### **OPENING TIP**

#### **CLEMSON-NORTHWESTERN**

- This will be the fourth meeting all-time between the two teams, with Clemson holding the 2-1 edge in the series, winning the last two meetings.
- Coach Butler has never faced Northwestern as the head coach of the Tigers but once while at Florida and is 0-1 all-time against Northwestern.

#### **CLEMSON AGAINST THE B1G**

- Clemson is 13-14 all-time against teams from the Big Ten, including just one meeting against Maryland since joining the Big Ten on July 1, 2014.
- The game against Northwestern will be the second game this season against a team from the Big Ten, having faced Penn State on Nov. 21. The Tigers won that game 67-64.
- The Tigers are 4-5 in B1G/ACC Challenges. See results on page 7.

#### **ALLIANCE MENTAL HEALTH INITIATIVE**

- The ACC, Big Ten, and Pac-12 announced a joint initiative entitled "Teammates for Mental Health," designed to raise
  awareness about the importance of mental health and wellness among their more than 27,000 student-athletes.
- This initiative builds upon the work all three conferences continue to dedicate toward mental health, including the creation of dedicated task forces and cabinets comprised of mental health professionals on campuses at the 41 world-class institutions that comprise the ACC, Big Ten, and Pac-12.
- The Alliance's Teammates for Mental Health initiative includes a public service announcement (PSA) featuring
  women's and men's basketball head coaches and the commissioners from all three conferences. The 30-second
  PSA will air on ESPN, ACC Network, Big Ten Network, and Pac-12 Network, as well as on conference-owned digital
  and social media channels.

#### ACC, BIG TEN & PAC-12 ANNOUNCE ALLIANCE

On Aug. 24, the ACC, Big Ten, and Pac-12 announced a historic alliance that will bring 41 world-class institutions together on a collaborative approach surrounding the future evolution of college athletics and scheduling. The alliance – which was unanimously supported by the presidents, chancellors, and athletics directors at all 41 institutions – will be guided in all cases by a commitment to and prioritization of supporting student-athlete well-being, academic and athletic opportunities, experiences, and diverse educational programming. 

#### **IMPORTANT TO NOTE**

- Clemson's 31 points in the 2nd quarter against Columbia were its most in any quarter since moving to the format in 2015
- The Tigers made six field goals and 18 free throws on their way to scoring the 31 points.
- The Tigers scored 30 points in the first quarter of the game against Mount St. Mary's on Nov. 28, and that was the most points scored in the first quarter for Clemson since the NCAA moved to quarter play during the 2015-16 season.

#### WIP BEING WIP

- They say that the only constant in life change, but this is not the case with WIP (Work in Progress) as Delicia Washington picked up where she left off as a leader for the Tiger.
- Washington leads the team in points (15.5), rebounds (7.7), and assists (2.6). She is also averaging 2.1 steals per game.
- Recorded a season-high 23 points against North Florida
- She has recorded two double-doubles this season in games against Penn State on Nov. 21 (15 points and 12 rebounds) and against North Florida on Nov. 24 (23 points and 11 rebounds)
- She is ranked 3rd in the ACC in field goal attempts and 7th in field goals made.
- She has scored in double-figures in five of the six games she has played in this season.

#### **ELLIOTT COMING INTO HER OWN**

- Tigers sophomore Gabby Elliott is starting to gel for Clemson after scoring a season-high 19 points in the win over Penn State on Nov. 21.
- Elliott has scored in double figures in three games so far in the season.
- She is currently averaging 11.4 points per game.

#### **KIKI THE MENACE**

- Kiki Lewis is making her presence known early in the season, averaging 12.0 points, 5.2 rebounds, 2.3 steals per game, and 2.3 assists.
- Lewis recorded a career-high 11 rebounds in just her second game as a Clemson Tiger against Columbia on Nov. 14.
- Lewis has scored double figures in back-to-back games (11 against Penn State on Nov. 28 and 14 against North Florida on Nov. 24).
- Lewis is ranked 4th in the ACC in steals per game.

#### NUNU A'INT NU NO MO'

- Daisha "NuNu" Bradford averages 9.3 points per game and 4.0 rebounds per game for the Tigers.
- In her first game against Upstate on Nov. 10, NuNu scored a game-high 16 points shooting .875 percent (7-for-8) from the floor and was a perfect 2-for-2 from beyond the arc.
- Shot .857 percent from the floor, making 6-of-7 shots taken.

#### **OWNING THE PAINT**

- Clemson has scored 220 points in the paint at this point in the season.
- This is added to the fact that the Tigers have also scored 119 points off opponents' turnovers.
- They have also scored 75 fast breakpoints.

#### LEWIS NAMED TO MEYERS-DRYSDALE WATCH LIST

- Lewis has been named one of 20 candidates for the 2022 Ann Meyers-Drysdale Award. The annual award recognizes the top shooting guard in women's NCAA Division I college basketball in its fifth year.
- Lewis, a graduate transfer for the Tigers, is a native of Chicago, Ill., who came to Clemson after playing for Syracuse. Last season, she started in 24 games for the Orange, earning All-ACC honorable mention accolades, and scored doubledigit scoring 16 games while averaging 14 points a contest.
- Lewis is averaging 12.0 points per game, 5.2 rebounds, 2.3 steals per game, and 2.3 assists.

### **TOUGH SLATE**

- The Tigers have a tough season ahead of them, facing an earlyseason road game at South Carolina and playing a strong Penn State team just four days later. In early December, the BIG10/ ACC Challenge sees the Tigers in a match-up with an outstanding Northwestern team, followed by contests with local teams Presbyterian and Wofford.
- The Tigers wrap up non-conference play with LSU and Dayton at the West Palm Beach Invitational in late December and slug it out with an always-challenging ACC schedule for the remainder of the season.

#### **TIGER TAILS**

- Coach Butler is 18-6 in home non-conference games as the head coach of the Tigers.
- Clemson will play its sixth of 17 home games when they welcome Northwestern to Littlejohn Coliseum.
- This will be the fourth meeting all-time between the Tigers and the Wildcats.
- This will be the second meeting for Coach Butler against Northwestern.
- Tigers are now 4-1 at home this season trying to protect Littlejohn.

#### **TIGERS AGAINST RANKED TEAMS**

- The Tigers start the season scheduled to play six teams ranked in the preseason Top 25.
- Clemson has faced the #1 ranked team in the nation in South Carolina on the road in a tough outing.
- The Tigers are still scheduled to play NC State, Louisville, Florida State, and Georgia Tech, all currently ranked.

#### **TIGERS SIGN THREE TO 2022 CLASS**

- Clemson women's basketball head coach Amanda Butler and her staff announced the addition of Tadassa Brown (Lansing, Mich./ Columbia Central HS), Ale'jah Douglas (Omaha, Neb./Western Nebraska CC), and Ruby Whitehorn (Detroit, Mich./Detroit Edison Public Academy) to National Letters of Intent (NLI) to join Team 48 and begin to play for the Tigers in 2022-23.
- This year's signing class is ranked 19thby the All-Star Girls Reports (ASGR) and 18th in the JR All-Star 2022 National class rankings.
