THE OPENING TIP

- » Northwestern opens December with the BIG/ACC Challenge at Clemson on Thursday night. Tip-off is set for 7 p.m. CT at Littlejohn Coliseum on ACCN.
- » The Wildcats are looking for their second straight win in the challenge after defeating Boston College 66-63 in 2019. The 'Cats helped the Big Ten pull off their first ever win in the challenge by a 9-5 score.
- » NU is coming off a 1-2 trip at the Paradise Jam in the U.S. Virgin Islands. The 'Cats earned a quality win against South Dakota, the Summit League preseason favorites, but fell to Pitt and No. 12 Texas A&M.
- » NU has been without senior guard Sydney Wood since the second half of the DePaul game. She remains out for Thursday's contest.
- » The Wildcats have seen their youth thrown into the fire through seven games, with first-years Jillian Brown, Melannie Daley and Caleigh Walsh all making significant contributions.
- » Senior guard Veronica Burton has continued her elite play at point guard, averaging 17.4 points, 5.7 assists, 5.3 rebounds and 4.0 steals. Per Her Hoop Stats she ranks 13th in total win shares nationally.
- » Clemson leads the all-time series 2-1 and won the last meeting 69-68 in the BIG/ACC Challenge in 2009. The Tigers are off to a 4-2 start this season.

AMERICA'S POINT GUARD: Veronica Burton spent the early portion of her offseason with USA Basketball as a roster selection for the FIBA AmeriCup. Coached by Dawn Staley and Adia Barnes, the team was composed of the top rising juniors and seniors around the country, including Big Ten counterparts Naz Hillmon, Grace Berger and Ashley Owusu. Burton started every game at point guard as the USA claimed a gold medal in Puerto Rico.

THE BACKCOURT BURGLAR RISES: Veronica Burton has earned a slew of preseason accolades, starting with a selection to the 10-member All-Big Ten Preseason Team. She was selected to the Nancy Lieberman Award Watch List as one of 20 of the top point guards in the sport. She also was selected to watch lists for three national player of the year awards - the Wooden Award, the Naismith Trophy, and the Wade Trophy. Burton is the reigning two-time Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year after leading the country in steals last season.

THE LEGEND OF VB12: Burton started her senior season with a strong all-around performance vs. UIC but stole the show with a halfcourt buzzer beater right before halftime. It was the third play of its kind in her career after she hit two halfcourt shots before halftime in her rookie season in 2018-19 in back-to-back games against Illinois and Minnesota.

In terms of general buzzer beater/clutch plays, Burton has three from her sophomore season that stand out: her floater to send the Marquette game to overtime, her pass to Pulliam to win at Minnesota, and her and-one layup to tie the game late at Indiana.

THE POINT GODDESS: Burton has been on fire to start the season, averaging 17.4 points, 5.7 assists, 5.3 rebounds and 4.0 steals on 42% from deep, and 90% from the free throw line. She ranks 24th in the country in assists per game and fourth nationally and first in the Big Ten in steals per game.

COURT IS IN SESSION: Senior forward Courtney Shaw has been on a tear to start the season, averaging a double-double through seven games. She is averaging a career-high 11.4 points and 10.9 rebounds, the latter of which ranks third in the Big Ten. Her defense has been stellar as well with a career-high five steals against the Gauchos. Her average of 2.1 steals per game ranks fifth in the conference.

WINTER IS COMING: Northwestern's blizzard has been especially active this season, with the Wildcats holding three of their opponents under 50 points and limiting the high-flying Blue Demons to 14 points below their scoring average. The Wildcats rank 30th nationally in steals per game (11.7) and 12th in blocks per game (6.6). Both marks lead the Big Ten

A SECTION ON REJECTION: Northwestern is averaging 6.6 blocks per game, the most in the Big Ten and the 12th most in the country. Courtney Walsh leads the Big Ten with 2.2 per game. The most blocks the 'Cats have averaged per season since at least 2014-15 was in that season with 5.9 per game.

BLIZZARD TO AVALANCHE: Joe McKeown's patented Blizzard defense wreaked havoc on opposing backcourts last season and picked up this season right where it left off. The 'Cats ranked 12th in the country in turnovers forced per game (20.9) in 2020-21 and are forcing 20.6 per game through seven games this season. They use those turnovers to jumpstart their offense and are averaging 21.3 points off of turnovers.

