

# FLYER FACTS

- » Head coach Shauna Green is the eighth head coach in program history and is in her sixth season at the helm of the Flyers. She previously served as an assistant on the Dayton staff from 2012-15. Green was named the 2020 Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year for the second time.
- » This is the Flyers' 53rd season (1968-69) as an intercollegiate sport at Dayton. UD's all-time record sits at 863-616 (.583). The Flyers are 238-162 (.595) in Atlantic 10 regular season play (27th season).
- » Dayton was picked as the preseason favorites with 11 first-place votes ahead of Rhode Island, Fordham, Saint Louis, and VCU. URI received two first-place votes and VCU received one.
- » For the preseason Atlantic 10 All-Conference teams, grad student Jenna Giacone was named First Team while fellow grad student Erin Whalen was named Second Team. Sophomore Tenin Magassa was named Third Team while grad student Araion Bradshaw was named All-Defensive Team.
- » UD's roster is made up of three graduate students, two true seniors, two juniors, four sophomores, a redshirt freshman, and two freshmen.

### **SCOUTING THE FLYERS**

Dayton enters the contest with a 7-3 record overall and 2-1 neutral site mark. The Flyers have won four of their last five games, only one of which took place at home.

Head coach Shauna Green is in her sixth season in charge of the Flyers and was named Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year 2020, her second time at UD. She earned her 100th win at Dayton in the regular season final last year.

As a team this year, Dayton is scoring 66.7 points per game and holding opponents to 59.7 points each outing. The Flyers are shooting 39.9 percent overall, 39.3 percent from three point range, and 63.2 percent from the free throw line. UD also benefits from +4.4 rebounding and +1.1 turnover margins.

Dayton is led by sophomore Makira Cook, who is averaging 15.5 points per game, and graduate student Erin Whalen, who is averaging 15.4 points and 6.6 rebounds per game. Fellow grad student Jenna Giacone is another double-figure scoring threat with 12.5 points per game.

# **SCOUTING CLEMSON**

Clemson finishes up its pre-holiday break slate with a 6-5 record on the season and 0-1 neutral site mark. The Tigers have played just two games away from home since Nov. 17, both losses at Syracuse and No. 21 LSU.

Head coach Amanda Butler is in her fourth season with Clemson, but has 16 years of head coaching experience and 276 career wins.

This season, Clemson is averaging 65.1 points per outing and giving up 65.4 points to opposing squads. The Tigers are shooting 38.5 percent from the field, 23.9 percent from behind the arc, and 66.5 percent from the charity stripe. Clemson is outrebounding opponents by a +4.6 margin and committing fewer turnovers.

The Tigers are led by Delicia Washington with 12.5 points and 7.2 rebounds per game in 11 starts. Kiara Lewis is chipping in 10.2 points and 3.8 boards each outing, also starting all 11 contests.

# **LAST TIME OUT**

Dayton started off its second Florida tournament with a 71-64 victory over High Point Monday, holding off a late Panther rally. Erin Whalen had a team-high 26 points and hit eight threes, the second most in program history.

# THE SERIES

Dayton and Clemson have met twice previously with both teams holding one victory each. In the last meeting back in 2007, the Flyers won at home 81-43.

# STATISTICAL RANKINGS

Dayton ranks 18th nationally in fewest turnovers per game and 20th in three point field goal percentage. Individually, Tenin Magassa is 46th in the country in blocked shots per game while Makira Cook is 56th in Division I in field goal attempts.

# SHOUP HILL NAMED A-10 ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Freshman forward Brynn Shoup-Hill was named A-10 Rookie of the Week on Dec. 6 for her efforts in wins over Florida A&M and Illinois St. The Goshen, Ind. native had a breakout performance with a career-high 14 points, going 4-of-4 from three and 2-of-2 from the free throw line along with three rebounds in the win Sunday. She finished the week with an 8.5 points per game average and only missed one shot over the two-game stretch last week, both wins for the Flyers.

### COOK EARNS ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM HONORS AT DAYTONA BEACH INVITATIONAL

Sophomore guard Makira Cook was named to the All-Tournament Team as well as Player of the Game in the win over Illinois, capping off a productive weekend at the Daytona Beach Invitational. Cook averaged 18.5 points, 2.5 rebounds, and 2.0 assists per game without committing a turnover and shooting 46.2 percent from three.

# FLYERS FAVORITE IN PRESEASON POLL

Dayton was picked to as preseason favorites after winning the A-10 regular season in 2020-21. The Flyers received 11 first-place votes and were selected ahead of Rhode Island, Fordham, Saint Louis, and VCU.

