### CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has a 12-8 home record, swept Wake Forest in three home games last weekend by a combined score of 14-8.
- The Tigers are averaging 5.4 runs per game and hitting .253 with a .405 slugging percentage, .352 on-base percentage and 26 steals.

- The pitching staff has a 4.67 ERA, .262 opponents' batting average and 2.88 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .968.

### LOUISVILLE OVERVIEW

- Louisville, who has an 8-6 road record, is led by 15th-year Head Coach Dan McDonnell.
- The Cardinals beat Kentucky 12-5 on April 20 in their last game. They are hitting .299 and have a 4.32 ERA and .965 fielding percentage.
- Henry Davis is hitting .398 with eight homers, 34 RBIs and 10 steals, while Trey Leonard is batting .394 with four homers and 24 RBIs.

### QUICK HITS

- Sunday is Senior Day, as Clemson honors its seniors during a pregame ceremony at 1:40 p.m.
- Clemson has won five of its last seven games against Louisville.
- Eleven different Tigers have started a game on the mound in 2021. Keyshawn Askew and Ty Olenchuk are tied for the team lead in starts (6).

### ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is tied for fourth place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 12-12 league mark.
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is tied for ninth place.

### BULLPEN PROVIDING RELIEF

- Clemson's bullpen has kept it in many games this season.
- The bullpen is 9-8 with a 3.90 ERA, .251 opponents' batting average and 170 strikeouts against 60 walks in 161.2 innings pitched.
- It has a 2.83 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

## DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

## TWO TIGERS NAMED CAPTAINS

- Junior and graduate righthander Evan Estridge and sophomore catcher Adam Hackenberg were named team co-captains.
- The two were voted co-captains in a vote by the players in the preseason.
- Estridge played two years at Newberry, then transferred to Clemson, where he walked on and sat out his first year (2019) due to NCAA rules.
- Hackenberg is in his third year in the program and won the 2020 Tiger Baseball Award as the team's best leader.

## ANGLIN EMERGING IN ROTATION

- Freshman righthander Mack Anglin was a reliever early in the 2021 season, but he has recently moved into the weekend rotation.
- He is 1-2 with a 3.23 ERA, .217 opponents' batting average and 43 strikeouts in 30.2 innings pitched over eight appearances (four starts).
- He has allowed just four extra-base hits, including only one home run, in 2021.
- Opponents are 0-for-7 with five strikeouts with the bases loaded.
- He pitched 6.0 innings of one-hit ball with six strikeouts against no walks to earn his first career win against Virginia on April 9.
- He pitched 6.1 innings, allowing four hits and no earned runs with 11 strikeouts against Wake Forest on April 23.
- He earned ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week honors for his start against the Demon Deacons, becoming the first Tiger since 2017 to receive that honor.
- In his career, he is 1-3 with a 4.78 ERA and 54 strikeouts against 24 walks in 37.2 innings pitched over 12 appearances (seven starts).

## ASKEW RETURNS ON TOP OF HIS GAME

- Sophomore lefthander Keyshawn Askew suffered a leg injury in a scrimmage on Feb. 14 and did not make his first outing until March 14.
- He has recovered and been one of the team's best pitchers since his return.
- He is 1-1 with a 4.04 ERA and .272 opponents' batting average in 35.2 innings pitched over seven appearances (six starts).
- He has 42 strikeouts against only four walks and has allowed only six extra-base hits.
- In his career, he is 3-2 with a 4.15 ERA and .275 opponents' batting average in 93.1 innings pitched over 28 appearances (16 starts).
- He has 90 strikeouts against 30 walks in his career, good for a 3.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

## BREWER PROVIDING PUNCH

- Freshman outfielder Dylan Brewer has batted in the heart of the batting order all season and is one of the team's best run producers.
- He is hitting .206 with six doubles, seven homers, 26 RBIs, 28 runs, a .337 on-base percentage and six steals in 36 games.
- He is one of only two Tigers (James Parker) to start every game in 2021.
- He totaled two homers and six RBIs in Clemson's 10-6 win at NC State on April 2.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball on April 5. He totaled three homers and 10 RBIs in four games.
- In his career, he's hitting .217 with 11 doubles, eight homers, 32 RBIs, 39 runs, a .358 on-base percentage and nine steals in 52 games.

