CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- · Clemson, who has a 16-9 home record, won two of three games against Notre Dame at Doug Kingsmore Stadium last weekend.
- The Tigers are averaging 6.8 runs per game and hitting .291 with a .436 slugging percentage, .389 on-base percentage and 61 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 4.54 ERA, .259 opponents' batting average and 2.54 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .974.

GEORGIA OVERVIEW

- Georgia, who has a 5-7 road record and is averaging 7.7 runs per game, is led by 10th-year Head Coach Scott Stricklin.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse. coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

• A total of 17 of the Tigers' last 19 regular-season games are against teams in the top 39 of the unofficial RPI.

SWIPING BAGS

- A key to Clemson's scoring has been its ability to steal bases, as it has 61 in 37 games (1.6 per game).
- · Clemson has multiple steals in 16 games.
- A total of 12 different Tigers have contributed to the team's 61 stolen bases.
- Clemson has totaled 100+ steals in 18 seasons. The last time doing so was in 2013, when it had 111 steals.
- Cam Cannarella has a team-high 17 steals, while Benjamin Blackwell is second on the team with 15 steals.
- Clemson totaled 17 steals in the season-opening series against Binghamton, including 11 in the season opener, one shy of the school record.

FIELDING STEADY

- Clemson has a solid fielding percentage of .974 in 2023. That mark would be second highest in Tiger history if the season ended today.
- The Clemson record for fielding percentage in a season is .975, set by the 2018 team.
- · Clemson has committed just 35 errors in 37 games.
- Clemson has committed no errors or one error in 22 of the last 23 games.
- Clemson is 8-3 when not committing an error in a game.
- No Tiger has committed more than five errors.
- The everyday third baseman (Blake Wright), shortstop (Benjamin Blackwell) and second baseman (Riley Bertram) have combined for 14 errors.
- · Clemson has a .978 fielding percentage in ACC regularseason games, committing only 12 errors in 15 games.

CAPTAINS

- Ryan Ammons, Riley Bertram, Jackson Lindley and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains.
- Benjamin Blackwell, Chad Fairey and Mac Starbuck were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Tristan Bissetta, Jacob Jarrell and Rocco Reid were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

AMICK PUTS NAME IN TIGER LORE

- Sophomore infielder and catcher Billy Amick had been a bench player in his career until March 10, when he put his stamp in Tiger lore.
- He entered the series opener against Georgia State in the sixth inning as a pinch-hitter and had a single later in the game.
- In the ninth inning with the Tigers trailing 8-5, he blasted a 446-foot grand slam with two outs to give Clemson a 9-8 walkoff victory.
- It was his first career homer in his 12th career game and second year at Clemson. It was also the third walkoff grand slam in Tiger history.
- He is hitting .379 with four homers, a triple, five doubles, 16 RBIs, 14 runs & a .431 on-base percentage in 20 games (16 starts) in 2023.
- He has a team-high .667 slugging percentage.
- He went 3-for-4 with a homer, two doubles and four RBIs in Clemson's 8-1 win at Georgia on April 11.
- He went 3-for-4 with two doubles, including the goahead, two-out, run-scoring double in the seventh inning against Notre Dame on April 16.
- In his career, he is hitting .318 with four homers, a triple, five doubles, 16 RBIs and 15 runs in 29 games (19 starts).

BLACKWELL GLAD HE RETURNED

• Senior infielder Benjamin Blackwell decided late in the process last summer to return for his fifth collegiate season in 2023.

- The Tigers are glad he did, and he is putting up solid numbers along the way, including 15 stolen bases.
- He is hitting .307 with seven doubles, two triples, a homer, 15 RBIs, 21 runs and a .398 on-base percentage in 37 games in 2023.
- He has 14 multiple-hit games.
- He is one of two Tigers to play and start every game in 2023.
- He has a .962 fielding percentage as Clemson's starting shortstop, committing only five errors in 133 chances.
- In his two-year Tiger career, he is hitting .319 with 17 doubles, three triples, four homers, 48 RBIs, 73 runs and 19 steals in 95 games.
- . He has committed only 16 errors in his two seasons at Clemson, good for a solid .955 fielding percentage.

