BOSTON COLLEGE VS. CLEMSON - ALL-TIME SERIES

- Today's game marks the 27th meeting between the two schools.
- BC is 7-19 all-time against Clemson, dating back to 1975-76.
- In ACC regular season play, BC is 6-13 against Clemson.
- Clemson has won the last nine games in the series.
- It is BC's longest active losing streak versus an opponent.
- BC and Clemson did not meet in in 2020-21 due to COVID-19.
- The Tigers took the last meeting - 82-64 - on Feb. 22, 2020 at Conte.
- Head coach Earl Grant was an assistant at Clemson from 2010-14, helping guide the Tigers to an NCAA Tournament and a trip to the NIT.
- Assistant coach Anthony Goins was on Brad Brownell's staff the previous two seasons, including a trip to the 2021 NCAA Tourney.
- Brevin Galloway's younger brother Braden was a member of Clemson's football team, starring as a tight end.

BOSTON COLLEGE IN ACC REGULAR SEASON PLAY

- Boston College is 92-183 in 16+ seasons in the ACC.
- BC won its ACC opener, 73-57, at home vs. Notre Dame.
- In 2019-20, BC was 7-13 in ACC play, finishing 10th.
- It marked the most ACC wins since the 2017-18 season and was the seventh time since 2005-06 that BC had at least seven ACC wins.
- BC's best ACC mark came in its inaugural season, going 11-5 in conference play in 2005-06 en route to a third place finish. BC tied for third in 2006-07 (10-6) and was fourth in 2010-11 (9-7).

CAREER NIGHT FOR QP VERSUS GEORGIA TECH

- Quinten Post scored a career-high 24 points - against Georgia Tech. Post scored 18 of his 24 in the second half.
- The 7-footer from Amsterdam connected on 10-of-14 shots from the floor. The 10 FG are the most by a BC player in 2021-22.
- Post also corralled a season-best nine rebounds in the Georgia Tech game, while dishing out two assists.
- His previous career-high was 14 points, set in the season opener against Dartmouth.
- Between 2020-21 and this season, Post is averaging +6.6 points and +3.2 rebounds per game.
- Percentage-wise, Post and is shooting +8.0% better from the floor and +15.0% better from the free throw line.
- Post ranks fourth on BC in scoring (9.2 ppg) and second in rebounding (5.3 rpg) this season.

GAINS BEYOND THE ARC - WITH AND WITHOUT BREVIN GALLOWAY

- Boston College's 239 3FG attempts are the lowest (15th) in the ACC and its 17.1 3FG attempts per game rank 14th.
- Through 14 games, the Eagles rank 13th in 3FG made per game (5.9 3FGM) and ninth in 3FG percentage (.343).
- BC has seen significant gains in its long-distance shooting with graduate transfer guard Brevin Galloway in the lineup.
- In the seven games with Galloway, here are BC's 3-point stats: 140 3FGA (20.0 per game), 7.0 3FGM/g, .350 3FG%
- In the seven games which Galloway missed: 99 3FGA (14.1 per game), 4.7 3FGM/g, .333 3FG%.

TODAY'S BOSTON COLLEGE NOTE(S) YOU CAN'T LIVE WITHOUT

- Boston College is visiting two straight opponents - at Clemson and at Louisville - for the first time in three seasons.
- Only Quinten Post has faced Clemson before in his career - two scoreless minutes last season while at Miss. State.
- Jaeden Zackery is posting a team-best effective FG% of 57.9% with only 43.9% of his shots coming at the rim.

ON THIS DATE: JANUARY 15

- Boston College is 9-11 all-time - and 2-2 in ACC play - in games played on the January 15 calendar date.
- January 15 also marks the dual celebration of National Bagel and National Strawberry Ice Cream Days.
- Several notable events in history occurred on January 15 - **1535** - Henry VIII declares himself head of the Church of England; **1759** - Voltaire's "Candide" is published anonymously; **1892** - **Dr. James Naismith publishes the rules of basketball in Triangle Magazine at Springfield College**; **1919** - two million gallons of molasses floods the North End of Boston, killing 21; **1951** - SCOTUS rules that "clear & present danger" of incitement to riot is not protected speech.
- Notable January 15 birthdays: civil rights pioneer Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.; former NFL quarterback Drew Brees; actress Regina King; Saint and French heroine Jeanne D'Arc; playwright Moliere; hockey trophy namesake Lord Stanley.

