2020 ACC COASTAL DIVISION CHAMPIONS

- For the first time in program history, the Pitt Panthers were named the ACC Coastal Division Champions after its 5-0 shutout victory over Virginia at home April 8.
- Pitt concluded the spring regular season with a 5-1 conference record and a 9-1 overall ACC mark between the fall and spring seasons. The previous high for ACC wins in a season was four set back in 2019.
- The shutout victory was the fourth of the season for the Panthers, all at home. Pitt ended the regular season with a perfect 5-0 record at Amrbose Urbanic Field.
- Five different players registered goals vs. Virginia, with **Alexander Dexter**, **Luke Peperak**, **Bertin Jacquesson**, **Filip Mirkovic** and **Bryce Washington** scoring for Pitt.
- The Panthers tallied five assists in the match, with Dexter and **Veljko Petkovic** each having two and **Raphaël Crivello** totaling one.





THE SERIES - CLEMSON

- Clemson leads the all-time series 5-1-0.
- Pitt's lone win came in 2018, when the Panthers won 2-1 in double overtime.
- Most recently, Pitt fell to Clemson, 2-1, in the ACC Championship Final Nov. 22 in Cary, N.C.
- Head Coach **Jay Vidovich** is 14-10-6 all-time against Clemson.

SCOUTING THE TIGERS

- Clemson enters the contest as the Atlantic Division Champions out of the ACC, finishing with a 12-3-2 overall record and 7-3-2 conference mark.
- The fourth-ranked Tigers are second behind the Panthers for total goals in the ACC this year, totaling 30 for fifth in the country.
- Nine Tigers were named to the All-ACC Conference Teams this past week, with three first team, one second team, three third team and two freshman team awardees.
- The three first team recipients - Grayson Barber, Philip Mayaka and Kimarni Smith - all moved on from the program following the conclusion of the fall season. Smith was taken No. 3 overall in the 2021 MLS Superdraft, while Mayaka was chosen immediately after him at No. 4. Barber signed a Homegrown Player contract with Sporting KC.
- Leading the way on Clemson's defense is Oskar Agren, who was named to the All-ACC second team. Agren has helped the Tigers register six shutouts this season.
- Leading the Tiger attack is Callum Johnson, who has four goals, four assists and a .448 shot on goal percentage this year.
- James Brighton is second on the team in total goals with five and leads the team with 36 shots and has tallied 17 shots on goal.
- Clemson goalkeeper George Marks sits second behind Pitt goalie Nico

Campuzano in total saves with 39. Marks received All-ACC third team recognition.

- The Tigers are known for shooting the ball on net, totaling 14.88 shots per game and 6.35 shots on goal per game, both of which lead the conference.

THE REMATCH

- Saturday night's contest is a rematch of the ACC Championship Final Nov. 22, 2020, a game in which the Tigers won 2-1 in Cary, N.C.
- The two teams have squared off three times since 2018, with each game being decided by one goal. Pitt defeated Clemson at home 2-1 in double overtime in 2018, while the Tigers have won the last two meetings (1-0 in 2019 / 2-1 in 2020).
- Head Coaches **Jay Vidovich** and Mike Noonan have a combined 659 wins. Noonan ranks 11th among active coaches in the NCAA with 346 victories, while Vidovich ranks 19th with 313.

PANTHERS RECLAIM NO. 1 RANKING

- For the first time this spring and sixth time this season, the Pitt Panthers were named the No. 1 team in the country according to the United Soccer Coaches Poll April 6, 2021.
- Pitt was again named No. 1 the week of April 12-18, making it seven weeks the Panthers have been the top team in the country.
- Pitt earned the number one ranking for five weeks straight in the fall from Oct. 20 to Nov. 17.
- The Panthers reclaimed the No. 1 spot after spending the first five weeks in the top-10 during the spring campaign.

