CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has a 13-8 home record, was swept at home by No. 2 Wake Forest last weekend by a combined score of 18-11.
- The Tigers are averaging 6.8 runs per game and hitting .290 with a .436 slugging percentage, .386 on-base percentage and 56 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 4.88 ERA, .265 opponents' batting average and 2.41 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .973.

COASTAL CAROLINA OVERVIEW

- Coastal Carolina, who has a 6-2 road record and is averaging 10.6 runs per game, is led by 28th-year Head Coach Gary Gilmore.

- The Chanticleers swept Georgia State on the road last weekend. They are hitting .330 and have a 6.31 ERA and .969 fielding percentage.
- Payton Eeles is hitting .394 with 14 steals, Derek Bender is batting .383 with seven homers and 38 RBIs and Teddy Sharkey has five saves.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson has at least one extra-base hit in every game in 2023.
- Clemson's bullpen has a 12-8 record, six saves, a 4.61 ERA, .277 opponents' batting average and 151 strikeouts in 146.1 innings pitched.
- Clemson outit No. 2 Wake Forest .280 to .228 in the Demon Deacons' three-game sweep at Doug Kingsmore Stadium last weekend.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,418 fans per home date (19), the 12th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of April 2).
- Entering 2023, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 29 straight seasons.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in seventh place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 2-7 league mark.
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is in 14th place.

SCHEDULE STRONG

- Clemson has an RPI of 45 (through games of April 2) according to WarrenNolan.com.
- A big reason for the Tigers' top-50 RPI is their strength of schedule, which is No. 5 in the nation.
- Clemson's non-conference strength of schedule is No. 18 in the nation.
- A total of 25 of the Tigers' last 27 regular-season games are against teams in the top 56 of the unofficial RPI.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

SWIPING BAGS

- A key to Clemson's scoring has been its ability to steal bases, as it has 56 in 29 games (1.9 per game).
- Clemson has at least one steal in 21 of the 29 games and multiple steals in 14 games.
- A total of 11 different Tigers have contributed to the team's 56 stolen bases.
- Clemson has totaled 100+ steals in 18 seasons. The last time doing so was in 2013, when it had 111 steals.
- Cam Cannarella has a team-high 16 steals, while Benjamin Blackwell is second on the team with 14 steals.
- Clemson totaled 17 steals in the season-opening series against Binghamton, including 11 in the season opener, one shy of the school record.

CAPTAINS

- Ryan Ammons, Riley Bertram, Jackson Lindley and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains in the pre-season.
- Benjamin Blackwell, Chad Fairey and Mac Starbuck were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Tristan Bissetta, Jacob Jarrell and Rocco Reid were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

AMICK PUTS NAME IN TIGER LORE

- Sophomore infielder and catcher Billy Amick had been a bench player in his career until March 10, when he put his stamp in Tiger lore.
- He entered the series opener against Georgia State in the sixth inning as a pinch-hitter and had a single later in the game.
- In the ninth inning with the Tigers trailing 8-5, he blasted a 446-foot grand slam with two outs to give Clemson a 9-8 walkoff victory.
- It was his first career homer in his 12th career game and second year at Clemson. It was also the third walkoff grand slam in Tiger history.
- He is hitting .324 with a homer, triple, eight RBIs, six runs and a .378 on-base percentage in 12 games (eight starts) in 2023.
- In his career, he is hitting .245 with a homer, triple, eight RBIs and seven runs in 21 games (11 starts).

BLACKWELL GLAD HE RETURNED

- Senior infielder Benjamin Blackwell decided late in the process last summer to return for his fifth collegiate season in 2023.
- The Tigers are glad he did, and he is putting up solid numbers along the way, including 14 stolen bases.
- He is hitting .309 with six doubles, a triple, homer, 14 RBIs, 14 runs, 14 walks and a .408 on-base percentage in 29 games in 2023.
- He has 11 multiple-hit games.
- He is one of two Tigers to play and start every game in 2023.
- He has a .962 fielding percentage as Clemson's starting shortstop, committing only four errors in 104 chances.
- In his two-year Tiger career, he is hitting .321 with 16 doubles, two triples, four homers, 47 RBIs, 66 runs and 18 steals in 87 games.
- He has committed only 15 errors in his two seasons at Clemson, good for a solid .954 fielding percentage.

CANNARELLA EMERGING AS FRESHMAN

- Freshman Cam Cannarella has stepped in to become the everyday starter in center as a freshman in 2023.
- He is hitting .417 with 10 doubles, a triple, two homers, 22 RBIs, 33 runs, a .492 on-base percentage and 16 steals in 22 games.
- He leads or is tied for the team lead in batting average, runs, hits (45), doubles, triples, total bases (63), RBIs and steals.

- He also leads the team in on-base percentage.
- He has a team-high 13 multiple-hit games, including two three-hit games, one four-hit game and two five-hit games.
- He is hitting .488 with runners on base and .485 with runners in scoring position.
- He started his college career on a 14-game hitting streak and has reached base via a hit or walk in all 26 games.
- He won the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the South Carolina three-game series from March 3-5, as he was 6-for-13 with three doubles.
- He went 5-for-6 with four runs in Clemson's 9-8 walkoff win over Georgia State on March 10.
- He joined Cooper Ingle, who also had five hits in the game, as the first Tigers with five hits in a game since 2012.
- Cannarella and Ingle became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.
- He went 5-for-6 with two doubles, two RBIs and three runs in the 14-9 win over Duke in the second game of a doubleheader on March 18.
- He hit a three-run walkoff homer to lift Clemson to an 8-5 win over Winthrop on March 21.