GALLOWAY HEATING UP

- Brevin Galloway scored a season-high 18 points against Georgia Tech on Jan. 12, knocking down 7-14 FG (4 3FG).
- It was his first four 3-pointer game of the season - and the third instance where the grad transfer made at least three 3FG.
- It marked his second consecutive game in double-figures, tallying 11 points at Pittsburgh on Jan. 8.
- In only seven games played, Galloway ranks second on the team in 3-pointers made - 16.

COBRA KAI - EFFICIENT PERFORMANCE AT PITTSBURGH

- At Pitt, Makai Ashton-Langford put forth one of the most efficient performances by a point guard in the nation in 2021-22.
- Ashton-Langford finished the game with 23 points (4 3FGM), 3 rebounds, 4 assists (1 turnover), 1 block, and 3 steals.
- His EFF rating ($PTS + REB + AST + STL + BLK - Missed\ Shots - TO$) was a team-best 24, while his offensive rating was 133.8.
- The 23 points - and four 3-pointers made - were new career-highs for the 6-3 point guard.
- He is one of only two players to post that statistical line on the box score this season (A.J. Walker of Air Force).
- Dating back to 1996-97, Troy Bell was the only Boston College player to post at least those totals in a single game.
- Bell did it twice - Jan. 11, 2003 against Syracuse and Jan 29, 2003 versus Virginia Tech.
- Among all ACC players since 1996, eight players have registered those totals in a single game.
- They are (in chronological order): Coby White (UNC) vs. Virginia Tech; Dennis Smith Jr. (NCST) vs. McNeese; Angel Rodriguez (Miami) vs. Duke; Lamar Patterson (Pitt) vs. Texas Tech; Tim Pickett (FSU) vs. UNC; Mike Dunleavy Jr. (Duke) vs. NC State; Shane Battier (Duke) vs. N.C. A&T. Four of those eight performances came in an ACC game.

FIRST TIME IN TWO SEASONS FOR THE NEXT TWO (AND FOUR STRAIGHT)

- Boston College's game against Clemson is the fourth of four straight games against ACC opponents that the Eagles did not face during the COVID-19 shortened 2020-21 season. *Note research courtesy of BC radio pxp Josh Maurer.*
- Due to pauses in the schedule due to coronavirus breakouts, BC missed games vs. UNC (Feb. 1, 2021), Pittsburgh (Jan. 23, 2021), Georgia Tech (Feb. 17, 2021), and Clemson (Jan. 27, 2021) last season.

RARE COMPANY ON REBOUNDED PERCENTAGE LIST

- Boston College is one of 14 teams nationally to rank among the top 60 in both offensive and defensive rebounding percentage.
- BC ranks 18th in DReb% (77.0) and 56th in OReb% (32.6) nationally - and rank second in the ACC in both categories.
- The other schools to rank in the top 60 in both categories: Boise State, BYU, College of Charleston, Gonzaga, Illinois, Kentucky, Mississippi State, Purdue, Stanford, TCU, Texas Tech, UCLA, and UNC Greensboro.

