KEY STORYLINES

LAST TIME

- **BALANCED ATTACK:** Wake Forest had a balanced scoring effort against Florida St. Thursday night with junior guard Jewel Spear leading the way offensively. All but one of the 10 Deacs who played found the score column.
- **ELISE'S CAREER NIGHT:** Sophomore guard Elise Williams had another strong game for the Demon Deacons, recording a career-best seven steals in the game to go along with nine points. This ended her nine-game streak of scoring in double figures. The seven steals marked the most by a Wake Forest player since Amber Campbell tallied seven in a 61-50 victory over Miami on Jan. 7, 2018.
- **BENCH PRODUCTION:** Off the bench, sophomore guard Alyssa Andrews and sophomore forward Marta Morales played quality minutes. When the two entered in the third quarter, Wake Forest went on a 9-3 scoring run to cut into the lead.

FEAR THE SPEAR

- **1,000:** With 17 points against Charlotte, Jewel Spear became the 30th player in program history to reach the 1,000-point milestone. Spear moved into 21st on the all-time scoring list against Miami and she only needs 11 points to tie Corinne Groves (2005-09) for 20th. Additionally, Spear passed Nicole Levesque (1991-94) for third on the all-time three-point list against Duke earlier this season.
- **FROM BEHIND THE ARC:** Through 22 games played, she has averaged 15.6 points per game and ranks 26th in the nation with 60 three-point makes and her 2.73 makes per game is 30th.
- **CONSISTENT SCORER:** Spear has netted 344 total points over the Demon Deacons' first 23 games this season.

SERIES HISTORY

- **ALL-TIME VS CLEMSON:** This marks the 79th time in program history that the two schools will play each other as the Deacs own a 25-53 mark against the Tigers.
- **LAST TIME AGAINST CLEMSON:** Despite a well-rounded performance from Olivia Summiel, the Wake Forest women's basketball team dropped a close road contest at Clemson, 60-59, on New Years Day. Summiel had an impressive performance to lead the Deacs, totaling 11 points, eight rebounds, five assists, one steal and one block. She led the Deacs in rebounds, assists, blocks and steals in the loss to the Tigers. Elise Williams finished the game with 12 points on 4-of-7 shooting from the field while Kaia Harrison posted eight points on 3-of-5 from the field. The Deacs also got strong contributions off the bench from Niyah Becker and Alyssa Andrews who combined to play 31 minutes, posting 10 combined points on 4-of-4 shooting while also having a pair of rebounds and assists combined.
- **A WIN WOULD:** Improve the Deacs to a stellar 11-1 at home this season.

FAST BREAK

FEAR THE SPEAR

- Jewel Spear was named a Preseason All-ACC selection and Wooden Award Watch List member heading into the 2022-23 season. This comes on the heels of being named a First Team All-ACC selection as a sophomore and both to the ACC All-Freshman Team and the ACC All-Tournament Team in 2020-21.
- With 17 points against Charlotte, Jewel Spear became the 30th player in program history to reach the 1,000-point milestone. Spear moved into 21st on the all-time scoring list against Miami and she only needs 11 points to tie Corinne Groves (2005-09) for 20th. Additionally, Spear passed Nicole Levesque (1991-94) for third on the all-time three-point list against Duke earlier this season.
- Through 22 games played, she has averaged 15.6 points per game and ranks 26th in the nation with 60 three-point makes and her 2.73 makes per game is 30th.
- Last season, Spear became just the fifth player in Wake Forest program history to earn first team honors, joining Ivana Raca (2020-21), Dearica Hamby (2013-14, 2014-15), Tracy Connor (1995-96) and Jen Hoover (Mitchell) (1989-90). Additionally, it marked just the second time in program history the Demon Deacons have had First Team All-ACC members in back-to-back seasons.
- A product of The Colony, Texas, Spear finished last season as the ACC leading scorer with 18.3 points per game. She became the first sophomore leading scorer in the conference since Alyssa Thomas did it a decade ago at Maryland in 2011-12. Additionally, it was just the third time in the last 20 seasons as the only other sophomore to lead the conference in scoring during that time was Alana Beard for Duke in 2001-02.
- Since stepping onto campus, Spear has been one of the best shooters in program history. She went into her junior season sixth in program history with 148 career three-point makes in just 56 career games. Last season, Spear finished second in single-season threes, trailing Cotelia Bond-Young (2004-05) by just seven makes.
- A year ago, Spear had one of the greatest performances in program history against ETSU on Dec. 13, netting 40 points, the second best mark in school history while also breaking the program record with 10 three-point makes.
- Spear went for 30-plus three times last season and 20-plus 10 times.
- Her rookie campaign was the best in program history from behind the arc. Spear holds the Wake Forest freshman record with 2.32 three-point makes per game. Additionally, her career mark of 40.0 percent shooting from behind the line is the best mark in program history.
- During her freshman campaign, Spear was named to the 2021 ACC All-Freshman Team, ACC All-Academic Team and ACC All-Tournament Team.

