## STORYLINES

- Georgia Tech makes its return trip to Clemson on Thursday looking to get back to winning ways. The Yellow Jackets and Tigers tip at 8 p.m. on RSN. Fans can also tune-in to hear Richard Musterer's call on the GT Gameday App.
- Georgia Tech took the first meeting against Clemson this season and looks to complete the sweep on Thursday. With its win in January, Tech pushed its win streak to nine consecutive games against the Tigers and now leads the all-time series, 47-45. The Jackets have taken the last three meetings in Littlejohn Coliseum.
- In the first meeting between the teams just two weeks ago, Tech shot 50.8 percent from the field led by five players in double-figures. Tonie Morgan recorded a double-double with 13 points and 12 assists, while Cameron Swartz finished with a team-high 24 points. The Jackets scored 38 points in the paint in the win, dished out 23 assists and converted 18-of-22 free throw attempts.
- Tonie Morgan picked up her second ACC Rookie of the Week honor on Feb. 6 after helping the Jackets to a 1-1 week, topping No. 15/13 NC State. Morgan nearly averaged a double-double on the week, pitching in 13.5 points and 8.0 assists per game. Morgan earned her first rookie of the week honor on Jan. 23. She is only the second player to earn multiple rookie honors in the conference this season - Ta'Niya Latson (FSU) being the other freshman.
- The Yellow Jackets captured their third ACC win of the season in statement fashion last Thursday against No. 15/13 NC State, 68-62. Three Yellow Jackets contributed double-figure scoring numbers led by Tonie Morgan with 17 points to match her career-high. Tech won the second half, 35-29, after the teams stood tied at intermission. Nerea Hermosa scored 10 of her season-high 14 points in the second half to help lift Tech to victory. It marked the first win over a ranked opponent this season.
- Tonie Morgan dished out a career-high 12 assists against Clemson on Jan. 26. She is one of only five players in the ACC to record a game with 10-plus assists, and one of four with 12-plus. Only Olivia Miles (Notre Dame) and Taina Mair (BC) have recorded more at 14 and 13 assists, respectively.
- Nerea Hermosa has led Tech on the glass in the last two games - Miami and NC State. In Tech's last three games, Hermosa has averaged 11.7 points and 6.3 rebounds per game, with two double-figure scoring outings. She has led Tech on the boards in seven games this season.
- Kayla Blackshear nearly missed a double-double against Clemson, finishing with a career-best 19 points to go along with eight rebounds. Blackshear led the Jackets on the glass for the ninth time this season. She has now scored in double-figures in six of the last eight games.
- Tonie Morgan has flirted with a triple-double multiple times this season as the freshman was two assists shy against Furman, finishing with 11 points, 10 rebounds and eight assists - she also recorded 17 points, 10 assists and six rebounds against NCSU. The last Yellow Jacket to record a triple-double dates all the way back to Milli Martinez on Feb. 23, 2002.

## STANDOUT MORGAN

Freshman Tonie Morgan has put together quite the freshman resume this season. Currently third on the team in scoring, Morgan leads Tech with 82 assists and four double-doubles on the season. She has collected two ACC Rookie of the Week honors and is second on the team in rebounding.

In the ACC, Morgan is one of only four freshmen to own a double-double this season - she is one of only three to own multiple double-doubles. Additionally, she is one of only four players overall in the league to own a double-double on points and assists.

## ACC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK X 2

On Feb. 6, Tonie Morgan collected her second ACC Rookie of the Week honor. She helped the Jackets to a 1-1 week, including a win over No. 15/13 NC State on Feb. 2. Morgan averaged 13.5 points, 8.0 assists and 5.0 rebounds per game in Tech's games against the Wolfpack and Miami. She recorded her fourth double-double of the season with 17 points and 10 assists against NC State, and followed with a 10-point performance at Miami.