TOP RANKED PANTHERS EARN MULTIPLE ALL-ACC AWARDS

- The Atlantic Coast Conference released its annual All-Conference Teams Wednesday, April 14, and Pitt earned a school record 10 All-ACC honorees, three Player of the Year awardees and Coach of the Year.
- Sophomore **Valentin Noel** was named ACC Offensive Player of the Year. The Niort, France, native ranks among the best in the nation in major offensive categories, including total goals (3rd - 11), points per game (24th - 1.71), goals per game (10th - .79), total points (3rd - 24) and shot accuracy (49th - .549).
- Graduate student **Jasper Löeffelsend** was named ACC Defensive Player of the Year. Löeffelsend has cemented himself as one of the best passers in the country, totaling seven assists (1st in ACC/5th in country). His .50 assists per game ratio ranks second in the league. Löeffelsend, along with teammate **Bertin Jacquesson**, each tallied three assists at home against Virginia Tech, both of which tied for second in program history for a single game.
- Freshman **Bertin Jacquesson** made an immediate impact when he arrived at Pitt in the fall, totaling nine points in his first three games. Jacquesson was honored by the ACC with Freshman of the Year. He has three goals, six assists, 27 shots and 13 shots on goal for the season.

VIDOVICH NAMED COACH OF THE YEAR

- For the sixth time in his illustrious career, Pitt head coach Jay Vidovich was named ACC Coach of the Year.
- Vidovich has led the Panthers to a 13-2 overall record and 9-1 ledger in conference play. Pitt's 13 wins is tied for second most all-time in school history and its nine conference victories surpassed the 1995 team that won eight Big East games for most league wins in a single year.

•Vidovich, who won the award in 2002, 2004, 2006, 2008 and 2009 as Wake Forest's head coach, has led the Panthers to its first number one ranking in program history. The team has been ranked number one for seven weeks this season.

TEN NAMED TO ALL-CONFERENCE TEAMS

- A record ten Panthers were named to the All-ACC Teams, with three earning first team, three second team, two third team and two freshman team.
- Graduate student goalkeeper **Nico Campuzano**, graduate student **Jasper Löeffelsend** and sophomore **Valentin Noel** were tabbed first team.
- Freshman **Bertin Jacquesson**, sophomore **Veljko Petkovic** and junior **Jackson Walti** received second team.
- Senior **Alexander Dexter** and sophomore **Arturo Ordoñez** earned third team.
- Jacquesson and freshman Filip Mirkovic rounded out the group with All-Freshman team honors.



Senior Alexander Dexter was named College Soccer News National Player of the Week April 12 for his performance vs. Virginia. The forward had a goal and two assists in Pitt's 5-0 shutout victory.

THE FIRST NOEL

- Sophomore **Valentin Noel** finished the regular season as one of the best goal scorers in the country, leading the Panther offense in goals, points, shots and shots on goal.
- The midfielder scored his first two goals of the spring campaign Mar. 19 at Duke in Pitt's 20T thrilling victory over the Blue Devils. He followed that up with a goal at Virginia Tech Mar. 27, giving Pitt a 1-0 lead at halftime in Pitt's eventual 2-1 20T victory over the Hokies.
- On Nov. 15 vs. Duke, Noel set a school record for consecutive games played with a goal at four. The streak finished at six games, as he scored Pitt's lone goal in the ACC Championship Final against Clemson Nov. 22.

A HISTORIC FALL SEASON

- While Pitt finished as ACC Champion runner-ups, the 2020 fall season was nothing short of a historic season filled with record breaking performances and milestones.
- The Panthers' 7-0 start to the season was the best start to a season in program history.
- Pitt's appearance in the ACC Championship game was the first in school history.
- Sophomore **Valentin Noel** broke a school record with four consecutive games played with a goal. Noel's streak is still alive, as he currently sits at six-straight games played with a goal.
- Senior **Alexander Dexter** tallied an assist against Duke in the ACC Championship Quarterfinal and is now second all-time in career assists with 15.
- The Panthers earned the No. 1 ranking in the country Oct. 20 for the first time in program history. Men's soccer joins football and men's basketball as the only Pitt athletics teams to earn the No. 1 spot in their respective polls.

ACC'S NO. 1 SCORING OFFENSE

- Pitt enters the Clemson match with the number one scoring offense in the conference with a 2.53 goals per game mark, a number also good for eighth in the nation.
- The Panthers have totaled 38 goals this season, which leads the nation. Pitt also leads the country in total points (111) and is second in total assists (37).
- Pitt's 7.53 points per game mark and .552 shot accuracy rank first in the conference and ninth and third in the nation, respectively.
- The Panthers have had 10 different goal scorers this season and have had 12 different players assist a goal this year.

