CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has an 8-4 road record, defeated Kennesaw State 15-5 in seven innings at Doug Kingsmore Stadium on Tuesday.
- The Tigers are averaging 7.0 runs per game and hitting .300 with a .452 slugging percentage, .395 on-base percentage and 63 steals.

- The pitching staff has a 4.57 ERA, .257 opponents' batting average and 2.54 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .975.

BOSTON COLLEGE OVERVIEW

- Boston College, who has a 8-5 home record and is averaging 6.7 runs per game, is led by 13th-year Head Coach Mike Gambino.
- The Eagles defeated UMass Lowell 9-3 at home on Wednesday. They are hitting .277 and have a 5.48 ERA and .979 fielding percentage.
- Barry Walsh is hitting .321, Cameron Leary has 10 homers, Joe Vetrano has nine homers and Andrew Roman has a team-high eight saves.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson is 58-for-153 (.379) with 42 runs, 10 doubles, eight homers and a .601 slugging percentage in the last four games.
- Clemson is 9-2 in its last 11 games and has won six straight road games, the longest active streak by a Power Five Conference team.
- Clemson's bullpen has a 17-9 record, eight saves, a 4.16 ERA, .262 opponents' batting average and 221 strikeouts in 205.1 innings pitched.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,444 fans per home date (25), the 13th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of April 26).
- Entering 2023, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 29 straight seasons.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in fourth place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 9-9 league mark.
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is tied for seventh place.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

SCHEDULE STRONG

- Clemson has an RPI of 22 (through games of April 26) according to WarrenNolan.com.
- A big reason for the Tigers' top-25 RPI is their strength of schedule, which is No. 4 in the nation.
- Clemson's non-conference strength of schedule is No. 10 in the nation, and the Tigers are 17-7 in non-conference games.
- A total of 13 of the Tigers' last 14 regular-season games are against teams in the top 47 of the unofficial RPI.

SWIPING BAGS

- A key to Clemson's scoring has been its ability to steal bases, as it has 63 in 42 games (1.5 per game).
- Clemson has multiple steals in 16 games.
- A total of 12 different Tigers have contributed to the team's 63 stolen bases.
- Clemson has totaled 100+ steals in 18 seasons. The last time doing so was in 2013, when it had 111 steals.
- Cam Cannarella has a team-high 17 steals, while Benjamin Blackwell is second on the team with 16 steals.
- Clemson totaled 17 steals in the season-opening series against Binghamton, including 11 in the season opener, one shy of the school record.

FIELDING STEADY

- Clemson has a solid fielding percentage of .975 in 2023. That mark would be second highest in Tiger history if the season ended today.
- The Clemson record for fielding percentage in a season is .975, set by the 2018 team.
- Clemson has committed just 39 errors in 42 games in 2023.
- Clemson has committed no errors or one error in 26 of the last 28 games.
- Clemson is 9-4 when not committing an error in a game.
- No Tiger has committed more than five errors.
- The everyday third baseman (Blake Wright), shortstop (Benjamin Blackwell) and second baseman (Riley Bertram) have combined for 15 errors.
- Clemson has a .977 fielding percentage in ACC regular-season games, committing only 15 errors in 18 games.

CAPTAINS

- Ryan Ammons, Riley Bertram, Jackson Lindley and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains in the pre-season.
- Benjamin Blackwell, Chad Fairey and Mac Starbuck were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Tristan Bissetta, Jacob Jarrell and Rocco Reid were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

AMICK PUTS NAME IN TIGER LORE

- Sophomore infielder and catcher Billy Amick had been a bench player in his career until March 10, when he put his stamp in Tiger lore.
- He entered the series opener against Georgia State in the sixth inning as a pinch-hitter and had a single later in the game.
- In the ninth inning with the Tigers trailing 8-5, he blasted a 446-foot grand slam with two outs to give Clemson a 9-8 walkoff victory.
- It was his first career homer in his 12th career game and second year at Clemson. It was also the third walkoff grand slam in Tiger history.
- He is hitting .400 with six homers, a triple, seven doubles, 24 RBIs, 18 runs and a .458 on-base percentage in 25 games (21 starts) in 2023.
- He has a team-high .718 slugging percentage in the 2023 season.
- He went 3-for-4 with a homer, two doubles and four RBIs in Clemson's 8-1 win at Georgia on April 11.