She picked up her first weekly ACC Rookie of the Week on Jan. 23. Morgan helped Georgia Tech to a 1-1 mark, picking up a win against Syracuse. The Yellow Jacket averaged a double-double on the week behind 15.5 points and 11.5 rebounds per game. Against the Orange, Morgan recorded her second career double-double with 16 points and 15 rebounds, before following up with 15 points and eight rebounds at No. 17 North Carolina.

Morgan is the first freshman Yellow Jacket to earn multiple rookie of the week honors since Elizabeth Balogun and Elizabeth Dixon did so in 2018-19.

## GETTING A RANKED WIN

Georgia Tech collected its first ranked win over an opponent this season on Feb. 2, defeating No. 15/13 NC State in McCamish Pavilion, 68-62. Last season, the Yellow Jackets defeated three ranked opponents:

Under head coach Nell Fortner's guidance, Tech is 8-11 when competing against nationally ranked opponents.

## HERMOSA SHINING

Nerea Hermosa has been a solid contributor as of late, adding double-figure scoring numbers to the scoreboard the two of the last three games, most recently contributing a season-high 14 points in the win over NC State. With seven rebounds against the Wolfpack, Hermosa led Tech on the glass for the sixth time this season. She also contributed 12 points and seven rebounds in Tech's win over Clemson on Jan. 26, playing 25-plus minutes in both outings.

At Miami, Hermosa led the Jackets on the glass for the second consecutive outing, and seventh time this season.

## LOGGING SEASON-HIGHS

Tech's game against Clemson on Jan. 26 saw several season-bests, including:

- \*shooting 50.8 percent from the field;
- \*tallying 85 points with a balanced offense;
- \*Jackets connected on 31 field goals made;
- \*Cameron Swartz Nerea Hermosa recorded individual season-bests with 24 and 12 points, respectively;
- \*Kayla Blackshear chipped in a career-high 19 points.

## DOUBLE FIGURES

Swartz leads Tech with 16 games scoring in double-figures, right ahead of Jackson with 11. Swartz also had led Tech in scoring in a team-high nine games.

### UNSTOPPABLE MORGAN

Freshman Tonie Morgan was unstoppable against Syracuse, dropping her second career double-double with 16 points and a career-high 15 rebounds. The last time a Yellow Jacket pulled down 15 rebounds dates back to Lorela Cubaj with 16 at Wake Forest on Feb. 27, 2022.

The last time a freshman pulled down 15 or more rebounds was Elizabeth Dixon against Duke on Jan. 10, 2019 when the Jacket owned 17. That same season, freshman Elizabeth Bologun also recorded 17 rebounds in a game - at Boston College on Jan. 3.

Heading into Thursday's game at Clemson, amongst all freshmen in the ACC, Morgan ranked fifth in scoring and Kara Dunn ranked ninth. Morgan leads all freshmen in rebounding at 5.48 rebounds per game and is second in assists at 3.57.

### ON THE GLASS

Sophomore Kayla Blackshear continues to lead Georgia Tech on the glass, averaging a team-high 6.4 rebounds per game. In the ACC, Blackshear ranks 13th overall in rebounds per game and second overall in offensive rebounds per game (3.39 per game).

In ACC only games, Georgia Tech is fifth in offensive rebounds per game, averaging 12.33 per game (Syracuse leads the ACC at 14.23). Blackshear is ninth in overall rebounds in ACC games only and is tied for first in the ACC in offensive rebounds per game in league games (3.58 average).

### PRODUCTIVE BLACKSHEAR

Sophomore Kayla Blackshear put together a string of four impressive outings, highlighted by a pair of double-doubles against Wake Forest and Miami. The Jacket nearly missed her third-straight double-double against Duke with 14 points and eight rebounds. She hit double-figure scoring totals in all four games. Over the the four game stretch, Blackshear averaged 14.5 points and 9.3 rebounds per game.

She topped her career-high in scoring, originally set at WFU, against Miami with 18 points. At Wake Forest, Blackshear secured a personal-best 13 rebounds.