JASPER SENDS IT IN

- Graduate student **Jasper Löeffelsend** has emerged as one of the best passers in the country, finding his teammates on seven different occasions this season for goals.
- Löeffelsend recorded an assist vs. Boston College Mar. 13 in the lone goal of the 1-0 shutout for his first of the spring campaign.
- Löeffelsend tallied three assists against Virginia Tech Oct. 10, tying him for second all-time in a single-game in program history. Freshman teammate **Bertin Jacquesson** also had three assists in that same game.
- Löeffelsend's seven assists currently ranks tied for ninth in a single-season in program history.

CAMPUZANO MAKING THE STOPS

- Graduate student goalkeeper **Nico Campuzano** finished the ACC Tournament with 15 saves and ended the fall season with 31 total saves.
- Campuzano's seven saves in the ACC Championship Final earned him a new career-high.

- Campuzano has registered seven games with four or more saves and three games with six or more stops on the year.
- Campuzano delivered a clean sheet against Boston College at home Saturday, Mar. 13, making four stops for his second shutout of the season.
- The Cantabria, Spain, native has 45 saves on the season and four shutouts to his credit. His 45 total saves is first in the ACC and 10th in the nation.
- Campuzano's 13 wins in goal ranks tied for second for wins in a single-season at Pitt.

DEXTER NAMED NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Senior **Alexander Dexter** had a career performance at home against Virginia April 8, scoring a goal and tallying two assists in Pitt's 5-0 shutout of the Cavaliers.
- Dexter was named College Soccer News Player of the Week for his performance against Virginia, and became the second Panther this season to be named National Player of the Week by College Soccer News, joining sophomore **Veljko Petkovic** (Oct. 11).

DEXTER SECOND ALL-TIME IN ASSISTS

- Senior **Alexander Dexter** moved into second place all-time in school history in assists Sunday, Nov. 15, with his 15th career assist against Duke.
- Dexter tallied his fifth multi-assist game of his career Thursday, April 8 vs. Virginia, assisting two goals against the Cavaliers.
- The Bronx, N.Y., native is fourth on the team with five assists this season, and sits nine back from Eric Prex's record of 26 career assists (1991-1994).

PITT CLAIMS COASTAL DIVISION CROWN WITH 5-0 VICTORY OVER VIRGINIA

- The Panthers shutout Virginia, 5-0, Thursday evening at Ambrose Urbanic Field and captured the ACC Coastal Division Championship.
- The division title is the first in program history since joining the ACC in 2013.
- Pitt had five different goal scorers and totaled 15 points as a team.

PITT DEFENDS HOME TURF WITH 2-0 VICTORY OVER NOTRE DAME

- The Panthers defeated Notre Dame, 2-0, at home Saturday, April 3 for its fourth win of the season at Ambrose Urbanic Field.
- The shutout victory was the third of the spring - all of which have come at home.
- Sophomore **Arturo Ordoñez** scored the games first goal in the 48th minute, taking a pass from senior **Bryce Washington** inside the box for the goal.
- Senior **Alexander Dexter** scored the second goal of the contest in the 76th minute. Sophomore midfielder **Veljko Petkovic** assisted Dexter on the play.

PITT PREVAILS IN 2OT IN BLACKSBURG

- Pitt endured its second-straight double overtime match Mar. 27 against Virginia Tech in Blacksburg, winning 2-1 in the 103rd minute.
- Senior **Alexander Dexter** scored the game-winning goal in the second overtime, his third goal of the season. Freshman **Filip Mirkovic** tallied an assist on the play.
- Sophomore **Valentin Noel** recorded his 11th goal of the season in the first half, giving Pitt a 1-0 lead in the 43rd minute. Freshman **Luke Peperak** registered the first point of his collegiate career, earning the assist on Noel's goal.

A THRILLING 2OT VICTORY IN DURHAM

- The Panthers and Blue Devils played 107

minutes Mar. 19 in Durham, N.C., with Pitt prevailing 4-3 in double overtime off a game-winning header from sophomore **Arturo Ordoñez**.

- Pitt trailed, 1-0, early before scoring three unanswered goals to take a 3-1 lead in the second half. Duke came back with two unanswered goals of their own and tied it 3-3 after regulation. Ordoñez's goal in the 107th minute was his second of the season and second game-winning header of the year, previously doing so at Virginia Oct. 18, 2020 in the 103rd minute.
- Sophomore **Valentin Noel** scored two goals on two shots, while freshman **Filip Mirkovic** registered his second goal of the year. Freshman **Bertin Jacquesson** tallied an assist.