THIRD QUARTER JEWEL

- Against Virginia Tech and Louisville, junior guard Jewel Spear didn't miss in the third quarter, literally. Spear combined to go a perfect 8-for-8 from the field including 5-of-5 from the three-point line. Additionally, she was a perfect 8-for-8 from the free throw line.
- In the two games, she combined to average 14.5 points in the third quarter alone and it helped pace her to her two best performances in conference play this season.
- In those contests, she totaled 61 points (30.1 PPG) while also knocking down 9-of-19 threes (47.4 percent) and 20-of-22 free throw attempts (90.9 percent).

SPECIAL GAME AT MINNESOTA

- Junior guard Jewel Spear had a historic game against Minnesota, becoming the first player since Dearica Hamby in the 2013-14 season to record a double-double with 19-plus points in a road win over a Power-5 program. Additionally, Spear's performance marked the fifth such game since the start of the 2009-10 season:

- During Spear's 703 minutes played this season, the Demon Deacons are +66 when she is on the court.

LOCKDOWN DEFENSE

- Through 22 games this season, the Demon Deacons have done a stellar job of holding their opponents down in shooting and scoring. The Deacs have held their opponents to an average of 58.5 points allowed per game, ranking 55th nationally and third in the ACC.
- This is a massive improvement in the rankings from a season ago when the Deacs ended the year ranked 164th nationally and ninth in the ACC in the category at 63.0 points per game.
- Wake Forest has held their opponents to just 38.7 percent shooting from the field and just 27.8 percent shooting from behind the arc. The opponent shooting percentage ranks 116th in the nation, the Deacs also rank 74th with 3.9 blocks per game and the three-point defense ranks 39th. The Deacs have achieved a block on 9.4 percent of possessions this season, the fifth-highest rate in the Her Hoops Stats era (2009-10 to present).
- Over the last 18 games, the Demon Deacons have been playing their best defense of the season, holding 14 of 18 opponents to 61 points or less and eight opponents in that stretch to less than 55 points.
- Over the last eight ACC games, Wake Forest has forced 15.5 turnovers including 20 in the win over Pitt, 20 in the win over Louisville and 19 against nationally-ranked Duke.

LIV BLOCKS EVERYTHING

- Olivia Summiel recorded three blocks against Florida State Thursday. She now ranks 43rd nationally with 36 blocks on the season and her total already is the most by a Demon Deacon since the 2018-19 season when Ona Udoh had 41 blocks for the season. Additionally, Summiel entered the top 10 in single-season program history against Florida State.
- Her 1.57 blocks per game also rank third in the ACC and 58th nationally.
- As a team, the Deacs have blocked 3.9 shots per game which is close to a school record and ranks 74th nationally. The school record was set in 2010-11 when that squad averaged 4.3 blocks per game.

TEAMWORK

- Under head coach Megan Gebbia, the Demon Deacons have seen a huge increase in number of assists and percentage of assists on made baskets. Wake Forest currently ranks in the 89th percentile country, assisting on 62.4 percent of made baskets versus a season ago where their 45.0 percent of assists on made baskets ranked in the 4th percentile in the country.
- The Demon Deacons had their best game in terms of assisting the basketball in over three seasons as the 23 assists in the win over Longwood marked the most since Nov. 8, 2019 against College of Charleston. Additionally, sophomore guard Elise Williams tied her career-best with eight helpers in the victory. In total, seven Demon Deacons finished the night with at least one assist including five from guard Kaia Harrison and four from guard Jewel Spear.
- This season, the Demon Deacons have registered 15 or more assists in six games. Of note, the Deacs only recorded 15 or more assists in two games last season.

