CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has a 5-5 road record, lost at home against College of Charleston 13-6 on Tuesday.
- The Tigers are averaging 5.8 runs per game and hitting .259 with a .419 slugging percentage, .359 on-base percentage and 18 steals.

MIAMI OVERVIEW

- Miami, who has a 9-5 home record, is led by third-year Head Coach Gino DiMare.
- The Hurricanes defeated Florida Gulf Coast 3-2 at home on Wednesday. They are hitting .263 and have a 4.76 ERA and .966 fielding percentage.
- Christian Del Castillo is hitting .364 with 25 RBIs, Yohandy Morales has seven homers and 27 RBIs and Carson Palmquist has nine saves.

QUICK HITS

- Each of Clemson's last 21 regular-season games are against teams in the top 64 of the unofficial RPI (WarrenNolan.com).
- Clemson is 12-1 when outhitting its opponent. That one loss came against College of Charleston on Tuesday.
- No Tiger has pitched more than 26.1 innings this season, but 11 Tigers have pitched at least 14.2 innings.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in fourth place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 9-9 league mark.
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is tied for eighth place.

BATS HEATING UP

- Clemson's season batting average has risen to .259 thanks to the last 11 games, when the Tigers are hitting .300.
- In the last 11 contests, Clemson has totaled 11.1 hits per game, 7.0 runs per game, a .451 slugging percentage and .390 on-base percentage.
- Clemson has totaled at least nine hits in 10 of the last 11 games.
- Clemson is 6-3 in ACC games during that stretch.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

BULLPEN PROVIDING RELIEF

- Clemson's bullpen has kept it in many games this season.
- The bullpen is 9-6 with a 3.42 ERA, .237 opponents' batting average and 149 strikeouts against 52 walks in 144.2 innings pitched.
- It has a 2.87 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

TWO TIGERS NAMED CAPTAINS

- Junior and graduate righthander Evan Estridge and sophomore catcher Adam Hackenberg were named team co-captains.
- The two were voted co-captains in a vote by the players in the preseason.
- Estridge played two years at Newberry, then transferred to Clemson, where he walked on and sat out his first year (2019) due to NCAA rules.
- Hackenberg is in his third year at Clemson and won the 2020 Tiger Baseball Award as the team's best leader.

ANGLIN EMERGING IN ROTATION

- Freshman righthander Mack Anglin was a reliever early in the 2021 season, but he has recently moved into the weekend rotation.
- He is 1-1 with a 2.18 ERA, .200 opponents' batting average and 29 strikeouts against four walks in 20.2 innings pitched over six outings.
- He has allowed just 14 hits, all singles, in 2021.
- He has made two starts and has allowed seven hits, one run and no walks with 12 strikeouts in 9.0 innings pitched in his starts.
- Opponents are 0-for-7 with five strikeouts with the bases loaded.
- In four outings (two starts) in ACC games, he is 1-1 with a 1.80 ERA, .164 opponents' batting average and 21 strikeouts against two walks.
- He pitched 6.0 innings of one-hit ball with six strikeouts against no walks to earn his first career win against Virginia on April 9.
- In his career, he is 1-2 with a 4.55 ERA and 40 strikeouts against 15 walks in 27.2 innings pitched over 10 appearances (five starts).

ASKEW RETURNS ON TOP OF HIS GAME

- Sophomore lefthander Keyshawn Askew suffered a leg injury in a scrimmage on Feb. 14 and did not make his first outing until March 14.
- He has recovered and been one of the team's best pitchers since his return.
- He is 1-0 with a 2.84 ERA and .255 opponents' batting average in 25.1 innings pitched over five appearances (four starts).
- He has 29 strikeouts against only two walks and has allowed only three extra-base hits, including no homers.
- Clemson is 3-1 in his four starts, all in ACC games.
- In his career, he is 3-1 with a 3.80 ERA and .269 opponents' batting average in 83.0 innings pitched over 26 appearances (14 starts).
- He has 77 strikeouts against 28 walks in his career.

BREWER PRODUCTIVE

- Freshman outfielder Dylan Brewer has a .346 on-base percentage thanks in part to 19 walks and four hit-pitches in 29 games in 2021.
- He is hitting .217 with six doubles, five homers, 22 RBIs, 23 runs and four steals.
- He is one of only two Tigers (James Parker) to start every game in 2021.
- He totaled two homers and six RBIs in Clemson's 10-6 win at NC State on April 2.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball on April 5. He totaled three homers and 10 RBIs in four games.

- In his career, he's hitting .226 with 11 doubles, six homers, 28 RBIs, 34 runs, a .367 on-base percentage and seven steals in 45 games.

CLARK IN CONTROL

- Junior lefthander Mat Clark has used his control and change of speed to be effective on the mound during his entire career.
- He is 1-0 with two saves, a 3.28 ERA and .242 opponents' batting average in 24.2 innings pitched over seven appearances (one start) in 2021.
- He has 23 strikeouts against one walk in 2021.
- In ACC games, he is 1-0 with a 2.84 ERA and .233 opponents' batting average in 19.0 innings pitched over five appearances (one start).
- In ACC games, he has 16 strikeouts against one walk.
- In 16.1 innings pitched after the fifth inning, he has allowed just nine hits, one run (0.55 ERA) and no walks with 14 strikeouts.
- In his career, he is 16-3 with a 2.95 ERA and .216 opponents' batting average in 131.0 innings pitched over 44 appearances (13 starts).
- His 84.2 career winning percentage is eighth in Clemson history.
- He has 120 strikeouts against only 31 walks in his career, good for a 3.87 strikeout-to-walk ratio, sixth in Clemson history.
- He has a 2.13 career walks-per-nine-innings-pitched mark, sixth in Clemson history.