- He went 3-for-4 with two doubles, including the go-ahead, two-out, run-scoring double in the seventh inning against Notre Dame on April 16.
- He went 4-for-5 with two homers, a double and five RBIs in Clemson's 10-2 win at NC State on April 21.
- In his career, he is hitting .346 with six homers, a triple, seven doubles, 24 RBIs and 19 runs in 34 games (24 starts).
- He has a .606 slugging percentage and .400 on-base percentage in his career.

AMMONS RETURNS

- Junior lefthander Ryan Ammons was Clemson's closer in 2022 and moved into the rotation early in 2023, but suffered an injury in February.
- He missed almost two months, but made his return to the mound against Georgia on April 18 out of the bullpen, where he has settled.
- He is 1-0 with a save, 2.70 ERA, .170 opponents' batting average and 21 strikeouts in 13.1 innings pitched over four outings (two starts).
- He has only allowed three walks, good for a 7.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- He is holding opponents to an .067 batting average with two outs.
- He has not allowed a steal.
- In 5.0 innings pitched in each of his two starts in 2023, he struck out nine and 10, respectively.
- In his career, he's 2-2 with nine saves, a 4.00 ERA, .195 opponents' batting average and 70 strikeouts in 45.0 innings pitched (38 outings).

BLACKWELL GLAD HE RETURNED

- Senior infielder Benjamin Blackwell decided late in the process last summer to return for his fifth collegiate season in 2023.
- The Tigers are glad he did, and he is putting up solid numbers along the way, including 16 stolen bases.
- He is hitting .325 with seven doubles, two triples, a homer, 21 RBIs, 24 runs and a .413 on-base percentage in 42 games in 2023.
- He has 17 multiple-hit games.
- He is one of two Tigers to play and start every game in 2023.
- He has a .968 fielding percentage as Clemson's starting shortstop, committing only five errors in 158 chances.
- In his two-year Tiger career, he is hitting .326 with 17 doubles, three triples, four homers, 54 RBIs, 76 runs and 20 steals in 100 games.
- He has committed only 16 errors in his two seasons at Clemson, good for a solid .958 fielding percentage.

CANNARELLA EMERGING AS FRESHMAN

- Freshman Cam Cannarella has stepped right in to become the everyday starter in center field and has shown consistency as a freshman in 2023.
- He is hitting .400 with 11 doubles, a triple, four homers, 31 RBIs, 50 runs, a .476 on-base percentage and 17 steals in 39 games.
- He leads or is tied for the team lead in batting average, runs, hits (66), total bases (91), on-base percentage and steals.
- He has a team-high 19 multiple-hit games, including four three-hit games, two four-hit games and two five-hit games.
- He is hitting .424 with runners on base, .396 with runners in scoring position and .444 with two outs in 2023.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in 38 of his 39 games.
- He started his college career on a 14-game hitting streak and reached base via a hit or walk in his first 30 games.

NOTES

- He won the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the South Carolina three-game series from March 3-5, as he was 6-for-13 with three doubles.
- He went 5-for-6 with four runs in Clemson's 9-8 walkoff win over Georgia State on March 10.
- He joined Cooper Ingle, who also had five hits in the game, as the first Tigers with five hits in a game since 2012.
- Cannarella and Ingle became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.
- He went 5-for-6 with two doubles, two RBIs and three runs in the 14-9 win over Duke in the second game of a doubleheader on March 18.
- He hit a three-run walkoff homer to lift Clemson to an 8-5 win over Winthrop on March 21.

