### CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has a 17-8 home record, won one of three games at No. 10 Florida State last weekend.
- The Tigers are averaging 5.8 runs per game and hitting .257 with a .419 slugging percentage, .363 on-base percentage and 34 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 4.64 ERA, .262 opponents' batting average and 2.71 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .966.

### DUKE OVERVIEW

- Duke, who has an 8-13 road record, is led by ninth-year Head Coach Chris Pollard.
- The Blue Devils beat Davidson 18-2 and have won five games in a row. They are hitting .286 and have a 4.81 ERA and .965 fielding percentage.
- Joey Loperfido is hitting .366 with 10 steals, RJ Schreck is batting .345 with 12 homers and Peter Matt is hitting .303 with 12 homers.

### QUICK HITS

- The series opener against Duke marks Clemson's first game on a Thursday in 2021.
- Clemson has won eight home games in a row.
- Twelve Tigers have started a game on the mound in 2021.

### ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in fifth place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 16-17 league mark.
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is tied for ninth place.

### TAKING ONE FOR THE TEAM

- Clemson has an on-base percentage 106 points higher than its batting average thanks in large part to its 70 hit-by-pitches in 2021.
- Clemson is averaging 1.49 hit-by-pitches per game.
- The school record for hit-by-pitches (72) and hit-by-pitches per game (1.13) were both set by the 2016 team.
- At least one Tiger has been hit-by-pitch in each of the last 15 games, including 10 of those games with multiple hit-by-pitches.
- Kier Meredith (16) and Bryce Teodosio (12) are the team leaders in hit-by-pitches. Meredith's total is fourth in Tiger history.
- Khalil Greene owns the Clemson record for hit-by-pitches in a season with 21 in 2001.

## DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

## BULLPEN PROVIDING RELIEF

- Clemson's bullpen has kept it in many games this season.
- The bullpen is 17-11 with a 3.69 ERA, .243 opponents' batting average and 230 strikeouts against 82 walks in 217.0 innings pitched.
- It has a 2.80 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

## HISTORIC SWEEP OVER CARDINALS

- Clemson swept No. 4 Louisville by a combined score of 31-12 in three games at Doug Kingsmore Stadium from April 30 to May 2.
- It marked the first time since 2011, including the first time since joining the ACC in 2015, that Louisville suffered a three-game sweep.
- Clemson hit .350 with six doubles, a triple, seven homers, a .631 slugging percentage, .500 on-base percentage and three steals.
- The Tiger pitching staff had a 3.00 ERA, .210 opponents' batting average and 29 strikeouts against eight walks.
- In game one, Caden Grice totaled a Clemson-record-tying three home runs and eight RBIs (most by a Tiger since 2016) in the 11-3 win.
- In game two, Grice hit a solo homer in the eighth inning to break a 4-4 tie in Clemson's 5-4 win.
- In game three, the Tigers totaled 18 hits in their 15-5 victory to complete the sweep.
- Grice was 9-for-13 (.692) with four homers, a double, 12 RBIs, seven runs, a 1.692 slugging percentage and .750 on-base percentage.

## GRADUATES

- Eight Tiger players and two graduate managers received their diplomas during commencement ceremonies in Greenville, S.C. in May.
- The players graduated May 6.
- Matt Cooper and James Parker graduated with a degree in management. Parker received his degree in three years.
- Elijah Henderson and Bryce Teodosio graduated with a degree in agribusiness.
- Sam Hall graduated with a degree in sports communication.
- Bo Majkowski graduated with a degree in parks, recreation & tourism management.
- Kier Meredith graduated with a degree in psychology.
- Connor O'Rear graduated with a degree in financial management.
- Thomas Brittle and Ben Scheinbaum, both graduate managers, received a master's degree in athletic leadership on May 5.
- Mat Clark and Evan Estridge entered the season as Clemson graduates, while Rasesh Pandya is a graduate transfer from Wofford.

## TWO TIGERS NAMED CAPTAINS

- Junior and graduate righthander Evan Estridge and sophomore catcher Adam Hackenberg were named team co-captains.
- The two were voted co-captains in a vote by the players in the pre-season.
- Estridge played two years at Newberry, then transferred to Clemson, where he walked on and sat out his first year (2019) due to NCAA rules.
- Hackenberg is in his third year in the program and won the 2020 Tiger Baseball Award as the team's best leader.

## CATCHING DUO

- Since Adam Hackenberg returned from injury that forced him to miss the first 13 games of 2021, the Tigers have used two catchers.

- Jonathan French, who was the predominant starter at catcher early in the season, and Hackenberg have split time behind the plate.
- French has started 24 games at catcher (12-12 record), while Hackenberg has started 21 games at catcher (12-9 record).
- Hackenberg is hitting .229 with a homer, seven doubles, 11 RBIs, 12 runs and a steal in 29 games (28 starts).
- French is hitting .264 with five homers, two doubles, 20 RBIs and 12 runs in 28 games (24 starts).