CLAYTON CLUTCH IN RELIEF

- Freshman righthander Nick Clayton has been steady and clutch out of the bullpen in 2021.
- He is 4-1 with a 2.42 ERA, .183 opponents' batting average and 25 strikeouts against six walks in 22.1 innings pitched.
- In seven relief outings in ACC games, he is 2-1 with a 1.80 ERA, .211 opponents' batting average and 13 strikeouts against five walks.
- He pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in relief of two-hit ball with four strikeouts to earn the win at NC State on April 2.
- In his career, he is 5-1 with one save, a 1.74 ERA and 33 strikeouts against 10 walks in 31.0 innings pitched over 17 relief appearances.

GILBERT LEADING BULLPEN

- Freshman lefthander Geoffrey Gilbert has pitched late in games for the Tigers since his first season in 2020.
- He is 1-3 with three saves, a 1.37 ERA, .242 opponents' batting average and 35 strikeouts against nine walks in 26.1 innings pitched.
- In 11 relief outings in ACC games, he has allowed 16 hits and three earned runs (1.47 ERA) with 17 strikeouts in 18.1 innings pitched.
- He is holding opponents to a .173 batting average with runners on base.
- In his career, he is 2-3 with three saves, a 1.15 ERA and 49 strikeouts against 16 walks in 39.0 innings pitched over 24 relief appearances.

GRICE POWERING LINEUP

- Freshman lefty and first baseman Caden Grice showed his power potential in the fall and preseason, and he has carried that into the season.
- He was one of 45 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- He is hitting .340 with seven homers, a triple, five doubles, 27 RBIs, a .629 slugging percentage and .458 on-base percentage in 28 games.
- He is hitting .391 with runners on base and .393 with runners in scoring position.
- He has also made two starts on the mound in 2021.

NOTES

- With his 6'6" frame, he has saved several runs at first base with his ability to stretch and catch errant throws.
- He was named one of 12 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball on March 8 for his previous four games, when he hit four homers.
- He was 8-for-14 (.571) with three doubles, a triple, 10 RBIs and a .647 on-base percentage in the three-game series at Boston College.
- He was named ACC Player-of-the-Week on March 29 by leading Clemson to a 4-0 record in four road games the previous week.
- He was also named NCBWA National Hitter-of-the-Week on March 30.
- He was 9-for-18 with three doubles, a triple, homer, 13 RBIs, five runs, a .944 slugging percentage and .571 on-base percentage on the week.

HOFFMANN THROWING STRIKES

- Freshman righthander Nick Hoffmann has been effective mainly due to his ability to throw strikes.
- He is 3-0 with a 4.85 ERA, .299 opponents' batting average and 21 strikeouts against one walk in 26.0 innings pitched in 2021.
- He tossed a complete game in his first career start in Clemson's 7-2 win at Boston College in the second game of a doubleheader on March 27.
- Against the Eagles, he gave up just six hits (all singles), two runs and no walks with seven strikeouts, throwing 111 pitches.
- It was the first complete game by a Tiger since 2017.
- In his career, he is 5-1 with a 3.89 ERA and .278 opponents' batting average in 37.0 innings pitched over 14 appearances (three starts).
- He has 32 strikeouts against one walk in his career. He has also hit just one batter and has not thrown a wild pitch in his career.

PARKER SOLIDIFYING INFIELD

- Sophomore James Parker has continued his role as the starting shortstop in 2021 after leading the team in starts at shortstop in 2020.
- He is hitting .353 with six doubles, seven homers, 25 RBIs, 17 runs, a .430 on-base percentage and steal in 29 games in 2021.
- He is one of only two Tigers (Dylan Brewer) to start every game in 2021 and the only Tiger to start every game at the same position.
- He has a .936 fielding percentage (seven errors in 110 chances).
- He has hit safely in 26 of the 29 games in 2021 and 33 of the last 36 games dating to 2020.
- He had a 12-game hitting streak, which included the last seven games of 2020 and the first five games of 2021.
- He had an 11-game hitting streak between March and April.
- He hit a home run and later added a walkoff single in the 10th inning in the 8-7 win over Cincinnati on Feb. 21.
- He hit a home run in each of the three games against No. 13 Virginia Tech at Doug Kingsmore Stadium from March 19-21.
- Against the Hokies on March 21, he hit a three-run homer on an 0-2 pitch with two outs in the eighth inning to lift Clemson to a 4-2 win.
- In his career, he is hitting .310 with 11 doubles, nine homers, 40 RBIs, 33 runs and five steals in 69 games (57 starts).

TEODOSIO SHOWING ALL-AROUND GAME

- Junior Bryce Teodosio has always been one of the nation's best defensive outfielders, but in 2021, he has stepped up his game at the plate.

- He is hitting .253 with four homers, two doubles, seven RBIs, 16 runs, a .363 on-base percentage and five steals in 29 games (27 starts).
- In his career, he is hitting .211 with 17 homers, 15 doubles, 50 RBIs, 62 runs and 17 steals in 129 games (111 starts).

THREE TIGERS IN THE MAJORS IN 2021

- Former Tigers Paul Campbell, Brad Miller and Eli White are on 2021 MLB rosters.
- Campbell is in his first MLB season, Miller is in his ninth MLB season and White is in his second MLB season.
- Campbell, who made 30 appearances (three starts) as a Tiger from 2015-17, made his MLB debut with the Miami Marlins on April 3.
- Miller, the 2011 ACC Player-of-the-Year, hit .339 with 36 doubles, eight triples, 16 homers, 135 RBIs and 46 steals in 191 games as a Tiger.
- White, who hit .275 with 104 runs and 36 steals at Clemson from 2014-16, made his MLB debut with the Texas Rangers on Sept. 1, 2020.
- Every Tiger team from 1974 to 2017 had at least one future major leaguer on its roster.