ZACKERY MAKING AN IMPACT

- Jaeden Zackery ranks third on BC in scoring (10.7), second in assists (2.7), and first in steals (1.5) so far this season.
- *Among all ACC first-year players, Zackery is one of five players to average double figures in scoring. He ranks fifth in scoring, second in assists, and third in steals among ACC newcomers.*
- He has reached double-digits nine times and has led the Eagles in scoring on four occasions.
- The Salem, Wisc. product has registered an effective FG% of 57.9% and a true shooting percentage of 60.2% in 14 games.
- Zackery is connecting on 52.6% of his 3-point attempts on the season, knocking down 20-of-38.
- **He is one of four players nationally to shoot better than 52% from 3FG (20 3FGM min).**
- He was named to the Sunshine Slam All-Tourney team, after scoring a season-high 19 points against Rhode Island.
- The 6-2 guard added 15 points (3-4 3FG) vs. Utah the night before in the semifinal round of the Sunshine Slam tourney.
- In three Sunshine Slam games: 15.7 points, 2.7 rebounds, 2.7 assists, 1.7 steals, 64% (16-25) FG, 63.6% (7-11) 3FG.
- Earlier this season, he became the first BC freshman to dish out at least six assists in consecutive games in nearly a decade.
- In 2012-13, Boston College's Joe Rahon had six dimes against Providence (12/21/12) and Holy Cross (12/29/12).
- Zackery was a 2020-21 NJCAA Third Team All-American out of Chipola College in Florida.

ASHTON-LANGFORD'S JOURNEY CONTINUES

- Makai Ashton-Langford enters his fourth season of college basketball in 2021-22.
- He leads the Eagles in scoring, at a career-best 11.8 points per game - a nearly +3.0 improvement from a season ago.
- At Pittsburgh, the grad student poured in a career-high 23 points, making 7-of-14 shots - including 4-of-6 from the outside.
- The 6-3 guard scored 16 of his team-high 18 points in the second half at Saint Louis.
- Ashton-Langford ranks 11th in the ACC in assists (3.5 apg), eighth in FT% (.792), and eighth in assist/turnover (1.88:1).
- The Worcester product has tallied double digits in the scoring column in 11 of BC's 14 games in 2021-22.
- In games where he grabs at least four rebounds and dishes out four assists, BC is 4-1 in 2021-22.
- Last season, he posted career-high averages in scoring (9.6 ppg), rebounding (3.3), assists (3.2), and steals (1.7).
- Over the final four games of 2020-21, he averaged 13.0 points, 3.3 rebounds, 4.8 assists - one of just two ACC players to post those averages over the final stretch of the regular season.
- This past summer, Ashton-Langford was awarded his undergraduate degree in communications from Boston College.
- He began his college career at Providence, playing 63 games for the Friars from 2017-19.

IF THIS, THEN THAT...

WITH A WIN VS. CLEMSON...

- BC would improve to 7-8 overall and 2-3 in ACC play
- Boston College would end a five-game losing streak
- BC would improve to 1-3 in road games in 2021-22
- The Eagles would capture their first road win since Feb. 8, 2020 - spanning 13 games.
- BC would improve to 8-19 (7-13 ACC) all-time against Clemson, snapping a nine-game slide vs. the Tigers.
- Boston College would move to 1-3 in January
- Head coach Earl Grant would earn his seventh victory at Boston College and his 134th as a collegiate head coach.
- BC would earn win #1,231 all-time dating back to 1904-05 and win #93 in ACC play dating back to 2005-06.

WITH A LOSS VS. CLEMSON...

- Boston College drops to 6-9 overall and 1-4 in ACC play
- BC would drop its sixth straight, dating back to Dec. 13
- The Eagles would fall to 0-4 in road games, posting their 14th consecutive road loss
- BC would move to 8-20 all-time vs. Clemson - the 10th straight loss to the Tigers
- BC would fall to 0-4 in January play
- Boston College would register the 1,054th loss all-time in program history, dating back to the 1904-05 season.

