### OPENING TIP

#### GUESS WHO'S BACK...BACK AGAIN

- The Tigers welcome back second-team All-ACC honoree **Delicia Washington**, who will play in her fifth season after being granted an additional year of eligibility due to the pandemic.
- Washington, ended the 2020-21 season being named Second Team All-ACC, WNIT All-Region and leading the Tigers in scoring and assists, looks to make an even bigger impact this year. Her scoring average of 16.3 points a game was the highest for a Tiger since Lakeia Stokes in 2003-04 (17.0 ppg), and she recorded her career high of 33 points against Florida State.

#### NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- The Tigers welcome eight new faces to the roster this season.
- Clemson added five-star guard **Kionna Gaines** (5-9, Columbus, Ga.), along with four other freshmen to the 2021-22 team – **Eno Inyang** (6-3, St. Cloud, Fla.), **Makayla Elmore** (6-3, Fostoria, Ontario), **Sydney Standifer** (5-7, Argyle, Texas) and **Madi Ott** (5-10, Frisco Texas).
- Clemson also welcomes graduate transfers **Kiara Lewis** (Syracuse) and **LaTrese Saine** (SEMO), as well as junior college transfer **Daisha Bradford** who will make instant impacts. Lewis, was a First-Team All-ACC selection in 2019-20 and an honorable mention selection last season at Syracuse.

#### EXPERIENCE IS THE BEST TEACHER

- Graduate transfers **Kiara Lewis** (Syracuse) and **LaTrese Saine** (SEMO), as well as junior college transfer **Daisha Bradford** will make instant impacts.
- **Lewis**, was a First-Team All-ACC selection in 2019-20 and an honorable mention selection last season at Syracuse. She led Syracuse in points (547), assists (151), and steals (54) her junior year with the Orange and started all games her senior year, averaging 14 points per game, 33.3 percent from the field and over 72 percent from the FT line.
- **Saine**, hailing from Southeast Missouri State, was the 2020-21 Ohio Valley Conference Defensive Player of the Year, and became the all-time blocks leader her senior year.
- **Bradford**, a Jones College transfer, was an NCJAA First Team All-American, First Team All-MACCC and unanimous MACCC South Division MVP during the 2020-21 season. She also led Jones in scoring (17.3 ppg), rebounding (7.0 rpg), assists (95), steals (60) and blocked shots (16), shooting 44 percent from the field and 70 percent from the line.

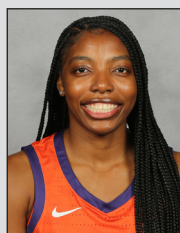

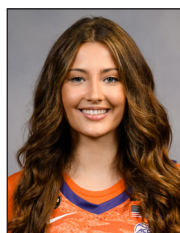

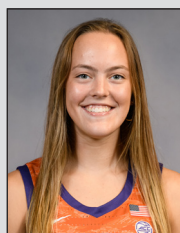

## TEAM NOTES

### TOUGH SLATE

- The Tigers have a tough season ahead of them, facing an early-season road game at South Carolina and playing a strong Penn State team just four days later. The BIG10/ACC Challenge in early December sees the Tigers in a match-up with a very good Northwestern team, followed by contests with local teams Presbyterian and Wofford.
- The Tigers wrap up non-conference play with LSU and Dayton at the West Palm Beach Invitational in late December and slug it out with an always-challenging ACC schedule for the remainder of the season.

### TIGER TAILS

- Coach Butler is 3-0 in season and home openers as head coach of the Tigers.
- Clemson has not a lost a season opener since Nov. 8, 2013 when they lost 57-77 to Davidson.
- Tigers have not lost to at home to an in state team since South Carolina 48-84 at home on Nov. 24, 2019.
- Clemson has not lost a home game to an in state non-powers five since Nov. 21, 2015 when lost to Furman 49-70 on the road.

### HOME SWEET HOME

- Clemson boasts a 33-13 record in the 46 season openers in program history. The Tigers are looking to extend their win streak to seven straight season opener with a win against Upstate on Wednesday.
- When opening the season at home, the Tigers are 22-4, with the last home loss coming against Davidson, 77-57, to open the 2013-14 campaign.
- The Tigers have defeated their opponents by double-digits in 20 of the 46 season openers, with 14 of the 21 contests coming at home.

- The Tigers start the season scheduled to play six teams ranked in the preseason Top 25.

- The inaugural group will be celebrated throughout the 2021-22 campaign. Men's Basketball alumnus Jordan Roper, now a member of the IPTAY staff, spearheaded the initiative.

McIntyre is currently on the men's basketball staff as the director of player development.

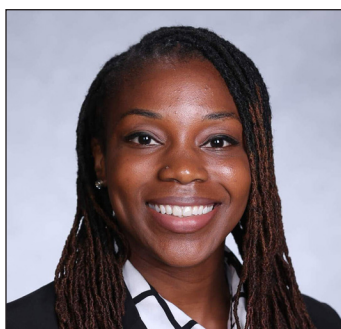

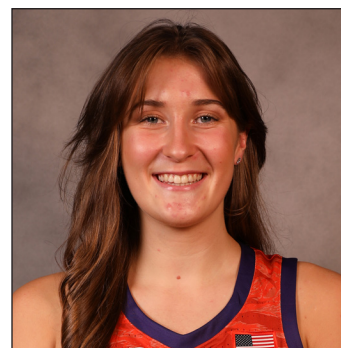

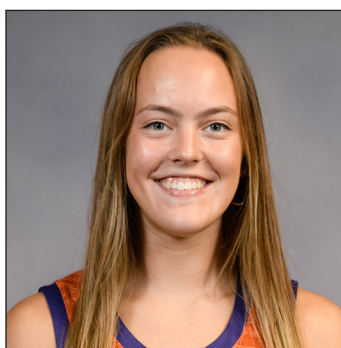