### CAREER-HIGH IN FIRST CAREER START

Freshman Kara Dunn earned her first collegiate start of her career at Louisville and wasted no time making it productive. The Dallas, Ga., native led the Jackets offensively in the outing with 17 points. Dunn shot 50.0 percent (6-12) from the floor, hitting a pair of three-pointers, and went a perfect 3-for-3 from the free throw line in personal-high 33:54 of playing time.

Freshman Inés Noguero also earned her first collegiate career

### OFFENSIVE OUTPUT

Florida State scored 99 points against Georgia Tech on Jan.

1, marking the highest offensive output by an opponent this season. In fact, the last opponent to score 99-plus points dates back to March 2, 2008 when Virginia scored 103 in double-overtime (GT scored 101). That same season (2007-08), Maryland also scored 99 points in double-overtime (GT scored 95). In regulation play, the last team to score 99-plus points was No. 4 North Carolina in a 99-78 loss on Jan. 5, 2008.

### BIANCA HITS 1,000 CAREER POINTS

In Georgia Tech's game at Virginia, graduate transfer Bianca Jackson joined the elite 1,000-career points club with a three-pointer in the third quarter. Needing just 14 points to hit the mark, Jackson finished with 14 points, five rebounds, four steals and three assists in the contest.

Jackson reached the milestone after producing 392 points at South Carolina, 440 points at Florida State and 168 points at Georgia Tech.

### LENDING A HAND

In Georgia Tech's game against Furman on Dec. 21, Georgia Tech dished out a season-high 24 assists with six different Yellow Jackets recording multiple on the day. Tonie Morgan led the way with eight.

For the second time this season, Georgia Tech dished out 20 or more assists with 20 against Miami for the second highest total this season. The Jackets once again dished out 20 or more assists against Clemson, recording 23 on the day.

## SEEING DOUBLE

Against Furman, Tonie Morgan recorded the first double-double by a Yellow Jacket this season with 11 points and 10 rebounds. It marked the first time a freshman recorded a double-double since Elizabeth Balogun and Elizabeth Dixon each recorded double-doubles their freshman seasons in 2018-19. Balogun finished the season with two double-doubles, while Dixon recorded four.

Morgan recorded her second double-double of the season against Syracuse (Jan. 19) with 16 points and a career-high 15 rebounds. She logged her third double-double with 13 points and 12 assists against Clemson (Jan. 26) and fourth against NC State (Feb. 2) with 17 points and 10 assists. She leads the team in double-doubles this season.

## SHOOTING STRUGGLES

Georgia Tech has only been held to under 30.0 percent shooting three times this season - versus South Florida (27.9), at Boston College (28.2) and versus Florida State (27.3). The Jackets were held to exactly 30.0 percent shooting in its first game against Belmont in the Gulf Coast Showcase.

When held to under 30.0 percent shooting, Tech fell in all three games and lost the rebounding battle. Tech's best shooting percentage this season was 48.2 percent (27-56) versus Air Force.

## FIVE-GAME SWING

Georgia Tech spent a three week span away from McCamish Pavilion, competing in a Thanksgiving tournament before a pair of road games. During the five-game swing, three Yellow Jackets averaged double-figure scoring totals, paced by Bianca Jackson (14.2 ppg), Cameron Swartz (12.2 ppg) and Tonie Morgan (10.8 ppg). Morgan also paced the team in rebounds (5.8 rpg) and assists (11) - Kayla Blackshear followed at 5.4 rebounds per game. The Yellow Jackets shot 78.7 percent (70-89) from the free throw line, led by Swartz's 20-for-23 (87.0 percent) effort. Jackson followed at 86.7 percent (13-for-15).

## ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE

Closing out the ACC/Big Ten Challenge with the 15th installment, Georgia Tech ended the series on a high note with a win at Michigan State. The win was the first on the road in the Challenge since 2009 for the Yellow Jackets, who finished the Challenge with a 9-6 record. In the Challenge, GT secured wins over Michigan State (A-2022), Wisconsin (H-2019), Purdue (H-2017), Illinois (H-2013), Nebraska (H-2011), Northwestern (H-2010), Penn State (2009), Michigan State (H-2008) and Iowa (2007).