BOO FROM THE WOO - LANGFORD JR. SHINING IN SECOND SEASON

- Through 14 games, DeMarr Langford Jr. is showing no signs of a sophomore slump.
- He helps lead a balanced BC attack, averaging 11.2 points - second on BC - with 4.9 rebounds and 2.3 assists per game.
- He averaged 17.3 points per game while shooting nearly 63.3% (19-30) from the floor in the Eagles' first three wins.
- Langford Jr. scored a career-high 20 points (6-9 FG; 8-8 FT) in 31 minutes vs. Holy Cross.
- The sophomore connected 13 of his first 15 field goal attempts on the season, making his first five shots vs. Holy Cross.
- He opened the season with a 16-point performance vs. Dartmouth, making 8-of-10 shots on the night.
- *Since 1996-97, only 22 Boston College players have shot at least 80% while attempting at least 10 field goals in a game.*
- Last season as a freshman, he averaged 6.7 points and 4.2 boards while adding 1.4 assists, and 1.1 steals per game.
- Langford Jr. - nicknamed Boo by his grandmother - is the younger brother of starting point guard Makai Ashton-Langford.
- On Nov. 26, 2020 vs. Rhode Island, they became the first brothers from Massachusetts to start in the same game for BC.

TRANSFERS WITH SOME EXPERIENCE VS. THE ACC

- T. J. Bickerstaff registered 19 points, five rebounds, and two steals at Pitt last season while at Drexel.
- While at CofC, Brevin Galloway averaged 12.5 points, 2.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists, and 1.5 steals in two games vs. ACC foes.
- In the 2020-21 opener, Galloway scored 15 points - knocking down 3-of-6 from the perimeter - at North Carolina.
- As a junior, Galloway tallied 10 points in a non-conference matchup against Wake Forest.

KARNIK POSTING DOUBLE-DOUBLES

- James Karnik registered his second double of the season against Notre Dame - finishing with 17 points and 13 rebounds.
- Karnik was 8-of-11 from the floor vs. ND, connecting on a 3-pointer. He also had two steals and two blocks.
- The senior from Surrey, B.C. logged 11 points and 11 rebounds in 10 minutes of play in the first half vs. the Irish.
- He had his first double-double in a BC uniform, logging 15 points and 13 boards vs. Rhode Island at the Sunshine Slam.
- Since that game vs. Rhode Island, Karnik is averaging 8.7 points and 6.4 rebounds.
- Prior to that, through the first five games of the season, Karnik was averaging 5.0 points and 2.8 boards.
- He has 14 career double-doubles, dating back to him three seasons at Lehigh (2017-20).

BOARD MAN BICKERSTAFF

- T.J. Bickerstaff tied for the fifth-most rebounds in a game in Boston College history, grabbing 17 boards vs. Columbia.
- The 17 rebounds also rank as the fourth-most in a single-game in Conte Forum history.
- Danya Abrams holds the BC rebounding record, grabbing 20 boards at home vs. Providence on Jan. 22, 1994.
- It was Bickerstaff's second game with at least 15 rebounds - and his third double-digit rebounding game - of the season.
- He registered his first collegiate double-double - 22 points/15 rebounds - and three steals and two blocks at Rhode Island.
- Bickerstaff is one of only four players nationally to have a stat line with at least 22-15-3-2 in a single game.
- The transfer from Drexel is shooting nearly 45% from the floor, including close to 44% from beyond the arc on the season.
- He leads BC and ranks ninth in the ACC in overall rebounding (7.1), including ranking fourth in OReb (2.6).

QUINTEN POST-ING NUMBERS

- Quinten Post is making an impact in his first season for Boston College, 9.4 points and 5.3 boards per game in 14 outings.
- He scored a career-high 24 points - scoring 18 in the second half - on 10-of-14 shooting against Georgia Tech.

- Gianni Thompson - in his first extended action since the Holy Cross game - knocked down two 3FG vs. North Carolina..

- From Nov. 26-Dec. 3, BC limited opponents to 55.3 ppg - the lowest three-game scoring defense mark in over a decade.
- During the 2010-11 season, the Eagles yielded 55.0 ppg over a three-game stretch.
- During that span, BC held No. 19 North Carolina to 48 points, Miami to 73, and Virginia to 44 between Feb. 19-20, 2011.
- Since the 1996-97 season, BC's lowest three-game span of opponent scoring was 48.7 (Feb. 22-March 3, 2004).