# **PRESEASON HONORS**

The Atlantic 10 released its preseason all-conference teams and recognized four Flyers ahead of the upcoming campaign. Grad student Jenna Giacone was named First Team while fellow grad student Erin Whalen was named Second Team. Sophomore center Tenin Magassa was named to the Third Team and grad student Araion Bradshaw picked up All-Defensive Team accolades.

# FLYERS DOMINATE IN EXHIBITION

The Flyers had one preseason game this year on Nov. 5 at home where they defeated IUP 83-46. Dayton had five players in double-figures scoring and shot 61.2 percent from the field, higher than any total the previous season.

# FLYERS IN REGULAR SEASON LEAGUE PLAY

Dayton has won 126 of its last 153 regular season Atlantic 10 games (.824), a streak that dates back to a 97-46 win over Rhode Island on Jan. 7, 2012, and includes a perfect 14-0 mark in conference play during the 2012-13 season.

# **BRADSHAW NAMED A-10 WOMAN OF THE YEAR NOMINEE**

The Atlantic 10 Conference chose its NCAA Woman of the Year nominees and selected University of Dayton graduate student Araion Bradshaw as one of the two representatives. Bradshaw is the point guard with the women's basketball program and entering her fifth year at UD this fall. The Boston, Mass. native has helped lead the Flyers to four A-10 Championship titles. Bradshaw is a graduate student with a bachelor's degree in civil engineering, master's in engineering management, and working on her master's in business management.

Off the court, she has been just as impactful. She started the Athletes Driving Change organization that is a group of minority A-10 women's basketball players focused on the mission to "promote permanent change toward equality through the voices of Atlantic 10 female athletes using a unified and inclusive platform." She earned the Social Justice Award at this year's R.U.D.Y.S. Banquet for her work on equality and education. Bradshaw is a passionate and vocal leader in the community and has represented the University with the upmost integrity.

# **FLYERS DOMINATE A-10 MAJOR HONORS**

The Atlantic 10 Conference released its end-of-the-season awards the week prior to the tournament and recgonized three Flyers with major awards. Redshirt senior Jenna Giacone was named Most Improved Player as well as First Team All-Conference. Fellow senior Araion Bradshaw took home Defensive Player of the Year accolades as well as Third Team and All-Defensive team. Freshman center Tenin Magassa was named Sixth Woman of the Year and named to the All-Rookie Team. On top of that, redshirt senior Erin Whalen was named to the Second Team and All-Academic team, totaling nine awards for the Flyers.

# **FLYERS CLINCH SIXTH A-10 TITLE**

After going 12-1 in the regular season, the Flyers clinched their sixth overall regular season league title and second straight. It was also the fourth in five years under head coach Shauna Green.

# **WE'VE GOT AN AUDIENCE**

On Dec. 5, 2019, the Flyers played in front of 10,554 fans at UD Arena while hosting Morehead State. The record-breaking crowd was due to the overwhelming success of UD's annual School Day game, a chance for local school-aged children to take a field trip with the Flyers. It was the fourth largest crowd for a NCAA women's game that year and biggest in program history.

# OFF TO A HOT START

Dayton has found much success under Coach Green in the month of January, going 34-2 in her first five seasons as head coach of the Flyers. That includes going undefeated in four of her five seasons.

Dayton has hit at least one three-point shot in 631 consecutive games dating back to Jan. 2, 2001, the longest streak in the Atlantic 10 Conference and one of the top streaks in the nation. The Flyers made a program-record 15 three-point field goals against Buffalo in the Connecticut World Vision Classic on Nov. 25, 2011. Dayton tied the record with 15 vs. Wright State on Nov. 28, 2012.

# APPLEWHITE RETURNS TO DAYTON, JOINS STAFF

Head coach Shauna Green announced the addition of Olivia Applewhite as an assistant coach.

Applewhite joins the Flyers after spending the past five seasons at Atlantic 10 rival Saint Louis University where she served as assistant coach and prior to that, director of operations/ video coordinator and graduate assistant. She has been responsible for post-player development including guiding Kendra Wilken to Most Improved Player and Third Team All-Conference honors in 2019-20, as well as helping Brooke Flowers earn All-Defensive Team and Third Team All-Conference in 2020-21. In 2020, Applewhite was also named to the prestigious WBCA Thirty Under 30 Honoree list.

Applewhite returns to her alma mater Dayton ('13) where she played four years with the Flyers and was a part of four NCAA tournament appearances. The forward out of Forestville, Md. capped off her stellar career earning Atlantic 10 Sixth Woman of the Year honors in 2013. She also served as team captain and still ranks in the Top 15 all-time in games played in program history with 121 appearances. She received her master's degree in student personnel administration in her time at SLU after earning her bachelor's degree in public relations and minor in marketing at UD. Applewhite went on to play three seasons professionally overseas in France, Ireland, and Denmark, each season leading her team, and twice the league, in rebounding. After finishing up her playing career, she enter the coaching field and joined SLU as a graduate assistant.