## ANGLIN EMERGING IN ROTATION

- Freshman righthander Mack Anglin was a reliever early in the 2021 season, but he has recently moved into the weekend rotation.
- He is 2-4 with a 3.21 ERA, .215 opponents' batting average and 65 strikeouts in 47.2 innings pitched over 11 appearances (seven starts).
- His 12.27 strikeouts-per-nine-innings-pitched mark is fifth in Clemson history.
- He has allowed just seven extra-base hits, including only one home run, in 2021.
- Opponents are 0-for-9 with five strikeouts with the bases loaded.
- He pitched 6.0 innings of one-hit ball with six strikeouts against no walks to earn his first career win against Virginia on April 9.
- He pitched 6.1 innings, allowing four hits and no earned runs with 11 strikeouts against Wake Forest on April 23.
- He earned ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week honors for his start against the Demon Deacons, becoming the first Tiger since 2017 to receive that honor.
- He allowed five hits and one run with nine strikeouts in 7.0 innings pitched to earn the win against No. 4 Louisville on April 30.
- In his career, he is 2-5 with a 4.28 ERA and 76 strikeouts against 39 walks in 54.2 innings pitched over 15 appearances (10 starts).

## ASKEW RETURNS ON TOP OF HIS GAME

- Sophomore lefthander Keyshawn Askew suffered a leg injury in a scrimmage on Feb. 14 and did not make his first outing until March 14.
- He has recovered and been one of the team's best pitchers since his return.
- He is 1-1 with a 4.56 ERA and .275 opponents' batting average in 53.1 innings pitched over 10 appearances (nine starts) in 2021.
- He has 66 strikeouts against only nine walks, good for a 7.33 strikeout-to-walk ratio. That mark is fourth in Clemson history.
- In his career, he is 3-2 with a 4.38 ERA and .276 opponents' batting average in 111.0 innings pitched over 31 appearances (19 starts).
- He has 114 strikeouts against 35 walks in his career, good for a 3.26 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

## BREWER PROVIDING PUNCH

- Freshman outfielder Dylan Brewer has been one of the team's best run producers in 2021.
- He is hitting .207 with seven doubles, nine homers, 29 RBIs, 33 runs, a .332 on-base percentage and six steals in 45 games.
- He totaled two homers and six RBIs in Clemson's 10-6 win at NC State on April 2.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball on April 5. He totaled three homers and 10 RBIs in four games.
- In his career, he's hitting .216 with 12 doubles, 10 homers, 35 RBIs, 44 runs, a .351 on-base percentage and nine steals in 61 games.

# NOTES

## CLARK IN CONTROL

- Junior lefthander Mat Clark has used his control and change of speed to be effective on the mound during his entire career.
- He is 1-1 with two saves, a 4.28 ERA and .269 opponents' batting average in 40.0 innings pitched over 11 appearances (four starts) in 2021.
- He has 38 strikeouts against only one walk, good for a 38.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio. That mark is best in Clemson history.
- In 20.0 innings pitched after the fifth inning, he has allowed just 13 hits, two runs (0.90 ERA) and no walks with 18 strikeouts.
- In his career, he is 16-4 with a 3.26 ERA and .227 opponents' batting average in 146.1 innings pitched over 48 appearances (16 starts).
- He has 135 strikeouts against only 31 walks in his career, good for a 4.35 strikeout-to-walk ratio, third in Clemson history.
- He has a 1.91 career walks-per-nine-innings-pitched mark, third in Clemson history.

## CLAYTON STEADY IN RELIEF

- Freshman righthander Nick Clayton has been steady and clutch out of the bullpen in 2021.
- He is 6-2 with a 3.89 ERA, .229 opponents' batting average and 40 strikeouts against 11 walks in 37.0 innings pitched.
- In 11 outings (one start) in ACC games, he is 3-2 with a 3.65 ERA, .258 opponents' batting average and 25 strikeouts against nine walks.
- He pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in relief of two-hit ball with four strikeouts to earn the win at NC State on April 2.
- He pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in relief of two-hit ball with two strikeouts to earn the win against USC Upstate on May 5.
- In his career, he is 7-2 with one save, a 3.15 ERA and 48 strikeouts against 15 walks in 45.2 innings pitched over 23 outings (one start).

