Need to Know

TOUGH TO BEAT

- Clemson has been tough to beat at home under Mike Noonan. Since Noonan took over, the Tigers are 93-30-15 in home games. Clemson finished the 2021 season second nationally in cumulative attendance (31,853) and fourth in attendance per game (2,275). Both marks topped the ACC.
- Clemson is 84-5-4 under Noonan when leading at the half and was unbeaten (12-0-1) last season when scoring the game's first goal. Noonan is 120-8-8 at Clemson when his team scores first
- During his time at Clemson, Noonan is 113-8-5 when the Tigers score at least twice. Clemson won all of its games last season when scoring at least two goals (14-0-0). GUESS WHO'S BACK

- The Tigers will return two All-ACC Second Team members in junior midfielder Ousmane Sylla and junior defender Hamady Diop.
- College Cup Offensive MVP Isaiah Reid and midfielder Alvaro Gomez return for their senior seasons and were named captains for the 2022 campaign.

FRESH FACES

- Clemson adds a whopping 14 newcomers to the 2022 roster, including grad transfer and former Brown captain Derek Waleffe, as well as UNCG transfer Joey Skinner.
- •The Tigers bring in 12 true freshmen for the 2022 season but also expect to see massive contributions from last season's true freshmen in Adam Lundegard, Dawson Malcolm, Tristan DeLoach, Elton Chifamba and Tim Strobeck.

NEW NETMINDERS

- Junior Trevor Manion is primed to take over the starting goalkeeper role following the departure of George Marks. Manion hails from Phoenixville, Pennsylvania and has played in big moments for the Tigers, including the spring 2021 penalty shootout vs. Marshall in which he made the first save.
- Three freshmen (Joseph Andema, Patrick Donovan and Aiden Hampton) join the Tigers' goal-keepers room coached by Camilo Rodriguez.

DOMINATING THE DRAFT

- A program-record six Tigers were selected in the 2021 MLS SuperDraft, tied for most from any one school in a single draft. It marked the third consecutive year in which at least three Tigers were selected.
- . Clemson has had 34 players drafted since 2000, including 23 in the last seven years, most of any program in that span. Every starter on Clemson's 2019 team was drafted or signed to a professional contract.


