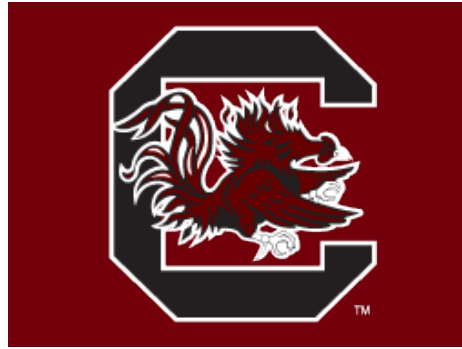

TIPOFF NOTABLES

> South Carolina scored the most points in the Frank Martin era and its most points in a game since 1995 (won 112-61 vs. The Citadel on 12/21/95) in a 110-51 victory vs. Allen (Dec. 14); the 15 players suited up for Carolina each scored in the game; Brandon Martin had his first career double-double with 10 points and 11 rebounds - he also had a career-high five assists; the Gamecocks dished out 31 assists total, the second best mark in program history (school record is 33 in win over Georgia Southern in 1976).

> Rookie guard Devin Carter matched his career high with 16 points, and he pulled down a team best seven rebounds, while graduate student guard James Reese V scored 13 - all in the second half - as South Carolina overcame a 16-point first-half deficit to post a 66-65 win over Florida State on Dec. 12 at the No Room For Racism Classic in Rock Hill.

PROBABLE GAMECOCK STARTERS (BASED ON PREVIOUS GAME)

















> Following his standout performance in the win over FSU, Devin Carter earned his first-career SEC Freshman of the Week award on Monday, Dec. 13

> Carolina posted a convincing 80-67 win over Georgetown at Colonial Life Arena Dec. 5 in non-conference action. The Hoyas never led in the contest, and the Gamecock defense held Georgetown to just 32.9 percent (23-70) from the floor.

> The Gamecocks fell 80-56 in their first true road contest of the season at Coastal Carolina on Dec. 1. CCU led for the majority of the first half, before the Gamecocks pulled to within one at halftime, however, the Chanticleers out-scored Carolina 44-21 in the second half to capture the non-conference win.

> The Gamecocks trailed for the majority of their contest with Rider at Colonial Life Arena on Nov. 28, but a 3-pointer from senior forward Keyshawn Bryant tied the contest at 36-all with 12:30 to go, and Carolina was able to maintain its lead the remainder of the game to close the 65-58 non-conference win.

> Carolina captured a big win over visiting Wofford on Nov. 23 at Colonial Life Arena, posting an 85-74 victory over the Terriers. Senior guard Erik Stevenson had his best performance this season, hitting nine field goals, including five 3-pointers, en route to a 25-point performance. His six rebounds were also a team best.

> Rookie guard Devin Carter was clutch at the free throw line, hitting all four of his attempts in the final five seconds of play to clinch a 66-63 Gamecock win over visiting UAB at Colonial Life Arena on Nov. 18. The Blazers, who are the preseason pick to win C-USA this season, battled back from a 16-point deficit to make it a one-point game with a minute remaining in the matchup, but Carter sank all four of his attempts late in the contest to secure the Carolina win.

> Following its first loss of the season, Carolina rebounded with a 75-64 victory over Western Kentucky on Nov. 14 in its final contest at the inaugural Asheville Championship. Junior guard Jermaine Cousnard and rookie guard Devin Carter led Carolina with 16 points each, and graduate student guard James Reese V tallied a season high 14 points behind four makes from 3-point range.

> The Gamecocks suffered their first loss of the season on Nov. 12, falling 66-62 to Princeton. Carolina struggled from the field, hitting just 36.2 percent overall, and just 15.4 percent (4-26) from 3-point range. Princeton made 11 3-pointers in the win.

> Junior forward Wildens Leveque posted the

first double-double of his career with a dominant 12-point, 10-rebound performance vs. Princeton on Nov. 12. Leveque, who was 6-of-6 from the field, played 32 minutes of action, including 18:52 of the second half. Four of his rebounds were on the offensive end.

> The Gamecocks improved to 84-30 all-time in season openers when they posted a 78-60 victory over USC Upstate in the 2021-22 opener on Nov. 9 at Colonial Life Arena. Junior guard Jermaine Cousnard and junior forward Wildens Leveque led the Gamecocks with 14 points each, while Cousnard dished out a game high seven assists in the win.

