CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has a 17-10 home record, won two of three games at No. 11 Boston College last weekend.
- The Tigers are averaging 6.9 runs per game and hitting .295 with a .446 slugging percentage, .391 on-base percentage and 66 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 4.54 ERA, .254 opponents' batting average and 2.52 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .976.

LOUISVILLE OVERVIEW

- Louisville, who has a 5-8 road record and is averaging 7.4 runs per game, is led by 17th-year Head Coach Dan McDonnell.
- The Cardinals defeated Bellarmine 18-7 on Tuesday. They are hitting .295 and have a 3.92 ERA and .970 fielding percentage.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson Assistant Coach Jimmy Belanger was a pitcher at Louisville in 2007 and 2008.
- Clemson is outhitting ACC opponents .284 to .252.
- The Tiger bullpen has an 18-9 record, nine saves, a 4.15 ERA, .261 opponents' batting average and 226 strikeouts in 212.2 innings pitched.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,444 fans per home date (25), the 13th-highest figure in the nation and secondin the ACC (through games of May 3).
- Entering 2023, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 29 straight seasons.

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 18 in the country by Perfect this week, its first weekly ranking of the 2023
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse. coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

• Clemson was in last place in the overall ACC standings at 2-8 after its loss at Florida State on April 6, but is 9-2 in ACC games since.

SCHEDULE STRONG

- Clemson has an RPI of 14 (through games of May 3).
- A big reason for the Tigers' top-15 RPI is their strength of schedule, which is No. 3 in the nation.
- · Clemson's non-conference strength of schedule is No. 12 in the nation, and the Tigers are 17-7 in nonconference games.
- A total of 10 of the Tigers' last 11 regular-season games are against teams in the top 52 of the unofficial RPI.

ROAD SURGE

- Clemson's second-half surge is due in large part to its success in road games, as it has won eight of its last nine road contests
- The Tigers have a 10-5 road record on the season after starting the year 2-4 in road games.
- · Clemson won the final two games at Florida State, downed Georgia, swept NC State and won two of three games at No. 11 Boston College.
- · Clemson is 8-4 in road ACC games.
- Excluding the shortened 2020 season, Clemson has not finished with a .500 or better road record since 2018 (15-5)

SWIPING BAGS

- A key to Clemson's scoring has been its ability to steal bases, as it has 66 in 45 games (1.5 per game).
- · Clemson has multiple steals in 17 games.
- · A total of 12 different Tigers have contributed to the team's 66 stolen bases.
- · Cam Cannarella has a team-high 19 stolen bases, while Benjamin Blackwell is second on the team with 16 steals.
- Clemson totaled 17 steals in the season-opening series against Binghamton, including 11 in the season opener, one shy of the school record.

FIELDING STEADY

- · Clemson has a solid fielding percentage of .976 in 2023.
- The Clemson record for fielding percentage in a season is .975, set by the 2018 team.
- Clemson has committed just 40 errors in 45 games in 2023
- · Clemson has committed no errors or one error in 29 of the last 31 games.
- Clemson is 10-5 when not committing an error in a
- · No Tiger has committed more than five errors.
- The everyday third baseman (Blake Wright), shortstop (Benjamin Blackwell) and second baseman (Riley Bertram) have combined for 15 errors.
- · Clemson has a .979 fielding percentage in ACC regularseason games, committing only 16 errors in 21 games.

- Ryan Ammons, Riley Bertram, Jackson Lindley and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains in the pre-
- Benjamin Blackwell, Chad Fairey and Mac Starbuck were voted to the leadership council (assistant cap-
- Tristan Bissetta, Jacob Jarrell and Rocco Reid were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

AMICK PUTS NAME IN TIGER LORE

• Sophomore infielder Billy Amick had been a bench player in his career until March 10, when he put his stamp in Tiger lore.

