CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has a 16-10 home record, swept NC State in three games in Raleigh last weekend by a combined score of 27-14.
- The Tigers are averaging 6.9 runs per game and hitting .295 with a .443 slugging percentage, .390 on-base percentage and 63 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 4.53 ERA, .257 opponents' batting average and 2.53 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .975.

KENNESAW STATE OVERVIEW

- Kennesaw State, who has a 6-7 road record and is averaging 6.5 runs per game, is led by second-year Head Coach Ryan Coe.
- The Owls won two of three games at Queens last weekend. They are hitting .284 and have a 5.05 ERA and .953 fielding percentage.
- Brayden Eidson is hitting .352, Nick Colina is batting .336 with a .537 on-base percentage and Smith Pinson has a team-high four saves.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson broke a 2-2 tie with four runs in the eighth inning in its 6-2 victory at Kennesaw State on March 22, 2023.
- The Tigers have won six road contests in a row, April victories over Florida State (2), Georgia (1) and NC State (3).
- Clemson has four wins this year when trailing entering the eighth inning.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,458 fans per home date (24), the 13th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of April 23).
- Entering 2023, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 29 straight seasons.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in fourth place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 9-9 league mark.
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is tied for seventh place.

SCHEDULE STRONG

- Clemson has an RPI of 22 (through games of April 23) according to WarrenNolan.com.
- A big reason for the Tigers' top-25 RPI is their strength of schedule, which is No. 3 in the nation.

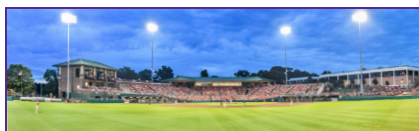

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

- Clemson's non-conference strength of schedule is No. 7 in the nation, and the Tigers are 16-7 in non-conference games.
- A total of 13 of the Tigers' last 15 regular-season games are against teams in the top 47 of the unofficial RPI.

SWIPING BAGS

- A key to Clemson's scoring has been its ability to steal bases, as it has 63 in 41 games (1.5 per game).
- Clemson has multiple steals in 16 games.
- A total of 12 different Tigers have contributed to the team's 63 stolen bases.
- Clemson has totaled 100+ steals in 18 seasons. The last time doing so was in 2013, when it had 111 steals.
- Cam Cannarella has a team-high 17 steals, while Benjamin Blackwell is second on the team with 16 steals.
- Clemson totaled 17 steals in the season-opening series against Binghamton, including 11 in the season opener, one shy of the school record.

FIELDING STEADY

- Clemson has a solid fielding percentage of .975 in 2023. That mark would be second highest in Tiger history if the season ended today.
- The Clemson record for fielding percentage in a season is .975, set by the 2018 team.
- Clemson has committed just 38 errors in 41 games in 2023.
- Clemson has committed no errors or one error in 25 of the last 27 games.
- Clemson is 9-4 when not committing an error in a game.
- No Tiger has committed more than five errors.
- The everyday third baseman (Blake Wright), shortstop (Benjamin Blackwell) and second baseman (Riley Bertram) have combined for 15 errors.
- Clemson has a .977 fielding percentage in ACC regular-season games, committing only 15 errors in 18 contests.

CAPTAINS

- Ryan Ammons, Riley Bertram, Jackson Lindley and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains in the pre-season.
- Benjamin Blackwell, Chad Fairey and Mac Starbuck were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Tristan Bissetta, Jacob Jarrell and Rocco Reid were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

AMICK PUTS NAME IN TIGER LORE

- Sophomore infielder and catcher Billy Amick had been a bench player in his career until March 10, when he put his stamp in Tiger lore.
- He entered the series opener against Georgia State in the sixth inning as a pinch-hitter and had a single later in the game.
- In the ninth inning with the Tigers trailing 8-5, he blasted a 446-foot grand slam with two outs to give Clemson a 9-8 walkoff victory.
- It was his first career homer in his 12th career game and second year at Clemson. It was also the third walkoff grand slam in Tiger history.
- He is hitting .402 with six homers, a triple, seven doubles, 23 RBIs, 17 runs and a .462 on-base percentage in 24 games (20 starts) in 2023.
- He has a team-high .732 slugging percentage.
- He went 3-for-4 with a home run, two doubles and four RBIs in the Tigers' 8-1 victory at Georgia on April 11.
- He went 3-for-4 with two doubles, including the go-ahead, two-out, run-scoring double in the seventh inning against Notre Dame on April 16.
- He went 4-for-5 with two homers, a double and five RBIs in Clemson's 10-2 win at NC State on April 21.