SUMMIEL'S CAREER NIGHT

- The Demon Deacons owned the glass against High Point, finishing +21 in the rebounding battle including a career-best performance from senior forward Olivia Summiel.
- With a game-high and career-high 16 rebounds, Summiel notched her second career double-double and the first for her this season. Additionally, that performance marked Summiel's 10th double-digit rebounding performance of her career. This marked the most rebounds by a Demon Deacon since Ivana Raca pulled down 19 in a victory at Virginia Tech on Jan. 17, 2021.

MORE NOTES

OWNING THE ARC

- The trio of senior Olivia Summiel, junior Jewel Spear and sophomore Elise Williams has been shooting the basketball from behind the arc at high clips. They have combined to knock down 116-of-317 attempts from distance or 36.5 percent. Spear has hit 60-of-163 (36.8 percent), Summiel has knocked down 26-of-73 (35.6 percent) and Williams has hit 30-of-81 (37.0 percent).
- Spear ranks second in the conference with 60 three pointers made (26th nationally) and ranks first in the conference with 2.73 threes made per game (30th nationally). Additionally, she is one of just three players in program history to reach 200 career threes, achieving the milestone against Virginia Tech.
- On the defensive side of the floor, Wake Forest is limiting opponents to just 27.8 percent shooting from behind the arc, ranking 39th in the country.
- The Demon Deacons have been one of the best teams in the ACC at shooting the three-point shot so far this season, knocking down 6.7 threes per game over their first 23 games. This also ranks 110th nationally.
- Last season, Megan Gebbia's American coached team was one of the best in the nation in three-point defense. The Eagles finished the season ranked third in the nation, allowing their opponents to shoot just 24.4 percent from behind the arc.

CRASHING THE BOARDS

- Wake Forest has tallied 793 rebounds in its first 23 games, winning the rebounding battle in 13 of 23 games.
- In the last seven seasons, Wake Forest has averaged better than 38 rebounds per game including averaging 40 or more during the 2013-14 season (40.5 rebounds per game) and the 2016-17 season (41.1 rebounds per game).

ELISE CONTINUES TO GROW

- Sophomore guard Elise Williams tallied double-digit points in nine-consecutive games prior to Thursday's game against Florida State.
- Against Georgia Tech, Elise Williams finished the game as the Deacs' high scorer, totaling 15 points on 6-of-12 shooting while also converting 3-of-3 free throws.
- Additionally, the Raleigh, N.C., native had a well-rounded game for the Deacs in the win over Rhode Island as she led the team in rebounding (6) and assists (5).

- The sophomore guard ended the conference opener against Virginia with a new career high on the glass, posting nine rebounds against the Cavaliers. In addition to the rebounding effort, Williams also finished in double figures in the score column, tallying 10 points in the loss, a team best. The sophomore was nearly perfect at the line, going 7-of-8 from the charity stripe which was also a team-high and career-best.
- In her first full season at Wake Forest a year ago, Williams was a key to the Deacs success last season contributing in nearly every area.
- She led the team in assists (87), steals (51) while ranking second for the Deacs in scoring (9.5 PPG), three-point makes (28) and blocks (13) in 2021-22.

TOP-25 SIGNING CLASS

- The Wake Forest women's basketball team announced the addition of three players during National Signing Day, marking the first official signing class for head coach Megan Gebbia.
- In Madisyn Jordan, Makaela Quimby and Rylie Theuerkauf, the Demon Deacons signed some of the best talent in the country. This marks the first time since the 2014 class that the Deacs have signed multiple top-100 players in the same class. - Additionally, ESPN ranked the Demon Deacons class as one of the top-25 in the country.