CLAYTON A NEW PITCHER FROM SIDE

- Junior righty Nick Clayton changed his arm slot to the side prior to the season, and it has paid dividends.
- He is 3-0 with a 2.32 ERA, .196 opponents' batting average and 37 strikeouts against 12 walks in 31.0 innings pitched over 16 outings.
- He has only allowed three extra-base hits thanks in large part to 39 groundball outs compared to 13 flyball outs.
- He is holding opponents to .127 with runners on base and .094 with runners in scoring position.
- In 18.0 innings pitched after the sixth inning, he has allowed just one run (0.50 ERA) and eight hits (.136 OBA) with 22 strikeouts.
- He has only allowed four of 17 inherited baserunners to score.
- He is 1-0 with a 2.18 ERA, .192 opponents' batting average and 28 strikeouts in 20.2 innings pitched over nine relief outings in ACC games.
- He pitched 3.0 perfect innings in relief with four strikeouts to earn the win in Clemson's 8-5 walkoff victory over Winthrop on March 21.
- In his career, he is 10-3 with a save, 3.88 ERA, .242 opponents' batting average and 108 strikeouts in 109.0 innings pitched (52 outings).

DARDEN A TIGER WINNER

- Freshman lefthander Ethan Darden was a reliever and spot starter in the first half of the season, but he has emerged as a weekend starter.
- He is 3-2 with a 4.46 ERA, .266 opponents' batting average and 29 strikeouts in 36.1 innings pitched over 13 outings (seven starts) in 2023.
- He has 56 groundball outs compared to only 18 flyball outs.
- He has not allowed a steal.
- He has a 3-1 record, 4.30 ERA, .276 opponents' batting average and 25 strikeouts against nine walks in 29.1 innings pitched in seven starts.
- Clemson has a 6-1 record in his seven starts.
- He pitched 5.0 scoreless innings of four-hit ball to earn the win in his first career ACC start at Florida State on April 7.
- He allowed just one run and no walks with three strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched to earn the win at NC State on April 21.

GARRIS GARNERING ATTENTION

- Sophomore Reed Garris was a catcher as a freshman in 2022, but has emerged as a dependable reliever in 2023.
- He is 3-0 with a 2.29 ERA, .205 opponents' batting average and 29 strikeouts against six walks in 19.2 innings pitched over 17 appearances.
- He leads the team in appearances.
- He has not allowed a homer.
- He is holding opponents to .194 with runners on base and .167 with runners in scoring position.

GORDON PROVIDING STARTS

- Sophomore righthander Austin Gordon has been a weekend starter all season and has provided consistency.
- He is 1-3 with a 5.12 ERA, .260 opponents' batting average and 47 strikeouts against 12 walks in 51.0 innings pitched over 10 starts.
- A total of 22 of his 31 runs allowed have come on the 14 home runs he has allowed.
- He is holding opponents to .130 with two outs.
- He is 1-3 with a 4.45 ERA, .238 opponents' batting average and 33 strikeouts against 10 walks in 32.1 innings pitched over six ACC starts.
- In his career, he is 2-3 with two saves, a 5.13 ERA and 78 strikeouts against 21 walks in 79.0 innings pitched over 27 outings (10 starts).

GRICE TWO-WAY PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- Junior Caden Grice is contributing as both a lefthander on the mound and slugger at the plate in 2023.
- He is 3-1 with a 4.04 ERA .202 opponents' batting average and 48 strikeouts in 35.2 innings pitched over eight starts on the mound in 2023.
- He is holding opponents to .158 with runners on base, .171 with runners in scoring position and .128 with two outs.
- He is hitting .310 with 10 homers, a triple, 10 doubles, 39 RBIs, 35 runs and three steals in 38 games (37 starts) batting in 2023.
- He has a .606 slugging percentage and .416 on-base percentage.
- He has hit all 10 of his homers in the last 24 games.
- He's hitting .343 with seven homers, five doubles, 23 RBIs, 19 runs, a .731 slugging percentage and .439 on-base percentage in 18 ACC games.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball and ACC Co-Player-of-the-Week on March 27.
- He became the 15th Tiger to earn ACC weekly honors at least three times in a career, while it was his fourth career national weekly honor.
- In five games, he totaled four homers and 11 RBIs, and he also earned the win on the mound at Georgia Tech on March 26.
- On March 26, he hit two homers with five RBIs, and he pitched 5.0 strong innings with six strikeouts to earn the win in a starting role.
- At Florida State on April 8, he pitched 6.1 innings to earn the win and went 2-for-4 with a grand slam in the 6-2 series-clinching victory.
- With two outs and Clemson trailing in the eighth inning, he hit a grand slam in the Tigers' 9-7 win at NC State on April 22.
- He went 3-for-4 with a homer, double, five RBIs, two runs and two walks in the 15-5 win in seven innings over Kennesaw State on April 25.
- In his career, he is 5-2 with a 4.53 ERA, .213 opponents' batting average and 69 strikeouts in 51.2 innings pitched over 20 appearances.
- In his career, he is hitting .286 with 37 homers, two triples, 30 doubles, 132 RBIs, 120 runs and 11 steals in 147 games (146 starts).