- He entered the series opener against Georgia State in the sixth inning as a pinch-hitter and had a single later in the game.
- In the ninth inning with the Tigers trailing 8-5, he blasted a 446-foot grand slam with two outs to give Clemson a 9-8 walkoff victory.
- It was his first career homer in his 12th career game and second year at Clemson. It was also the third walkoff grand slam in Tiger history.
- He is hitting .406 with six homers, a triple, nine doubles, 27 RBIs, 20 runs and a .468 on-base percentage in 28 games (24 starts) in 2023.
- He has a team-high .708 slugging percentage.
- He played only one of the first 12 games in 2023 and did not make his first start until March 11, Clemson's 15th game of the season.
- He went 3-for-4 with a homer, two doubles and four RBIs in Clemson's 8-1 win at Georgia on April 11.
- He went 3-for-4 with two doubles, including the goahead, two-out, run-scoring double in the seventh inning against Notre Dame on April 16.
- He went 4-for-5 with two homers, a double and five RBIs in Clemson's 10-2 win at NC State on April 21.
- In his career, he is hitting .357 with six homers, a triple, nine doubles, 27 RBIs and 21 runs in 37 games (27 starts).
- He has a .609 slugging percentage and .414 on-base percentage in his career.

AMMONS RETURNS

- Junior lefthander Ryan Ammons was Clemson's closer in 2022 and moved into the rotation early in 2023, but suffered an injury in February.
- He missed almost two months, but made his return to the mound against Georgia on April 18 out of the bullpen, where he has settled.
- He's 1-0 with two saves, 2.51 ERA, .160 opponents' batting average and 21 strikeouts in 14.1 innings pitched over five outings (two starts).
- He has only allowed three walks, good for a 7.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- He is holding opponents to an .063 batting average with two outs.
- He has not allowed a steal.
- In 5.0 innings pitched in each of his two starts in 2023, he struck out nine and 10, respectively.
- In his career, he's 2-2 with 10 saves, a 3.91 ERA, .192 opponents' batting average and 70 strikeouts in 46.0 innings pitched (39 outings).

BLACKWELL GLAD HE RETURNED

- Senior infielder Beniamin Blackwell decided late in the process last summer to return for his fifth collegiate season in 2023.
- The Tigers are glad he did, and he is putting up solid numbers along the way, including 16 stolen bases.
- He is hitting .311 with eight doubles, two triples, a homer, 21 RBIs, 26 runs and a .400 on-base percentage in 45 games in 2023.
- He has 17 multiple-hit games.
- He is one of two Tigers to play and start every game in 2023
- He has a .971 fielding percentage as Clemson's starting shortstop, committing only five errors in 171 chances in 2023.
- His .971 fielding percentage is second highest in a season by a Tiger shortstop in history, trailing only Jason Stolz's .985 mark in 2012.
- In his two-year Tiger career, he is hitting .321 with 18 doubles, three triples, four homers, 54 RBIs, 78 runs and 20 steals in 103 games.
- . He has committed only 16 errors in his two seasons at Clemson, good for a solid .959 fielding percentage.

CANNARELLA EMERGING AS FRESHMAN

- Freshman Cam Cannarella has stepped right in to become the everyday starter in center field and has shown consistency as a freshman in 2023.
- He is hitting .388 with 11 doubles, a triple, four homers, 32 RBIs, 53 runs, a .463 on-base percentage and 19 steals in 42 games.
- He leads the team lead in runs, hits (69), multiple-hit games (20) and steals.
- He has four three-hit games, two four-hit games and two five-hit games.
- He is hitting .403 with runners on base, .408 with runners in scoring position and .426 with two outs.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in 40 of his 42 games.
- He started his college career on a 14-game hitting streak and reached base via a hit or walk in his first 30 games.
- He won the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the South Carolina three-game series from March 3-5, as he was 6-for-13 with three doubles.
- He went 5-for-6 with four runs in Clemson's 9-8 walkoff win over Georgia State on March 10.
- He joined Cooper Ingle, who also had five hits in the game, as the first Tigers with five hits in a game since 2012.
- Cannarella and Ingle became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.
- He went 5-for-6 with with two doubles, two RBIs and three runs in the 14-9 win over Duke in the second game of a doubleheader on March 18.
- He hit a three-run walkoff homer to lift Clemson to an 8-5 win over Winthrop on March 21.