THE TALLEST COLLEGE DORM ROOM IN THE COUNTRY

- Justin Vander Baan and Quinten Post are what is believed to be the tallest pair of roommates in America.
- The pair of 7-footers live together on campus - and mark the first time since 2014-15 that BC has two 7-footers on its roster.
- Dennis Clifford and Kyle Caudill were together on the BC roster from 2011-15.
- Prior to that, Nate Doornekamp and Kirsten Zoellner played together from 2001-03.
- Boston College is one of seven schools with at least two 7-footers on its roster in 2021-22. Florida State tops the list, with four.
- According to Google, there are approximately 2,800 7-footers in the world. @BCMBB has two of them.

INSIDE THE METRICS - STYLE OF PLAY (per KenPom)

- Earl Grant-coached teams have shown a strong ability to take care of the ball.
- Through 14 games, BC is averaging 11.7 turnovers per outing - including lows against USF (6), UNC (8), and Holy Cross (9).
- Boston College ranks 70th nationally in fewest turnovers per game (11.8 TO/g) - 2.0 turnovers/game fewer than last season.

- James Karnik registered his first double-double in a BC uniform, logging 15 points and 13 boards vs. Rhode Island.
- Karnik made 5-of-8 shots from the floor while pulling down 13 boards - including four on the offensive glass.
- It marked the 13th career double-double, dating back to him three seasons at Lehigh (2017-20).

BOSTON COLLEGE ANNOUNCES NATIONALLY-RANKED RECRUITING CLASS

- Boston College has secured one of its highest-rated recruiting classes in program history.
- The quartet of Prince Aligbe, D.J. Hand, Chas Kelley, and Armani Mighty - rank 26th nationally as a class per Rivals.com.
- Aligbe is a 6-7, 215 lb. forward from Minnehaha Academy in Minneapolis, Minn. and is a four-star rated recruit.
- He averaged 11.2 points per game as a junior in a program that has featured two of the top prep players in the country over the past two seasons - Jalen Suggs and Chet Holmgren, both of Gonzaga.
- Hand is a 6-5, 180 lb. guard from Landstown H.S. in Virginia Beach, Va. and is also a four-star ranked player.
- One of the top shooting guards in the country, Hand averaged nearly 33 points per game as a junior and was a First Team All-State selection.
- Kelley is a 6-5, 180 lb. guard from Houston who is playing his final prep season at The Phelps School in Malvern, Pa.
- A high three-star rated recruit, Kelley played his first two seasons of prep basketball at Cy-Creek H.S. in Houston, averaging nearly 16 points, five rebounds, five assists, and four steals as a sophomore.
- Mighty is a 6-10, 220 lb. center from Toronto and United Scholastic Academy.
- Born in Jamaica, the three-star rated big man has been playing organized basketball for only three years and shined on the grassroots circuit this past summer with Canada Elite - the country's top AAU program.
- Head coach Earl Grant on his four-player class: *"We believe that we added four high character guys to our program. They are welcome additions and we look forward to seeing the impact they will have in Boston!"*

GALLOWAY DIALS LONG-DISTANCE IN RETURN TO LINEUP

- Brevin Galloway saw 14 minutes of play vs. Columbia, connecting on 3-of-5 from beyond the arc.
- The graduate transfer finished with nine points and two assists.
- He had missed the previous five games due to an injury suffered in the season opener vs. Dartmouth.
- Galloway is a career 335.26% 3-point shooter, having connected on 151 made trifectas in 81 games.

BOSTON COLLEGE SEVENTH-LOWEST PERCENTAGE OF MINUTES RETURNING

- Boston College has the seventh-lowest percentage nationally of minutes played returning for 2021-22.
- Returning BC players accounted for 27.6% of minutes played a season ago.

- He was a finalist for the 2019 Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award, presented annually to a coach who not only achieves success on the basketball court, but who also displays moral integrity off the court.

THE CLEMENT AND ELIZABETH IZZI FAMILY HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



On March 17, Earl Grant was introduced as The Clement and Elizabeth Izzi Family Head Men's Basketball Coach at Boston College. Grant brings an impressive track record to BC after he turned the College of Charleston men's basketball program into a consistent championship contender in the Colonial Athletic Association.

