»LAST TIME OUT

Wofford's comeback fell short in the second half at Youngstown State to open the season as the Terriers lost 81-72. With over 40 combined fouls, Wofford made more of its free throws by converting 85.7%, but YSU shot 45.8% overall, more than Wofford's 33.3% clip. A rough first quarter of just an 8.33% shooting mark by the Terriers created a tough hole to climb out of, but thanks to 19-point efforts by Rachael Rose and Jackie Carman, Wofford pulled within one point in the fourth. However, the Penguins held on to win.

WEEK ONE

- The 2022-23 season is the 43rd in Wofford women's basketbal history. The Terriers are 18-25 all-time in season openers
 and 2-5 under head coach Jimmy Garrity after falling on the road to Youngstown State.
- Wofford opens on the road for the first time since 2019, in which the Terriers began the campaign at Auburn. Wofford had opened at home each of the last two seasons.

MATCH-UP PREVIEW

- Wofford and Clemson are meeting for the 10th time ever, with Clemson having claimed every match-up thus far.
 Wofford is seeking its first win over the Tigers and only its second-ever triumph over a Power Five team (Alabama, 2012)
- $\bullet \ \ \text{The Terriers and Tigers squared off last season with Clemson winning 84-49}.$
- Wofford and Clemson are meeting in back-to-back seasons for the first time since matching up in three-straight from 1998-2000.

PRESEASON HONORS

- Wofford was picked to finish second in the SoCon by the league's head coaches in the Preseason Coaches Poll. The media poll was less favorable, tabbing the Terriers in fourth place, still in the top half of the league.
- A pair of Terriers earned Preseason All-SoCon Team honors: Jackie Carman and Lilly Hatton. Hatton repeats with the honor after being the lone Terrier to earn it prior to last season.

TERRIER TALES (CONT.)

LET'S DANCE

- Wofford made its first-ever appearance in the Postseason WNIT to conlcude last season, which was also its first-ever postseason appearance at the Divison Hevel.
- The season ended in a pseudo full-circle fashion, as the Terriers opened the campaign in the Preseason WNIT Classic in Raleigh, N.C., taking on NC State, Towson and Florida in games two through four of the season.

NEW HÉIGHTS

• The 11-3 SoCon record in 2021-22 was Wofford's bestever and the fourth-straight season with at least a .500 league record. With a 17-14 overall record, the Terriers finished .500 or better for a fourth-straight season, and the 17 wins are fourth-most in a season in program history (most at DI level).

HISTORIC SENIOR CLASS

• The 2022 senior class was 61-54 overall. The 61 wins are the most at the Division I level in program history, and the class is the first DI class in program history to finish over .500.

FLY THE W

- Wofford women's basketball legend Chloe Wanink is the winningest individual in program history. As one of just a few players to have been on the team for five years, Wanink accrued a 63-87 record during her time as a Terrier between 2015-20.
- · Jackie Carman, a former teammate of Wanink, is following in her footsteps as a fifth-year player this season. Through her first four seasons, Carman is 61-56 with Wofford and sits just two wins away from matching Wanink's mark. Three more wins will make Carman the winningest Terrier in program history.

TOP DOGS

- A few Terriers finished among SoCon leaders in 2021-22: Reagan Rapert was second in assists (3.7 APG); Alexis Tomlin was fourth in rebounding (7.5 RPG); Jackie Carman was sixth in scoring (12.4 PPG); Tomlin (1.0 BPG) and Lilly Hatton (0.9 BPG) were fifth and sixth, respectively, in blocked shots.
- Wofford as a team ranked first in the SoCon in a few categories: scoring offense (66.2 PPG), free throw percentage (74.6%) and assist/turnover ratio (0.9).
- The Terriers were second in some marks: scoring margin (+4.1), three-point percentage (31.9%), turnover margin (+3.0) and three-point defense (27.9%).

