Clemson when entering a match ranked higher than his opponent.
- Noonan led the team to its 65th shutout under his direction.
