NEWS AND NOTES

• THANK YOU #12: Starting guard and two-year member of the Charlotte women's basketball family Mikayla Boykin had to announce that her collegiate career has ended abruptly after suffering the fifth ACL tear of her career vs. Illinois in the Dautona Beach Invitational on November 25th.

· GRINDING WIN: Mya McGraw dropped in a layup with 13 seconds left while the suffocating defense did its job as the Niners took a 59-58 victory over Cincinnati to wrap up the Daytona Beach Invitational. Dazia Lawrence scored a game-high 21 with Jada McMillian following up with an even dozen.

• SECOND HALF SHOOTING: Through six games this season, the 49ers are shooting 45% from the field in the second half to compare to a slower start of 32% over the first 20 minutes. So far, the third quarter has been the friendliest 10 minutes as the Niners are shooting at a 46% clip. As a team, Charlotte has shot over 40% in three of the six contests.

• 21 TO START: Charlotte's one-point win over Cincinnati was sparked by a 21-point first quarter on 11/26, their third period this season scoring atleast 20. The others? A 20-point third and 26-point fourth to erase the season-opening 21-point deficit vs. App. State on 11/8.

• 200! Charlotte Head Coach Cara Consuegra secured her 200th career win in the 55-47 win over VCU on November 20th. Consuegra became the program's all-time winningest coach last season at #176. Ironically, it was also the team's 200th win under Consueora when holding the opponent to under 50% shooting in the game.

• NCAA RECORD: The 49ers opened the new season with a bang on Tuesday, November 8th setting the NCAA record for largest fourth-quarter comeback in history by turning a 21-point deficit to App. State with 9:48 to play in the 4th into a 98-94 double OT win.