Under Grant's leadership, the College of Charleston was one of only 21 NCAA Division I schools to have players drafted in both the 2019 and 2020 NBA Drafts. Grant led the Cougars to a top-four finish in the CAA in each of the last five seasons, including the 2018 regular season and conference tournament championship.

A finalist for the 2019 Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award, presented annually to a coach who not only achieves success on the basketball court, but who also displays moral integrity off the court, Grant led the Cougars to a memorable run in 2017-18 that included the program's second-straight 25-win campaign, an impressive 26-8 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. The co-regular-season champions earned the No. 1 seed in the CAA Men's Basketball Championship and defeated No. 2 seed Northeastern in an overtime thriller to punch the program's first ticket to the NCAA Tournament since 1999.

Grant is the 13th head coach in Boston College men's basketball history.

"When we began our search for a new head men's basketball coach, we set out to find a leader of young men, someone who shares our vision and our values, who could lead our program to championships while ensuring a world-class student-athlete experience and education for our players," said Kraft. "After a comprehensive national search, it was clear that Earl is exactly what we were looking for and what our basketball program needs at this moment and I am confident he will have tremendous success in Chestnut Hill, on the court and off."

Grant guided the Cougars to three 20-win campaigns and a 67-22 home-court winning record over the previous six years and produced 12 all-conference honorees.

"My family and I are really excited about the opportunity to start a new journey," Grant said. "I look forward to representing such a prestigious academic institution, to coach in the top basketball conference in America, and do it in one of the best cities in the world. I can't wait to meet and develop a relationship with all who have worked so hard over the years to make BC a special place. I am thankful to Pat Kraft, Father Leahy and the Board of Trustees for affording me this tremendous opportunity."

For the first time in program history, College of Charleston's men's basketball was recognized by the NCAA for the 2018-19 academic year. Under the guidance of Grant, the programs' four-year rolling APR was in the Top 10% of all men's basketball programs in the country. The Cougars were one of only 51 men's basketball programs honored nationally. In all, 24 players have gone on to earn their degree at The College.

In 2018-19, CofC posted a 24-9 overall record with non-conference victories over Rhode Island, VCU and Memphis. Two players – Grant Riller and Jarrell Brantley – were named to the All-CAA First Team. Known for their gritty defense, the Cougars led the CAA in scoring defense for the fourth-straight year holding opponents to 68.6 points per game. CofC also ranked No. 17 in the nation in turnovers per game (10.5 avg.) and No. 16 in free-throw percentage (76.4%).

Known as a player's coach, Grant and his staff helped develop Brantley into a 2019 NBA Draft Pick and Riller into a 2020 NBA Draft Pick - the third and fourth-ever College of Charleston players to be drafted. Brantley is currently a two-way player with the Utah Jazz and was named to the 2020 NBA G League First Team and All-Rookie Team as a member of the Salt Lake City Stars. He was second in voting for NBA G League Rookie of the Year honors. Riller was selected in the second round by the Charlotte Hornets giving the Cougars back-to-back NBA Draft picks for the first time in school history.

In 2016-17, Grant led the Cougars to a 25-10 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. It marked the program's first 20-win campaign since 2013. Charleston, seeded a program-best No. 2, advanced to the championship game of the CAA Tournament for the first time since CofC joined the Colonial in 2013. They were also selected and made their fifth all-time appearance in the Postseason NIT. It was their first postseason berth (NCAA or NIT) since 2011.

In his second season with the Cougars, Grant and his staff turned the program into one of the most improved in NCAA Division I and developed four all-conference players including Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year and All-CAA Third Team selection Jarrell Brantley – the first freshman to receive such honors since 2006.

Known as a top recruiter, Grant has shown impressive credentials in both identifying and developing top-flight talent. No stranger to the ACC, he previously spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Clemson under Brad Brownell, where he made a positive impact on the Tiger men's basketball program, both in recruiting and with player development. He worked primarily with Clemson's point guards.