THE SWISS ARMY KNIFE: Sydney Wood was named to the 2021 Big Ten All-Defensive team by the coaches and was an honorable mention 2021 All-Big Ten selection by the media. She ranked second in the conference in steals per game and averaged a career-best 11.1 points per game on 51.2% shooting from the field, the fourth best mark in the conference. Her fingerprints were all over the UIC game, with nine defensive rebounds, five assists, and three steals.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: The Wildcats reloaded with an incoming class – Jillian Brown, Hailey Weaver, Caleigh Walsh, Melannie Daley and Mercy Ademusayo – ranked No. 10 in the country by ESPN. Here's what they said about the class:

"This could be coach Joe McKeown's deepest class ever. Weaver [No. 35] and No. 50 Jillian Brown are two quality perimeter players whose skill sets complement each other. No. 56 Caleigh Walsh is a stretch 4 player who is learning the value of physicality in the paint. The Wildcats have two four-star prospects: [Mercy] Ademusayo, who has elite height and length, and Melannie Daley, an under-the-radar prospect who has serious game as a three-level scorer."

All five Wildcats have appeared so far with Walsh and Brown starting every game and averaging 8.4 and 8.7 points per game, respectively.

BAG ALERT: Head Coach Joe McKeown received a contract extension through the 2024-25 season from Combe Family Vice President for Athletics and Recreation Dr. Derrick Gragg in October. McKeown led the Wildcats to their first NCAA Tournament win in over 25 years and their first Big Ten Championship in 30 years. He is the second winningest coach in Northwestern history with 233 wins at NU, 28 wins behind Don Perrelli.

POP TO THE TOP: Kate Popovec was elevated to associate head coach in the offseason in her fifth year on the staff. Popovec was an assistant coach from 2017-2021, and before she spent a year as an assistant at Colgate, she was the Director of Player Development from 2014 to 2016. She played for Northwestern for two seasons from 2011 to 2013.

O CAPTAIN MY CAPTAINS: Northwestern's captains for the 2021-22 season are seniors Veronica Burton, Sydney Wood and graduate Lauryn Satterwhite. Between the three of them, they have 239 games of experience.

RECORD ESOTERICA: Northwestern is 1-0 on Thursdays this season, defeating South Dakota on Thanksgiving. They are 3-2 at night, 0-2 in purple, and 0-1 on the road after falling at DePaul. The 'Cats are 6-6 in BIG/ACC Challenge games under Joe McKeown, last winning on the road against North Carolina in 2015.

HISTORICAL REDUX

UNDISPUTED: The Wildcats graduated program GOAT Lindsey Pulliam, who scored over 2,000 points in her career. She finished 2021 with a spot on the All-Big Ten second team, giving her four All-Big Ten selections in four years, including two first team selections in 2019 and 2020. The only other Wildcats to earn four All-Big Ten selections are Amy Jaeschke and Nia Coffey. Pulliam was drafted by the Atlanta Dream in the WNBA Draft and now plays overseas in Turkey.

THE BACKCOURT BURGLAR: Veronica Burton was named the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year for the second straight season. Burton becomes the fifth player in conference history to have won the honor twice, along with fellow Wildcat Ashley Deary in 2016 and 2017. She was additionally named one of four finalists for the Naismith Women's Defensive Player of the Year on Monday.

Burton lead the nation in steals per game with 3.8. She has led the Big Ten in steals per game for three seasons in a row.

Burton ranks second all-time in Northwestern history in career steals with 277 as a junior, and is 50 steals off of the top ten career list in the Big Ten. With 96 steals last season, she posted fifth most steals in a season in program history, and now has three entries on that list in three seasons, with two of her seasons being shortened due to COVID-19 (2019-20 and 2020-21).

Burton is seventh on the active career leaderboard in NCAA Division I, with the six players in front of her all seniors. Burton has reached her mark of 277 in just 86 games while the next lowest games played total in the top ten is 111. Burton's career steals per game average of 3.24 ranks third out of all active NCAA players, and she is the only junior on that top ten list.

DANCING KING: Joe McKeown made the 19th NCAA Tournament appearance of his career in 2021, which was tied for sixth most among head coaches in the year's 64-team field, behind legends of the sport Tara VanDerveer (Stanford), C. Vivian Stringer (Rutgers), Geno Auriemma (UConn), Gary Blair (Texas A&M) and Bill Fennelly (Iowa State). At George Washington, McKeown's teams advanced to four Sweet 16s.

COAAAACH: Head Coach Joe McKeown won 2020 Big Ten Coach of the Year, as selected by coaches and media, becoming the first Wildcat to win the honor since Don Perelli did so in 1990. He helped guide the Wildcats to their first Big Ten Championship since 2020. He finished as one of three finalists for the Naismith Trophy Women's College Coach of the Year, along with Adia Barnes (Arizona) and Kelly Graves (Oregon).

THE BACKCOURT BURGLAR BEGINS: Veronica Burton won Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year in 2020, marking the third time in five years that a Wildcat has won the award after Ashley Deary did so in 2016 and 2017. Burton ranked ninth in the country and first in the Big Ten with 3.3 steals per game. She also finished with 100 steals on the season, the third best single-season total in program history, behind Deary's two best seasons.

