CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has a 5-12 road record, defeated No. 16 South Carolina 7-2 at home on Tuesday night.
- The Tigers are averaging 5.8 runs per game and hitting .259 with a .424 slugging percentage, .366 on-base percentage and 33 steals.

- The pitching staff has a 4.53 ERA, .260 opponents' batting average and 2.85 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .967.

FLORIDA STATE OVERVIEW

- Florida State, who has a 16-12 home record, is led by second-year Head Coach Mike Martin Jr.
- The Seminoles split a two-game series against Florida Gulf Coast. They are hitting .241 and have a 3.23 ERA and .970 fielding percentage.
- Matheu Nelson is hitting .325 with 20 homers, 12 doubles and 58 RBIs, while Elijah Cabell is hitting .291 with 13 homers and 32 RBIs.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson is 12-3 against ACC Atlantic Division teams in 2021.
- Clemson is 18-1 when outhitting the opponent in the 2021 season.
- Clemson is 12-2 when committing exactly one error in 2021.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in fifth place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 15-15 league mark.
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is in ninth place.

TAKING ONE FOR THE TEAM

- Clemson has an on-base percentage 107 points higher than its batting average thanks in large part to its 65 hit-by-pitches in 2021.
- Clemson is averaging 1.48 hit-by-pitches per game in 2021.
- The school record for hit-by-pitches (72) and hit-by-pitches per game (1.13) were both set by the 2016 team.
- At least one Tiger has been hit-by-pitch in each of the last 12 games, including nine of those games with multiple hit-by-pitches.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

- Kier Meredith (14) and Bryce Teodosio (12) are the team leaders in hit-by-pitches. Meredith's total is tied for sixth most in Tiger history.
- Khalil Greene owns the Clemson record for hit-by-pitches in a season with 21 in 2001.

BULLPEN PROVIDING RELIEF

- Clemson's bullpen has kept it in many games this season.
- The bullpen is 16-10 with a 3.55 ERA, .241 opponents' batting average and 213 strikeouts against 70 walks in 205.1 innings pitched.
- It has a 3.04 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

HISTORIC SWEEP OVER CARDINALS

- Clemson swept No. 4 Louisville by a combined score of 31-12 in three games at Doug Kingsmore Stadium from April 30 to May 2.
- It marked the first time since 2011, including the first time since joining the ACC in 2015, that Louisville suffered a three-game sweep.
- Clemson hit .350 with six doubles, a triple, seven homers, a .631 slugging percentage, .500 on-base percentage and three steals.
- The Tiger pitching staff had a 3.00 ERA, .210 opponents' batting average and 29 strikeouts against eight walks.
- In game one, Caden Grice totaled a Clemson-record-tying three home runs and eight RBIs (most by a Tiger since 2016) in the 11-3 win.
- In game two, Grice hit a solo homer in the eighth inning to break a 4-4 tie in Clemson's 5-4 win.
- In game three, the Tigers totaled 18 hits in their 15-5 victory to complete the sweep.
- Grice was 9-for-13 (.692) with four homers, a double, 12 RBIs, seven runs, a 1.692 slugging percentage and .750 on-base percentage.

GRADUATES

- Eight Tiger players and two graduate managers received their diplomas during commencement ceremonies in Greenville, S.C. in May.
- The players graduated May 6.
- Matt Cooper and James Parker graduated with a degree in management. Parker graduated in three years.
- Elijah Henderson and Bryce Teodosio graduated with a degree in agribusiness.
- Sam Hall graduated with a degree in sports communication.
- Bo Majkowski graduated with a degree in parks, recreation & tourism management.
- Kier Meredith graduated with a degree in psychology.
- Connor O'Rear graduated with a degree in financial management.
- Thomas Brittle and Ben Scheinbaum, both graduate managers, received a master's degree in athletic leadership on May 5.
- Mat Clark and Evan Estridge entered the season as Clemson graduates, while Rasesh Pandya is a graduate transfer from Wofford.

TWO TIGERS NAMED CAPTAINS

- Junior and graduate righthander Evan Estridge and sophomore catcher Adam Hackenberg were named team co-captains.
- The two were voted co-captains in a vote by the players in the preseason.
- Estridge played two years at Newberry, then transferred to Clemson, where he walked on and sat out his first year (2019) due to NCAA rules.
- Hackenberg is in his third year in the program and won the 2020 Tiger Baseball Award as the team's best leader.