The ACC won the 2022 edition of the Challenge, marking the 11th ACC/Big Ten Challenge win and moved its all-time advantage in the series to 11-1-3. Collectively, the ACC finished with a 112-80 record against the Big Ten in the Challenge.

On Nov. 29, the ACC, Southeastern Conference and ESPN announced the formation of the ACC/SEC Challenge for men's and women's basketball, scheduled to begin as part of the 2023-24 season. Each of the 28 games (30 starting in 2025-26) will be carried on an ESPN platform.

## GULF COAST SHOWCASE BREAKOUT

Freshman Tonie Morgan put together a pair of impressive performances in the first two games of the Gulf Coast Showcase. The Tallahassee, Fla., native led Tech offensively (vs. USF, vs. Air Force), producing back-to-back double-figure scoring performances to average 15.5 points per game. Morgan also led Tech on the glass in both games for a team-best 8.0 rebounds per game average and assists, totaling nine (4.5 assists per game average). In the three games, Morgan averaged 11.7 points, 6.7 rebounds and 26.1 minutes per game, while accumulating a team-high 10 assists.

Bianca Jackson led Georgia Tech in the three-game tournament, averaging a team-best 13.3 points per game. She dropped a season-high 24 points against Belmont in the final game, helping the Jackets overcome a five-point deficit late in the ballgame to secure the win. One point shy of matching her career-high in scoring, Jackson finished the tournament shooting 87.5 percent (7-8) from the free throw line and 41.7 percent from the field.

## SCORELESS FROM THREE

Georgia Tech held the Lady Bulldogs of Georgia scoreless from three-point distance on Nov. 20. Georgia went 0-for-7 from long range, marking the first opponent this season held without a three-pointer.

The Yellow Jackets have held at least one opponent a season without a three-pointer in the Nell Fortner Era. The last time dates back to last season against Kennesaw State (11/11/21), which went 0-for-6. In 2020-21 season, Tulane (12/3/20) was held scoreless from three-point range (0-11) and in 2019-20, Notre Dame (2/2/20) went without a three-pointer (0-7).

## STIFLING DEFENSE

Nell Fortner teams have become known for their stifling defense, and this squad started no different. In Georgia Tech's first three games of the season (Georgia State, Kennesaw State and Auburn), they held every opponent to under 30.0 percent shooting. Georgia was the first program to shoot over 30.0 percent, connecting on 45.2 percent (28-62) from the field. The best shooting percentage by opponent to date was Florida State (1/1), shooting 49.2 percent (32-65). Through 18 games, Georgia Tech has held nine opponents to under 35 percent shooting.

In the Nell Fortner era at Georgia Tech (since 2019-20), the lowest field goal percentage an opponent was held to was 16.7 percent (9-54) by Georgia State on Nov. 20, 2019. The highest field goal percentage by an opponent is 56.4 percent (31-55) by South Carolina in the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 on March 28, 2021.

## REBOUNDING GAME

Through Tech's first 23 games, the Yellow Jackets have averaged 37.4 rebounds per game, paced by Kayla Blackshear at 6.4 rebounds per game. Tech has won the battle on the glass in 12 outings, including five ACC opponents.

Auburn proved heavy on the boards and finished with 29 offensive rebounds, converting for 22 second chance points. With its 29 offensive boards, the Tigers were able to attempt 26 shots. The 29 offensive rebounds marked the most by an opponent in the Nell Fortner era at GT. The previous high was 19 twice - at Clemson (1/7/21) and at Florida State (2/18/21).

