VS. CLEMSON (HOLIDAY HOOPSGIVING) DECEMBER 11, 2021

•After trailing by 11 points early in the second half, Drake rallied to defeat Omaha, 78-70 for its first road victory of the season on Wednesday (Dec. 8).

•Senior forward ShanQuan 'Tank' Hemphill was named a candidate for the prestigious men's basketball Senior CLASS Award.

•Freshman swingman Tucker DeVries scored a career-high 24 points at Omaha and made a career-best five shots from beyond the arc.

He responded to his first collegiate start with his previous career-high of 21 points as Drake topped St. Thomas, 74-64 on Sunday (Dec. 5).

DeVries, the son of coach Darian DeVries, scored 21 points and grabbed eight rebounds in 34 minutes -- all highs in his young career. He scored the first two points of the game for Drake. Late in the second half with Drake clinging to a 54-49 lead DeVries scored the Bulldogs' next nine points in a 3:02 span.

•Drake guard Roman Penn, a first-team all-conference performer who led the MVC in assists last season (5.5 avg.) will be sidelined indefinitely after suffering a small fracture in his left foot. Penn missed Drake's final seven games of last season with a similar injury.

•Center Darnell Brodie's best game of the season and a timely steal by Tucker DeVries in the final minute helped Drake open Missouri Valley Conference play with the victory over Valparaiso, breaking a three-game losing streak.

It was the earliest Drake has ever played a Valley game and the Bulldogs won it with contributions up and down the lineup along with some solid defense at key stretches. Drake never trailed after scoring nine straight points to open a 17-12 lead.

•Drake is ranked No. 9 in the latest men's basketball CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll.

DRAKE HEAD COACH DARIAN DEVRIES

Darian DeVries, the 2018-19 and 2020-21 Missouri Valley Conference Coach of the Year, is in his fourth season as the head coach of the Drake men's basketball program.

In his first three seasons, the Bulldogs won 70 games, to tie for the most of any three-year period in school history and just the second time the program has recorded three-straight 20-win seasons.

DeVries guided Drake to its fifth NCAA Tournament appearance in school history in 2020-21 with the Bulldogs recording their first NCAA Tournament victory in 50 years when they beat Wichita State, 53-52, in the First Four game. Drake's 26-5 record was the second best in school history.

Of the eight 20-win seasons in program history, three have come under DeVries, including 24 wins in both 2018-19 and 2020-21 to tie for the third-most in program history. In 2020-21 he also tied a school record with 15 MVC wins.

During his second season he guided the Bulldogs to the program's second-straight 20-win season which marked the first time since 1971 the program had won 20 or more games in consecutive seasons and just the third time it had occurred in program history. Nearly a third of the Bulldogs' 20-win seasons have come under DeVries' leadership.

The 2019-20 season ended in the MVC Tournament semifinals for the second-straight season as the Bulldogs clipped No. 1 seed UNI in the quarterfinals to become the first No. 8 seed to upend a No. 1 seed in tournament history.

That team set a school record for blocks in a season with 132, surpassing the mark of 130 set in his first season. Additionally, the 2019-20 team's 237 three-pointers were the eighth most in season. The team recorded 279 three-pointers in his first season at the helm, the fourth-most in Drake history.

The longtime assistant from Creighton took the reins of the Bulldog program in March, 2018, and inherited a roster with just one returning starter and three returning contributors. He quickly assembled a talented roster and let that squad to its first regular-season Missouri Valley Conference title since 2008 and the program's 12th all-time postseason appearance.

Under his guidance, the Bulldogs led the Valley in scoring at 75.4 points per game to rack up 24 wins and record the program's sixth 20-win season and third most wins in school history.

DeVries' first recruiting class at Drake included a junior college All-American, graduate transfers with all-conference pedigrees, a 7-footer and in-

ternational talent. That roster eventually earned eight All-MVC honors, including MVC Defensive Player of the Year Nick McGlynn.

His first team began the season by winning the Continental Tire Las Vegas Classic to conclude the non-conference schedule with a 12-4 record before amassing a 12-6 mark in conference action.