ALL-SOCON

- Five different Terriers earned All-SoCon selections in 2021-22: Jackie Carman (first team), Lilly Hatton (second team), Nivah Lutz (third team), Alexis Tomlin (third team) and Reagan Rapert (all-freshman team and all-defensive team).
- · Wofford was the only team in the conference with all five members of its starting lineup represented in some way in the postseason awards.

MILESTONE WATCH

- Jackie Carman currently holds 843 points scored in her career, needing 157 more to reach the 1,000-point benchmark.
- Lilly Hatton touts 779 points, needing 221 more to also join the 1,000 club.
- Only 16 Terriers all-time have reached the 1,000-point milestone, with Carman and Hatton looking to extend the list to 18.
- Hatton also boasts 99-career blocks, needing just one more for 100.
- At 476 boards, she needs 24 more rebounds to join the 500 club. She would be the 23rd Terrier in program history to reach the milestone after former teammate

- and close friend Alexis Tomlin became the 22nd Terrier in the club last season.
- Hatton is looking to become the 12th Terrier all-time in the 1,000 point - 500 rebound club. She would also be just the fifth to do so at the Division I level.

FORGED BY FIRE

- The Terriers boast another challenging non-conference slate in 2022-23.
- Eight of the 14 non-conference games are road affairs, with just six happening inside Jerry Richardson Indoor Stadium.
- Three of those contests are at Power Five opponents: Clemson, North Carolina and Tennessee.

HOME SWEET HOME

- · In the friendly confines of Jerry Richardson Indoor Stadium, the Terriers went 10-4 last season. However, they were only 7-10 away from home (road and neutral).
- Wofford tallied double-digit home wins for the first time since 2019-20 (11-5), and it was the seventh-straight season with a .500 or better home record.
- In Jimmy Garrity's seven seasons at the helm, the Terriers have posted a 55-25 home record, but they have yet to post a winning road record. Wofford is a nearly inversed 24-58 on the road and 5-10 at neutral sites for a 29-68 overall record away from home.
- Adding in the season before Garrity arrived (2015-16) in which Wofford began its run of seven consecutive .500plus records at home, the Terriers are 63-31 at home during the streak.
- Since the Jerry Richardson Indoor Stadium opened in 2017, the Terriers are 48-20 in the venue.
- Wofford has not posted a .500 record on the road in its Division I era and not since an 8-5 road mark in 1993-94.
- So far in 2022-23, the Terriers are 0-1 on the road.

FEELING '22

- The Terriers hit a stride after the calendar flipped to the new year. Wofford ended the 2021 part of last season at 4-9, but it was 13-5 in 2022. The 6-1 January record was Wofford's best monthly record of the campaign.
- In the 13 games played in 2021, the Terriers averaged 64.9 PPG, allowing 67.1 PPG. Wofford shot 35.6% overall, 32.4% beyond the arc. Wofford tallied marks of 37.5 RPG, 12.2 APG, 6.3 steals per game and 1.2 blocks per game.
- In 2022, the Terriers increased their scoring to 67.1 PPG on 38.8% shooting, 31.6% from three while allowing just 58.5 PPG. Assists (12.6 APG) and steals (7.4 SPG) were only slightly better, but blocking more than doubled to 3.5 blocks per game.

THREES UP

- Wofford thrived beyond the arc last season, second in the SoCon shooting 31.9% from three. The Terriers led the league with 8.0 triples per game.
- Nationally, the Terriers were 36th with 248 made threes and 35th in threes per game (8.0). The 248 made triples were a new program record for made threes in a season.
- Jackie Carman was fourth in the league in both threes per game (2.0) and fifth in three-point percentage

(33.5%).

• The Terriers didn't just shoot the three well, they were also stellar at quarding it. Wofford held its opponents to a 27.9% mark from three, 46th in the NCAA.

