CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has a 5-3 home record, won one of three games against No. 23 South Carolina at three different sites last weekend.
- The Tigers are averaging 6.8 runs per game and hitting .295 with a .456 slugging percentage, .385 on-base percentage and 30 steals.

- The pitching staff has a 4.50 ERA, .273 opponents' batting average and 2.82 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .962.

EAST TENNESSEE STATE OVERVIEW

- East Tennessee State, who has a 1-3 road record and is averaging 6.0 runs per game, is led by sixth-year Head Coach Joe Pennucci.
- The Buccaneers won two of three games against Marist last weekend. They are hitting .296 and have a 4.69 ERA and .973 fielding percentage.
- Cameron Sisneros is hitting .366, Tommy Barth is batting .360 with five steals and Garrett Wallace is hitting .318.

PRESBYTERIAN OVERVIEW

- Presbyterian, who is averaging 4.8 runs per game entering its game on Tuesday, is led by 19th-year Head Coach Elton Pollock.
- The Blue Hose won one of three home games against Georgia State. They are hitting .249 and have a 6.10 ERA and .962 fielding percentage.
- Brody Fahr is hitting .395, Joel Drago has three homers and six RBIs and Tanner Smith and Luke Gibson have two saves apiece.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson is 4-1 when committing more than one error and 0-5 when committing exactly one error.
- Clemson's starting pitchers have a 3.98 ERA, .233 opponents' batting average and 50 strikeouts against 12 walks in 43.0 innings pitched.
- Benjamin Blackwell, Cam Cannarella and Chad Fairey have all reached base in all 11 games in 2023.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,531 fans per home date (8), the 12th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of March 5).

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

- Entering 2023, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 29 straight seasons.

CAPTAINS

- Ryan Ammons, Riley Bertram, Jackson Lindley and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains in the pre-season.
- Benjamin Blackwell, Chad Fairey and Mac Starbuck were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Tristan Bissetta, Jacob Jarrell and Rocco Reid were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

SWIPING BAGS

- A key to Clemson's scoring (6.8 runs per game) has been its ability to steal bases, as it has 30 in 11 games (2.7 per game).
- The 30 steals are already approaching the 2022 Clemson season total of 32 steals in 58 games.
- Clemson totaled 17 steals in the season-opening series against Binghamton, including 11 in the season opener, one shy of the school record.
- Clemson has at least one steal in 10 of the 11 games.
- Ten different Tigers have contributed to the team's 30 stolen bases.
- Benjamin Blackwell leads the team with nine steals, while Cam Cannarella is second with seven steals.

BLACKWELL GLAD HE RETURNED

- Senior infielder Benjamin Blackwell decided late in the process last summer to return for his fifth collegiate season in 2023.
- The Tigers are glad he did, and he is putting up big numbers along the way, including a team-high nine stolen bases.
- He is hitting .366 with three doubles, a triple, nine RBIs, six runs, seven walks and a .469 on-base percentage in 11 games in 2023.
- He has a solid .970 fielding percentage as Clemson's starting shortstop, committing only one error in 33 chances.
- In his two-year Tiger career, he is hitting .333 with 13 doubles, two triples, three homers, 42 RBIs, 58 runs and 13 steals in 69 games.

CANNARELLA EMERGING AS FRESHMAN

- Freshman Cam Cannarella has stepped right in to become the everyday starter in center field as a freshman in 2023.
- He is hitting a team-high .435 with four doubles, a triple, nine RBIs, 12 runs, a .471 on-base percentage and seven steals in 11 games.
- He has four walks against only three strikeouts in 46 at-bats.
- He is hitting .478 with runners on base, .474 with runners in scoring position and .444 with two outs.
- He has a team-high six multiple-hit games.
- He has started his college career on an 11-game hitting streak.
- He won the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the South Carolina three-game series from March 3-5, as he was 6-for-13 with three doubles.

SMITH STELLAR FROM LEFT SIDE

- Freshman lefthander Tristan Smith was one of Clemson's most highly rated signees, and he has gotten off to a strong start.
- He is 0-0 with one save, an 0.00 ERA, a .174 opponents' batting average and nine strikeouts against three walks in 2023.
- He has pitched 7.0 innings over four appearances (two starts).
- He has only allowed one extra-base hit (double).

- He allowed just two hits and no runs with five strikeouts in 4.2 innings pitched in a start against No. 23 South Carolina on March 4.

WRIGHT WHERE HE LEFT OFF

- Junior infielder Blake Wright has picked up right in 2023 where he left off during his stellar 2023 sophomore season.
- He is hitting .381 with five doubles, two homers, 11 RBIs, 12 runs and four steals in 11 games in 2023.
- He has seven walks against only two strikeouts, and he has a .643 slugging percentage and .451 on-base percentage.
- He has committed only two errors in 27 chances (.926 fielding percentage) as the everyday starter at third base.
- He went 4-for-4 with two homers, three RBIs, three runs, a walk and three steals on opening day against Binghamton on Feb. 17.
- In his career, he is hitting .328 with 15 doubles, 14 homers, 56 RBIs, 45 runs and a .386 on-base percentage in 67 games (60 starts).