Before taking over the Bulldogs' program, DeVries was an assistant coach at Creighton University for 17 years and spent 20 total seasons on staff with the Bluejays. During that span, he helped guide the Bluejays to 19 postseason appearances and 12 NCAA Tournament berths.

DeVries was one of the longest-tenured men's basketball assistant coaches at one school in the nation and assisted the Bluejays in their fifth NCAA Tournament appearance in the last seven years before earning the Drake position. During his time on the Creighton staff under both Dana Altman and Greg McDermott, the program accumulated a record of 460-211 and 231-129 in conference games.

Under his guidance, Creighton had 15 first-team all-conference selections, six conference Players of the Year, three Newcomers of the Year, three Freshmen of the Year and three Defensive Players of the Year. CU has also had six All-American honorees in that time, including Doug McDermott, the first player in 30 years to be named a First Team All-American by the AP in three straight seasons.

DeVries had an extensive background in the Valley as a starter at UNI under coach Eldon Miller. DeVries was twice an MVC Scholar-Athlete Team selection. The two-time UNI captain led the Panthers in three-point shooting three years and converted on 44 percent of his attempts as a senior with 3.1 assists per game.

DeVries was a standout athlete in high school at Aplington-Parkersburg (Iowa), and in the spring of 2015 was inducted into the IHSAA Hall of Fame for his playing prowess. The oldest of five siblings, DeVries' family boasts a tremendous academic pedigree with all five competing collegiately. His brother, Jared, was an All-American on the football team at the University of Iowa and was a 12-year member of the Detroit Lions, while another brother, Dusty, also played football for the Hawkeyes. His youngest brother, Jay, played football at Wartburg College and his sister, Jodi, was a Second Team All-MVC selection in volleyball at Northern Iowa.

Darian and his wife, Ashley, have one son, Tucker, who is a freshman swingman for the Bulldogs and one daughter, Tatum.

SCOUTING CLEMSON

•Clemson is coming off an 80-75 loss in its ACC opener at Miami on Saturday (Dec. 4) following a loss at Rutgers in the Big Ten-ACC Challenge (74-64) on Nov. 30. The Tigers led the Hurricanes, 70-61 with 5:02 remaining before surrendering the lead.

•Sophomore center PJ Hall paces Clemson with a team-high 13.9 points per night while hauling 5.4 rebounds per game. Junior guard Nick Honor has a team-best 33 assists and averages 11.2 points per game.

THE SERIES

•This will be the first-ever meeting between Drake and Clemson in men's basketball.

•It also will be the first test for the Bulldogs against an Atlantic Coast Conference team since beating Wake Forest, 77-74, in the opening round of the Virgin Islands Paradise Jam Nov. 17, 2017.

GEORGIA ON MY MIND

•Surprisingly, this will mark the first time Drake has ever played a basketball game in the state of Georgia.

•However, Drake has played four schools from the state of Georgia: Georgia, (1973,1983); Georgia Southern (1988, 2006, 2008), Georgia State (2009), and Kennesaw State (2019) but the games were either played in Des Moines or neutral sites.

REGION CONNECTION

•Five current Bulldogs hail from the portion of northwestern Indiana near Gary colloquially called 'The Region.'

•**D.J. Wilkins** (Merrillville), **Jonah Jackson** (Merrillville), **Tremell Murphy** (Griffith), **Shanquan Hemphill** (Gary) and **Roman Penn** (Calumet City, Ill.) all grew up within an approximately four-mile radius of each other.

•The five continue a long tradition of Bulldogs from The Region that includes Gary, Ind., natives **Willie McCarter** and **Dolph Pulliam** who were captains from the Bulldogs' 1969 tNCAA Final Four team which narrowly lost to the Lew Alcindor UCLA Bruins, 85-82, in the semifinal round before whipping North Carolina, 104-84, in the third-place game.

•Drake is averaging 9.9 offensive rebounds, reaching double figures in six of nine games so far.