## CLARK IN CONTROL

- Junior lefthander Mat Clark has used his control and change of speed to be effective on the mound during his entire career.
- He is 1-1 with two saves, a 2.97 ERA and .242 opponents' batting average in 33.1 innings pitched over nine appearances (two starts) in 2021.
- He has 31 strikeouts against one walk in 2021.
- In ACC games, he is 1-1 with a 2.60 ERA and .236 opponents' batting average in 27.2 innings pitched over seven appearances (two starts).
- In ACC games, he has 24 strikeouts against one walk.
- In 20.0 innings pitched after the fifth inning, he has allowed just 13 hits, two runs (0.90 ERA) and no walks with 18 strikeouts.
- In his career, he is 16-4 with a 2.90 ERA and .218 opponents' batting average in 139.2 innings pitched over 46 appearances (14 starts).
- He has 128 strikeouts against only 31 walks in his career, good for a 4.13 strikeout-to-walk ratio, third in Clemson history.
- He has a 2.00 career walks-per-nine-innings-pitched mark, fourth in Clemson history.

## CLAYTON STEADY IN RELIEF

- Freshman righthander Nick Clayton has been steady and clutch out of the bullpen in 2021.
- He is 5-1 with a 3.51 ERA, .200 opponents' batting average and 28 strikeouts against seven walks in 25.2 innings pitched.
- In nine relief outings in ACC games, he is 3-1 with a 2.08 ERA, .215 opponents' batting average and 15 strikeouts against five walks.
- He pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in relief of two-hit ball with four strikeouts to earn the win at NC State on April 2.
- In his career, he is 6-1 with one save, a 2.62 ERA and 36 strikeouts against 11 walks in 34.1 innings pitched over 20 relief appearances.

## GILBERT LEADING BULLPEN

- Freshman lefthander Geoffrey Gilbert has pitched late in games for the Tigers since his first season in 2020.
- He is 2-4 with three saves, a 1.71 ERA, .273 opponents' batting average and 41 strikeouts against 11 walks in 31.2 innings pitched.
- He leads the team with 20 appearances, all in relief.
- In 14 relief outings in ACC games, he has allowed 19 hits and three earned runs (1.27 ERA) with 21 strikeouts in 21.1 innings pitched.
- In his career, he is 3-4 with three saves, a 1.42 ERA and 55 strikeouts against 18 walks in 44.1 innings pitched over 28 relief appearances.

## GRICE POWERING LINEUP

- Freshman lefty and first baseman Caden Grice showed his power potential in the fall and preseason, and he has carried that into the season.
- He was one of 45 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- He is hitting .323 with eight homers, a triple, six doubles, 31 RBIs, a .581 slugging percentage and .427 on-base percentage in 35 games.
- He is hitting .339 with runners on base and .343 with runners in scoring position.
- He has also made two starts and one relief appearance on the mound in 2021.
- With his 6'6" frame, he has saved several runs while playing first base with his ability to stretch and catch errant throws.
- He was named one of 12 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball on March 8 for his previous four games, when he hit four homers.

# NOTES

- He was 8-for-14 (.571) with three doubles, a triple, 10 RBIs and a .647 on-base percentage in the three-game series at Boston College.
- He was named ACC Player-of-the-Week on March 29 by leading Clemson to a 4-0 record in four road games the previous week.
- He was also named NCBWA National Hitter-of-the-Week on March 30.
- He was 9-for-18 with three doubles, a triple, homer, 13 RBIs, five runs, a .944 slugging percentage and .571 on-base percentage on the week.

## HALL RETURNS FROM INJURY

- Junior infielder and outfielder Sam Hall missed the first half of the year due to several injuries, but he is back as one of the top hitters.
- He is hitting .333 with a homer, three doubles, two RBIs, seven runs, a .471 on-base percentage and two steals in nine games in 2021.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in all eight games with a plate appearance in 2021.
- In his career, he is hitting .248 with 11 homers, a triple, 19 doubles, 43 RBIs, 91 runs and 42 steals in 110 games (100 starts).

## HAWKINS HOT DURING SECOND HALF

- Sophomore infielder Bryar Hawkins has been one of the team's best hitters during the second half of the season.
- He is hitting .310 with three doubles, a triple, four RBIs, nine runs and a .394 on-base percentage in 21 games (15 starts) in 2021.
- In his 11 ACC games (seven starts), he is hitting .333 with a .379 on-base percentage.
- In his last 11 games, he is 14-for-31 (.452).
- In his career, he is hitting .292 with eight homers, three triples, 12 doubles, 36 RBIs, 47 runs and four steals in 88 games (74 starts).

