CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has an 0-2 neutral record, won one of three games at Georgia Tech last weekend.
- The Tigers are averaging 7.0 runs per game and hitting .291 with a .444 slugging percentage, .391 on-base percentage and 53 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 4.90 ERA, .269 opponents' batting average and 2.43 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .973.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON OVERVIEW

- College of Charleston, who has yet to play a neutral game and is averaging 5.7 runs per game, is led by sixth-year Head Coach Chad Holbrook.
- The Cougars swept Towson in three one-run games last weekend. They are hitting .266 and have a 3.67 ERA and .957 fielding percentage.

- Will Baumhofer is hitting .355 with nine steals, Joseph Mershon has 10 steals and William Privette has a team-high four saves.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson is the designated visiting team against College of Charleston and occupies the first-base dugout.
- Clemson scored three runs in the eighth inning to defeat College of Charleston 4-3 at Doug Kingsmore Stadium on March 14, 2023.
- Only two Tigers (Riley Bertram, Benjamin Blackwell) have played all 25 games in 2023.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,428 fans per home date (16), the 11th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of March 26).
- Entering 2023, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 29 straight seasons.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is tied for fifth place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 2-4 league mark.
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is tied for 11th place.

SWIPING BAGS

- A key to Clemson's scoring has been its ability to steal bases, as it has 53 in 25 games (2.1 per game).
- The 53 steals are already more than the 2022 Clemson team's season total of 32 steals in 58 games.
- Clemson has at least one steal in 19 of the 25 games and multiple steals in 13 games.
- A total of 11 different Tigers have contributed to the team's 53 stolen bases.
- Clemson has totaled 100+ steals in 18 seasons. The last time doing so was in 2013, when it had 111 steals.
- Benjamin Blackwell has a team-high 14 steals, while Cam Cannarella is second on the team with 13 steals.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

• Clemson totaled 17 steals in the season-opening series against Binghamton, including 11 in the season opener, one shy of the school record.

CAPTAINS

- Ryan Ammons, Riley Bertram, Jackson Lindley and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains in the pre-season.
- Benjamin Blackwell, Chad Fairey and Mac Starbuck were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Tristan Bissetta, Jacob Jarrell and Rocco Reid were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

AMICK PUTS NAME IN TIGER LORE

- Sophomore infielder and catcher Billy Amick had been a bench player in his career until March 10, when he put his stamp in Tiger lore.
- He entered the series opener against Georgia State in the sixth inning as a pinch-hitter and had a single later in the game.
- In the ninth inning with the Tigers trailing 8-5, he blasted a 446-foot grand slam with two outs to give Clemson a 9-8 walkoff victory.
- It was his first career homer in his 12th career game and second year at Clemson. It was also the third walkoff grand slam in Tiger history.
- He is hitting .300 with a homer, triple, eight RBIs, five runs and a .364 on-base percentage in 11 games (seven starts) in 2023.
- In his career, he is hitting .224 with a homer, triple, eight RBIs and six runs in 20 games (10 starts).

BLACKWELL GLAD HE RETURNED

- Senior infielder Benjamin Blackwell decided late in the process last summer to return for his fifth collegiate season in 2023.
- The Tigers are glad he did, and he is putting up solid numbers along the way, including a team-high 14 stolen bases.
- He is hitting .337 with six doubles, a triple, homer, 13 RBIs, 14 runs, 14 walks and a .442 on-base percentage in 25 games in 2023.
- He has a team-high 11 multiple-hit games.
- He is one of two Tigers to play and start every game in 2023.
- He has a .966 fielding percentage as Clemson's starting shortstop, committing only three errors in 87 chances and none in the last 11 games.
- In his two-year Tiger career, he is hitting .330 with 16 doubles, two triples, four homers, 46 RBIs, 66 runs and 18 steals in 83 games.
- He has committed only 14 errors in his two seasons at Clemson, good for a solid .955 fielding percentage.

CANNARELLA EMERGING AS FRESHMAN

- Freshman Cam Cannarella has stepped right in to become the everyday starter in center field as a freshman in 2023.
- He is hitting .418 with nine doubles, a triple, two homers, 19 RBIs, 30 runs, a .491 on-base percentage and 13 steals in 22 games.
- He leads or is tied for the team lead in batting average, runs, hits (38), doubles, triples, total bases (55) and RBIs.
- He also leads the team in slugging percentage (.604) and on-base percentage.
- He has 10 multiple-hit games, including one three-hit game, one four-hit game and two five-hit games.
- He is hitting .421 with runners on base, .433 with runners in scoring position and .400 with two outs.
- He started his career on a 14-game hitting streak and has reached base via a hit or walk in all 22 games.

- He won the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the South Carolina three-game series from March 3-5, as he was 6-for-13 with three doubles.
- He went 5-for-6 with four runs in Clemson's 9-8 walkoff win over Georgia State on March 10.
- He joined Cooper Ingle, who also had five hits in the game, as the first Tigers with five hits in a game since 2012.
- Cannarella and Ingle became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.
- He went 5-for-6 with two doubles, two RBIs and three runs in the 14-9 win over Duke in the second game of a doubleheader on March 18.
- He hit a three-run walkoff homer to lift Clemson to an 8-5 win over Winthrop on March 21.

