CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has a 14-8 home record, defeated Georgia 8-1 on the road on Tuesday behind Billy Amick's two doubles and three-run homer.
- The Tigers are averaging 6.9 runs per game and hitting .291 with a .438 slugging percentage, .389 on-base percentage and 59 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 4.58 ERA, .260 opponents' batting average and 2.49 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .974.

NOTRE DAME OVERVIEW

- Notre Dame, who has a 9-9 road record and is averaging 5.8 runs per game, is led by first-year Head Coach Shawn Stiffler.
- The Fighting Irish fell at home to Michigan State 7-6 on Tuesday. They are hitting .228 and have a 4.59 ERA and .977 fielding percentage.
- Carter Putz is hitting .289 with five homers and 22 RBIs and Aidan Tyrell has a 6-1 record and 1.62 ERA in nine relief appearances.

QUICK HITS

- In a pregame ceremony at approximately 3:45 p.m. on Saturday, Clemson will retire the #7 of former Head Coach Jack Leggett.
- Clemson is hitting .348 with the bases loaded, while its opponents are hitting just .188 with the bases loaded.
- Clemson's bullpen has a 14-8 record, six saves, a 4.35 ERA, .270 opponents' batting average and 172 strikeouts in 165.1 innings pitched.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,431 fans per home date (20), the 13th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of April 12).

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in sixth place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 4-8 league mark.
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is in 13th place.

SCHEDULE STRONG

- Clemson has an RPI of 35 (through games of April 12) according to WarrenNolan.com.
- A big reason for the Tigers' top-50 RPI is their strength of schedule, which is No. 9 in the nation.
- Clemson's non-conference strength of schedule is No. 11 in the nation.
- A total of 20 of the Tigers' last 22 regular-season games are against teams in the top 36 of the unofficial RPI.

SWIPING BAGS

- A key to Clemson's scoring has been its ability to steal bases, as it has 59 in 34 games (1.7 per game).
- Clemson has multiple steals in 15 games.
- A total of 12 different Tigers have contributed to the team's 59 stolen bases.
- Clemson has totaled 100+ steals in 18 seasons. The last time doing so was in 2013, when it had 111 steals.
- Cam Cannarella has a team-high 17 steals, while Benjamin Blackwell is second on the team with 14 steals.
- Clemson totaled 17 steals in the season-opening series against Binghamton, including 11 in the season opener, one shy of the school record.

FIELDING STEADY

- Clemson has a solid fielding percentage of .974 in 2023. That mark would be second highest in Tiger history if the season ended today.
- The Clemson record for fielding percentage in a season is .975, set by the 2018 team.
- Clemson has committed just 32 errors in 34 games in 2023
- No Tiger has committed more than five errors.
- Clemson is 8-3 when not committing an error in a game.
- The everyday third baseman (Blake Wright), shortstop (Benjamin Blackwell) and second baseman (Riley Bertram) have combined for 13 errors.
- Clemson has a .980 fielding percentage in ACC regular-season games, committing only nine errors in 12 games.

CAPTAINS

- Ryan Ammons, Riley Bertram, Jackson Lindley and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains in the preseason.
- Benjamin Blackwell, Chad Fairey and Mac Starbuck were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Tristan Bissetta, Jacob Jarrell and Rocco Reid were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

AMICK PUTS NAME IN TIGER LORE

- Sophomore infielder and catcher Billy Amick had been a bench player in his career until March 10, when he put his stamp in Tiger lore.
- He entered the series opener against Georgia State in the sixth inning as a pinch-hitter and had a single later in the game.
- In the ninth inning with the Tigers trailing 8-5, he blasted a 446-foot grand slam with two outs to give Clemson a 9-8 walkoff victory.
- It was his first career homer in his 12th career game and second year at Clemson. It was also the third walkoff grand slam in Tiger history.
- He is hitting .377 with three homers, a triple, three doubles, 14 RBIs, 11 runs & a .441 on-base percentage in 17 games (13 starts) in 2023.
- He has a .642 slugging percentage.

- He went 3-for-4 with a homer, two doubles and four RBIs in Clemson's 8-1 win at Georgia on April 11.
- In his career, he is hitting .306 with three homers, a triple, three doubles, 14 RBIs and 12 runs in 26 games (16 starts).