CLAYTON A NEW PITCHER FROM SIDE

- Junior righty Nick Clayton changed his arm slot to the side prior to the season, and it has paid dividends.
- He is 2-0 with a 2.14 ERA, .227 opponents' batting average and 23 strikeouts against four walks in 21.0 innings pitched over 12 outings.
- He has only allowed two extra-base hits thanks in large part to 26 groundball outs compared to 12 flyball outs.
- He is holding opponents to .162 with runners on base.
- He has only allowed one of 11 inherited baserunners to score.
- He pitched 3.0 perfect innings in relief with four strikeouts to earn the win in Clemson's 8-5 walkoff victory over Winthrop on March 21.
- In his career, he is 9-3 with a save, 4.00 ERA, .252 opponents' batting average and 94 strikeouts in 99.0 innings pitched over 48 outings.

GARRIS GARNERING ATTENTION

- Sophomore Reed Garris was a catcher as a freshman in 2022, but has emerged as a dependable reliever in 2023.
- He is 2-0 with a 3.07 ERA, .204 opponents' batting average and 20 strikeouts against four walks in 14.2 innings pitched over 12 appearances.
- He has not allowed a homer.
- He is holding opponents to a .160 batting average with runners on base and .095 batting average with runners in scoring position.
- He has only allowed one of eight inherited baserunners to score.

GRICE TWO-WAY PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- Junior Caden Grice is contributing as both a lefthander on the mound and slugger at the plate in 2023.
- He is 1-1 with a 3.79 ERA .164 opponents' batting average and 29 strikeouts in 19.0 innings pitched over five starts on the mound in 2023.
- He is holding opponents to .121 with runners on base, .154 with runners in scoring position and .136 with two outs.
- He is hitting .337 with seven homers, a triple, seven doubles, 19 RBIs, 25 runs and three steals in 25 games (24 starts) batting in 2023.
- He has a team-high .653 slugging percentage and a .414 on-base percentage.
- He has hit all seven of his home runs in the last 11 games.

NOTES

- He is hitting .457 with five homers, four doubles, 12 RBIs, a 1.000 slugging percentage and .500 on-base percentage in nine ACC games.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball and ACC Co-Player-of-the-Week on March 27.
- He became the 15th Tiger to earn ACC weekly honors at least three times in a career, while it was his fourth career national weekly honor.
- In five games, he totaled four homers and 11 RBIs, and he also earned the win on the mound at Georgia Tech on March 26.
- On March 26, he hit two homers with five RBIs, and he pitched 5.0 strong innings with six strikeouts to earn the win in a starting role.
- In his career, he is 3-2 with a 4.63 ERA, .198 opponents' batting average and 50 strikeouts in 35.0 innings pitched over 17 appearances.
- In his career, he is hitting .289 with 34 homers, two triples, 27 doubles, 112 RBIs, 110 runs and 11 steals in 134 games (133 starts).

INGLE NOT JUST A SINGLES HITTER

- Junior catcher Cooper Ingle has proven why he is one of the best hitters in the ACC, including with some power.
- He is hitting .313 with four homers, six doubles, 21 RBIs, 24 runs, a .410 on-base percentage and a steal in 28 games in 2023.
- He is hitting .370 with runners on base and .344 with runners in scoring position.
- He has thrown out four of 13 basestealers in 2023.
- He had a 16-game hitting streak from February to March.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in 23 straight games.
- He went 5-for-6 with a homer, four RBIs and two runs in Clemson's 9-8 walkoff win over Georgia State on March 10.
- He joined Cam Cannarella, who also had five hits in the game, as the first Tigers with five hits in a game since 2012.
- Ingle and Cannarella became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.
- In his career, he is hitting .324 with 19 doubles, 12 homers, 68 RBIs, 76 runs and a .425 on-base percentage in 92 games (86 starts).

LINDLEY A SUPER SENIOR OUT OF PEN

- Fifth-year senior and righty Jackson Lindley has continued his dependability out of the bullpen from the 2022 season into the 2023 season.
- He is 1-3 with two saves, a 2.91 ERA and .271 opponents' batting average in 21.2 innings pitched over 13 relief appearances in 2023.
- He has 23 strikeouts against eight walks.
- He has only allowed two of nine inherited baserunners to score.
- In his career, he is 10-3 with three saves, a 4.46 ERA and 88 strikeouts against 40 walks in 103.0 innings pitched over 62 appearances.

TAYLOR FINDING HIS BASEBALL RHYTHM

- Sophomore outfielder Will Taylor is finally healthy after an injury-plagued freshman season.
- The wide receiver on the Tiger football team has found his rhythm in left field in 2023.
- He is hitting .340 with seven doubles, a triple, two homers, 21 RBIs, 22 runs, a .459 on-base percentage and six steals in 28 games in 2023.
- He has 12 multiple-hit games and a team-tying-high six multiple-RBI games.
- He totaled multiple hits in six consecutive games in March.

- In his career, he is hitting .313 with seven doubles, a triple, three homers, 25 RBIs, a .438 on-base % and seven steals in 41 games.

WRIGHT WHERE HE LEFT OFF

- Junior infielder Blake Wright has picked up right in 2023 where he left off during his stellar 2023 sophomore season.
- He is hitting .287 with seven doubles, three homers, 20 RBIs, 17 runs and five steals in 26 games in 2023.
- He has 11 walks against only 11 strikeouts.
- He went 4-for-4 with two homers, three RBIs, three runs, a walk and three steals on opening day against Binghamton on Feb. 17.
- In his career, he is hitting .307 with 17 doubles, 15 homers, 65 RBIs, 50 runs and a .363 on-base percentage in 82 games (75 starts).
