CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has a 5-9 road record, beat USC Upstate 9-2 at home and has won seven games in a row.
- The Tigers are averaging 5.9 runs per game and hitting .262 with a .424 slugging percentage, .366 on-base percentage and 31 steals.

- The pitching staff has a 4.47 ERA, .259 opponents' batting average and 2.92 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .969.

GEORGIA TECH OVERVIEW

- Georgia Tech, who has a 9-12 home record, is led by 28th-year Head Coach Danny Hall.
- The Yellow Jackets won one of three games against Kennesaw State. They are hitting .283 and have a 5.69 ERA and .961 fielding percentage.
- Kevin Parada is hitting .335 with five homers, two triples, 17 doubles and 25 RBIs, while Luke Bartnicki has six of the team's 13 saves.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson is 18-1 when outhitting its opponent in 2021.
- Clemson is 11-3 when hitting two or more home runs and 11-15 when hitting less than two home runs.
- Clemson is hitting .300 with a .513 slugging percentage, .432 on-base percentage and 2.29 ERA during its current seven-game winning streak.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is tied for third place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 15-12 league mark.
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is tied for fourth.

BULLPEN PROVIDING RELIEF

- Clemson's bullpen has kept it in many games this season.
- The bullpen is 14-8 with a 3.54 ERA, .238 opponents' batting average and 191 strikeouts against 68 walks in 188.0 innings pitched.
- It has a 2.81 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

HISTORIC SWEEP OVER CARDINALS

- Clemson swept No. 4 Louisville by a combined score of 31-12 in three games at Doug Kingsmore Stadium from April 30 to May 2.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

2021 MEDIA INFORMATION

- It marked the first time since 2011, including the first time since joining the ACC in 2015, that Louisville suffered a three-game sweep.
- Clemson hit .350 with six doubles, a triple, seven homers, a .631 slugging percentage, .500 on-base percentage and three steals.
- The Tiger pitching staff had a 3.00 ERA, .210 opponents' batting average and 29 strikeouts against eight walks.
- In game one, Caden Grice totaled a Clemson-record-tying three home runs and eight RBIs (most by a Tiger since 2016) in the 11-3 win.
- In game two, Grice hit a solo homer in the eighth inning to break a 4-4 tie in Clemson's 5-4 win.
- In game three, the Tigers totaled 18 hits in their 15-5 victory to complete the sweep.
- Grice was 9-for-13 (.692) with four homers, a double, 12 RBIs, seven runs, a 1.692 slugging percentage and .750 on-base percentage.

GRADUATES

- Eight Tiger players and two graduate managers received their diplomas during commencement ceremonies in Greenville, S.C. in May.
- The players graduated May 6.
- Matt Cooper and James Parker graduated with a degree in management. Parker graduated in three years.
- Elijah Henderson and Bryce Teodosio graduated with a degree in agribusiness.
- Sam Hall graduated with a degree in sports communication.
- Bo Majkowski graduated with a degree in parks, recreation & tourism management.
- Kier Meredith graduated with a degree in psychology.
- Connor O'Rear graduated with a degree in financial management.
- Thomas Brittle and Ben Scheinbaum, both graduate managers, received a master's degree in athletic leadership on May 5.
- Mat Clark and Evan Estridge entered the season as Clemson graduates, while Rasesh Pandya is a graduate transfer from Wofford.

TWO TIGERS NAMED CAPTAINS

- Junior and graduate righthander Evan Estridge and sophomore catcher Adam Hackenberg were named team co-captains.
- The two were voted co-captains in a vote by the players in the pre-season.
- Estridge played two years at Newberry, then transferred to Clemson, where he walked on and sat out his first year (2019) due to NCAA rules.
- Hackenberg is in his third year in the program and won the 2020 Tiger Baseball Award as the team's best leader.

ANGLIN EMERGING IN ROTATION

- Freshman righthander Mack Anglin was a reliever early in the 2021 season, but he has recently moved into the weekend rotation.
- He is 2-2 with a 2.87 ERA, .214 opponents' batting average and 52 strikeouts in 37.2 innings pitched over nine appearances (five starts).
- He has allowed just five extra-base hits, including only one home run, in 2021.
- Opponents are 0-for-8 with five strikeouts with the bases loaded.
- He pitched 6.0 innings of one-hit ball with six strikeouts against no walks to earn his first career win against Virginia on April 9.
- He pitched 6.1 innings, allowing four hits and no earned runs with 11 strikeouts against Wake Forest on April 23.

