TIPPING OFF

• UNC is one of three undefeated teams in the NCAA DI ranks. The others are Arizona and Colorado.

• Carolina is off to a 12-0 start for the seventh time in program history. The last time UNC won more than 12 to start the year was 2010-11, when the team opened 14-0.

• Deja Kelly leads UNC and is tied for third in the ACC in scoring with 16.4 points per game. She's the only Tar Heel to have scored in double figures in every this season. Alyssa Ustby leads the team in rebounds with 9.6 per game, third in the conference and up significantly from her 5.7 average last season.

• UNC moved up a spot to No. 24 in this week's AP poll. The Tar Heels are up two to 18th in the coaches' poll. Prior to this season, Carolina's last national ranking was in the 2015-16 preseason.

NOTING THE TAR HEELS

UNC vs. Clemson

UNC and Clemson are meeting for the 88th time in a rivalry that dates back to the 1975-76 season, Carolina's second as a varsity program under the umbrella of the Department of Athletics.

The Tar Heels lead the overall series 59-28 after winning the last four and nine of the past 10.

- In the most recent meeting, at Clemson on Feb. 18, 2021, UNC won 77-64. Graduate guard and future top-10 WNBA Draft pick Stephanie Watts led the way with 26 points and then-freshman Deja Kelly was next with 19. The Tar Heels started slowly but opened the second quarter with a 9-0 run to lead 36-24 at halftime. Carolina led by 23 with eight minutes to play before a late Clemson run closed the gap.

- The last time the teams met in Chapel Hill was Feb. 2, 2020. Taylor Koenen (who preceded Alyssa Ustby as a Minnesota product wearing jersey No. 1) led UNC to an 86-72 win with a career-high 26 points.

- Clemson's last win in Chapel Hill was during the 2011-12 season, when current UNC assistant coach Ito Coleman was the Tigers' head coach. The Tar Heels have won the four home-turf meetings since then.

Scouting the Tigers

Clemson arrives in Chapel Hill with an overall record of 6-7 and an 0-2 mark in ACC play. The Tigers are 0-2 in road games this season, with losses at South Carolina and at Syracuse. Their most recent game is a 79-52 loss at home to NC State on Thursday. Freshman Madi Ott led the Tigers with 14 points, including 4-8 shooting from three-point range.

Graduate guard Delicia Washington leads the team in scoring with 12.5 points per game and is the only Tiger averaging double figures. She's also the team's top rebounder with 7.4 per game.

Up Next

After three consecutive games at home, the Tar Heels hit the road for the next one, but it's a short road: Carolina will travel 30 minutes down I-40 to take on NC State on Thursday in Raleigh. After that it's back home again to host Virginia Tech on Jan. 9.

Carolina leads the nation in scoring margin (+33.4) and is tied for first in won-lost percentage with two other undefeated teams, Arizona and Colorado. The Tar Heels rank in the top 10 in nine other categories:

Quick Hits

- The Tar Heels are third in the NET rankings, 18th in the coaches' poll and 24th in the AP poll.

- UNC has played the same starting lineup in all 12 games this season: Kelly, Littlefield, Todd-Williams, Ustby and Poole. In comparison, through 12 games last season the Tar Heels had tried five different lineups, and they would use seven during the course of the season's 24 games.

- In the Dec. 19 game at BC, UNC trailed for 30 minutes and was down by as many as 15 points in the fourth quarter. Aside from that game, the Tar Heels have trailed in only four other games this season (VCU, Washington, Minnesota, Syracuse), and never by more than five points. Carolina scored first and led wire-to-wire in the first four games of the season. In the fifth and sixth, in the Bahamas, the Tar Heels trailed by as many as three points before coming back to win. Five points (late first quarter at Minnesota) is the largest margin by which UNC trailed in nonconference play. The Tar Heels were down three early to Syracuse.

- UNC has outscored its opponent in 40 of 48 quarters this season. The exceptions are the second quarter at TCU (when the Horned Frogs led 14-12 as the Tar Heels shot 25.0 from the field), the third quarter vs. VCU (when the Rams outscored UNC 17-16), the fourth quarter vs. Washington (when the Huskies outscored UNC 14-12), the first (tied 17-17) and third quarters (UM led 26-19) at Minnesota, and the first, second and third quarters at BC.

- UNC has won its first four true road games for the first time since the 2013-14 season. The Tar Heels played six of their first 10 games away from home.

- UNC's 89-33 win at Charlotte on Nov. 14 was the 1,000th victory in program history. Carolina now has a record of 1,010-480, dating back to 1974-75, the first season for women's basketball as a varsity program under the umbrella of the Department of Athletics. UNC is the 18th DI program to reach 1,000 wins.