GARRIS GARNERING ATTENTION

- Reed Garris was a catcher as a freshman in 2022, but has emerged as a dependable reliever in 2023.
- He is 2-0 with a 2.63 ERA, .200 opponents' batting average and 19 strikeouts against two walks in 13.2 innings pitched over 11 appearances.
- He has not allowed a homer.
- He is holding opponents to a .167 batting average with runners on base and .100 batting average with runners in scoring position.
- He has only allowed one of eight inherited baserunners to score.

GRICE TWO-WAY PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- Junior Caden Grice is contributing as both a lefthander on the mound and slugger at the plate in 2023.
- He is 1-0 with a 3.21 ERA .180 opponents' batting average and 21 strikeouts in 14.0 innings pitched over four starts on the mound in 2023.
- He is holding opponents to .087 with runners on base, .105 with runners in scoring position and .125 with two outs.
- He is hitting .309 with five homers, six doubles, 16 RBIs, 21 runs and three steals in 21 games (20 starts) at the plate in 2023.
- He has a .568 slugging percentage and .383 on-base percentage.
- He is hitting .440 with four homers, three doubles, 11 RBIs, a 1.040 slugging percentage and .464 on-base percentage in six ACC games.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball and ACC Co-Player-of-the-Week on March 27.
- He became the 15th Tiger to earn ACC weekly honors at least three times in a career, while it was his fourth career national weekly honor.
- In five games, he totaled four homers and 11 RBIs, and he also earned the win in a starting role on the mound at Georgia Tech on March 26.
- On March 26, he hit two homers with five RBIs, and he pitched 5.0 strong innings with six strikeouts to earn the win in a starting role.
- In his career, he is 3-1 with a 4.50 ERA, .211 opponents' batting average and 42 strikeouts in 30.0 innings pitched over 16 appearances.
- In his career, he is hitting .283 with 32 homers, a triple, 26 doubles, 109 RBIs, 106 runs and 11 steals in 130 games (129 starts).

INGLE NOT JUST A SINGLES HITTER

- Junior catcher Cooper Ingle has proven why he is one of the best hitters in the ACC, including with some power.
- He is hitting .333 with four homers, six doubles, 19 RBIs, 22 runs, a .426 on-base percentage and a steal in 24 games in 2023.
- He is hitting .404 with runners on base and .379 with runners in scoring position.

NOTES

- He has thrown out four of the 12 basestealers in 2023.
- He had a 16-game hitting streak from February to March and has hit safely in 18 of the last 19 games.
- He went 5-for-6 with a homer, four RBIs and two runs in Clemson's 9-8 walkoff win over Georgia State on March 10.
- He joined Cam Cannarella, who also had five hits in the game, as the first Tigers with five hits in a game since 2012.
- Ingle and Cannarella became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.
- In his career, he is hitting .331 with 19 doubles, 12 homers, 66 RBIs, 74 runs and a .431 on-base percentage in 88 games (82 starts).

LINDLEY A SUPER SENIOR OUT OF PEN

- Fifth-year senior and righty Jackson Lindley has continued his dependability out of the bullpen from the 2022 season into the 2023 season.
- He is 1-2 with two saves, a 2.66 ERA and .268 opponents' batting average in 20.1 innings pitched over 12 relief appearances in 2023.
- He has 23 strikeouts against seven walks, good for a 3.29 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- He has only allowed one of eight inherited baserunners to score.
- In his career, he is 10-2 with three saves, a 4.43 ERA and 88 strikeouts against 39 walks in 101.2 innings pitched over 61 appearances.

TAYLOR FINDING HIS BASEBALL RHYTHM

- Sophomore outfielder Will Taylor is finally healthy after an injury-plagued freshman season.
- The wide receiver on the Tiger football team has found his rhythm in left field and as the designated hitter in 2023.
- He is hitting .338 with five doubles, a triple, two homers, 18 RBIs, 19 runs, a .476 on-base percentage and six steals in 24 games in 2023.
- He has 10 multiple-hit games and a team-tying-high five multiple-RBI games.
- He had multiple hits in six consecutive games in March.
- In his career, he's hitting .308 with five doubles, a triple, three homers, 22 RBIs, a .446 on-base percentage and seven steals in 37 games.

WRIGHT WHERE HE LEFT OFF

- Junior infielder Blake Wright has picked up right in 2023 where he left off during his stellar 2023 sophomore season.
- He is hitting .276 with six doubles, three homers, 17 RBIs, 16 runs and five steals in 22 games in 2023.
- He has 10 walks against only nine strikeouts.
- He went 4-for-4 with two homers, three RBIs, three runs, a walk and three steals on opening day against Binghamton on Feb. 17.
- In his career, he is hitting .304 with 16 doubles, 15 homers, 62 RBIs, 49 runs and a .363 on-base percentage in 78 games (71 starts).