He recruited 2014 first-team All-ACC selection K.J. McDaniels to Clemson, where he ultimately ended up averaging 17 points per game as a junior and was named ACC Defensive Player of the Year, before declaring early for the NBA Draft. McDaniels was selected 32nd overall in the 2014 NBA Draft by the Philadelphia 76ers.

Several Tiger point guards have flourished under Grant's mentoring including incumbent starter Rod Hall. After recruiting the Augusta, Ga., native to Clemson, Grant has seen Hall develop into one of the leaders of the program. During the 2013-14 season, Hall was second on the team in scoring average and ranked among the ACC's top 10 in both assists per game and assist-to-turnover ratio.

In 2010-11, Grant worked with Demontez Stitt, who was named third-team All-ACC and was a member of the All-ACC Tournament Team. That same season, Grant helped Andre Young to an ACC-leading 2.55 assist-to-turnover ratio. Young went on to lead the conference in steals per game as a senior in 2011-12, earning All-ACC Defensive Team honors. He also led the Tigers in scoring under Grant's direction.

Clemson put together strong team results with Grant in the fold as well. In 2013-14, the Tigers went 23-13 overall and recorded a 10-win improvement from the previous season. Clemson advanced to the NIT semifinals and was 10-8 during the ACC regular season.

In Grant's first season in 2010-11, Clemson put together a 22-12 overall record and 9-7 league mark in the ACC. The Tigers earned the No. 4 seed at the ACC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals in Greensboro, N.C. Clemson also went to a fourth-consecutive NCAA Tournament and won its first-round game over UAB, 70-52, in Dayton, Ohio.

Clemson was strong defensively in four seasons with Grant part of its coaching staff. In 2010-11, the Tigers ranked No. 24 nationally in scoring defense. In 2011-12, Clemson yielded just 60.6 points per game to the opposition, the second-best figure among ACC schools. In 2012-13, the Tigers dropped their average even further to 60.1 points per game. That figure dropped to an ACC era-best at Clemson – 58.4 points per game – in 2013-14. The Tiger perimeter defense was No. 1 nationally defending the three-pointer (.286).

Grant personally signed 10 of Clemson's 15 players recruited by Brownell's staff. He was Clemson's lead recruiter for players such as Austin Ajukwa, Jaron Blossomgame, Gabe DeVoe, Ibrahim Djambo, Sidy Djitte, Hall, K.J. McDaniels and Patrick Rooks.

Prior to Clemson, Grant served as an assistant coach first at Winthrop and then at Wichita State. He helped the Eagles to three consecutive Big South championships and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances. In 2004-05, the Eagles were 27-6 overall. The next season, Winthrop finished the year with a 23-8 overall record and came within two points of upsetting Tennessee in the NCAA Tournament. In 2007, Grant helped the Eagles to a 29-5 overall record and unblemished 14-0 mark in Big South play.

The 2007 campaign was a memorable one for Winthrop. With Grant's assistance, the Eagles claimed a 74-64 upset over No. 6 seed Notre Dame in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament. It was Winthrop's first-ever NCAA Tournament win in seven tries.

Grant was at Wichita State from 2007-10, when the Shockers made gradual improvement each season. In 2008-09, Wichita State made its first postseason appearance in three years and also defeated one of the nation's top mid-major programs in Siena during the regular season. In 2009-10, Wichita State improved its win total by eight and finished 25-10 overall, 12-6 in the Missouri Valley Conference. The Shockers advanced to the championship game of the conference tournament and also earned a bid to the National Invitation Tournament.

Prior to his stint at Winthrop, Grant was an assistant coach at The Citadel from 2002-04. Grant played two years at the Division II level at Georgia College. He led the school to two appearances in the NCAA Tournament and to consecutive Peach Belt Conference championships (1999, 2000). In 2000, the Bobcats advanced to the Elite Eight of the Division II national tournament.

A native of North Charleston, S.C., Grant earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from Georgia College in 2000. He and his wife, Jacci, have three sons: Trey, Eyaiah and Elonzo.
