Tiger Girls Soccer Camp-Summer 2021 Camper Protocol Requirements

Check-in Procedure/Pre-Arrival:

- NO Prearrival Test- A prearrival test is **not** required for our camp.
- QR CODE: All campers must be registered in our testing system and have established a QR Code at the
 time of check-in. QR Code must be shown at the time of check-in. Instructions to register for a QR Code
 are on Page 5 of this document or our camp website at https://clemsontigers.com/tiger-girls-soccer-camp/
- Health Screen Check: Each camper will receive a health screen check before camp begins each AM.
- Each Camper will receive a ID badge they must have with them throughout the camp event for identification and health clearance.
- Any camper with a pre-existing health condition or injury history will be prescreened at the time of check-in by our athletic training staff.
- Each Camper will receive a camp T-shirt, training/drop-off location and group/ID# assignment
- All campers must have paid in full and all areas completed in their registration prior to arrival.

Check-in Location:

Check In procedures will be held at the West Entrance of Littlejohn Basketball Coliseum. Each Camper will
be checked in by Last Name. Please follow the signage provided to locate your check-in table. Masks will
be required to be worn by all campers and adults during check in if entering any facilities.

Housing:

All campers will be required to arrange their own housing during the camp. Hotel Accommodation listings

Drop-off/Pick-up Procedure:

- Campers will need to check-in first at Littlejohn Basketball Coliseum-West Entrance (facing Perimeter Road) between 8-9:15 AM.
- Only 1 adult/legal guardian will be allowed to bring the camper to the check-in location-mask required
- At the time of check-in you will be provided a training location to drop off the camper for the day.
- Pick-up and Drop-Off locations will be predetermined and a map of this will be provided at check-in also
 for the whole camp. Drop-off location may not be the same as the pick-up location so please refer to the
 chart provided at check-in. (may also be sent via email)
- We highly encourage if campers are traveling together that everyone wears a mask in the vehicle to the camp and wears the clothing they are playing in.

Water Station Protocol:

- Each cohort group will be assigned a water station area. Campers are asked to bring their own sanitized water bottle with removable lid to have for their water supply. The camp will provide additional water and bottles of Gatorade for the camp.
- Each Camper should only take one bottle of Gatorade for each session
- Campers are not allowed to share bottles with others
- There will be a hand sanitizer unit at each water station.

Mask Required Areas:

- Masks are required to enter any university building by campers , parent/legal guardians and staff. This includes restrooms and dining halls for meals.
- Masks do not have to been worn during athletic activity and while eating or drinking.
- Campers and staff are required to spread out during timeouts or water breaks.
- Masks are encouraged to be worn around all water stations
- Masks are highly encouraged to be worn if commuting to the camp with multiple people in the vehicle.
- New CDC Camp Guidelines: Indoors. Mask use indoors is strongly encouraged for people who are not fully vaccinated including children. No child under the age of 2 should wear a mask.
 Outdoors. In general, people do not need to wear masks when outdoors. However, particularly in areas of substantial to high transmission, people who are not fully vaccinated are encouraged to wear a mask in crowded outdoor settings or during activities that involve sustained close contact with other people who are not fully vaccinated.

Camp Meals:

- Lunch is provided to all campers & staff during the event. We will be dining in Core Campus. The dining hall will provide all the necessary items specific to any dietary needs.
- Campers and staff must eat in an assigned area with their assigned cohort (training) group at the camp.
- Campers are asked to not share any food or drink items at all times.
- Campers and staff are required to ensure that all dining areas and water station areas remain clean.
- Comfortable walking shoes are encouraged to have for camp.

Camper Gear & Attire:

• Campers are asked to limit their belongings for the camp each day to: MASKs, cleats, shin guards, walking shoes, water bottle, sunscreen, mask, snack, and any personal required items to have on hand.

Symptomatic Campers:

• If or when a camper becomes symptomatic, they will be isolated with supervision by a minimum of 2 camp staff members in an assigned location. The staff members are required to be vaccinated. The parent/guardian of the camper will be notified and the parent/guardian must return back to the camp to pick up their camper to be removed from the camp for care.

Athletic Training:


• Our camp will provide an athletic trainer on site for any athletic related injuries to be addressed as needed. Our Athletic trainers are required to be certified in CPR and First Aid.


Venue Protocol for Parent/Guardian Viewing:

The following venues will be under specific social distancing and viewing restrictions:


• **F3**-Historic Riggs Field- all camper parents/guardians must adhere to sitting in the stadium portion of Riggs Field, must adhere to sitting 6 ft. apart and must wear a mask in the facility. Only camp staff and campers will be allowed on field level.

- **F1 & F2**-Soccer Practice Facility- do to the limit spacing between fencing and fields/field to field, viewers will unable to come inside the fence area.
- **F4 & F5**-Jervey Meadows- parent/guardians are asked to remain outside the field playing area by 10-15 feet and remain socially distanced 6 ft apart. We ask that distance be respected at water stations and teams.
- **F6-**LoConte Family Field- off of Hwy 93, 250 Campus View Trail, Seneca, SC 29678; Intramural turf fields; viewing must be socially distanced and remain outside the fence area and entrances cleared of any pedestrians.
- F7- Upper Intramural Fields- off of Hwy 93 and Williamston Road next to Memorial Stadium
- Littlejohn Basketball Coliseum- off of Hwy 93 and Perimeter Road, Clemson, SC 29634