CATCHING DUO

- Since Adam Hackenberg returned from injury that forced him to miss the first 13 games of 2021, the Tigers have used two catchers.
- Hackenberg and Jonathan French, who was the pre-dominant starter at catcher early in the season, have split time behind the plate.
- French has started 22 games at catcher (11-11 record), while Hackenberg has started 20 games at catcher (12-8 record).
- Hackenberg is hitting .238 with a homer, seven doubles, 11 RBIs and 12 runs in 28 games (27 starts).
- French is hitting .262 with five homers, two doubles, 19 RBIs and 11 runs in 26 games (22 starts).

ANGLIN EMERGING IN ROTATION

- Freshman righthander Mack Anglin was a reliever early in the 2021 season, but he has recently moved into the weekend rotation.
- He is 2-3 with a 3.24 ERA, .218 opponents' batting average and 56 strikeouts in 41.2 innings pitched over 10 appearances (six starts).
- His 12.10 strikeouts-per-nine-innings-pitched mark is sixth in Clemson history.
- He has allowed just six extra-base hits, including only one home run, in 2021.
- Opponents are 0-for-9 with five strikeouts with the bases loaded.
- He pitched 6.0 innings of one-hit ball with six strikeouts against no walks to earn his first career win against Virginia on April 9.
- He pitched 6.1 innings, allowing four hits and no earned runs with 11 strikeouts against Wake Forest on April 23.
- He earned ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week honors for his start against the Demon Deacons, becoming the first Tiger since 2017 to receive that honor.
- He allowed five hits and one run with nine strikeouts in 7.0 innings pitched to earn the win against No. 4 Louisville on April 30.
- In his career, he is 2-4 with a 4.44 ERA and 67 strikeouts against 35 walks in 48.2 innings pitched over 14 appearances (nine starts).

ASKEW RETURNS ON TOP OF HIS GAME

- Sophomore lefthander Keyshawn Askew suffered a leg injury in a scrimmage on Feb. 14 and did not make his first outing until March 14.
- He has recovered and been one of the team's best pitchers since his return.
- He is 1-1 with a 4.07 ERA and .271 opponents' batting average in 48.2 innings pitched over nine appearances (eight starts) in 2021.
- He has 58 strikeouts against only seven walks, good for a 8.29 strikeout-to-walk ratio. That mark is third in Clemson history.
- In his career, he is 3-2 with a 4.15 ERA and .274 opponents' batting average in 106.1 innings pitched over 30 appearances (18 starts).
- He has 106 strikeouts against 33 walks in his career, good for a 3.21 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

BREWER PROVIDING PUNCH

- Freshman outfielder Dylan Brewer has been one of the team's best run producers in 2021.
- He is hitting .211 with seven doubles, nine homers, 29 RBIs, 32 runs, a .339 on-base percentage and six steals in 42 games.
- He totaled two homers and six RBIs in Clemson's 10-6 win at NC State on April 2.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball on April 5. He totaled three homers and 10 RBIs in four games.

NOTES

• In his career, he's hitting .219 with 12 doubles, 10 homers, 35 RBIs, 43 runs, a .357 on-base percentage and nine steals in 58 games.

CLARK IN CONTROL

- Junior lefthander Mat Clark has used his control and change of speed to be effective on the mound during his entire career.
- He is 1-1 with two saves, a 4.28 ERA and .269 opponents' batting average in 40.0 innings pitched over 11 appearances (four starts) in 2021.
- He has 38 strikeouts against only one walk, good for a 38.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio. That mark is best in Clemson history.
- In 20.0 innings pitched after the fifth inning, he has allowed just 13 hits, two runs (0.90 ERA) and no walks with 18 strikeouts.
- In his career, he is 16-4 with a 3.26 ERA and .227 opponents' batting average in 146.1 innings pitched over 48 appearances (16 starts).
- He has 135 strikeouts against only 31 walks in his career, good for a 4.35 strikeout-to-walk ratio, third in Clemson history.
- He has a 1.91 career walks-per-nine-innings-pitched mark, third in Clemson history.