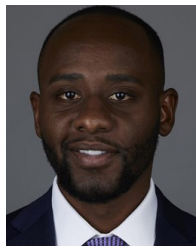
•The Bulldogs tied a season high with 13 offensive rebounds in its 73-66 Missouri Valley Conference opening win against Valparaiso.

ON THE BENCH



MARTY RICHTER

A native of Waterloo, Iowa, and a Simpson College graduate, Richter joined the Drake staff after two extremely successful seasons as the head coach at Florida SouthWestern State College. At Florida SouthWestern State College, he amassed a record of 56-10 in two seasons. His last season, the Buccaneers went 30-3, were ranked as high as No. 2 in the NJCAA poll and were one win away from advancing to the final four of the national tournament.



ACHOKI MOIKOBU

Joined the staff in June of 2021 after a serving on the Grand Canyon staff where he helped the Antelopes to the 2021 Western Athletic Conference title and first NCAA Tournament appearance. Before joining program at GCU, he spent the previous six years as postgraduate head coach at Sunrise Christian Academy in Bel Aire, Kan., where he coached 28

future Division I players, including current Bulldog D.J. Wilkins. The Seattle, Wash. native played at Fort Hays State where he made 91 three-point baskets in two years, shooting 47.7%.



MATT GATENS

Prior to joining the Bulldogs, he was on staff at Auburn. He was a four-year starter at guard for Iowa where he scored 1,635 career points, the sixth most in Iowa history, and averaged

12.8 points per game while averaging 2.3 rebounds per game. He was just the second Iowa player to record 1,600 points, 450 rebounds, 250 assists and 125 steals in a career.

DRAKE #1 IN PRESEASON MVC POLL

For the first time on record, Drake was picked as the preseason favorite in the Missouri Valley Conference men's basketball race by a voting panel consisting of coaches, sports information directors and the media. Drake received 29 first-place votes and 411 points. Loyola earned 363 points, including eight first-place votes, to finish second in the poll followed by UNI, Missouri State, Southern Illinois, Bradley, Valparaiso, Evansville, Indiana State and Illinois State. Drake's previous high ranking in a league pre-season poll was in 1988-89 when the Bulldogs were picked to finish third that season.

- Drake's **Roman Penn** was named to the first team preseason all-MVC team with **ShanQuan Hemphill** named to the second team.
- Drake was well represented on the list of 2020-21 MVC accolades with five Bulldogs collecting 15 total honors.

- ShanQuan Hemphill was the third Bulldog to earn Newcomer of the Year honors and first since 1995 when B.J. Windhorst earned the honor. Curt Smith previously did in 1993.
- Joseph Yesufu was the first Bulldog to earn Sixth Man of the Year honors.
- ShanQuan Hemphill was joined on the All-Newcomer team by Darnell Brodie to mark the first time Drake has had two members of the All-Newcomer team.
- Drake has also had a selection to the All-Newcomer team three-straight years. It is just the second-time that has occurred in program history and first since 1999-01.
- Garrett Sturtz and Joseph Yesufu were named to the All-Bench team, giving Drake two selections to the team in four straight seasons.
- Joseph Yesufu's inclusion on the Most-Improved Team marked the fourth-straight year a Bulldog had been on the team.

GRUMPY OLD MEN

Drake started the season with a roster whose average age was at 21.82 (believed to be the second-oldest behind Eastern Kentucky at 22.02). Notably, Drake's starting 5 averages 24.06.

- Five players are currently working on their Master's degrees in communications at Drake: **Ayo Akinwale, ShanQuan Hemphill, Jonah Jackson, Tremell Murphy** and **Roman Penn**.

MURPHY RISES TO OCCASSION

- Forward **Tremell Murphy** is enjoying a solid final campaign for Drake, leading the team in scor-

ing (12.1) and three-point field goal percentage (.438), while ranking second in field goal percentage (.531) and rebounding (5.9).