BLACKWELL GLAD HE RETURNED

- Senior infielder Benjamin Blackwell decided late in the process last summer to return for his fifth collegiate season in 2023
- The Tigers are glad he did, and he is putting up solid numbers along the way, including 14 stolen bases.
- He is hitting .302 with seven doubles, a triple, homer, 15 RBIs, 18 runs and a .396 on-base percentage in 34 games in 2023.
- He has 13 multiple-hit games.
- He is one of two Tigers to play and start every game in 2023.
- He has a .960 fielding percentage as Clemson's starting shortstop, committing only five errors in 124 chances.
- In his two-year Tiger career, he is hitting .318 with 17 doubles, two triples, four homers, 48 RBIs, 70 runs and 18 steals in 92 games.
- He has committed only 16 errors in his two seasons at Clemson, good for a solid .954 fielding percentage.

CANNARELLA EMERGING AS FRESHMAN

- Freshman Cam Cannarella has stepped right in to become the everyday starter in center field and shown consistency as a freshman in 2023.
- He is hitting .411 with 10 doubles, a triple, three homers, 27 RBIs, 40 runs, a .490 on-base percentage and 17 steals in 30 games.
- He leads or is tied for the team lead in batting average, runs, hits (53), doubles, total bases (74), on-base percentage and steals.
- He has a team-high 15 multiple-hit games, including two three-hit games, two four-hit games and two five-hit games
- He is hitting .463 with runners on base, .429 with runners in scoring position and .441 with two outs.
- He started his college career on a 14-game hitting streak and reached base via a hit or walk in his first 30 games.
- He won the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the South Carolina three-game series from March 3-5, as he was 6-for-13 with three doubles.
- He went 5-for-6 with four runs in Clemson's 9-8 walkoff win over Georgia State on March 10.
- He joined Cooper Ingle, who also had five hits in the game, as the first Tigers with five hits in a game since 2012
- Cannarella and Ingle became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.
- He went 5-for-6 with with two doubles, two RBIs and three runs in the 14-9 win over Duke in the second game of a doubleheader on March 18.
- He hit a three-run walkoff homer to lift Clemson to an 8-5 win over Winthrop on March 21.

CLAYTON A NEW PITCHER FROM SIDE

- Junior righty Nick Clayton changed his arm slot to the side prior to the season, and it has paid dividends.
- He is 2-0 with a 1.90 ERA, .212 opponents' batting average and 26 strikeouts against five walks in 23.2 innings pitched over 13 outings.
- He has only allowed two extra-base hits thanks in large part to 31 groundball outs compared to 12 flyball outs in 2023
- He is holding opponents to .156 with runners on base and .095 with runners in scoring position.
- He has only allowed one of 11 inherited baserunners to score.

- He pitched 3.0 perfect innings in relief with four strikeouts to earn the win in Clemson's 8-5 walkoff victory over Winthrop on March 21.
- In his career, he is 9-3 with a save, 3.90 ERA, .248 opponents' batting average and 97 strikeouts in 101.2 innings pitched over 49 outings.

DARDEN A TIGER WINNER

- Freshman lefthander Ethan Darden was a reliever and spot starter in the first half of the season, but he has emerged as a weekend starter.
- He is 2-1 with a 3.81 ERA, .250 opponents' batting average and 24 strikeouts in 28.1 innings pitched over 11 outings (five starts) in 2023.
- He has 46 groundball outs compared to only 10 flyball outs.
- He has not allowed a steal.
- He has a 2-0 record, 3.38 ERA, .259 opponents' batting average and 20 strikeouts against seven walks in 21.1 innings pitched in five starts.
- Clemson has a 5-0 record in his five starts.
- He pitched 5.0 scoreless innings of four-hit ball to earn the win in his first career ACC start at Florida State on April 7.

GARRIS GARNERING ATTENTION

- Sophomore Reed Garris was a catcher as a freshman in 2022, but has emerged as a dependable reliever in 2023
- He is 2-0 with a 2.87 ERA, .207 opponents' batting average and 21 strikeouts against four walks in 15.2 innings pitched over 13 appearances.
- He has not allowed a homer.
- He is holding opponents to a .148 batting average with runners on base and .095 batting average with runners in scoring position.
- He has only allowed one of eight inherited baserunners to score.

GRICE TWO-WAY PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- Junior Caden Grice is contributing as both a lefthander on the mound and slugger at the plate in 2023.
- He is 2-1 with a 3.55 ERA .180 opponents' batting average and 34 strikeouts in 25.1 innings pitched over six starts on the mound in 2023.
- He has not allowed a steal.
- He is holding opponents to .116 with runners on base, .148 with runners in scoring position and .111 with two outs.
- He is hitting .342 with eight homers, a triple, nine doubles, 28 RBIs, 30 runs and three steals in 30 games (29 starts) batting in 2023.
- He has a team-high .658 slugging percentage and a .440 on-base percentage.
- He has hit all eight of his homers in the last 16 games.
- In the last 17 games (since the start of ACC play), he is hitting .403 with eight homers, 26 RBIs, a .919 slugging % and .494 on-base %.
- He is hitting .455 with six homers, five doubles, 17 RBIs, 16 runs, a .977 slugging percentage and .528 on-base percentage in 12 ACC games.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball and ACC Co-Player-of-the-Week on March 27.
- He became the 15th Tiger to earn ACC weekly honors at least three times in a career, while it was his fourth career national weekly honor.
- In five games, he totaled four homers and 11 RBIs, and he also earned the win on the mound at Georgia Tech on March 26.
- On March 26, he hit two homers with five RBIs, and he pitched 5.0 strong innings with six strikeouts to earn the win in a starting role.