The last time an opponent secured 29 offensive rebounds or more dates back to Tech's game at Tennessee on Nov. 17, 2013 when the Lady Vols recorded 33 offensive boards. Tennessee finished with 32 defensive rebounds for a total of 65 boards and took the game, 87-76. Since the 2013-14 season, Georgia Tech has allowed opponents to pull down 20 or more offensive rebounds 21 times.

## HOW MANY ATTEMPTS?

In Georgia Tech's game at Auburn on Nov. 16, the Tigers recorded 76 field goal attempts, marking the most field goal attempts by an opponent in the Nell Fortner era (since 2019-20). In her four seasons, only two opponents have attempted 70 or more field goals, the other being Notre Dame (70) last season on Feb. 17, 2022.

While Auburn attempted 76 field goals, they were held to a mere 26.3 percent (20-76) efficiency thanks to Georgia Tech's defense.

## APPROACHING A MILESTONE

Georgia Tech's Nerea Hermosa is closing in on a prestigious career milestone, the 1,000 career points club. Currently, Hermosa owns 869 career points in three seasons, needing just 131 points to become the 34th player in Georgia Tech women's basketball history to hit 1,000 career points.

Last season, the Yellow Jackets lauded two players into the club - Lotta-Maj Lahtinen and Lorela Cubaj.

Fifth-year transfer Bianca Jackson hit the prestigious mark in Tech's game at Virginia, finishing with 14 points to hit 1,000 career points on the dot. She accomplished the feat in 126 career games between South Carolina, Florida State and Georgia Tech.

## ACC PREDICTIONS

Georgia Tech was picked to finish eighth in the preseason Atlantic Coast Conference poll, as picked by the Blue Ribbon Panel. The Yellow Jackets finished sixth in the league last season and advanced to their second consecutive NCAA Tournament.

However, Tech lost three of its starters to graduation and eligibility, including its leading rebounder (Lorela Cubaj - 11.1 rpg) and scorer (Lotta-Maj Lahtinen - 10.9 ppg). Cubaj, who averaged a double-double behind 10.0 ppg, led the ACC in rebounding. Cubaj finished ninth in the nation in rebounds and 16th in rebounds per game.

## ANN MEYERS DRYSDALE WATCH LIST

Georgia Tech fifth-year transfer, Cameron Swartz was one of 20 shooting guards named to the watch list. The reigning ACC Most Improved Player, Swartz transferred to Georgia Tech for her fifth year of eligibility after leading Boston College in scoring last season, averaging 16.1 points per game. The local native ranked sixth overall in the ACC in scoring and earned an all-ACC first team nod.

Swartz was one of five players from the ACC on the list, joining Celeste Taylor (Duke), Hailey Van Lith (Louisville), Jakia Brown-Turner (NC State), and Ashley Owusu (Virginia Tech).

## HITTING THE PORTAL

Georgia Tech hit the transfer portal over the summer and welcomed two transfers to The Flats for their fifth seasons of eligibility. Joining the 2022-23 roster are Bianca Jackson (Florida State) and Cameron Swartz (Marietta, Ga.)

Jackson - A native of Montgomery, Ala., Jackson played the last two seasons at Florida State, helping the Seminoles to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. At FSU, she appeared in 45 contests, starting 26 and averaged 9.8 points per game in two years. Last season, she finished third on the team in scoring, posting 6.7 ppg, switching to a shooting guard. Her first season with the Seminoles, Jackson averaged a team-best 14.1 ppg as a redshirt-junior. She played her first two seasons at South Carolina (2017-19) before transferring to Florida State. Jackson played in 57 games in two seasons, helping the Gamecocks reach the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 in 2019. She was named SEC All-Freshman Team in 2017-18.

Swartz - A three-year starter at Boston College (2019-22), Swartz averaged 12.9 points per game over her career as an Eagle. She played in 82 games, starting 71. Swartz started all 33 games her senior season, earned all-ACC first team recognition and was named ACC Most Improved Player. She averaged a team-high 16.1 points per game, led the team in three-pointers (60) and three-point percentage (35.5 percent). Swartz led the ACC in scoring in conference play and finished sixth overall. Last season, she increased her scoring average by 6.5 points, rebounding by 1.2, field goal percentage by plus-four percent and 3-point field goal percentage by over 10 percent from her junior season. Swartz played her freshman season at Colorado, taking the floor in seven games.