- He has led the team in scoring in four of the nine games played so far including season highs of 18 in back-to-back games against Richmond and Belmont.
- He's the only Drake player to reach double figure scoring in seven games.
- Murphy scored 18 points, including four three-pointers, along with seven rebounds and one blocked shot in Drake's 73-70 victory past Richmond, which was picked to finish second in the Atlantic-10 Conference preseason poll.
- He needs just one three-point basket to equal his entire combined output of 18 three-point baskets made during his first two seasons at Drake in 2018-19 and 2019-20..
- Murphy has made three or more three-point baskets in three games this season, including three treys in Drake's 78-70 win at Omaha Wednesday.

CLOSE BUT NO CIGAR...

• Drake's performance at the ESPN Events Invitational was deceptive during Thanksgiving weekend.

—Drake owned a 62-61 lead against Belmont with 4:58 left but then missed its next six shots during a stretch of 4:11. Belmont responded with the 11-0 run, to grab a 71-62 advantage it never relinquished.

—Drake owned a five-point lead against No. 10 Alabama in the second half and the score was tied at 61-61 with 5:16 left before the Bulldogs would only make four baskets to close out the game, while also missing three free throws.

—Drake saw two shots come up short in the final 10 seconds against North Texas. Trailing 55-54, the Bulldogs had two opportunities to take the lead in the waning seconds but Tremell Murphy had a shot blocked with 10 seconds left. Then following a Drake time out with eight seconds remaining the Bulldogs' Tucker DeVries missed a three-point shot from half court with two seconds left.

Earlier, Murphy's layup with 48 seconds remaining had given Drake its last lead of the game at 54-53. North Texas came back to grab the lead for good at 55-54 on two free throws by Bell with 23 seconds left and then Adam Scott sealed the victory adding two more free throws with 1.8 seconds.

- Drake entered the three-game ESPN Event Invitational averaging 86.3 points, while shooting nearly 50 percent from the floor (.497) and making 11.3 three-point baskets per game but in the three games in Orlando, the Bulldogs averaged 64.7 points, while hitting at a 44.6 percent clip and averaging 5.3 treys.

FRESHMAN SHINES

- Freshman swingman **Tucker DeVries**, who was named Iowa's Mr. Basketball after guiding Waukeet High School to the 2021 Iowa state championships, has made his presence known. He leads the team in three-point baskets made (22) and blocked shots (seven) and ranks first on the team in scoring (13.3).

- He came off the bench to collect 11 points, six rebounds, two assists and one steal against Richmond. DeVries helped Drake rally from a 58-51 deficit with six minutes left by scoring five points in a 10-4 run. He also drew a charging foul which led to a Drake basket. Then with Drake clinging to a 72-70 lead, DeVries had a key offensive rebound

off a missed free throw and was fouled with five second left sinking a free throw to account for the final margin.

TANK GEARS UP

- After averaging just 6.3 points in Drake's first three games, forward **ShanQuan (Tank) Hemphill**, is starting to regain his all-conference form. He is averaging 11.8 points in his last five games, while shooting 54.7 percent from the floor (23-42).
- Hemphill, named to the 2021 MVC All-Newcomer and All-Defensive teams, missed the last nine games of the 2020-21 regular season after fracturing his left foot Feb. 11. He led Drake with a 13.6 scoring average last year.

PENN MOVES UP ASSISTS LIST

- **Roman Penn** ranks No. 4 on the Drake career assists list with 351. Next on the list at the No 3 spot is Stephfon Butler who had 378 assists from 198-85.
- In his first year as a starting guard at Drake in 2019-20, the Siena College transfer dished out 192 assists which ranked No. 2 on the Drake single-season list, trailing only the school-record 192 assists by All-American Adam Emmenecker in 2007-08.

A GOOD DECEMBER

- Drake has been particularly strong in the month of December under head coach Darian DeVries.
- During the past three seasons, Drake is 23-3 in the month of December with the only losses coming to Iowa State (2018), No. 14 Dayton (2019) and at Bradley (2019).
- Drake's nine wins in December of 2020 were the most in the month by a team since 2011-12 when St. Mary's and Southern Miss won nine December games.

DEVRIES CLIMBING WINS CHART

- Drake head coach Darian DeVries' 75 wins are already the seventh most in Drake history despite ranking 12th in total games coached.
- The 76 wins over the last three-plus seasons are the most in any three year-plus period in school history