> Head coach Frank Martin is in his 10th season leading the Gamecocks. He is assisted by associate head coach Chuck Martin (fifth season), assistant coaches Will Bailey (second season) and Brian Steele (first season), and the director of operations is Andy Assaley (10th season).

> South Carolina posted a 101-76 exhibition win vs. Benedict on Nov. 4. James Reese V led all scorers with 21 in the contest.

> The 2021-22 campaign is the 20th season of basketball at Colonial Life Arena. The facility opened just prior to the 2002-03 campaign.

> South Carolina returns three of its top five scorers from a season ago, including senior forward Keyshawn Bryant (14.4 ppg), junior guard Jermaine Cousnard (10.1 ppg) and junior forward Wildens Leveque (6.1 ppg).

> The Gamecocks welcome nine newcomers to the team this season, including a trio of freshmen in Devin Carter, Ta'Quan Woodley and Jacobi Wright. Six transfers are also set for their first season at Carolina in Chico Carter Jr. (Murray State), Josh Gray (LSU), Brandon Martin (USC Upstate), James Reese V (North Texas), Erik Stevenson (Washington) and AJ Wilson (George Mason).

BREAKING DOWN THE DEFENSIVE NUMBERS

16.1

> South Carolina ranks 61st nationally, forcing 16.1 opponent turnovers per contest. That mark is sixth in the SEC. All ten of Carolina's opponents this season have committed at least 14 turnovers.

37.3%

> Carolina is ranked second in the SEC and 15th nationally, holding opponents to just 37.3 percent from the field. The Gamecocks have held seven of the team's 10 opponents below 40 percent shooting this season.

5.3

> Carolina ranks sixth in the SEC with 5.3 blocks per game, which ranks 31st nationally. Senior forward Keyshawn Bryant paces the Gamecocks with 1.8 blocks per game this season.

DID YOU KNOW?

> First-year assistant coach Brian Steele is one of 28 assistants nationally who are 30 or younger. Steele just turned 28 on Nov. 10. A three-year letterwinner for the Gamecocks on the hardwood (2012-15), Steele saw action in 50 career games in the Garnet and Black, with four starts. After knee injuries dotted his first three seasons on the court, Steele opted to serve as a student assistant coach during the 2015-16 campaign. He did the same during the historic 2016-17 season that saw Carolina reach the Final Four, and then was a graduate assistant manager the following year.

BY THE NUMBERS

3,018 - South Carolina's six incoming transfer student-athletes combined to score 3,018 points during their college careers prior to joining the Gamecocks, led by Erik Stevenson's 826 career points.

212 - AJ Wilson saw action in 114 games during his career at George Mason. As a junior, Wilson set GMU's all-time record for blocks in a single season with 92, and he concluded his career as the school's all-time record holder in the category with 212 blocks.

87.3% - James Reese V entered action this season having hit 62 of his 71 career attempts at the foul line, 87.3 percent. Reese was 15-of-16 (93.8%) at the line as a freshman at Buffalo, 23-of-24 (95.8%) as a junior at North Texas, and he was 24-of-31 (77.4%) at the free throw line for the Mean Green last season.

:52 - Junior guard Jermaine Couisnard almost gave the Gamecocks the winning edge vs. Princeton on Nov. 12, as the East Chicago, Ind., native hit a trio of 3s in the final 52 seconds of play to twice pull the Gamecocks to within three of the Tigers.

12/10 - Junior forward Wildens Leveque posted the first double-double of his career with 12 points, and a game high 10 rebounds vs. Princeton (Nov. 12). Leveque was 6-of-6 from the floor, including a pair of highlight reel dunks in the matchup.

69.5% - Leveque is 41-of-59 from the field so far during the 2021-22 season, good for nearly 70 percent

8-for-8 - Rookie guard Devin Carter was a perfect 8-of-8 from the free throw line in the win vs. WKU (Nov. 14). He had 16 points, dished out a team high four assists and also had eight rebounds.

16 - Carter's 16 points against the Hilltoppers and his 16 points in the comeback win vs. Florida State (Dec. 12) were a career high.

32 & 45 - Carolina made 32 field goals against Georgetown (Dec. 5), then a season high, and followed that up with 45 made shots vs. Allen (Dec. 14), the most ever in the Frank Martin era.

20 - The Gamecocks dished out 20 assists in the win over the Hoyas, the most since posting 20 in a road win at Georgia last season (Feb. 27, 2021).