CLAYTON A NEW PITCHER FROM SIDE

- Junior righty Nick Clayton changed his arm slot to the side prior to the season, and it has paid dividends.
- He is 4-0 with a 2.57 ERA, .192 opponents' batting average and 39 strikeouts against 15 walks in 35.0 innings pitched over 17 outings.
- He has only allowed four extra-base hits thanks in large part to 46 groundball outs compared to 15 flyball outs.
- He is holding opponents to .123 with runners on base and .103 with runners in scoring position.
- In 20.0 innings pitched after the sixth inning, he has allowed just three runs (1.35 ERA) and 10 hits (.152 OBA) with 23 strikeouts.
- He has only allowed five of 20 inherited baserunners to score.
- He is 2-0 with a 2.55 ERA, .186 opponents' batting average and 30 strikeouts in 24.2 innings pitched over 10 relief outings in ACC games.
- He pitched 3.0 perfect innings in relief with four strikeouts to earn the win in Clemson's 8-5 walkoff victory over Winthrop on March 21.
- In his career, he is 11-3 with a save, 3.90 ERA, .239 opponents' batting average and 110 strikeouts in 113.0 innings pitched (53 outings).

DARDEN A TIGER WINNER

- Freshman lefthander Ethan Darden was a reliever and spot starter in the first half of the season, but he has emerged as a weekend starter.
- He is 3-2 with a 5.13 ERA, .280 opponents' batting average and 30 strikeouts in 40.1 innings pitched over 14 outings (eight starts) in 2023.
- He has 64 groundball outs compared to only 20 flyball outs.
- He has not allowed a steal.
- Clemson has a 7-1 record in his eight starts.
- He pitched 5.0 scoreless innings of four-hit ball to earn the win in his first career ACC start at Florida State on April 7.

 He allowed just one run and no walks with three strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched to earn the win at NC State on April 21.

GARRIS GARNERING ATTENTION

- Sophomore Reed Garris was a catcher as a freshman in 2022, but has emerged as a dependable reliever.
- He is 3-0 with a 2.61 ERA, .221 opponents' batting average and 31 strikeouts against six walks in 20.2 innings pitched over 18 appearances.
- He leads the team in appearances.
- He has not allowed a homer.
- He is holding opponents to .205 with runners on base and .188 with runners in scoring position.

GORDON PROVIDING STARTS

- Sophomore righthander Austin Gordon has been a weekend starter all season and has provided consistency on the mound.
- He is 1-4 with a 4.99 ERA, .249 opponents' batting average and 53 strikeouts against 14 walks in 57.2 innings pitched over 11 starts.
- A total of 23 of his 34 runs allowed have come on the 15 home runs he has surrendered.
- He is holding opponents to .145 with two outs.
- He's 1-4 with a 4.38 ERA, .224 opponents' batting average and 39 strikeouts against 12 walks in 39.0 innings pitched over seven ACC starts.
- In his career, he is 2-4 with two saves, a 5.04 ERA and 84 strikeouts against 23 walks in 85.2 innings pitched over 28 outings (11 starts).