PETKOVIC'S EARLY GOAL LIFTS PITT OVER BC, 1-0

- Sophomore **Veljko Petkovic's** early goal in the third minute proved just enough as No. 8 Pitt defeated Boston College at home, 1-0, Saturday, Mar. 13.
- Graduate student **Nico Campuzano** registered four saves and a clean sheet, his second of the season and third at home.
- The Panthers improved to 9-2 overall and 5-1 in conference play. The five ACC wins are most in a season since joining the league in 2013, with four being the previous high set in 2019.

NO. 4 PITT FALLS AT NORTH CAROLINA

- In its last outing, No. 4 Pitt fell, 3-0, Friday, Mar. 5 at North Carolina.
- The loss was just the second of the season for the Panthers and the first conference loss of the year.
- Pitt was outshot, 8-3, and was held without a goal for the first time this season and the first time since Nov. 24 against Georgetown in the NCAA

Tournament Second Round.

SHUTOUT TO START THE SPRING

- The Panthers opened up spring play with a 1-0 shutout of Duquesne Saturday, Feb. 27 at Ambrose Urbanic Field.
- Senior defender **Bryce Washington** scored the lone goal via penalty kick in the 36th minute, his second goal of the season and fourth of his career.
- Washington's performance (three shots, two shots on goal) earned him TopDrawerSoccer and College Soccer News Team of the Week accolades.
- The shutout was the first of the season for Pitt, while the one goal scored offensively matched a season low (Clemson - Nov. 22).

PANTHERS FALL TO CLEMSON IN ACC FINAL

- In a clash between the top-two teams in the country, Clemson edged Pitt, 2-1, in the ACC Championship Final Nov. 22 at WakeMed Soccer Park in Cary, N.C.
- Sophomore **Valentin Noel** scored the lone goal for the Panthers in the 46th minute. Noel's goal tied Clemson's Kimarni Smith for the nation's lead.
- Graduate student goalkeeper **Nico Campuzano** totaled a career-high seven saves, including five in the first half. Campuzano finished with 15 saves in the ACC Tournament and 31 saves on the season (2nd in nation).

EARLY OFFENSE POWERS PITT TO ACC FINAL

- Three first half goals and three key first half saves set the tempo for the No. 1 ranked Panthers Wednesday night in the ACC Championship Semifinal, as Pitt defeated Notre Dame 3-1.
- Sophomore **Veljko Petkovic** scored two goals, including one from a free kick 25-yards out, to lead the Panther offense. The multi-goal game was the second of Petkovic's career.
- Sophomore **Valentin Noel** scored his seventh goal of the season and kept his



goal streak alive at five games.

- Sophomore **Raphaël Crivello** and graduate student **Jasper Löeffelsend** each registered an assist, while graduate student goalkeeper **Nico Campuzano** tied a career-high six saves.

PITT HOLDS OFF DUKE IN ACC QUARTERS

- Pitt scored its lowest amount of goals on the season in a physical, defensive battle against Duke Sunday, Nov. 15, but came away with the 2-1 victory to advance to the ACC Championship Semifinals.
- Junior **Jackson Walti** scored the games' first goal in the 34th minute, the third of his career and first score since the Panthers defeated Duke at home on Oct. 25, 2019.
- Sophomore **Valentin Noel** broke the 1-1 tie in the 62nd minute, his sixth of the season. Noel's goal proved to be the deciding factor for the Panthers, as Pitt held off Duke's late minute attack.
- Noel, senior **Alexander Dexter** and freshman **Filip Mirkovic** all tallied assists.

PITT REMAINS UNDEFEATED

- The Panthers kept their undefeated season in check with a 4-1 road victory at Louisville on Friday, Oct. 23.
- Pitt saw four different goal scorers in a game that included an hour and 15 minute weather delay.
- Senior **Bryce Washington** scored the first goal in the ninth minute, his first of the year. Freshman **Filip Mirkovic** netted his first career goal in the 42nd minute. Sophomore **Veljko Petkovic** assisted on both of Washington's and Mirkovic's goals.
- Sophomore **Valentin Noel** recorded his fifth goal of the year in the 64th minute, putting Pitt back up by two (3-1). Freshman and Greensburg, Pa., native **Luke Mort** sealed the deal with his first career goal in the 70th minute.