BIG SHOES TO FILL

- The senior Terriers took charge throughout the 2021-22 season, leaving big openings for the 2022-23 returners to step up into.
- Two of the top three scorers were seniors: Jackie Carman (first, 12.4 PPG) and Niyah Lutz (third, 8.7 PPG). Junior Lilly Hatton was second with 9.7 PPG. While Carman and Hatton are back, Lutz graduted.
- The veteran leadership shined on the glass as well, with the top three rebounders being Tomlin (7.5 RPG), Hatton (5.8 RPG) and Lutz (5.7 RPG). Only Hatton is returning.
- Though a freshman last season, assist leader Reagan Rapert (3.7 APG) transferred out. The second-leading helper was Niyah Lutz (2.0 APG), leaving the top returner as junior Helen Matthews (1.7 APG).
- In the season opener, new Terrier Rachael Rose stepped up in her Wofford debut. She posted 19 points to tie for the team lead while pacing the squad in assists (six) and steals (three). Her five boards were second on the squad in the contest.

DOUBLE TROUBLE?

- Lilly Hatton's double-double against Furman in the SoCon semis was the 11th by a Terrier (her second) last season, but Wofford did not have consistent success when a player recorded the feat.
- The Terriers were just over .500 (6-5) when a player tallied a double-double.

JACKIE BUCKETS

- Jackie Carman was on fire all last season, shooting 38.8%, 33.5% from three with 12.4 PPG.
- Carman's 33.3% three-ball mark was fifth in the league.
- Her eight three-pointers at UNCG (Feb. 3) tied the program record for most in a single game, originally set by Chloe Wanink (eight at Auburn, 11/6/19).
- She was the only Terrier with multiple 20-point games, doing so three times with a career-high 26 at App State, 24 at UNCG and 21 against Furman.
- Carman opened the 2022-23 campaign with a 19-point outing at Yougnstown State, tying for the team lead.

GO (DOUBLE) FIGURE

- Junior Lilly Hatton grooved to finish last season's campaign, as she posted double figures in seven out of the last nine games.
- The Georgetwon, Ind. native tallied 12.9 PPG during the span, shooting 42.4% from the field.
- Hatton posted 25 points in the regular season finale at Chattanooga, one-shy of her career-high and her first 20ball of the season (sixth by a Terrier).
- She recorded her second double-double of the season with 11 points and a career-high-tying 12 boards in the SoCon semis against Furman.

ROSE GOLD

- Rachael Rose is one of the new Terriers joining the team this season. She makes her way to Wofford after a decorated freshman campaign with crosstown rival USC
- Rose was second on the Spartans in scoring (13.1 PPG) and rebounding (5.1 RPG). She shot at a 54.6 percent clip and a 40.3 percent mark from three.
- Her 3.6 APG topped the Spartans and ranked fifth in the
- Her 81.9 percent free throw mark clocked in at third-best in

the Big South.

- She collected eight different Big South Freshman of the Week honors en route to a Big South Freshman of the Year recognition. In addition, she was named to the All-Freshman Team for the conference.
- Rose is picking up where she left off and was golden in her Wofford debut at Youngstown State. Her 19 points tied for the team lead while she paced the squad with six assists and three steals. She was a perfect 9-for-9 at the charity stripe.

ITALIAN ICE

- Sophomore Sydnee Richetto earned solid playing time (10.3 min/g) off the bench as a pinpoint shooter during her freshman campaign, especially from three.
- She boasted a 39.2% three-ball mark (20-51).
- Overall, Richetto shot 42.0% to average 4.5 PPG.
- Richetto, nicknamed Italian Ice, looks to remain cool under pressure in what should be an advanced role this season.

IF IT AIN'T BROKE

- Wofford utlized the same starting lineup in 27 of its 31 games last season: Niyah Lutz, Reagan Rapert, Lilly Hatton, Alexis Tomlin and Jackie Carman.
- Three of the other four lineups were without Carman, with Helen Matthews (two) and Annabelle Schultz (one) taking her place. The other lineup featured senior Alea Harris starting in place of Rapert on senior day against Samford
- Entering the SoCon Tournament, Wofford was one of just nine Division I teams to use the same starting five in 24 or more games last season.
- However, only two of those regular starters return to the squad from last season: Jackie Carman and Lilly Hatton. Niyah Lutz, Alexis Tomlin and Reagan Rapert all departed the team following the season, opening up three new spots in the lineup.
- If the opener was an indication, Schultz, Matthews and Rachael Rose will be filling those spots.