## HOFFMANN THROWING STRIKES

- Freshman righthander Nick Hoffmann has been effective mainly due to his ability to throw strikes.
- He is 4-0 with a 4.00 ERA, .255 opponents' batting average and 25 strikeouts against two walks in 36.0 innings pitched in 2021.
- He has made 10 appearances (four starts).
- He tossed a complete game in his first career start in Clemson's 7-2 win at Boston College in the second game of a doubleheader on March 27.
- Against the Eagles, he gave up just six hits (all singles), two runs and no walks with seven strikeouts, throwing 111 pitches.
- It was the first complete game by a Tiger pitcher since 2017.
- In his career, he is 6-1 with a 3.45 ERA and .249 opponents' batting average in 47.0 innings pitched over 17 appearances (four starts).
- He has 36 strikeouts against two walks in his career. He has also hit just two batters and has not thrown a wild pitch in his career.

## MEREDITH SURGING

- Sophomore outfielder Kier Meredith has been one of the Tigers' best hitters of late.
- He is hitting .289 with four doubles, a triple, two homers, 14 RBIs, 18 runs, a .381 on-base percentage and four steals in 31 games in 2021.
- He is 22-for-57 (.386) in the last 14 games.
- He leads the team in hit-by-pitches (10).
- He is hitting .355 with runners in scoring position and .370 with two outs.
- He missed the first five games of the season due to injury.

- In his career, he is hitting .296 with 10 doubles, two triples, four homers, 25 RBIs, a .415 on-base percentage and 13 steals in 70 games.

## PARKER SOLIDIFYING INFIELD

- Sophomore James Parker has continued his role as the starting shortstop in 2021 after leading the team in starts at shortstop in 2020.
- He is hitting .297 with seven doubles, seven homers, 25 RBIs, 18 runs, a .382 on-base percentage and steal in 36 games in 2021.
- He is one of only two Tigers (Dylan Brewer) to start every game in 2021 and the only Tiger to start every game at the same position.
- He has a .947 fielding percentage (seven errors in 132 chances).
- He had a 12-game hitting streak, which included the last seven games of 2020 and the first five games of 2021.
- He had an 11-game hitting streak from March to April.
- He hit a home run and later added a walkoff single in the 10th inning in the 8-7 win over Cincinnati on Feb. 21.
- He hit a home run in each of the three games against No. 13 Virginia Tech at Doug Kingsmore Stadium from March 19-21.
- Against the Hokies on March 21, he hit a three-run homer on an 0-2 pitch with two outs in the eighth inning to lift Clemson to a 4-2 win.
- In his career, he is hitting .282 with 12 doubles, nine homers, 40 RBIs, 34 runs and five steals in 76 games (64 starts).

## TEODOSIO SHOWING ALL-AROUND GAME

- Junior Bryce Teodosio has always been one of the nation's best defensive outfielders, but in 2021, he has stepped up his game at the plate.
- He is hitting .245 with four homers, three doubles, nine RBIs, 18 runs, a .341 on-base percentage and five steals in 36 games (34 starts).
- In his career, he is hitting .211 with 17 homers, 16 doubles, 52 RBIs, 64 runs and 17 steals in 136 games (118 starts).

## FOUR TIGERS IN THE MAJORS IN 2021

- Former Tigers Paul Campbell, Steven Duggar, Brad Miller and Eli White are on 2021 MLB rosters.
- Campbell is in his first MLB season, Duggar is in his fourth season, Miller is in his ninth season and White is in his second season.
- Campbell, who made 30 appearances (three starts) as a Tiger from 2015-17, made his MLB debut with the Miami Marlins on April 3.
- Duggar was a two-time All-ACC player as a Tiger from 2013-15 and made his MLB debut with the Giants on July 8, 2018.
- Miller, the 2011 ACC Player-of-the-Year, hit .339 with 36 doubles, eight triples, 16 homers, 135 RBIs and 46 steals in 191 games as a Tiger.
- White, who hit .275 with 104 runs and 36 steals at Clemson from 2014-16, made his MLB debut with the Texas Rangers on Sept. 1, 2020.
- Every Tiger team from 1974 to 2017 had at least one future major leaguer on its roster.