## GILBERT LEADING BULLPEN

- Freshman lefthander Geoffrey Gilbert has pitched late in games for the Tigers since his first season in 2020.
- He was one of 65 pitchers named to the NCBWA Stopper-of-the-Year Award Watch List on April 29.
- He is 3-5 with three saves, a 2.08 ERA, .255 opponents' batting average and 48 strikeouts against 15 walks in 39.0 innings pitched.
- He leads the 2021 team with 26 appearances, all in relief.
- In 19 relief outings in ACC games, he has a 1.95 ERA and .220 opponents' batting average with 27 strikeouts in 27.2 innings pitched.
- In two relief appearances against No. 4 Louisville on May 1,2, he combined to pitch 4.1 perfect innings in relief with three strikeouts.
- In his career, he is 4-5 with three saves, a 1.74 ERA and 62 strikeouts against 22 walks in 51.2 innings pitched over 34 relief appearances.

## GRICE POWERING LINEUP

- Freshman first baseman and lefty Caden Grice showed his power potential in the fall and preseason, and he has carried that into the season.
- He was one of 45 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- He is hitting .317 with 13 homers, a triple, nine doubles, 49 RBIs, a .617 slugging percentage and .426 on-base percentage in 46 games.
- In 33 ACC games, he is hitting .341 with 10 homers, a triple, seven doubles, 39 RBIs, 28 runs and a .450 on-base percentage.

- He is hitting .326 with runners on base and .370 with runners in scoring position.
- He is 4-for-6 (.667) with a grand slam, two doubles, 12 RBIs and a walk with the bases loaded.
- He has also made two starts and two relief appearances on the mound in 2021.
- With his 6'6" frame, he has saved several runs at first base with his ability to stretch and catch errant throws.
- He was named one of 12 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball on March 8 for his previous four games, when he hit four homers.
- He was 8-for-14 (.571) with three doubles, a triple, 10 RBIs and a .647 on-base percentage in the three-game series at Boston College.
- He was named ACC Player-of-the-Week on March 29 by leading Clemson to a 4-0 record in four road games the previous week.
- He was also named NCBWA National Hitter-of-the-Week on March 30.
- He was 9-for-18 with three doubles, a triple, homer, 13 RBIs, five runs, a .944 slugging percentage and .571 on-base percentage on the week.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball and ACC Player-of-the-Week on May 3 against No. 4 Louisville.
- He was also named national player-of-the-week by D1Baseball and Perfect Game on May 4.
- He was 9-for-13 (.692) with four homers, a double, 12 RBIs, seven runs, a 1.692 slugging percentage and .750 on-base percentage.

## HALL RETURNS FROM INJURY

- Junior infielder and outfielder Sam Hall missed the first half of the year due to several injuries, but he is back as one of the top hitters.
- He is hitting .279 with four homers, six doubles, eight RBIs, 21 runs, a .437 on-base percentage and three steals in 20 games in 2021.
- He reached base via a hit or walk in each of his first 18 games with a plate appearance in 2021.
- In his career, he is hitting .248 with 14 homers, a triple, 22 doubles, 49 RBIs, 105 runs and 43 steals in 121 games (111 starts).

## HAWKINS HOT DURING SECOND HALF

- Sophomore infielder Bryar Hawkins has been one of the team's best hitters during the second half of the season.
- He is hitting .286 with four doubles, a triple, six RBIs, 18 runs and a .381 on-base percentage in 32 games (26 starts) in 2021.
- In his 20 ACC games (16 starts), he is hitting .300 with a .382 on-base percentage.
- In his last 22 games, he is 24-for-71 (.338).
- In his career, he is hitting .287 with eight homers, three triples, 13 doubles, 38 RBIs, 56 runs and five steals in 99 games (85 starts).

## HOFFMANN THROWING STRIKES

- Freshman righthander Nick Hoffmann has been effective mainly due to his ability to throw strikes.
- He is 4-1 with four saves, a 3.59 ERA, .254 opponents' batting average and 38 strikeouts against five walks in 47.2 innings pitched in 2021.
- He has made 16 appearances (four starts).
- His 7.60 strikeout-to-walk ratio is second in Clemson history.
- He tossed a complete game in his first career start in Clemson's 7-2 win at Boston College in the second game of a doubleheader on March 27.
- Against the Eagles, he gave up just six hits (all singles), two runs and no walks with seven strikeouts, throwing 111 pitches.

- It was the first complete game by a Tiger since 2017.
- In his career, he is 6-2 with four saves, a 3.22 ERA and .249 opponents' batting average in 58.2 innings pitched over 23 appearances.
- He has 49 strikeouts against five walks in his career. He has also hit just two batters and has thrown only one wild pitch in his career.

### MEREDITH SURGING

- Sophomore outfielder Kier Meredith has been one of the Tigers' best hitters of late.
- He is hitting .308 with seven doubles, three triples, three homers, 25 RBIs, 29 runs, a .410 on-base percentage and six steals in 42 games.
- He is 36-for-95 (.379) in the last 25 games.
- He leads the team in hit-by-pitches (16). His 16 hit-by-pitches are fourth in Clemson history.
- He is hitting .386 with runners in scoring position and .389 with two outs.
- He missed the first five games of the season due to injury.
- In his career, he is hitting .306 with 13 doubles, four triples, five homers, 36 RBIs, a .426 on-base percentage and 15 steals in 81 games.