31 & 59 - Carolina had 31 assists in the win over the Yellow Jackets, the most in the Frank Martin era and second most in program history. The team also had 59 rebounds, which was the most in the Martin era by six.

10/11 - Senior forward Brandon Martin had his first career double-double in the blowout win vs. Allen; he had 10 points, 11 rebounds and a career high five assists.

7 - South Carolina has held seven opponents below 40 percent shooting this season.

33.9% - During the team's current three game-win streak, the Gamecocks have held opponents to 33.9 percent shooting (62-for-183).

37.3% - South Carolina has limited opponents to just 37.3 percent shooting this season, the 15th best FG percentage defense in the country (2nd in SEC).

110 - Carolina's 110 points vs. Allen (Dec. 14) were its most since 1995.

15 - 15 different Gamecocks scored in the Allen win, including five players in double figures: D. Carter (12), Leveque (12), Green (11), Bryant (10) and Martin (10).

14.8 - Carolina is averaging 14.8 offensive rebounds per game this season, good for second in the SEC and 14th nationally.

Frank Martin was named the head men's basketball coach at the University of South Carolina on March 27, 2012, becoming the 32nd head coach in the history of the South Carolina program, which enters its 113th season as a varsity sport in 2021-22. Martin owns a 270-188 (.589) overall record as a head coach, entering his 15th season overall, and a 153-134 (.533) record entering his 10th season at South Carolina. Martin was named the 2017 Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year after leading the Gamecocks to the best season in school history during the 2016-17 campaign, as the squad advanced to the program's first Final Four and recorded a school record 26 wins.

Prior to his appointment in Columbia, Martin spent the previous five seasons as the head coach at Kansas State University, leading the Wildcats to the NCAA Tournament four times, including a trip to the Elite Eight, during the 2009-10 campaign when the squad won a school record 29 contests.

Prior to his time on the sidelines in the college ranks, Martin spent 15 years in high school coaching in Miami, Fla., including the last seven as a head coach.

A native of Miami, Fla., Martin earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Florida International in 1993. He and his wife, Anya, have three children, Brandon, a senior on the men's basketball team at Carolina, Amalia and Christian.

COLUMBIA (AP) - Jermaine Cousnard scored 14 points and made seven assists, Wildens Leveque also scored 14 points with eight rebounds and South Carolina defeated USC-Upstate 78-60 Tuesday night.

Bryson Mozone scored 20 points and Jalen Brazale added 17 to lead USC-Upstate, which was outrebounded 52-34.

The Spartans made a run early. Mozone hit a 3-pointer, lifting USC-Upstate into a 6-4 lead, and added two more from distance as he and Jordan Gainey scored 16 points to fashion a 17-8 lead by 12:59 of the first half.

The lead lasted for less than two minutes as South Carolina reeled off the next 10 points, controlling the offensive glass to keep possession.

The larger, stronger Gamecocks were never in jeopardy the rest of the way. They scored 20 points off 20 Upstate turnovers and dominated the offensive glass, 17-3.

The Gamecocks are 84-30 in season openers, rebounding from last season's season-opening loss to Liberty.

ASHEVILLE - South Carolina (1-1) suffered a 66-62 loss to Princeton (2-0) in its opening contest at the Asheville Championship on Friday night. The Gamecocks will face Western Kentucky (1-1) on Sunday at 5 PM in their final matchup at the Harrah's Cherokee Center.

Junior forward Wildens Leveque was a perfect 6-of-6 from the field, en route to 12 points, and he matched his career high with 10 rebounds for the first double-double of his career. Junior guard Jermaine Cousnard led all scorers with 17 points, and senior guard Erik Stevenson added 14 for Carolina.

Princeton would use strong shooting from 3-point range in the win, hitting 11-of-31 attempts from beyond the arc, compared to just four makes from 3 from the Gamecocks.

Carolina held a 19-9 upperhand with 11:38 to go in the first half before Princeton would close the opening 20 minutes of play on a 22-6 run to hold a 31-25 upperhand at the half. Cousnard would tie the contest at 33-33 early in the second half, and a pair of free throws from Stevenson with 9:46 to play would give the Gamecocks a slight 44-43 advantage.

Strong outside shooting, and makes at the foul line had the Princeton lead at 56-50 with 3:58 to play. Princeton held a 61-53 advantage with under a minute to play before Cousnard would hit his first of three 3s in the final 52 seconds of play to bring the Gamecocks within five at 61-56. The Tigers would make one free throw at the opposite end on the next play, but Cousnard would answer, hitting another 3 to bring Carolina within three at 62-59 with 36 seconds to play.