- He earned ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week honors for his start against the Demon Deacons, becoming the first Tiger since 2017 to receive that honor.
- He allowed five hits and one run with nine strikeouts in 7.0 innings pitched to earn the win against No. 4 Louisville on April 30.
- In his career, he is 2-3 with a 4.23 ERA and 63 strikeouts against 27 walks in 44.2 innings pitched over 13 appearances (eight starts).

ASKEW RETURNS ON TOP OF HIS GAME

- Sophomore lefthander Keyshawn Askew suffered a leg injury in a scrimmage on Feb. 14 and did not make his first outing until March 14.
- He has recovered and been one of the team's best pitchers since his return.
- He is 1-1 with a 3.83 ERA and .269 opponents' batting average in 42.1 innings pitched over eight appearances (seven starts) in 2021.
- He has 52 strikeouts against only four walks, good for a 13.0 strikeout-to-walk ratio. That mark is second in Clemson history.
- In his career, he is 3-2 with a 4.05 ERA and .269 opponents' batting average in 100.0 innings pitched over 29 appearances (17 starts).
- He has 100 strikeouts against 30 walks in his career, good for a 3.33 strikeout-to-walk ratio. That mark is 10th in Clemson history.

BREWER PROVIDING PUNCH

- Freshman outfielder Dylan Brewer has been one of the team's best run producers in 2021.
- He is hitting .207 with seven doubles, seven homers, 26 RBIs, 29 runs, a .343 on-base percentage and six steals in 39 games.
- He totaled two homers and six RBIs in Clemson's 10-6 win at NC State on April 2.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball on April 5. He totaled three homers and 10 RBIs in four games.
- In his career, he's hitting .217 with 12 doubles, eight homers, 32 RBIs, 41 runs, a .361 on-base percentage and nine steals in 55 games.

CLARK IN CONTROL

- Junior lefthander Mat Clark has used his control and change of speed to be effective on the mound.
- He is 1-1 with two saves, a 3.41 ERA and .255 opponents' batting average in 37.0 innings pitched over 10 appearances (three starts) in 2021.
- He has 35 strikeouts against one walk in 2021.
- In ACC games, he is 1-1 with a 3.16 ERA and .252 opponents' batting average in 31.1 innings pitched over eight appearances (three starts).
- In ACC games, he has 28 strikeouts against one walk.
- In 20.0 innings pitched after the fifth inning, he has allowed just 13 hits, two runs (0.90 ERA) and no walks with 18 strikeouts.
- In his career, he is 16-4 with a 3.01 ERA and .222 opponents' batting average in 143.1 innings pitched over 47 appearances (15 starts).
- He has 132 strikeouts against only 31 walks in his career, good for a 4.26 strikeout-to-walk ratio, third in Clemson history.
- He has a 1.95 career walks-per-nine-innings-pitched mark, fourth in Clemson history.

CLAYTON STEADY IN RELIEF

- Freshman righthander Nick Clayton has been steady and clutch out of the bullpen in 2021.
- He is 6-1 with a 3.03 ERA, .194 opponents' batting average and 30 strikeouts against seven walks in 29.2 innings pitched.

NOTES

- In nine relief outings in ACC games, he is 3-1 with a 2.08 ERA, .215 opponents' batting average and 15 strikeouts against five walks.
- He pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in relief of two-hit ball with four strikeouts to earn the win at NC State on April 2.
- He pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in relief of two-hit ball with two strikeouts to earn the win against USC Upstate on May 5.
- In his career, he is 7-1 with one save, a 2.35 ERA and 38 strikeouts against 11 walks in 38.1 innings pitched over 21 relief appearances.

GILBERT LEADING BULLPEN

- Freshman lefthander Geoffrey Gilbert has pitched late in games for the Tigers since his first season in 2020.
- He was one of 65 pitchers named to the NCBWA Stopper-of-the-Year Award Watch List on April 29.
- He is 3-4 with three saves, a 1.46 ERA, .248 opponents' batting average and 45 strikeouts against 12 walks in 37.0 innings pitched.
- He leads the team with 23 appearances, all in relief.
- In 16 relief outings in ACC games, he has allowed 19 hits and three earned runs (1.05 ERA) with 24 strikeouts in 25.2 innings pitched.
- In two relief appearances against No. 4 Louisville on May 1,2, he combined to pitch 4.1 perfect innings in relief with three strikeouts.
- In his career, he is 4-4 with three saves, a 1.27 ERA and 59 strikeouts against 19 walks in 49.2 innings pitched over 31 relief appearances.