PANTHERS OUTLAST VIRGINIA IN OT

- Sophomore **Arturo Ordoñez** headed in the game-winning goal in the 93rd minute against No. 5 Virginia, giving Pitt the 3-2 victory and its second top-five victory of the season.
- Sophomore **Valentin Noel** scored twice, both in the first half against the Cavaliers. Ordoñez, along with classmate **Raphaël Crivello** and graduate student **Jasper Löeffelsend**, each tallied an assist.
- The victory was the third straight at Klockner Stadium, dating back to 2018. It was also the third-straight victory over a ranked Cavaliers team.

PANTHERS UPEND HOKIES, 4-2

- Pitt defeated Virginia Tech, 4-2, in its home opener on Saturday, Oct. 10 to improve to 3-0 overall and 2-0 in the ACC.
- Sophomore **Valentin Noel** scored twice, including a goal in the 87th minute to seal the deal for the second-ranked Panthers.
- Both graduate student **Jasper Löeffelsend** and freshman **Bertin Jacquesson** tallied three assists, which individually tied for second in a single game in program history.
- Graduate student goalkeeper **Nico Campuzano** recorded a career-high six saves. Campuzano has 11 on the season, good for sixth in country and second in the ACC.

JACQUESSON PLAYS HERO AT CUSE

- Freshman **Bertin Jacquesson** lifted the Panthers over Syracuse, 3-2, in double OT Tuesday, Oct. 6 with a golden goal in the 103rd minute. The score was the Frenchman's first game-winner of his career.
- Sophomore **Veljko Petkovic** recorded two goals, his first multi-score game

of his career, while Jacquesson, sophomore **Arturo Ordoñez** and senior **Alexander Dexter** each tallied an assist.

PANTHERS OPEN SEASON WITH TOP-FIVE WIN

- Pitt opened the regular season with a top-five, 3-1 victory at No. 5 Notre Dame on Sept. 26.
- The fourth-ranked Panthers held the Irish to five shots and used forwards Alexander Dexter and Bertin Jacquesson to pace the offense, as each scored a goal and tallied an assist.
- The victory was the second in as many years over a top-five team on the road. Pitt upset No. 1 Virginia in Charlottesville, Va., 2-0, on Oct. 18, 2019.
- The victory over Notre Dame was the first regular season opening win for Pitt since 2014.

RECAPING EXHIBITIONS

- Pitt played in two exhibitions prior to to Notre Dame, first facing Wake Forest on the road Saturday, Sept. 13 followed by a home contest against Louisville this past Saturday.
- The Panthers dropped a 3-2 decision to the Demon Deacons, before bouncing back with a 5-0 shutout of the Cardinals.
- Senior **Alexander Dexter** netted three goals and added an assist between the two exhibitions, scoring twice against the Cardinals.
- Sophomore **Veljko Petkovic** tallied a goal and two assists in total, including a one goal and one assist performance against the Cardinals.

Jay Vidovich, one of America's most respected and accomplished soccer coaches, was named the third Pitt men's soccer head coach at the University of Pittsburgh in December of 2015.

In his fourth year at the helm of Pitt men's soccer, Vidovich led the Panthers to one of its most successful seasons in program history. Finishing the 2019 campaign 10-8-2, Vidovich saw Pitt upset No. 1 Virginia on the road on Oct. 18, host an ACC Tournament game against NC State for the first time in school history on Nov. 10, earn a trip to the ACC Semifinals for the first time in program history and stamp its name into the NCAA Men's Soccer Championship for the first time since 1965.

Vidovich and the Panthers earned a monumental victory on Nov. 21, as they defeated Lehigh at Ambrose Urbanic Field, 2-0, winning the first NCAA Men's Soccer Championship game in school history. The season ended Nov. 24 against No. 2 Georgetown in the second round of the NCAA Men's Soccer Championship, but only after a record setting season that saw six All-ACC honorees, two ACC All-Tournament Team winners and one United Soccer Coaches All-South Region Team recipient.

During his third year at Pitt in the 2018 season, Vidovich led the Panthers to wins over two ranked opponents in No. 12 NC State and No. 7 Virginia in the ACC Men's Soccer Tournament. The victory over the Cavaliers marked the Panthers' first ACC Tournament win in program history. Pitt collected its first conference win on the season against the Wolfpack and picked up another ACC victory over Clemson on Oct. 5.