After more Tiger free throws, Cousnard would sink another 3 to bring the score to 65-62 with 8.4 seconds to play, but Princeton's Drew Friberg would collect the inbounds pass and be fouled, and he would seal the 66-62 Tiger win at the free throw line.

ASHEVILLE (AP) - Jermaine Cousnard hit a clutch 3-pointer to blunt a Western Kentucky rally, finishing with 16 points, and South Carolina held off the Hilltoppers 75-64 in the consolation game of the inaugural Asheville Championship on Sunday.

Devin Carter also scored 16 for the Gamecocks (2-1) and James Reese scored 14 points, draining four 3-pointers.

Carter, who finished 8-of-8 at the line, made six-straight free throws and Erik Stevenson added a drive off a steal and a 3-pointer as South Carolina broke open a three-point game with an 11-1 run at the midpoint of the second half.

Western Kentucky (1-2) never led halftime but kept whittling South Carolina's leads down to one possession. After the surge by Carter and Stevenson eventually led to a 15-point Gamecocks advantage, the Hilltoppers scored eight in a row to trail 68-61 with 3:28 to go.

That's when Cousnard rattled home a corner 3, sparking a 9-4 breakaway to get the lead back to 15.

South Carolina had its best showing of the young season from beyond the arc, making 9-of-27. The Gamecocks are 16-for-69 from deep in three games.

Josh Anderson scored 16 points to lead four Hilltoppers into double-figure scoring. Jarius Hamilton added 13 with three steals, Dayvion McKnight 11 with four steals and Jaylen Butz scored 10 with three steals.

COLUMBIA (AP) -- Wildens Leveque scored 12 points in 11 minutes of play and South Carolina overwhelmed NAIA-member Allen University 110-51 on Tuesday night.

It was the largest margin of victory for South Carolina since a 53-point (108-55) win over Furman during the 1967-68 season. The Gamecocks, who had not scored 100 points in a game since the 2007-08 season, have done it twice this season. They improved to 48-1 all-time when topping the century mark.

Leveque sank 5 of 6 shots from the floor for the Gamecocks (8-2), who shot 54% overall. Devin Carter came off the bench to contribute 12 points, seven rebounds and four assists. Reserve Brandon Martin finished with 10 points, 11 rebounds and five assists, while Mike Green hit three 3-pointers and scored 11. Keyshawn Bryant had 10 points.

Carter scored nine points in the first half as the Gamecocks took a 51-22 lead into intermission. South Carolina topped 100 on Green's 3-pointer with 3:31 remaining in the game. The Gamecocks finished with 31 assists - the second best in school history. South Carolina had 33 assists in a win over Georgia Southern in 1976.

Jaylen Green led the Yellow Jackets with 12 points, while Andre Baker scored 11.

South Carolina dominated the boards 59-20 and out-scored Allen 60-14 in the paint. The Yellow Jackets made just 20 of 62 shots (32.3%).

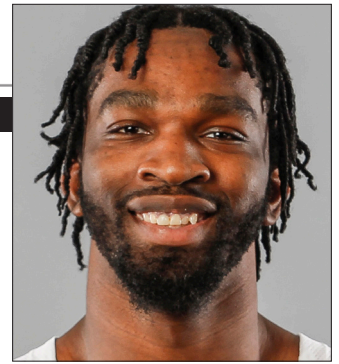

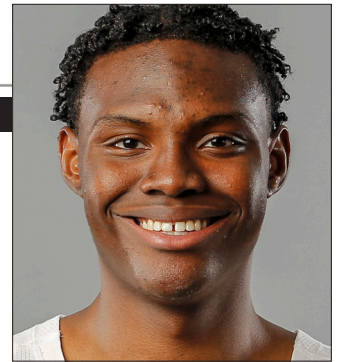

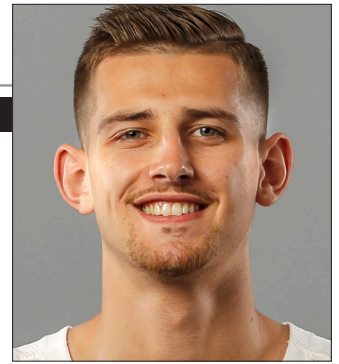