- Over an 11-day span, UNC played games in Texas (TCU on Nov. 21), the Bahamas (VCU on Nov. 26 and Washington on Nov. 27) and Minnesota (Big Ten/ACC Challenge vs. the Golden Gophers on Dec. 1). The nearly 2,500-mile distance between the site of the Washington game in Bimini, Bahamas and the Minnesota game in Minneapolis marks the largest distance between back-to-back games this year.

Story Lines

- Eva Hodgson and Carlie Littlefield are both enrolled in the MBA program at UNC's Kenan-Flagler Business School after completing their undergraduate degrees at their previous schools, Hodgson at William & Mary (where she was the 2019 CAA Freshman of the Year) and Littlefield at Princeton (where she played two seasons for Courtney Banghart prior to Banghart taking the head job at UNC).

- In early August, the Tar Heels took a team bonding trip to West Virginia, where they stayed in cabins and went zip-lining and white-water rafting. "It's just a really fun group to have an adventure with and that's kind of what the season is – it's an adventure," coach Courtney Banghart said.

- Assistant coaches Joanne Aluka-White and Ito Coleman, whose friendship dates back to high school in Hephzibah, Ga., were teammates on Nigeria's National Team at the 2004 Athens Olympics.

- Assistant coach Adrian Walters started his coaching career with the men's program at Gallaudet University in Washington, D.C., where he was an assistant coach for two years and the head coach for one. He learned sign language while coaching there and is still fluent.

Welcome to the Tar Heel Family

On the first day of the signing period, Nov. 10, the Tar Heels inked a standout in Paulina Paris, a 5-7 guard from New City, N.Y.

"It's a really exciting day for our program as we add Paulina Paris to the Carolina family," said UNC coach Courtney Banghart, who has signed exceptional classes in each of her previous two falls in Chapel Hill. "Paulina is one of the nation's elite perimeter threats. Her competitiveness, toughness, and ability to score at all three levels makes her a great add to our program. In addition, she is a gym rat and will continue to raise the level of her game throughout her career in the Carolina blue. We are all so glad she's a Tar Heel."

Paris is currently ranked 27th overall in the class of 2022 and seventh at her position by ESPNW HoopGurlz.

The daughter of Bryan Paris, a former member of Puerto Rico's National Team, and Melissa Paris, she is a junior at Saddle River Day School. A two-time Rockland County Player of the year. She has averaged 20+ points in all three of her high school seasons so far, with 21.3 points per game as a freshman, 25.4 as a sophomore and 24.6 as a junior in 2020-21, when she was named All-Bergen County. She has already passed the 1,000-career-points mark and headed into her senior season with a total of 1,361.

Key, Young Sidelined

On the eve of her team's season opener in November, UNC women's basketball coach Courtney Banghart announced that two of her Tar Heels will be sidelined for 2021-22.

Freshman Teonni Key and redshirt junior Ariel Young each suffered a knee injury during the preseason. Both have subsequently been diagnosed with ACL tears. Young hurt her left knee in a practice early in the preseason and Key hurt her right knee during the team's closed scrimmage at South Carolina in late October.

"I'm absolutely heartbroken for both Ariel and Teonni, two very important pieces of our team's puzzle," Banghart said. "Both of these athletes have such a genuine love for the game and this program, and both have become huge parts of this team. They have put so much work into their development and training and to be forced to the sideline for the duration of the season is a tough pill to swallow for us all."

"It's also undoubtedly a huge hit for our team. Our collective group is hard at work to fill their void on both sides of the ball. Both AY and Teonni will redshirt and they will attack their rehab in much the same way they have attacked their development plan. We look forward to having them back better than ever."

Key is a guard/forward from Cary, N.C. A McDonald's All-American and the ninth-ranked recruit in the freshman class, she was named the 2021-22 Atlantic Coast Conference Newcomer Watch List.

Young is a guard from Tallahassee, Fla. A transfer to UNC after spending her freshman year at Michigan, she appeared in all 24 games last season for the Tar Heels, averaging 2.4 points per game and contributing valuable minutes off the bench.

McPherson to Redshirt

On December 16, UNC coach Courtney Banghart announced that freshman Kayla McPherson will redshirt the 2021-22 season while continuing to rehabilitate a knee injury sustained in high school.