RETURNING PRODUCTION

- The only departure from last year's roster is Christina Morra, who graduated and is now playing professionally overseas.
- That means the 2022-23 Wake Forest women's basketball team returns 89.2 percent of their minutes, 87.2 percent of their scoring, 91.2 percent of their rebounding and 95.8 percent of their assists from a season ago.
- The returning scoring production is the most in the Atlantic Coast Conference.
- Additionally, the Demon Deacons return nine players who were on the NCAA Tournament team during the 2020-21 season.

YEAR ONE IN WINSTON-SALEM

Megan Gebbia was announced as the 11th head coach in the program history of Demon Deacons women's basketball on May 26, 2022.

In her 27 years in coaching, Coach Gebbia has helped her teams reach the NCAA Tournament 12 times including a Sweet Sixteen appearance as an assistant at Marist in 2007. She is American University's all-time winningest leader and the only head coach in program history to lead the Eagles to the NCAA Tournament. She has been named Patriot League Coach of the Year twice and has led the Eagles to five 20-plus win seasons.

"I'm extremely excited to join the incredible Wake Forest and Winston-Salem community and I am so thankful and appreciative of the opportunity to be the head women's basketball coach at Wake Forest University," said Gebbia. "I'm very appreciative of President Wenthe and John Currie for giving me the opportunity to fulfill a lifelong dream to coach in the premiere conference in the country and impact the lives of young women as we help them reach their full potential on and off the floor. Wake Forest presents an opportunity to be a part of a special brand at one of the top academic institutions in the country. My highest priority will be spending time and developing relationships with our current student-athletes, alumni and the young women who will make up the future of Demon Deacons basketball."

During her time at the helm of the American women's basketball program, Gebbia accumulated a record of 160-105 (.604) including a 106-49 (.684), both the highest totals in program history. She became the all-time wins leader in 2021-22 after her fifth 20-win season with the Eagles.

A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Gebbia's eight years with the Eagles have included three of the most historic seasons in program history starting with the then-program record 24-9 run during the 2014-15 season to lead the team to its first NCAA Tournament appearance. The Eagles topped that performance three years later with a 26-7 overall record to advance into the NCAA Tournament for the second time in program history.

The 23-8 season in 2021-22 ranks third in program history with all three seasons ending in trips to the NCAA Tournament.

Gebbia has mentored some of the top players in program history, including three Patriot League Players of the Year, five Patriot League Scholar-Athletes of the Year, one Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year, one CoSIDA Academic All-American First Team honoree, two CoSIDA Academic All-District selections, two ECAC Division I All-Stars, 25 All-Patriot League selections, and three NCAA Woman of the Year nominees.

Of the five Patriot League Scholar-Athletes of the Year, three were also selected as Patriot League Offensive Players of the Year with Jen Dumiak (2014-15), Emily Kinneston (2017-18) and Cecily Carl (2018-19), making American one of only two teams in league history to have players win both awards in a single season alongside Holy Cross (four from 1995-99).

In her first season in Washington, D.C., she became the winningest first-year coach in program history with a 22-10 record and the program's and Patriot League's first postseason at-large berth, facing Seton Hall in the First Round of the WNIT. A finalist for the Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year award, Gebbia's squad also ranked 13th among Division I women's basketball teams with a 3.510 GPA to land in the WBCA Academic Top-25 Honor Roll.

Prior to her time at American, she helped build Marist into one of the best mid-major programs in the country. During her 10 seasons with the Red Foxes, Marist advanced to the NCAA Tournament nine times. During that stretch, they won five NCAA Tournament games, defeating Power-5 programs Georgia, Iowa State and Ohio State.

The Red Foxes, who advanced to the 2007 Sweet 16, won the MAAC regular season title every season Gebbia was on staff and won the conference tournament title nine times. Much like at American, Gebbia and the Red Foxes created an impressive home court advantage, compiling a 114-14 record (.891) in her time in Poughkeepsie, N.Y. including an 85-5 record (.944) in conference home games.

Gebbia previously was an assistant coach at Wright State for one season in 2002-03 and an assistant coach at UMBC for six seasons from 1996-02.

She got her start as an assistant coach in 1995-96 at American University.

A native of Frederick, Md., Gebbia was a key player on the 1989 Maryland 2A State Championship Middletown High School women's basketball team. As a senior she was named Co-Player of the Year by The Frederick News-Post. She played college basketball at Towson University from 1990 to 1994.