CLAYTON STEADY IN RELIEF

- Freshman righthander Nick Clayton has been steady and clutch out of the bullpen in 2021.
- He is 6-2 with a 3.41 ERA, .206 opponents' batting average and 38 strikeouts against eight walks in 34.1 innings pitched.
- In 10 relief outings in ACC games, he is 3-2 with a 2.86 ERA, .229 opponents' batting average and 23 strikeouts against six walks.
- He pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in relief of two-hit ball with four strikeouts to earn the win at NC State on April 2.
- He pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in relief of two-hit ball with two strikeouts to earn the win against USC Upstate on May 5.
- In his career, he is 7-2 with one save, a 2.72 ERA and 46 strikeouts against 12 walks in 43.0 innings pitched over 22 relief appearances.

GILBERT LEADING BULLPEN

- Freshman lefthander Geoffrey Gilbert has pitched late in games for the Tigers since his first season in 2020.
- He was one of 65 pitchers named to the NCBWA Stopper-of-the-Year Award Watch List on April 29.
- He is 3-5 with three saves, a 1.66 ERA, .248 opponents' batting average and 47 strikeouts against 12 walks in 38.0 innings pitched.
- He leads the team with 25 appearances, all in relief.
- In 18 relief outings in ACC games, he has a 1.35 ERA and .208 opponents' batting average with 26 strikeouts in 26.2 innings pitched.
- In two relief appearances against No. 4 Louisville on May 1,2, he combined to pitch 4.1 perfect innings in relief with three strikeouts.
- In his career, he is 4-5 with three saves, a 1.42 ERA and 61 strikeouts against 19 walks in 50.2 innings pitched over 33 relief appearances.

GRICE POWERING LINEUP

- Freshman first baseman and lefty Caden Grice showed his power potential in the fall and preseason, and he has carried that into the season.
- He was one of 45 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- He is hitting .321 with 12 homers, a triple, eight doubles, 44 RBIs, a .615 slugging percentage and .429 on-base percentage in 43 games.

- In 30 ACC games, he is hitting .348 with nine homers, a triple, six doubles, 34 RBIs, 25 runs and a .457 on-base percentage.
- He is hitting .329 with runners on base and .367 with runners in scoring position.
- He is 4-for-6 (.667) with a grand slam, two doubles, 12 RBIs and a walk with the bases loaded.
- He has also made two starts and two relief appearances on the mound in 2021.
- With his 6'6" frame, he has saved several runs at first base with his ability to stretch and catch errant throws.
- He was named one of 12 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball on March 8 for his previous four games, when he hit four homers.
- He was 8-for-14 (.571) with three doubles, a triple, 10 RBIs and a .647 on-base percentage in the three-game series at Boston College.
- He was named ACC Player-of-the-Week on March 29 by leading Clemson to a 4-0 record in four road games the previous week.
- He was also named NCBWA National Hitter-of-the-Week on March 30.
- He was 9-for-18 with three doubles, a triple, homer, 13 RBIs, five runs, a .944 slugging percentage and .571 on-base percentage on the week.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball and ACC Player-of-the-Week on May 3 against No. 4 Louisville.
- He was also named national player-of-the-week by D1Baseball and Perfect Game on May 4.
- He was 9-for-13 (.692) with four homers, a double, 12 RBIs, seven runs, a 1.692 slugging percentage and .750 on-base percentage.

HALL RETURNS FROM INJURY

- Junior infielder and outfielder Sam Hall missed the first half of the year due to several injuries, but he is back as one of the top hitters.
- He is hitting .315 with three homers, six doubles, six RBIs, 18 runs, a .486 on-base percentage and three steals in 17 games in 2021.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in all 16 games with a plate appearance in 2021.
- In his career, he is hitting .251 with 13 homers, a triple, 22 doubles, 47 RBIs, 102 runs and 43 steals in 118 games (108 starts).

HAWKINS HOT DURING SECOND HALF

- Sophomore infielder Bryar Hawkins has been one of the team's best hitters during the second half of the season.
- He is hitting .267 with four doubles, a triple, four RBIs, 15 runs and a .370 on-base percentage in 29 games (23 starts) in 2021.
- In his 17 ACC games (13 starts), he is hitting .271 with a .364 on-base percentage.
- In his last 19 games, he is 19-for-59 (.322).
- In his career, he is hitting .282 with eight homers, three triples, 13 doubles, 36 RBIs, 53 runs and five steals in 96 games (82 starts).