A.B. FOR THREE

- Annabelle Schultz was a quality shooter for the Terriers last season, especially from three-point range. She knocked down 30.3 percent beyond the arc and 32.0 percent overall.
- She was also solid at the charity stripe, hitting 81.8 percent.
- Schultz posted a career-high 19-point outing against ETSU on Jan. 29 in which she tied her career-best marks for field goals (six) and threes (five).
- She made her first-career start at Furman two weeks prior and delivered 14 points in a career-high 38 minutes of action.
- In the final non-conference match-up against Erskine, Schultz recorded her first-career double-double by way of 17 points and 12 rebounds. The boards are a career best, and the 17 points were at the time until she topped that mark against ETSU.

CHARITY STRIPE

- Wofford's 74.6 free throw percentage last season was first in the SoCon and ranked 69th nationally.
- Five Terriers shot 75% or better from the line: Sydnee Richetto, 92.3% (12-13); Reagan Rapert, 87.3% (69-79); Annabelle Schultz, 81.8% (18-22); Niyah Lutz, 78.1% (25-32); Alexis Tomlin, 76.2% (64-84).
- Defensively, Wofford played clean, committing just 13.5 fouls per game. It was the fewest in the conference, and the mark ranked 24th in the nation.

- Wofford opened the campaign by reaching the free throw line 28 times at Youngstown State, converting 24 times for an 85.7 percent mark.
- Rachael Rose was a perfect 9-of-9 while Jackie Carman was 6-of-7.

BAKING TURNOVERS

- Wofford committed just 13.4 turnovers per game last season, fewest in the conference and 49th nationally.
- The Terrier defense was consistent at forcing turnovers.
 Wofford forced 16.4 turnovers per game, leading to a turnover margin of +3.0, second in the SoCon and 56th nationally.
- The Terriers forced at least 16 turnovers in 19 of their 31 games.
- Wofford again won the turnover battle to open the campaign, committing just seven while forcing 11 Penguin turnovers.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- The Terriers welcome five newcomers to the squad for the 2022-23 campaign.
- Four freshman make up the majority of the new faces.
 They are Indiya Clarke, Jessie Parish, Libby Privett and Sophie Smith.
- The final newcomer is a sophomore transfer, guard Rachael Rose. She joins Wofford after spending last season down the road at USC Upstate, where she was named Big South Freshman of the Year.

IN THE CLASSROOM

- Wofford has always taken pride in its academic rigors, and head coach Jimmy Garrity's team was stout in the classroom last year yet again.
- Eleven Terriers were named to the SoCon Academic Honor Roll: Jackie Carman, Abbey Crawford, Alea Harris, Lilly Hatton, Helen Matthews, Elena Pulanco, Reagan Rapert, Sydnee Richetto, Annabelle Schultz, Ja'Rae Smith and Alexis Tomlin.
- Four of those Harris, Hatton, Matthews and Tomlin - earned recognition on the 2022 Spring Academic All-SoCon Team.
- Three of the graduates Alea Harris, Elena Pulanco and Alexis Tomlin earned membership in Phi Beta Kappa.

WANINK BACK AT IT

- Wofford women's basketball legend Chloe Wanink is lacing up her shoes once more. After a brief stint in coaching as an assistant at Division II University of Mary in Bismarck, N.D., Wanink signed over the summer a professional contract with Tindastoll Basketball Club in Iceland.
- Wanink is one of 16 Terriers in the program's history to score 1,000 points, finishing with 1,789 at second place on the Wofford all-time scoring list.
- Wanink has been on fire to begin her professional career.
 In just eight games with Tindastoll, she is averaging 29.6
 PPG on a 50.3 percent shooting mark and 32.4 percent from three.
- Wanink leads Iceland's D1 league in scoring despite Tindastoll posting only a 1-7 record to currently sit eighth out of nine teams in the standings.