CANNARELLA EMERGING AS FRESHMAN

- Freshman Cam Cannarella has stepped right in to become the everyday starter in center field and has shown consistency as a freshman in 2023.
- He is hitting .408 with 11 doubles, a triple, three homers, 30 RBIs, 43 runs, a .488 on-base percentage and 17 steals in 34 games.
- · He leads or is tied for the team lead in batting average, runs, hits (58), doubles, total bases (80), on-base percentage and steals.
- He has a team-high 17 multiple-hit games, including three three-hit games, two four-hit games and two fivehit games
- He is hitting .466 with runners on base, .422 with runners in scoring position and .486 with two outs.
- He started his college career on a 14-game hitting streak and reached base via a hit or walk in his first 30 games.
- He won the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the South Carolina three-game series from March 3-5, as he was 6-for-13 with three doubles.
- He went 5-for-6 with four runs in Clemson's 9-8 walkoff win over Georgia State on March 10.
- He joined Cooper Ingle, who also had five hits in the game, as the first Tigers with five hits in a game since 2012
- Cannarella and Ingle became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.
- He went 5-for-6 with with two doubles, two RBIs and three runs in the 14-9 win over Duke in the second game of a doubleheader on March 18.
- He hit a three-run walkoff homer to lift Clemson to an 8-5 win over Winthrop on March 21.

CLAYTON A NEW PITCHER FROM SIDE

- Junior righty Nick Clayton changed his arm slot to the side prior to the season, and it has paid dividends.
- He is 3-0 with a 1.59 ERA, .202 opponents' batting average and 33 strikeouts against seven walks in 28.1 innings pitched over 15 outings.
- He has only allowed three extra-base hits thanks in large part to 36 groundball outs compared to 13 flyball outs.
- He is holding opponents to .123 with runners on base and .071 with runners in scoring position.
- He has only allowed two of 14 inherited baserunners to score.
- He is 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA, .200 opponents' batting average and 24 strikeouts in 18.0 innings pitched over eight relief outings in ACC games.
- He pitched 3.0 perfect innings in relief with four strikeouts to earn the win in Clemson's 8-5 walkoff victory over Winthrop on March 21.
- In his career, he is 10-3 with a save, 3.72 ERA, .244 opponents' batting average and 104 strikeouts in 106.1 innings pitched (51 outings).

DARDEN A TIGER WINNER

- Freshman lefthander Ethan Darden was a reliever and spot starter in the first half of the season, but he has emerged as a weekend starter.
- He is 2-2 with a 5.04 ERA, .256 opponents' batting average and 26 strikeouts in 30.1 innings pitched over 12 outings (six starts) in 2023.
- He has 47 groundball outs compared to 13 flyball outs.
- He has not allowed a steal.
- He has a 2-1 record, 5.01 ERA, .267 opponents' batting average and 22 strikeouts against nine walks in 23.1 innings pitched in six starts.
- Clemson has a 5-1 record in his six starts.
- He pitched 5.0 scoreless innings of four-hit ball to earn the win in his first career ACC start at Florida State on April 7.

GARRIS GARNERING ATTENTION

- Sophomore Reed Garris was a catcher as a freshman in 2022, but has emerged as a dependable reliever in 2023
- He is 2-0 with a 2.70 ERA, .222 opponents' batting average and 22 strikeouts against five walks in 16.2 innings pitched over 14 appearances.
- · He has not allowed a homer.
- He is holding opponents to .188 with runners on base and .154 with runners in scoring position.

GORDON PROVIDING STARTS

- Sophomore righthander Austin Gordon has been a weekend starter all season and has provided consistency on the mound.
- He is 1-3 with a 4.88 ERA, .257 opponents' batting average and 44 strikeouts against 10 walks in 48.0 innings pitched over nine starts.
- A total of 21 of his 28 runs allowed have come on the 13 home runs he has allowed.
- He is holding opponents to .137 with two outs.
- He's 1-3 with a 3.99 ERA, .230 opponents' batting average and 30 strikeouts versus eight walks in 29.1 innings pitched over five ACC starts.
- In his career, he's 2-3 with two saves, a 4.97 ERA and 75 strikeouts against 19 walks in 76.0 innings pitched over 26 outings (nine starts).