MR. 700: Head Coach Joe McKeown earned his 700th career win against East Carolina on Dec. 20, 2019. He became the 13th active head coach at the time in NCAA Division I to pass this milestone and the fourth coach in the Big Ten. He also earned his 200th career win at Northwestern against Michigan on Jan. 30, becoming just the second coach in program history to do so after Don Perelli.

WHATEVER IT TOOK: Northwestern won five postseason games in 2018-19 to advance to the finals of the WNIT, before falling to the Arizona Wildcats ... This tied the 'Cats' best finish in the tournament in program history with their run to the NWIT final in 1996, when they also faced Arizona.

A former Wildcat student-athlete, Kate Popovec started her career as an assistant coach for the Northwestern women's basketball team in 2017. In the spring of 2018, Popovec was named both the Recruiting Coordinator and the Defensive Coordinator.

As the recruiting coordinator, Popovec oversees all facets of recruiting organization. She helped bring in the Class of 2024, featuring Paige Mott, Anna Morris and Jasmine McWilliams. Morris is a five star recruit with scout's grade of 96 according to ESPN, ranking 11th at her position and in the top-50 overall for her class.

Preston Reid joined the Wildcat coaching staff in 2018. During his first season, Reid helped the team reach the championship game in the WNIT.

Reid primarily works with Northwestern's guards and handles scheduling for the program. In his time with the program, Reid has helped grow one of the best backcourts in the Big Ten, featuring Lindsey Pulliam, Veronica Burton, Sydney Wood and Jordan Hamilton.

Pulliam was an All-Big Ten selection in Reid's first season and earned a selection to USA Basketball in the summer of 2019 to play in the Pan-Am games, where the squad won a silver medal. After the Big Ten Championship season in 2019-20, Pulliam was a unanimous selection to the All-Big Ten First Team. In the 2021 WNBA Draft, Pulliam was the 27th overall pick, going to the Atlanta Dream. She now plays overseas with Elazig Il Özel Idare.

Reid coached at Akron for six seasons, spending two years as a graduate assistant before moving up to assistant coach in 2014. He helped lead the Zips to the MAC Tournament semifinals in 2016 and mentored Akron senior Sina King in her campaign for Mid-American Conference MVP and All-America Honorable Mention in 2015. During his time as an assistant, the Zips made two appearances in the WNIT tournament.

He earned a master's degree in 2014 in sport science and coaching from Akron.

One of the most accomplished WNBA players in history, Tangela Smith joined the Wildcats as an assistant coach for the Northwestern women's basketball team in 2018.

Smith's primary responsibilities for the Wildcats is post player development as well as the overall skill development of the team. In her first season with the Wildcats, she helped to develop the post play of Pallas Kunaiyi-Akpanah who went on to play professionally in Italy. Kunaiyi-Akpanah also represented her home country, Nigeria, in the 2020 Olympics, as well as winning the FIBA Women's AfroBasket with the Nigerian National team in 2021.

Smith was the No. 12 overall pick by the Sacramento Monarchs in the 1998 WNBA draft. In her WNBA career, she played for the Sacramento Monarchs, Charlotte Sting, Phoenix Mercury, Indiana Fever, and San Antonio Silver Stars. The Chicago native became just the seventh player in WNBA history to record 4,000 career points during her 15-year career.

She also won 2 WNBA Championships for the Phoenix Mercury and was selected as a WNBA All-Star while playing for the Charlotte Sting. She retired from the WNBA in 2012, ranking in the top-10 in history in points, rebounds, blocks, field goals made, field goals attempted, and minutes played. On Friday, August 13, 2010, she became the WNBA's all-time leader in games played with 411 in 13 seasons. In the WNBA offseason, Smith played professional basketball in several countries such as Italy, Israel, South Korea, Turkey, China, Hungary, Poland and many more. She won 3 championships in Turkey, China and Korea while playing overseas.

Smith, a standout student-athlete at The University of Iowa, came to Chicago's Big Ten Team after spending four seasons on the sidelines at Western Michigan following an outstanding WNBA career.

While at Iowa, Smith was named Big Ten Player of the Year in 1998 and was a first team All-Big Ten pick in 1996 and 1998. She led the Hawkeyes to Big Ten championships in both of those seasons and a conference tournament title in 1997. She finished her collegiate career ranked first in school history in blocks, third in rebounds, and seventh in scoring.

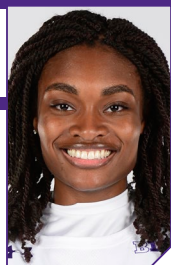

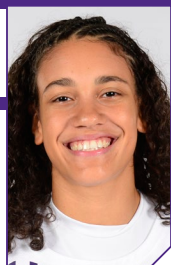