McPherson, a top-20 recruit who tore the ACL in her right knee during

Numbers of Note

- In their two ACC games this season, the Tar Heels have seen their best and worst rebounding margins. At Boston College on Dec. 19, the Eagles won the rebounding battle 44-26. It's one of just two games in which UNC has been outrebounded this season and the -18 margin is the worst of the year. In the second ACC game, at home against Syracuse, the Tar Heels outrebounded the Orange 63-37 to equal their best margin of the year, +26, also achieved in the game at TCU.
- The 79-43 win over Syracuse marked the ninth time in 12 games that the Tar Heels have held an opponent under 50 points.
- UNC has shot below 40 percent just four times this season, with two of those coming in ACC play. The Tar Heels are coming off a .395 shooting percentage that's their third-lowest of the season.
- The Tar Heels are averaging 24 points off the bench in ACC play, with 18 at BC (15 by Eva Hodgson) and 30 vs. Syracuse (11 by Hodgson, 9 by Destiny Adams).
- After a streak of five games with single-digit steals, UNC has reached double digits in each of the past four, with 11 against UNCA, a season-high 17 at BC, 13 against Alabama State and 12 vs. Syracuse. The Tar Heels now lead the ACC in steals with 10.83. Three Tar Heels are in the conference's top 15 individually: Alyssa Ustby (11th, 1.75 spg), Eva Hodgson (T13th, 1.67), Deja Kelly (T13, 1.67).
- Alyssa Ustby's 14 rebounds against Syracuse are a single-game high in ACC play this season.
- Charlie Littlefield reset her season scoring high in back-to-back games in December with 17 against UNCA then 22 at Boston College.
- Against James Madison (12/5), UNC hit a season-high 10 of 15 three-point attempts for a .667 percentage, the best single-game performance in the NCAA so far this season. Against UNC Asheville (12/12), Carolina was 11-20 to reset the team's single-game high. Charlie Littlefield was 4-5 to equal her career-high for makes and Kennedy Todd-Williams hit a career-high three of her four attempts.
- UNC's 107 points vs. UNC Asheville was the team's highest total of the season and the first time in triple digits since the 2018-19 opener. It was UNC's highest scoring game since hitting 124 in a neutral-site win over New Orleans in 2013 and the highest score at home since 109 vs. Gardner-Webb in 2011.
- Along with the season-high in three-pointers against UNCA, UNC also had a season-high 58 points in the paint.
- BC is the only UNC opponent to shoot better than 40 percent from the field this season. The Eagles hit 50.9 percent of their shots. The second-highest percentage by an opponent this season was 38.6 by Minnesota.
- No Tar Heel is averaging 30 minutes per game. Deja Kelly, who played all 40 minutes against BC, leads the team with an average of 28.8 minutes per game.
- Deja Kelly is the only Tar Heel to have hit double figures in all 12 games and leads the team in scoring with 16.4 ppg, third in the ACC.
- The Tar Heels are shooting free throws much more successfully away from home this season than at Carmichael. They've hit 78.8 percent of freebies in the three road games, 70.7 in the two neutral games and just 60.1 in the six games at home. (The performance vs. JMU – 75.0 – was the best at Carmichael so far this year).
- Eight different players have scored in double figures at least once this season and six Tar Heels are averaging 9.0 points or more per game.
- Junior transfer Eva Hodgson came off the bench for back-to-back season highs in the Bahamas. She scored 14 against VCU then had a team-best 15 against Washington..
- The Carolina defense has forced all 12 opponents into double-digit turnovers and has forced 20+ six times this season, including the past three games.
- Minnesota outscored UNC 47-43 in the second half, marking the first time this season that a team had outscored UNC in a half. Boston College also accomplished that, leading 40-33 at halftime.
- Two freshmen hit double figures for the first time as Tar Heels against App. State. Destiny Adams scored all 10 of her points in the fourth quarter, and Morasha Wiggins had seven of her 10 after halftime.

her senior year at Madison County High School, had not seen action through the Tar Heels' first nine games of the season.

"We're obviously heartbroken not to have Kayla on the court this

season, but our highest priority is to ensure that she's fully healthy before she's cleared," Banghart said. "Kayla is a special talent with a long career in front of her, which we want to include four full years with us in the Carolina blue. I can't say enough about how Kayla has handled the grueling rehabilitation process. She's proven to be a tireless worker and an outstanding teammate and she is getting better and better every day. Tar Heel fans are going to learn soon that she's worth waiting for."

McPherson, a 5-7 guard from Hull, Ga., was a standout player at Madison County. She was named to the McDonald's Girls All-American Team and the Jordan Brand Classic Girls National team and ranked 17th in ESPNW rankings of the freshman class. She led the nation with an average of 36.3 points per game her junior season, when she scored 63 points in a single game.

She earned Georgia Player of the Year honors in her sophomore and junior years but didn't compete during her senior year after she was injured in a preseason practice.

2021-22 Team Captains

In October, UNC coach Courtney Banghart announced that graduate students Eva Hodgson, Carlie Littlefield and Jaelynn Murray would serve as team captains for 2021-22.