Dayton women's basketball head coach Shauna Green is entering her sixth season in charge of the Flyers' program.

After overcoming obstacles from the pandemic during the 2020-21 season, the Flyers were able to clinch their sixth Atlantic 10 regular season title after going 12-1 in conference play. Dayton was 14-5 on the season overall and earned the top seed in the 2021 A-10 Championship in Richmond, Va. The Flyers advanced to the WNIT for postseason play and clinched their 14th straight postseason appearance. Numerous individuals earned A-10 season awards, including three major accolades. Redshirt senior Araion Bradshaw was named A-10 Defensive Player of the Year as well as Third Team and All-Defensive team. Fellow redshirt senior Jenna Giacone was named A-10 Most Improved Player as well as First Team honors. Freshman Tenin Magassa earned A-10 Sixth Woman of the Year honors and was named to the All-Rookie team. Redshirt senior Erin Whalen rounded out the awards earning Second Team and All-Academic team accolades.

In her fourth season in charge in 2019-20, Green earned Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year honors for the second time and led the Flyers to both the regular season and tournament titles in the conference, the second sweep in program history, both coming under Coach Green's leadership. Dayton earned the automatic bid to the NCAA tournament for the A-10 and finished the year 25-8. The Flyers rode a 15-game winning streak and did not lose a conference game, pushing the senior class' mark to 35-1 in home A-10 games in their career. Dayton had a trio of players recognized by the A-10 with Jayla Scaife earning First Team and All-Defensive team honors, Erin Whalen named Second Team and All-Academic, and Araion Bradshaw joining the All-Defensive team as well. Scaife and Kyla Whitehead were All-Tournament Team also.

The 2018-19 season saw the Flyers make their 11th straight postseason appearance as Dayton advanced to the first round of the WNIT Tournament, UD finished the season with a 17-14 record overall and a 10-6 Atlantic 10 mark. The Flyers were victorious in the first round and quarterfinals of the A-10 Tournament before eventually falling in the semifinals. During the season, senior Lauren Cannatelli rewrote the records books, sweeping single game, season, and career marks for made three pointers and three pointers attempted. She was named second team all-conference and all-academic while junior Jayla Scaife earned first team honors.

Coach Green was named the 2018 Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year after guiding the Flyers to the outright A-10 regular season championship and another NCAA Tournament berth. The Flyers finished the season with a 23-7 record overall, a 15-1 conference mark, and a 12-1 home record. Dayton led the A-10 in home attendance and boasted a 16-game winning streak from Dec. 21 to Feb. 21. Green also received the Forty Under 40 Award by the Dayton Business Journal for industry leaders in the Dayton community in May.

In Green's first year at the helm of the Flyers, she made Dayton women's basketball history by guiding UD to its first ever sweep of regular season and tournament titles in the Atlantic 10 Conference. She received WBCA National Rookie Coach of the Year honors after leading the Flyers to a 22-10 record, 13-3 A-10 mark, and a berth in the NCAA Division I Tournament. Dayton's season ended in a hard-fought loss to No. 5 seed and eight-time National Champion Tennessee at the KFC Yum! Center in Louisville on March 18.

In her previous stint at Dayton from 2012-2015, Green contributed to the success of the Flyers and made an impact on the current state of the program. In 2012-13, Dayton won 28 games, tying the most wins in the modern era of the program. The Flyers followed that up in Green's final season, 2014-15, with another 28 wins, a sixth-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance, and the program's first Regional Final. Two student-athletes from that team were drafted in the 2015 WNBA Draft - Ally Malott to the Washington Mystics and Andrea Hoover to the Los Angeles Sparks. Hoover ranks fourth all-time on Dayton's scoring list while Malott ranks seventh.

In just one year at Northwestern, Green helped numerous studentathletes earn athletic and academic accolades. Junior guard Nia Coffey earned WBCA All-America and All-Region honors while eight Wildcats were named Academic All-Big Ten. Junior guard Ashley Deary was named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year and All-Defensive Team as well.

Green also has a previous coaching stint at Providence College. With the Friars, she served as recruiting coordinator which carried over to the same role at Dayton. Green was responsible for recruiting many of the current players on the Flyer team.

A 2002 graduate of Canisius, Green received a degree in business marketing. She went on to earn a master's degree in physical education with an emphasis in athletic administration from Loras. Green and her husband, Andy, have one son, Matteo.
