PACK FACTS

A WIN ON SATURDAY WOULD

- Be the 531st win in program history (530-462-100)
- Be the 192nd win in head coach George Kiefer's career (191-113-63)
- Be Kiefer's 30th victory at NC State (29-27-12)
- Be Kiefer's ninth ACC win with the Pack (8-16-7)
- Give NC State its first win over a conference opponent during this 2020-21 campaign

TRACKING THE PACK

- A total of 21 players have made appearances for NC State, with five of those marking Wolfpack debuts. Five players have been named starters for the first time in their NC State careers, including true freshmen **Pau Palacin** and **Tal Segev**.
- Goalkeeper **Leon Krapf** made a career-high seven saves during the Pack's Oct. 23 match against Clemson. His six first-half stops tied his previous career high, which he'd set on two occasions during the 2018 campaign.
- Krapf has shut out three opponents this season UNC (0-0) on Nov. 1, UAB (2-0) on Feb. 20, VCU (1-0) on Feb. 24 and Wake Forest (0-0) on March 13. In his 50-game career, he has put together 18 games in which he did not concede a goal.
- The Wolfpack's 81 shot attempts have been distributed among 16 players, led by 14 strikes from **Kuda Muskwe**.
- NC State's six goals on the year have come from the feet or heads of four different players Alex Bautista (1), Brisma (2), Muskwe (2) and Segev (1).

LAST TIME OUT

- NC State battled to a scoreless draw in its March 13 match at fourth-ranked Wake Forest. The result marked the Pack's second draw in ACC play this season after also tying 0-0 with North Carolina in the fall
- The Pack ended the game with an 11-10 edge in shots, with two of those coming on target. After being out-shot 7-2 in the opening 45 minutes, NC State went on to outshoot Wake Forest by that same tally in the second half.
- All three of Wake Forest's shots on goal were in the first half, with all easily saved by Krapf.

SERIES HISTORY (NC State trails 15-40-7)

• Saturday marks the 63rd overall meeting between NC State and Clemson. The squads have played each other at least once every

season since their first meeting in 1967.

- The Wolfpack has won just one of its last 12 matches against the Tigers. In 2017, George Kiefer's first season at the helm of the program, NC State upset then-No. 3 Clemson by a 1-0 score at home.
- NC State and Clemson faced off in the fall at Dail Soccer Stadium. The then-third-ranked Tigers came away with the 1-0 decision.

RANKED OPPONENT RECORD

Despite being 0-2-2 against top-five teams this season, NC State has picked up six victories over ranked opponents in the three prior seasons of the Kiefer era. Four of those six wins were against top-five foes. The last time the Wolfpack defeated the nation's top-ranked team was a 2018 upset over UNC inside Dail Stadium.

KRAPF BACK WITH THE PACK

Goalkeeper **Leon Krapf** makes his return to the pitch in the fall after suffering a season-ending injury in the 54th minute of NC State's 2019 opener. Prior to that injury, Krapf played every single minute in goal during each of his first two seasons with the Wolfpack (38 games).

His 1.15 career GAA mark currently ranks as second best in program history, and the redshirt junior's 18 career shutouts are good for fourth in the NC State record book. Krapf tallied seven of those career shutouts in during the 2018 season, with that number ranking third in the conference and 26th in the nation that year.

In addition to his leadership role on the field, Krapf also serves as:

- NC State's SAAC (Student-Athlete Advisory Committee) President for the 2020-21 academic year
- The conference's SAAC representative to the NCAA
- A member of the ACC's Search Advisory Committee that provided feedback on the search process for the league's new Commissioner

MUSKWE MAGIC

NC State is 6-1-0 all-time when striker **Kuda Muskwe** finds the back of the net. His four match winners in 2019 ranked 30th nationally at the conclusion of last season and tied for fifth in the league. The Pack's Oct. 18 loss to Navy marked the only time that the Pack has

2019 REWIND

- The Pack went 9-7-3 (3-4-1 ACC) on the year with a ranked win over Louisville, which was No. 17 in the nation when the two teams faced off. That victory was NC State's only true road win of the season.
- NC State finished fifth in the conference standings, the team's best ACC finish since 2005.
- With its qualification for the 2019 NCAA Championship, NC State made its third consecutive postseason appearance for the first time since 1985-87.
- The squad finished listed 37th in the final NCAA RPI of the season that was released on Dec. 15.

LEADER OF THE PACK

NC State head coach **George Kiefer** ranks among some of the winningest active DI coaches in the nation. Through the 2019 season, his .627 career winning percentage ranked 31st in the country. Kiefer is one of eight ACC head coaches with a winning percentage that ranked in the top 35 at the start of the 2020 campaign.

APP TO PACK

Kiefer and his staff welcomed the addition of two former Appalachian State starters after the Mountaineers' men's soccer program was discontinued. **Parker Cross** and **Alex Hernandez** both spent their first two seasons of collegiate action in Boone and appeared in all 19 games for Appalachian State in 2019. Hernandez was the Mountaineers' team leader in goals (5) last season, and Cross started all 19 games while finishing the year with three assists.

#PACKUNITED

During the 2020-21 season, the Wolfpack will wear warmup shirts that showcase the department's #PackUnited movement against racial and social injustice. The logo, which was collaborated on by student-athletes from across multiple sports, features the three pillars of the movement: Education, Action, Awareness. The #PackUnited movement is a direct result of NC State's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC) and the Black Athlete Coalition's efforts to unite all student-athletes toward a greater cause.

EPL CONNECTION

Wolfpack defender **Jamie Smith**'s father Dean, is the manager of Aston Villa (English Premiere League) and managed to get his club over the line in 2019-20 with a late-season surge to avoid relegation. Dean Smith was appointed head coach in 2018 and helped Villa reach promotion for the first time since 2016. Jamie was able to make the journey home to Birmingham in the spring of 2019 to see the club's journey to promotion to the EPL.

Smith has a bit of a friendly rival connection to teammate and fellow Birmingham native **Brad Sweeney**. Sweeney played in West Bromwich's youth academy. Aston Villa and West Brom share a local rivalry, with their stadiums set just four miles away from each other.

STACKED SCHEDULE

With the unique circumstances of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Wolfpack's schedule is filled with matchups against some of the nation's best. Six out of NC State's 15 matches are against top-10 opponents.

KIEFER'S NCAA STREAK

Fourth-year head coach **George Kiefer** has qualified for 13 NCAA Championships as a head coach (10 at USF). Including his time with the Bulls, he has led his teams to the postseason

in 12 of the last 13 years. NC State has not missed an NCAA Tournament under his leadership.