"Team leadership is the catalyst and accountability that serves as the driving force for a team's success," said Banghart, who in addition to her 15 years of head coaching experience owns a master's degree in leadership development. "We have a great group this season and all have spoken. Carlie, Jaelynn, and Eva have earned the honor to lead together. This trio has unique gifts and a collective voice. We are eager for their impact, and trust that they will lead competitively, compassionately, and with proven consistency all year long. We are in great hands."

The trio is charged with leading a young team that includes a total of nine sophomores and freshmen among its 14 members.

Murray, a redshirt senior athletically, graduated from UNC in May and is now enrolled in the Master of Arts in Educational Innovation, Technology, and Entrepreneurship (MEITE) program through the UNC School of Education. Hodgson and Littlefield are both in the MBA program through UNC's Kenan-Flagler Business School, Hodgson after graduating from William & Mary and Littlefield from Princeton. Hodgson joins the Tar Heels as a redshirt junior in eligibility, while Littlefield is in her final season of play.

Noting the 2020-21 Tar Heels

- Five players averaged 9.9 points or better per game as the Tar Heels finished 13-11.
- Graduate student Stephanie Watts was the 10th overall pick in the 2021 WNBA Draft.
- Current sophomores Alyssa Ustby and Deja Kelly led the team in minutes. Ustby averaged 30.0 per game and Kelly 28.8. Both players were named to the All-ACC Academic Team and Kelly was also named to the All-ACC Freshman Team.
- UNC won five of its last six regular season games and earned an NCAA Tournament at-large bid. It was the 28th NCAA Tournament appearance in program history.

COURTNEY BANGHART

Head Coach • Third season at UNC, 15th season as a head coach



The 2021-22 season is the third at UNC for head coach Courtney Banghart, who has transformed the Tar Heel roster and led the team to an NCAA Tournament appearance in 2021.

Banghart was announced on April 30, 2019 as North Carolina's head coach, the first new face in the position since 1986. She came to Chapel Hill after 12 years as the head coach at Princeton, where her teams won seven Ivy League crowns and made eight NCAA Tournament appearances. (Before her arrival, Princeton hadn't reached the tournament even once.)

A New Hampshire native, Banghart was a three-year starter at Dartmouth, where she twice earned All-Ivy honors. She still holds the Ivy League record for career three-pointers (273) and as a senior competed in the three-point shooting contest at Butler's Hinkle Fieldhouse during the men's Final Four in Indianapolis.

Including a WNIT appearance at Princeton, Banghart has led her teams to 10 postseason appearances in 14 previous seasons as a head coach.

More on Banghart:

- She was the 2015 Naismith National Coach of the Year and is the only current ACC coach to have won that honor.
- A player she coached has been picked in the top 10 in the past two WNBA Drafts (Stephanie Watts from UNC 10th in 2021, Bella Alarie from Princeton 5th in 2020).
- In 2015 she was named to Fortune's list of the World's 50 Greatest Leaders. Also on the list that year: Pope Francis, Bill and Melinda Gates, Chief Justice John Roberts Jr., LeBron James, Elon Musk and Taylor Swift.
- She holds a bachelor's degree in neuroscience and a master's degree in writing and leadership, both from Dartmouth. Her graduate thesis was on sport leadership.
- Her first coaching position was head coach of a high school boys' tennis team, during her junior year at Dartmouth. She also worked as a tennis pro during high school, providing lessons to a range of abilities.
- She hitchhiked through Alaska after college (after ditching the outdoor leadership course in which she was enrolled) and has bungeed off a jump in Switzerland that was then the highest in the world.
- Right around the time she got the Princeton job, she and her brother were finalists to appear on "The Amazing Race."
- A four-time soccer state champion in high school, she planned to play that sport at Dartmouth until a coaching change made her rethink her path and talk the women's basketball coach into giving her a spot. (She also won two high school state titles in basketball and three in tennis.)

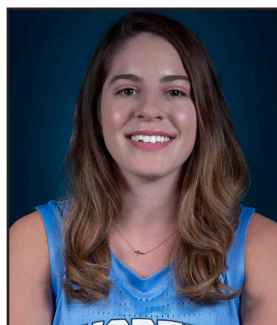

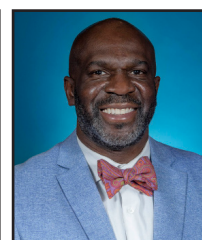

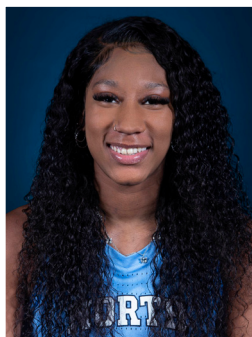