- At Florida State on April 8, he pitched 6.1 innings to earn the win and went 2-for-4 with a grand slam in the 6-2 series-clinching victory.
- In his career, he is 4-2 with a 4.35 ERA, .203 opponents' batting average and 55 strikeouts in 41.1 innings pitched over 18 appearances.
- In his career, he is hitting .291 with 35 homers, two triples, 29 doubles, 121 RBIs, 115 runs and 11 steals in 139 games (138 starts).

INGLE NOT JUST A SINGLES HITTER

- Junior catcher Cooper Ingle has proven why he is one of the best hitters in the ACC, including with some power.
- He is hitting .299 with four homers, six doubles, 23 RBIs, 28 runs, a .396 on-base percentage and a steal in 33 games in 2023.
- He has thrown out five of 14 basestealers in 2023.
- He had a 16-game hitting streak from February to March.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in 28 straight games.
- He went 5-for-6 with a homer, four RBIs and two runs in Clemson's 9-8 walkoff win over Georgia State on March 10
- He joined Cam Cannarella, who also had five hits in the game, as the first Tigers with five hits since 2012.
- Ingle and Cannarella became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.
- In his career, he is hitting .319 with 19 doubles, 12 homers, 70 RBIs, 80 runs and a .419 on-base percentage in 97 games (91 starts).

LINDLEY A SUPER SENIOR OUT OF PEN

- Fifth-year senior and righty Jackson Lindley has continued his dependability out of the bullpen from the 2022 season into the 2023 season.
- He is 1-3 with two saves, a 2.91 ERA and .271 opponents' batting average in 21.2 innings pitched over 13 relief appearances in 2023.
- He has 23 strikeouts against eight walks.
- He has only allowed two of nine inherited baserunners to score.
- In his career, he is 10-3 with three saves, a 4.46 ERA and 88 strikeouts against 40 walks in 103.0 innings pitched over 62 appearances.

TAYLOR FINDING HIS BASEBALL RHYTHM

- Sophomore outfielder Will Taylor is finally healthy after an injury-plagued freshman season.
- The wide receiver on the Tiger football team has found his rhythm in left field in 2023.
- He is hitting .325 with nine doubles, two triples, two homers, 24 RBIs, 28 runs, a .455 on-base % and six steals in 33 games in 2023.
- He has 13 multiple-hit games and a team-tying-high seven multiple-RBI games.
- \bullet He had multiple hits in six consecutive games in March.
- In his career, he is hitting .305 with nine doubles, two triples, three homers, 28 RBIs, a .438 on-base % and seven steals in 46 games.

WRIGHT WHERE HE LEFT OFF

- Junior infielder Blake Wright has picked up right in 2023 where he left off during his stellar 2023 sophomore season.
- He is hitting .283 with eight doubles, three homers, 26 RBIs, 21 runs and five steals in 31 games in 2023.
- He went 4-for-4 with two homers, three RBIs, three runs, a walk and three steals on opening day against Binghamton on Feb. 17.
- In his career, he is hitting .304 with 18 doubles, 15 homers, 71 RBIs, 54 runs and a .362 on-base percentage in 87 games (80 starts).

- Miller, the 2011 ACC Player-of-the-Year, hit .339 with 36 doubles, eight triples, 16 homers, 135 RBIs and 46 steals in 191 games as a Tiger.
- Strider, who had a 5-2 record in his two active seasons (2018,20) at Clemson, made his MLB debut with the Atlanta Braves in 2021.
- White, who hit .275 with 104 runs and 36 steals at Clemson from 2014-16, made his MLB debut with the Texas Rangers on Sept. 1, 2020.
- Every Tiger team from 1974 to 2020 had at least one future major leaguer on its roster.
- Clemson has had at least one former Tiger play in an MLB game each of the last 68 years (streak started in 1956)
- Clemson has had multiple former Tigers play in an MLB game each of the last 50 years (streak started in 1974)
- Clemson set a school record with 12 former Tigers in the majors in 2021, breaking the previous record of eight.