### PARKER SOLIDIFYING INFIELD

- Sophomore James Parker has continued his role as the starting shortstop in 2021 after leading the team in starts at shortstop in 2020.
- He is hitting .319 with 11 doubles, seven homers, 34 RBIs, 26 runs, a .401 on-base percentage and steal in 47 games in 2021.
- He is the only Tiger to start every game in 2021.
- He has a .932 fielding percentage (12 errors in 176 chances).
- He had a 12-game hitting streak, which included the last seven games of 2020 and the first five games of 2021.
- He had an 11-game hitting streak from March to April.
- He hit a home run and later added a walkoff single in the 10th inning in the 8-7 win over Cincinnati on Feb. 21.
- He hit a home run in each of the three games against No. 13 Virginia Tech at Doug Kingsmore Stadium from March 19-21.
- Against the Hokies on March 21, he hit a three-run homer on an 0-2 pitch with two outs in the eighth inning to lift Clemson to a 4-2 win.
- He received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the three-game season series against rival South Carolina.
- He was 6-for-11 (.545) with a homer, double, four RBIs, two runs and a .667 on-base percentage in the season series against the Gamecocks.
- In his career, he is hitting .299 with 16 doubles, nine homers, 49 RBIs, 42 runs and five steals in 87 games (75 starts).

### SHARPE CONTRIBUTING BOTH WAYS

- Sophomore utility player Davis Sharpe was Clemson's opening-day starter on the mound, but he was hampered by injury in March.
- He started the series opener in each of the first four weeks of 2021 before being shut down on the mound.
- The preseason first-team All-American has since rounded into form, making his return to the mound against USC Upstate on May 5.
- He is 3-1 with a 5.08 ERA, .255 opponents' batting average and 39 strikeouts in 28.1 innings pitched over seven appearances (five starts).
- Since returning from injury, he is 1-0 with a 3.12 ERA and 12 strikeouts in 8.2 innings pitched over three appearances (one start).

- He was able to contribute offensively during his hiatus, starting many games at first base, Clemson's best defensive player at the position.
- He is hitting .208 with three homers, five doubles, 12 RBIs, 13 runs and a .310 on-base percentage in 21 games (17 starts).
- He allowed just one hit, no runs and one walk with nine strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched to earn the win against Cincinnati on Feb. 19.
- He hit a two-run walkoff homer in the first game of a doubleheader against Wake Forest on April 25.
- He pitched 4.1 innings in relief, allowing three hits and no runs with eight strikeouts to earn the win at No. 10 Florida State on May 15.
- In his career, he is hitting .256 with 11 doubles, 10 homers, 40 RBIs, 41 runs, a .369 on-base percentage and four steals in 72 games.
- In his career, he is 11-6 with a 3.71 ERA, .227 opponents' batting average and 143 strikeouts in 131.0 innings pitched over 26 appearances.

### TEODOSIO SHOWING ALL-AROUND GAME

- Junior Bryce Teodosio has always been one of the nation's best defensive outfielders, but in 2021, he has stepped up his game at the plate.
- He is hitting .221 with six homers, three doubles, 13 RBIs, 23 runs, a .354 on-base percentage and six steals in 47 games (45 starts).
- In his career, he is hitting .205 with 19 homers, 16 doubles, 56 RBIs, 69 runs and 18 steals in 147 games (129 starts).

### FIVE TIGERS IN THE MAJORS IN 2021

- Former Tigers Paul Campbell, Steven Duggar, Brad Miller, Eli White and Steve Wilkerson are on 2021 MLB rosters.
- Campbell is in his first MLB season, Duggar is in his fourth, Miller is in his ninth, White is in his second and Wilkerson is in his third.
- Campbell, who made 30 appearances (three starts) as a Tiger from 2015-17, made his MLB debut with the Miami Marlins on April 3.
- Duggar was a two-time All-ACC player as a Tiger from 2013-15 and made his MLB debut with the Giants on July 8, 2018.
- Miller, the 2011 ACC Player-of-the-Year, hit .339 with 36 doubles, eight triples, 16 homers, 135 RBIs and 46 steals in 191 games as a Tiger.
- White, who hit .275 with 104 runs and 36 steals at Clemson from 2014-16, made his MLB debut with the Texas Rangers on Sept. 1, 2020.
- Wilkerson was a three-time All-ACC player as a Tiger from 2011-14 and made his MLB debut with the Baltimore Orioles on June 20, 2018.
- Every Tiger team from 1974 to 2017 had at least one future major leaguer on its roster.