- Wofford is led by its two senior captains, fifth-year senior Jackie Carman and true senior Lilly Hatton. They were Wofford's top-two scorers last season, and both earned All-SoCon recognitions.
- The junior class is four strong, featuring Annabelle Schultz and Helen Matthews as contributors from last season poised to add more this year. Abbey Crawford and Ja'Rae Smith round out the class and look to feature in the lineup more in 2022-23.
- The Terriers boast only two sophomores, with only Sydnee Richetto returning. Rachael Rose is new to the squad after transferring from USC Upstate. Rose was Big South Freshman of the Year last season.
- In addition to Rose, an incoming class of four freshmen give Wofford five new faces on the squad. Indiya Clarke, Jessie Parish, Libby Privett and Sophie Smith round out the Terrier team as the new freshmen.

•Wofford opens at Youngstown St. on Nov. 9 with the home opener against Coastal Carolina on Nov. 16. The slate features three Power Five teams: Clemson, UNC and Tennessee. SEVENTH SEASON AT WOFFORD 10TH SEASON OVERALL



Jimmy Garrity concluded his sixth season as the head coach of the Wofford women's basketball program in 2022-23. Garrity was named head coach on April 25, 2016. In his six seasons at the helm, he has seen players earn 13 All-Southern Conference honors, six All-Freshman Team honors, a trio of All-Defensive Team selections and a SoCon Freshman of the Year. Last season he led the team to the best Southern Conference record in school history with the program's first-ever WNIT appearance while putting together the fourth-straight season with a .500 or better

The 2021-22 season saw the team continue to reach new heights with a 17-14 overall record and an 11-3 SoCon mark. The 17 overall victories are the most at the Division I level in program history (fourth overall), and the 11-3 SoCon record is also the program's best ever. The team achieved a plethora of historic firsts, including road wins at Furman and Chattanooga and season series sweeps of Furman, Samford and Chattanooga. The season opened with the program's first Preseason WNIT Classic appearance with three games in Raleigh, N.C., including one against the host No. 5 NC State Wolfpack. Upon the conclusion of the regular season, Jackie Carman was named All-SoCon First Team by the coaches and media, and Lilly Hatton earned second-team honors by both. Niyah Lutz and Alexis Tomlin garnered third-team selections from the media. Reagan Rapert was named to the SoCon All-Freshman and All-Defensive Teams. The Terriers led the SoCon in scoring offense (66.2 PPG), free throw percentage (74.6%) and assist/turnover ratio (0.9).

The squad entered the Southern Conference Tournament as the No. 2 seed, its highest seeding ever. After a firstround win over No. 7 ETSU 66-54, the Terriers fell to No. 3 Furman in the semifinals in a close 59-64 contest. Alexis Tomlin and Jackie Carman earned All-Tournament nods on the first and second teams, respectively. The season was not over after the SoCon Tournament, as the Terriers made their first-ever appearance in the WNIT, which was the program's first postseason appearance at the Division I level. Wofford played at Middle Tennessee in the first round.

During the 2020-21 season, the team was 13-11 overall and 7-7 in Southern Conference play. Highlights included a home win over Furman and a series sweep of East Tennessee State. Following the regular season, Lilly Hatton was named to the All-SoCon Second Team by both the coaches and media, while Jamari McDavid was named to the All-SoCon Third Team by the media and was the recipient of the Ann Lashley Inspiration Award. Among SoCon teams, the Terriers were ranked first in rebounding margin (+3.8), fourth in scoring offense (62.5 ppg) and third in scoring defense (61.3 ppg).

In the Southern Conference Tournament, the team entered as the #4 seed. After a 78-66 win over #5 seed UNCG, the Terriers earned a 75-64 victory against #8 seed East Tennessee State in the semifinals. With the Terriers in the championship game for the first time in school history, Wofford was defeated by #2 seed Mercer. Lilly Hatton and Helen Matthews were named to the All-Tournament Team.