GRICE TWO-WAY PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- Junior Caden Grice is contributing as both a lefthander on the mound and slugger at the plate in 2023.
- He is 2-1 with a 3.64 ERA .198 opponents' batting average and 40 strikeouts in 29.2 innings pitched over seven starts on the mound in 2023.
- He is holding opponents to .137 with runners on base, .188 with runners in scoring position and .152 with two outs.
- He is hitting .325 with eight homers, a triple, nine doubles, 29 RBIs, 30 runs and three steals in 33 games (32 starts) batting in 2023.
- He has a .617 slugging percentage and .432 on-base percentage.
- He has hit all eight of his home runs in the last 19 games.
- He is hitting .396 with six homers, five doubles, 18 RBIs, 16 runs, an .830 slugging percentage and a .493 on-base % in 15 ACC games.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball and ACC Co-Player-of-the-Week on March 27.
- He became the 15th Tiger to earn ACC weekly honors at least three times in a career, while it was his fourth career national weekly honor.
- In five games, he totaled four homers and 11 RBIs, and he also earned the win on the mound at Georgia Tech on March 26.

- On March 26, he hit two homers with five RBIs, and he
 pitched 5.0 strong innings with six strikeouts to earn
 the win in a starting role.
- At Florida State on April 8, he pitched 6.1 innings to earn the win and went 2-for-4 with a grand slam in the 6-2 series-clinching victory.
- In his career, he is 4-2 with a 4.34 ERA, .212 opponents' batting average and 61 strikeouts in 45.2 innings pitched over 19 appearances.
- In his career, he is hitting .288 with 35 homers, two triples, 29 doubles, 122 RBIs, 115 runs and 11 steals in 142 games (141 starts).

INGLE NOT JUST A SINGLES HITTER

- Junior catcher Cooper Ingle has proven why he is one of the best hitters in the ACC, including with some power.
- He is hitting .313 with four homers, eight doubles, 25 RBIs, 29 runs, a .402 on-base percentage and steal in 36 games in 2023
- He had a 16-game hitting streak from February to March.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in 31 straight games.
- He went 5-for-6 with a homer, four RBIs and two runs in Clemson's 9-8 walkoff win over Georgia State on March 10.
- He joined Cam Cannarella, who also had five hits, as the first Tigers with five hits in a game since 2012.
- Ingle and Cannarella became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.
- In his career, he is hitting .324 with 21 doubles, 12 homers, 72 RBIs, 81 runs and a .421 on-base percentage in 100 games (94 starts).

LINDLEY A SUPER SENIOR OUT OF PEN

- Fifth-year senior and righty Jackson Lindley has continued his dependability out of the bullpen from the 2022 season into the 2023 season.
- He is 1-3 with two saves, a 2.91 ERA and .271 opponents' batting average in 21.2 innings pitched over 13 relief appearances in 2023.
- He has 23 strikeouts against eight walks.
- He has only allowed two of nine inherited baserunners to score.
- In his career, he is 10-3 with three saves, a 4.46 ERA and 88 strikeouts against 40 walks in 103.0 innings pitched over 62 appearances.

TAYLOR FINDING HIS BASEBALL RHYTHM

- Sophomore outfielder Will Taylor is healthy after an injury-plagued freshman season.
- The wide receiver on the Tiger football team has found his rhythm in left field in 2023.
- He is hitting .323 with 10 doubles, two triples, two homers, 27 RBIs, 30 runs, a .447 on-base % and six steals in 36 games in 2023.
- He has 15 multiple-hit games and a team-tying-high seven multiple-RBI games.
- He had multiple hits in six consecutive games during March.
- In his career, he is hitting .305 with 10 doubles, two triples, three homers, 31 RBIs, a .432 on-base % and seven steals in 49 games.

WRIGHT WHERE HE LEFT OFF

- Junior infielder Blake Wright has picked up right in 2023 where he left off during his stellar 2023 sophomore season.
- He is hitting .262 with eight doubles, three homers, 27 RBIs, 22 runs and five steals in 34 games in 2023.
- He went 4-for-4 with two homers, three RBIs, three runs, a walk and three steals on opening day against Binghamton on Feb. 17.