- In his career, he is hitting .347 with six homers, a triple, seven doubles, 23 RBIs and 18 runs in 33 games (23 starts).

AMMONS RETURNS

- Junior lefthander Ryan Ammons was Clemson's closer in 2022 and moved into the rotation early in 2023, but suffered an injury in February.
- He missed almost two months, but made his return to the mound against Georgia on April 18 out of the bullpen, where he has settled.
- He is 1-0 with a save, 2.70 ERA, .170 opponents' batting average and 21 strikeouts in 13.1 innings pitched over four outings (two starts).
- He has only allowed three walks, good for a 7.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- He is holding opponents to an .067 batting average with two outs.
- He has not allowed a steal.
- In 5.0 innings pitched in each of his two starts in 2023, he struck out nine and 10, respectively.
- In his career, he's 2-2 with nine saves, a 4.00 ERA, .195 opponents' batting average and 70 strikeouts in 45.0 innings pitched (38 outings).

BLACKWELL GLAD HE RETURNED

- Senior infielder Benjamin Blackwell decided late in the process last summer to return for his fifth collegiate season in 2023.
- The Tigers are glad he did, and he is putting up solid numbers along the way, including 16 stolen bases.
- He is hitting .314 with seven doubles, two triples, a homer, 18 RBIs, 22 runs and a .402 on-base percentage in 41 games in 2023.
- He has 16 multiple-hit games.
- He is one of two Tigers to play and start every game in 2023.
- He has a .968 fielding percentage as Clemson's starting shortstop, committing only five errors in 154 chances.
- In his two-year Tiger career, he is hitting .322 with 17 doubles, three triples, four homers, 51 RBIs, 74 runs and 20 steals in 99 games.
- He has committed only 16 errors in his two seasons at Clemson, good for a solid .958 fielding percentage.

CANNARELLA EMERGING AS FRESHMAN

- Freshman Cam Cannarella has stepped right in to become the everyday starter in center field and has shown consistency as a freshman in 2023.
- He is hitting .404 with 11 doubles, a triple, four homers, 31 RBIs, 49 runs, a .478 on-base percentage and 17 steals in 38 games.
- He leads or is tied for the team lead in batting average, runs, hits (65), total bases (90), on-base percentage and steals.
- He has a team-high 19 multiple-hit games, including four three-hit games, two four-hit games and two five-hit games.
- He is hitting .424 with runners on base, .396 with runners in scoring position and .455 with two outs.
- He started his college career on a 14-game hitting streak and reached base via a hit or walk in his first 30 games.
- He won the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the South Carolina three-game series from March 3-5, as he was 6-for-13 with three doubles.
- He went 5-for-6 with four runs in Clemson's 9-8 walkoff win over Georgia State on March 10.
- He joined Cooper Ingle, who also had five hits in the game, as the first Tigers with five hits in a game since 2012.
- Cannarella and Ingle became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.

NOTES

- He went 5-for-6 with two doubles, two RBIs and three runs in the 14-9 win over Duke in the second game of a doubleheader on March 18.
- He hit a three-run walkoff homer to lift Clemson to an 8-5 win over Winthrop on March 21.

CLAYTON A NEW PITCHER FROM SIDE

- Junior righty Nick Clayton changed his arm slot to the side prior to the season, and it has paid dividends.
- He is 3-0 with a 2.32 ERA, .196 opponents' batting average and 37 strikeouts against 12 walks in 31.0 innings pitched over 16 outings.
- He has only allowed three extra-base hits thanks in large part to 39 groundball outs compared to 13 flyball outs.
- He is holding opponents to .127 with runners on base and .094 with runners in scoring position.
- He has only allowed four of 17 inherited baserunners to score.
- He is 1-0 with a 2.18 ERA, .192 opponents' batting average and 28 strikeouts in 20.2 innings pitched over nine relief outings in ACC games.
- He pitched 3.0 perfect innings in relief with four strikeouts to earn the win in Clemson's 8-5 walkoff victory over Winthrop on March 21.
- In his career, he is 10-3 with a save, 3.88 ERA, .242 opponents' batting average and 108 strikeouts in 109.0 innings pitched (52 outings).