HOFFMANN THROWING STRIKES

- Freshman righthander Nick Hoffmann has been effective mainly due to his ability to throw strikes.
- He is 4-0 with four saves, a 3.53 ERA, .256 opponents' batting average and 35 strikeouts against two walks in 43.1 innings pitched in 2021.
- He has made 15 appearances (four starts).
- His 17.5 strikeout-to-walk ratio is second in Clemson history.
- He tossed a complete game in his first career start in Clemson's 7-2 win at Boston College in the second game of a doubleheader on March 27.

- Against the Eagles, he gave up just six hits (all singles), two runs and no walks with seven strikeouts, throwing 111 pitches.
- It was the first complete game by a Tiger since 2017.
- In his career, he is 6-1 with four saves, a 3.15 ERA and .250 opponents' batting average in 54.1 innings pitched over 22 appearances.
- He has 46 strikeouts against two walks in his career. He has also hit just two batters and has thrown only one wild pitch in his career.

MEREDITH SURGING

- Sophomore outfielder Kier Meredith has been one of the Tigers' best hitters of late.
- He is hitting .309 with seven doubles, three triples, three homers, 25 RBIs, 26 runs, a .406 on-base percentage and six steals in 39 games.
- He is 33-for-85 (.388) in the last 22 games.
- He leads the team in hit-by-pitches (14). His 14 hit-by-pitches are tied for sixth in Clemson history.
- He is hitting .386 with runners in scoring position and .389 with two outs.
- He missed the first five games of the season due to injury.
- In his career, he is hitting .306 with 13 doubles, four triples, five homers, 36 RBIs, a .424 on-base percentage and 15 steals in 78 games.

PARKER SOLIDIFYING INFIELD

- Sophomore James Parker has continued his role as the starting shortstop in 2021 after leading the team in starts at shortstop in 2020.
- He is hitting .315 with nine doubles, seven homers, 32 RBIs, 23 runs, a .399 on-base percentage and steal in 44 games in 2021.
- He is the only Tiger to start every game in 2021.
- He has a .940 fielding percentage (10 errors in 166 chances).
- He had a 12-game hitting streak, which included the last seven games of 2020 and the first five games of 2021.
- He had an 11-game hitting streak from March to April.
- He hit a home run and later added a walkoff single in the 10th inning in the 8-7 win over Cincinnati on Feb. 21.
- He hit a home run in each of the three games against No. 13 Virginia Tech at Doug Kingsmore Stadium from March 19-21.
- Against the Hokies on March 21, he hit a three-run homer on an 0-2 pitch with two outs in the eighth inning to lift Clemson to a 4-2 win.
- He received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the three-game season series against South Carolina.
- He was 6-for-11 (.545) with a homer, double, four RBIs, two runs and a .667 on-base percentage in the season series against the Gamecocks.
- In his career, he is hitting .295 with 14 doubles, nine homers, 47 RBIs, 39 runs and five steals in 84 games (72 starts).

TEODOSIO SHOWING ALL-AROUND GAME

- Junior Bryce Teodosio has always been one of the nation's best defensive outfielders, but in 2021, he has stepped up his game at the plate.
- He is hitting .234 with six homers, three doubles, 12 RBIs, 23 runs, a .364 on-base percentage and six steals in 44 games (42 starts).
- In his career, he is hitting .209 with 19 homers, 16 doubles, 55 RBIs, 69 runs and 18 steals in 144 games (126 starts).

FOUR TIGERS IN THE MAJORS IN 2021

- Former Tigers Paul Campbell, Steven Duggar, Brad Miller and Eli White are on 2021 MLB rosters.
- Campbell is in his first MLB season, Duggar is in his fourth season, Miller is in his ninth season and White is in his second season.
- Campbell, who made 30 appearances (three starts) as a Tiger from 2015-17, made his MLB debut with the Miami Marlins on April 3.
- Duggar was a two-time All-ACC player as a Tiger from 2013-15 and made his MLB debut with the Giants on July 8, 2018.
- Miller, the 2011 ACC Player-of-the-Year, hit .339 with 36 doubles, eight triples, 16 homers, 135 RBIs and 46 steals in 191 games as a Tiger.
- White, who hit .275 with 104 runs and 36 steals at Clemson from 2014-16, made his MLB debut with the Texas Rangers on Sept. 1, 2020.
- Every Tiger team from 1974 to 2017 had at least one future major leaguer on its roster.