Also arriving from the transfer portal, Kayla Blackshear was a mid-year transfer from Alabama, joining the team in January. Blackshear appeared in the Crimson Tide's first three games of the 2021-22 season, averaging 10.2 minutes per game off the bench. Blackshear contributed 5.0 points and 3.0 rebounds per game in the first three games.

## BIG SHOES TO FILL

Georgia Tech will have some big shoes to fill this season, having lost three of its starters from last season, including its leading scorer and rebounder. The Yellow Jackets lost All-American

starters Lorela Cubaj and Lotta-Maj Lahtinen, who led the team in rebounding (11.1 rpg) and scoring (10.9 ppg), respectively. Cubaj, an honorable mention all-American last season, was the Georgia College Player of the Year for the second straight year and was selected No. 18 overall in the WNBA Draft. Cubaj finished the season as the ACC's leading rebounder by nearly two rebounds per game above Elizabeth Kitley (VT) in second place.

### GOING DANCING

Under the direction of head coach Nell Fortner, Georgia Tech has made back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2021 and 2022, marking the first time Tech has made consecutive appearances since six-straight from 2007-12.

Tech reached the Sweet 16 for just the second time in program history in 2021. Last season's appearance marked the 11th in the Big Dance. The Jackets fell to Kansas in the first round, traveling to Palo Alto, Calif., for the contest.

### ACC WINS

Nell Fortner has guided Georgia Tech to three-straight seasons of double-digit ACC wins, marking the first time in program history for such a feat.

Prior to Fortner's arrival, Georgia Tech had posted double-digit ACC wins just once, going 12-4 in 2011-12. Tech's outright third-place finish in 2021 marked the best overall finish in program history as the Jackets tied for third in 2012.

### STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Georgia Tech will face a challenging schedule in 2022-23 with 12 teams having gone to postseason play in 2021-22. Of those 12 teams, 10 went to the NCAA Tournament, including five reaching the Sweet 16 or beyond.

The Yellow Jackets will also have some holiday fun, participating in the Gulf Coast Showcase in Estero, Fla., over Thanksgiving week. Tech will face South Florida in the first game followed by either Air Force or Michigan in its second game. Tech has the potential to face Baylor, Belmont, Saint Louis or Villanova in the final game. The tournament will be played at Hertz Arena and streamed on FloHoops.

### HOME SWEET HOME

All time, the Yellow Jackets are 408-227 (.620) when playing at home. The Jackets have won the last nine-consecutive home openers dating back to the 2012-13 season. Last season, Tech defeated Kennesaw State in its home opener, 72-45.

## HEAD COACH NELL FORTNER

4th Season • Texas '82

Nell Fortner was named the sixth head coach of Georgia Tech women's basketball on April 9, 2019. One of the most successful coaches in women's basketball history, Fortner has compiled a 375-229 (.625) record as a head coach at the collegiate, professional and international levels. She has led teams to Big Ten (Purdue – 1997) and Southeastern Conference (Auburn – 2009) championships and, perhaps most notably, coached the United States national team to three international titles from 1997-2000, including the gold medal at the 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney, Australia. Fortner is the winningest coach in the history of the USA women's basketball national team, having compiled a 101-14 (.878) record. In addition to the 2000 Olympics championship, she also led the team to the gold medal at the 1998 World Championship in Berlin, Germany and the 1998 William Jones Cup in Taipei, Taiwan. At the collegiate level, Fortner has 12 seasons of experience as a head coach – one at Purdue (1996-97), eight at Auburn (2004-12) and four at Georgia Tech (2019-22) – and has compiled a 232-159 (.598) overall record in the college ranks.