DARDEN A TIGER WINNER

- Freshman lefthander Ethan Darden was a reliever and spot starter in the first half of the season, but he has emerged as a weekend starter.
- He is 3-2 with a 4.46 ERA, .266 opponents' batting average and 29 strikeouts in 36.1 innings pitched over 13 outings (seven starts) in 2023.
- He has 56 groundball outs compared to only 18 flyball outs.
- He has not allowed a steal.
- He has a 3-1 record, 4.30 ERA, .276 opponents' batting average and 25 strikeouts against nine walks in 29.1 innings pitched in seven starts.
- Clemson has a 6-1 record in his seven starts.
- He pitched 5.0 scoreless innings of four-hit ball to earn the win in his first career ACC start at Florida State on April 7.
- He allowed just one run and no walks with three strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched to earn the win at NC State on April 21.

GARRIS GARNERING ATTENTION

- Sophomore Reed Garris was a catcher as a freshman in 2022, but has emerged as a dependable reliever in 2023.
- He is 3-0 with a 2.41 ERA, .214 opponents' batting average and 27 strikeouts against six walks in 18.2 innings pitched over 16 appearances.
- He has not allowed a homer.
- He is holding opponents to .194 with runners on base and .167 with runners in scoring position.

GORDON PROVIDING STARTS

- Sophomore righthander Austin Gordon has been a weekend starter all season and has provided consistency on the mound.
- He is 1-3 with a 5.12 ERA, .260 opponents' batting average and 47 strikeouts against 12 walks in 51.0 innings pitched over 10 starts.
- A total of 22 of his 31 runs allowed have come on the 14 home runs he has allowed.
- He is holding opponents to .130 with two outs.
- He is 1-3 with a 4.45 ERA, .238 opponents' batting average and 33 strikeouts against 10 walks in 32.1 innings pitched over six ACC starts.

- In his career, he is 2-3 with two saves, a 5.13 ERA and 78 strikeouts against 21 walks in 79.0 innings pitched over 27 outings (10 starts).

GRICE TWO-WAY PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- Junior Caden Grice is contributing as both a lefthander on the mound and slugger at the plate in 2023.
- He is 3-1 with a 4.04 ERA .202 opponents' batting average and 48 strikeouts in 35.2 innings pitched over eight starts on the mound in 2023.
- He is holding opponents to .158 with runners on base, .171 with runners in scoring position and .128 with two outs.
- He is hitting .297 with nine homers, a triple, nine doubles, 34 RBIs, 33 runs and three steals in 37 games (36 starts) batting in 2023.
- He has a .572 slugging percentage and .401 on-base percentage.
- He has hit all nine of his homers in the last 23 games.
- He's hitting .343 with seven homers, five doubles, 23 RBIs, 19 runs, a .731 slugging percentage and .439 on-base percentage in 18 ACC games.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball and ACC Co-Player-of-the-Week on March 27.
- He became the 15th Tiger to earn ACC weekly honors at least three times in a career, while it was his fourth career national weekly honor.
- In five games, he totaled four homers and 11 RBIs, and he also earned the win on the mound at Georgia Tech on March 26.
- On March 26, he hit two homers with five RBIs, and he pitched 5.0 strong innings with six strikeouts to earn the win in a starting role.
- At Florida State on April 8, he pitched 6.1 innings to earn the win and went 2-for-4 with a grand slam in the 6-2 series-clinching victory.
- With two outs and Clemson trailing in the eighth inning, he hit a grand slam in the Tigers' 9-7 win at NC State on April 22.
- In his career, he is 5-2 with a 4.53 ERA, .213 opponents' batting average and 69 strikeouts in 51.2 innings pitched over 20 appearances.
- In his career, he is hitting .282 with 36 homers, two triples, 29 doubles, 127 RBIs, 118 runs and 11 steals in 146 games (145 starts).

INGLE NOT JUST A SINGLES HITTER

- Junior catcher Cooper Ingle has proven why he is one of the best hitters in the ACC, including with some power.
- He is hitting .329 with five homers, 11 doubles, 28 RBIs, 35 runs, a .418 on-base percentage and steal in 40 games in 2023.
- He had a 16-game hitting streak from February to March.
- He is riding a current 12-game hitting streak.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in 35 straight games.
- He went 5-for-6 with a homer, four RBIs and two runs in Clemson's 9-8 walkoff win over Georgia State on March 10.
- He joined Cam Cannarella, who also had five hits, as the first Tigers with five hits in a game since 2012.
- Ingle and Cannarella became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.
- In his career, he is hitting .330 with 24 doubles, 13 homers, 75 RBIs, 87 runs and a .426 on-base percentage in 104 games (98 starts).

LINDLEY A SUPER SENIOR OUT OF PEN

- Fifth-year senior and righty Jackson Lindley has continued his dependability out of the bullpen from the 2022 season into the 2023 season.