INGLE NOT JUST A SINGLES HITTER

- Junior catcher Cooper Ingle has proven why he is one of the best hitters in the ACC, including with some power.
- He is hitting .333 with five homers, 11 doubles, 28 RBIs, 37 runs, a .422 on-base percentage and steal in 41 games in 2023.
- He had a 16-game hitting streak from February to March.
- He is riding a current 13-game hitting streak.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in 36 straight games.

- He joined Cam Cannarella, who also had five hits in the game, as the first Tigers with five hits in a game since 2012.
- Ingle and Cannarella became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.
- In his career, he is hitting .332 with 24 doubles, 13 homers, 75 RBIs, 89 runs and a .428 on-base percentage in 105 games (99 starts).

LINDLEY A SUPER SENIOR OUT OF PEN

- Fifth-year senior and righty Jackson Lindley has continued his dependability out of the bullpen from the 2022 season into the 2023 season.
- He is 1-3 with two saves, a 3.91 ERA and .280 opponents' batting average in 23.0 innings pitched over 14 appearances (one start) in 2023.
- He has 25 strikeouts against nine walks.
- He has only allowed two of nine inherited baserunners to score.
- In his career, he is 10-3 with three saves, a 4.66 ERA and 90 strikeouts against 41 walks in 104.1 innings pitched over 63 appearances.

- Junior righthander Ty Olenchuk changed his posture and delivery midway through the 2023 season.

- He is hitting .326 with 13 doubles, two triples, two homers, 33 RBIs, 37 runs, a .456 on-base percentage and six steals in 41 games in 2023.
- He has 16 multiple-hit games and a team-high 10 multiple-RBI games.
- He had multiple hits in six consecutive games in March.
- In his career, he is hitting .309 with 13 doubles, two triples, three homers, 37 RBIs, a .441 on-base % and seven steals in 54 games.

WRIGHT WHERE HE LEFT OFF

- Junior infielder Blake Wright has picked up right in 2023 where he left off during his stellar 2023 sophomore season.
- He is hitting .273 with eight doubles, four homers, 29 RBIs, 25 runs and five steals in 39 games in 2023.
- He went 4-for-4 with two homers, three RBIs, three runs, a walk and three steals on opening day against Binghamton on Feb. 17.
- In his career, he is hitting .298 with 18 doubles, 16 homers, 74 RBIs, 58 runs and a .362 on-base percentage in 95 games (88 starts).

THREE TIGERS IN THE MAJORS IN 2023

- Brad Miller, Spencer Strider and Eli White have played in an MLB game in 2023.
- Miller, the 2011 ACC Player-of-the-Year, hit .339 with 36 doubles, eight triples, 16 homers, 135 RBIs and 46 steals in 191 games as a Tiger.
- Strider, who had a 5-2 record in his two active seasons (2018,20) at Clemson, made his MLB debut with the Atlanta Braves in 2021.
- White, who hit .275 with 104 runs and 36 steals at Clemson from 2014-16, made his MLB debut with the Texas Rangers on Sept. 1, 2020.
- Every Tiger team from 1974 to 2020 had at least one future major leaguer on its roster.
- Clemson has had at least one former Tiger play in an MLB game each of the last 68 years (streak started in 1956).
- Clemson has had multiple former Tigers play in an MLB game each of the last 50 years (streak started in 1974).
- Clemson set a school record with 12 former Tigers in the majors in 2021, breaking the previous record of eight.