The 2019-2020 season saw the team finish with its best conference record in program history (8-6). They started the season with a last second loss against Auburn, but that showed promise for the year. The Terriers won con-vincingly against Mercer on 1/11/20 for the first time since 1997. Wofford recorded their first road conference win against ETSU, which started a four-game win streak. Another history marker was when the squad won its first ever game at Samford, defeating them 69-63. By the end of the year, Lilly Hatton was honored as Freshman of the Year, along with Chloe Wanink, Da'Ja Green, and Cairo Booker receiving All-Conference accolades as well.


The 2018-19 season marked the turning point for Wofford women's basketball, as Garrity led the team to their first winning season since the 2001-02 campaign with a 16-15 overall record and 7-7 SoCon mark in his third year at the helm. They earned their highest SoCon tournament seed since 2002 as a No. 5 seed, while Garrity earned his first SoCon tournament win in the quarterfinals with a upset victory over No. 4 seed ETSU, 75-66. The win marked the first playoff win since the 2011-12 season and first semifinals appearance since 2002. Garrity led the team to the program's second best home record (12-1) while also landing a program-best five Terriers on all-conference teams: Chloe Wanink (First Team), Da'Ja Green (Second/Third Team), Cairo Booker (Third/All-Defensive Team), Niyah Lutz and Jackie Carman (All-Freshman Team). Additionally, the team led the SoCon in scoring offense (72.8 ppg), 3-point field goal percentage (.350), and turnover margin (+4.48), while becoming the highest scoring team (2,258 pts - 857 made field goals) and best 3-point shooting team (35.0% - 180 made threes) in program history.

Garrity led the Terriers to a 10-20 record in 2017-18. After losing star guard Chloe Wanink to a season-ending knee injury seven games into the season, Garrity lead a group of young players through the transition from high school to college ball. Despite a record of 10-20 and 3-11 in the conference, the Terriers played numerous close games and picked up just the program's eighth win all-time against Furman in a dominant 79-48 victory over the Paladins. Freshman guard Da'Ja Green was named Second-Team All Conference and joined her teammate and fellow freshman Jamari McDavid on the All-Freshman team.

In Garrity's first season at the helm he led the Terriers to a 13-17 record overall and helped Wofford win six games away from Spartanburg, a vast improvement from the 2015-16 season when the Terriers won just one game on the road. Chloe Wanink was named All-Southern Conference Second Team as she averaged 16 points and 5.8 rebounds per game.

In the three years prior to his arrival at Wofford, Garrity serves as head coach at Anderson University. From 2013-15, Anderson reached the NCAA Division II Tournament twice as an at-large selection and in 2015 advanced to the Sweet Sixteen. At Anderson, Garrity coached two South Atlantic Conference Players of the Year. In 2015-16, the Trojans were 23-7 overall, including a 79-55 win over Clemson to open the year. They were the South Atlantic Conference regular season champions with an 18-4 record and were nationally ranked in the top 25. The squad was an at-large selection to the NCAA Tournament. As the #5 seed, they advanced to the second round after a win over #4 seed Clayton State. Senior large the second round after a win over #4 seed Clayton State. Stringing together one of the program's best seasons in 2014-15, Garrity was tabbed South Atlantic Conference Coach of the Year. Garrity led the Trojans to a 27-5 overall record and a berth into the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16. Prior to the postseason run, Garrity became the first coach in conference history to win 20 league games, finishing the season with a 20-2 SAC record and a regular-season championship. Garrity also saw point guard Sierra Simpson earn SAC Player of the Year and SAC first team honors.

In his first season at Anderson in 2013-14, Garrity led the Trojans to a 16-14 overall record and an 11-11 mark in SAC play. Anderson placed three players on all-conference teams, including Simpson's All-SAC second team honor and Alexis Dillard's all-freshman team spot.

Garrity spent the 2012-13 season at Clemson University as the women's basketball assistant coach. With the Tigers, Garrity was in charge of scouting, practice planning, game scheduling, coordinating of the guards, community service and alumni relations. Garrity also monitored the academic success of the student-athletes.




