- Clemson also adds freshmen Ruby Whitehorn and Tadassa Brown, both from Michigan, as well as junior Taylor Thompson, a walk-on from Greenville, S.C.

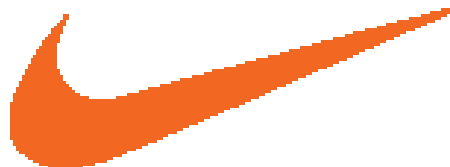