Vidovich played a crucial role in the development of Javi Perez, who was drafted by LAFC in the third round of 2019 MLS Superdraft. With the selection, Perez became only the second player in program history to be drafted to an MLS club team. Three Panthers were also named to All-ACC teams under Vidovich's guidance as Edward Kizza was given First Team honors, Javi Perez earned Second Team recognition and Chandler Vaughn was named to the All-Freshman Team. Both Kizza and Perez earned All-Region Honors as well, with Kizza voted to the Second Team and Perez named to the Third Team.

Following his first year at the helm, Vidovich led the Panthers to wins over No. 7 Notre Dame, No. 13 Columbia and No. 21 Syracuse in the 2017 season. The win against Syracuse would be the Panthers' first win over a ranked opponent since the 2008 season. The victory over the Orange was also the first conference win for Pitt since moving into the ACC at the start of the 2013 season, and they would add their second conference win against the Fighting Irish on Oct. 13. The Panthers would also capture victories against rivals Penn State and West Virginia throughout the season.

Vidovich also guided four players to All-ACC recognition, with Javi Perez earning Second Team honors, Pol Planellas receiving Third Team recognition and both Alexander Dexter and Edward Kizza being named to the All-Freshman Team. The postseason accolades were the team's first in program history since joining the ACC.

Planellas would go on to become the first Pitt men's soccer player in program history to be drafted by an MLS Club team after being selected by the Los Angeles Football Club in the second round of the 2018 MLS SuperDraft, becoming the 36th professional player under Vidovich's tutelage.

Prior to making the move to Pittsburgh, Vidovich oversaw the men's soccer program at Wake Forest for 21 seasons (1994-2014), building the Demon Deacons into a national power and winning the 2007 NCAA championship. He spent 2015 in professional soccer, coaching the Portland Timbers 2 (T2) in the United Soccer League (USL).

During his Wake Forest tenure, Vidovich compiled a 272-121-50 record and led the Demon Deacons to the NCAA Tournament in 13 of his final 14 seasons. Wake Forest won five Atlantic Coast Conference titles under his watch, compiling a 76-52-22 mark in one of the nation's most challenging leagues.

In 2007, Wake Forest went 22-2-2—the winningest season in school history—and defeated Ohio State, 2-1, in the national final to claim the program's first NCAA title. The Demon Deacons made four consecutive appearances in the College Cup from 2006-09.

Vidovich, a two-time National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) National Coach of the Year (2007 and 2008) and six-time ACC Coach of the Year (2002, 2004, 2006, 2008, 2009 and 2021), ranks among the most decorated coaches in collegiate soccer.

Vidovich was the 2008 recipient of the prestigious Walt Chyzowych Award for lifetime contributions to the sport of soccer. Vidovich was an assistant under the legendary Chyzowych for eight seasons at Wake Forest from 1986-93.

Widely regarded as one of the game's top evaluators and developers of talent, Vidovich has produced 21 All-Americans and five ACC Player of the Year honorees (three offensive and two defensive). He also coached Marcus Tracy, the first player in Wake history to win the Missouri Athletic Club's (MAC) Hermann Trophy, which honors the top individual player in college soccer.

Thirty-five players under Vidovich went on to play in the professional ranks from 2002-14. His Wake Forest teams also achieved academically, evidenced by two ACC Scholar-Athlete of the Year honorees, two Academic All-Americans, one adidas National Scholar-Athlete of the Year and one Senior CLASS Award recipient.

Born in Detroit, Mich., Vidovich was an all-state player for New Canaan High School in Connecticut. He played for Indiana University in 1978 before transferring to Ohio Wesleyan, where he was a three-year starter. As a senior, Vidovich was team captain and helped lead OWU to the semifinals of the NCAA Tournament.

A 1982 graduate of Ohio Wesleyan with a bachelor's degree in physical education, he went on to earn a master's degree in sports sciences from the University of Denver in 1983.

It was at Denver where Vidovich's coaching career was launched as an assistant in 1982. He served in additional assistant posts at Regis College (1983) and his alma mater Ohio Wesleyan (1984-85) before joining Wake Forest's staff in 1986.