GRICE POWERING LINEUP

- Freshman first baseman and lefty Caden Grice showed his power potential in the fall and preseason, and he has carried that into the season.
- He was one of 45 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- He is hitting .348 with 12 homers, a triple, seven doubles, 43 RBIs, a .667 slugging percentage and .450 on-base percentage in 39 games.
- In 27 ACC games, he is hitting .375 with nine homers, a triple, five doubles, 33 RBIs, 25 runs and a .476 on-base percentage.
- He is hitting .371 with runners on base and .395 with runners in scoring position.
- He has also made two starts and two relief appearances on the mound in 2021.
- With his 6'6" frame, he has saved several runs at first base with his ability to stretch and catch errant throws.
- He was named one of 12 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball on March 8 for his previous four games, when he hit four homers.
- He was 8-for-14 (.571) with three doubles, a triple, 10 RBIs and a .647 on-base percentage in the three-game series at Boston College.
- He was named ACC Player-of-the-Week on March 29 by leading Clemson to a 4-0 record in four road games the previous week.
- He was also named NCBWA National Hitter-of-the-Week on March 30.
- He was 9-for-18 with three doubles, a triple, homer, 13 RBIs, five runs, a .944 slugging percentage and .571 on-base percentage on the week.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball and ACC Player-of-the-Week on May 3 against No. 4 Louisville.
- He was also named national player-of-the-week by D1Baseball and Perfect Game on May 4.
- He was 9-for-13 (.692) with four homers, a double, 12 RBIs, seven runs, a 1.692 slugging percentage and .750 on-base percentage.

HALL RETURNS FROM INJURY

- Junior infielder and outfielder Sam Hall missed the first half of the year due to several injuries, but he is back as one of the top hitters.
- He is hitting .350 with two homers, four doubles, five RBIs, 15 runs, a .519 on-base percentage and three steals in 13 games in 2021.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in all 12 games with a plate appearance in 2021.
- In his career, he is hitting .253 with 12 homers, a triple, 20 doubles, 46 RBIs, 99 runs and 43 steals in 114 games (104 starts).

HAWKINS HOT DURING SECOND HALF

- Sophomore infielder Bryar Hawkins has been one of the team's best hitters during the season's second half.
- He is hitting .278 with three doubles, a triple, four RBIs, 10 runs and a .373 on-base percentage in 25 games (19 starts) in 2021.
- In his 14 ACC games (10 starts), he is hitting .297 with a .381 on-base percentage.
- In his last 15 games, he is 16-for-45 (.356).
- In his career, he is hitting .285 with eight homers, three triples, 12 doubles, 36 RBIs, 48 runs and five steals in 92 games (78 starts).

HOFFMANN THROWING STRIKES

- Freshman righthander Nick Hoffmann has been effective mainly due to his ability to throw strikes.
- He is 4-0 with three saves, a 3.60 ERA, .253 opponents' batting average and 30 strikeouts against two walks in 40.0 innings pitched in 2021.
- He has made 13 appearances (four starts).
- His 15.0 strikeout-to-walk ratio is best in Clemson history.
- He tossed a complete game in his first career start in Clemson's 7-2 win at Boston College in the second game of a doubleheader on March 27.
- Against the Eagles, he gave up just six hits (all singles), two runs and no walks with seven strikeouts, throwing 111 pitches.
- It was the first complete game by a Tiger since 2017.
- In his career, he is 6-1 with three saves, a 3.18 ERA and .247 opponents' batting average in 51.0 innings pitched over 20 appearances.
- He has 41 strikeouts against two walks in his career. He has also hit just two batters and has not thrown a wild pitch in his career.

MEREDITH SURGING

- Sophomore outfielder Kier Meredith has been one of the Tigers' best hitters of late.
- He is hitting .308 with six doubles, two triples, three homers, 20 RBIs, 25 runs, a .414 on-base percentage and five steals in 35 games.
- He is 28-for-69 (.406) in the last 18 games.
- He leads the team in hit-by-pitches (13). His 13 hit-by-pitches are tied for eighth in Clemson history.
- He is hitting .368 with runners in scoring position and .375 with two outs.
- He missed the first five games of the season due to injury.
- In his career, he is hitting .305 with 12 doubles, three triples, five homers, 31 RBIs, a .429 on-base percentage and 14 steals in 74 games.

PARKER SOLIDIFYING INFIELD

- Sophomore James Parker has continued his role as the starting shortstop in 2021 after leading the team in starts at shortstop in 2020.
- He is hitting .309 with eight doubles, seven homers, 29 RBIs, 23 runs, a .387 on-base percentage and steal in 40 games in 2021.