GRICE TWO-WAY PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- Junior Caden Grice is contributing as both a lefthander on the mound and slugger at the plate in 2023.
- He is 4-1 with a 3.50 ERA .183 opponents' batting average and 57 strikeouts in 43.2 innings pitched over nine starts on the mound in 2023.
- Clemson has a 7-2 record in his nine starts on the mound.
- He is holding opponents to .156 with runners on base, .179 with runners in scoring position and .111 with two outs.
- He is hitting .312 with 11 homers, a triple, 12 doubles, 44 RBIs, 37 runs and three steals in 41 games (40 starts) batting in 2023.
- He has a .617 slugging percentage and .414 on-base percentage.
- \bullet He has hit all 11 of his homers in the last 27 games.
- He has a team-high 11 multiple-RBI games, including two three-RBI games, three four-RBI games and two five-RBI games.
- He is hitting .342 with eight homers, seven doubles, 28 RBIs, a .734 slugging percentage and .432 on-base percentage in 21 ACC games.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball and ACC Co-Player-of-the-Week on March 27.
- In five games, he totaled four homers and 11 RBIs, and he also earned the win on the mound at Georgia Tech on March 26.
- On March 26, he hit two homers with five RBIs, and he pitched 5.0 strong innings with six strikeouts to earn the win in a starting role.
- At Florida State on April 8, he pitched 6.1 innings to earn the win and went 2-for-4 with a grand slam in the 6-2 series-clinching victory.
- With two outs and Clemson trailing in the eighth inning, he hit a grand slam in the Tigers' 9-7 win at NC State on April 22.
- He went 3-for-4 with a homer, double, five RBIs, two runs and two walks in the 15-5 win in seven innings over Kennesaw State on April 25.

- At No. 11 Boston College on April 29, he pitched 8.0 innings, allowing two hits and one earned run with nine strikeouts in a 6-3 win.
- It was the longest outing by a Tiger since 2021.
- He was named one of 15 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball and ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week on May 1.
- He became the sixth Tiger to earn ACC weekly honors at least four times in a career, while it was his fifth career national weekly honor.
- He joined Kris Benson (1994-96), Khalil Greene (1999-02), Kyle Parker (2008-10), Richie Shaffer (2010-12) and Seth Beer (2016-18) with 4+.
- In his career, he is 6-2 with a 4.07 ERA, .198 opponents' batting average and 78 strikeouts in 59.2 innings pitched over 21 appearances.
- In his career, he is hitting .287 with 38 homers, two triples, 32 doubles, 137 RBIs, 122 runs and 11 steals in 150 games (149 starts).

INGLE NOT JUST A SINGLES HITTER

- Junior catcher and outfielder Cooper Ingle has proven why he is one of the best hitters in the ACC, including with some power.
- He is hitting .326 with five homers, 11 doubles, 28 RBIs, 38 runs, a .413 on-base percentage and steal in 44 games in 2023.
- He has 26 walks against only 19 strikeouts in 181 at-bats.
- He had a 16-game hitting streak from February to March.
- He is riding a current 16-game hitting streak.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in 39 straight games
- He went 5-for-6 with a homer, four RBIs and two runs in Clemson's 9-8 walkoff win over Georgia State on March 10.
- He joined Cam Cannarella, who also had five hits in the game, as the first Tigers with five hits in a game since 2012
- Ingle and Cannarella became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.
- In his career, he is hitting .328 with 24 doubles, 13 homers, 75 RBIs, 90 runs and a .424 on-base percentage in 108 games (102 starts).

LINDLEY A SUPER SENIOR OUT OF PEN

- Fifth-year senior and righty Jackson Lindley has continued his dependability out of the bullpen from the 2022 season into the 2023 season.
- He is 1-3 with two saves, a 3.91 ERA and .280 opponents' batting average in 23.0 innings pitched over 14 appearances (one start) in 2023.
- He has 25 strikeouts against nine walks.
- He has only allowed two of nine inherited baserunners to score.
- In his career, he is 10-3 with three saves, a 4.66 ERA and 90 strikeouts against 41 walks in 104.1 innings pitched over 63 appearances.

OLENCHUK CHANGING FOR THE BETTER

- Junior righty and outfielder Ty Olenchuk changed his posture and delivery midway through the 2023 season.
- He is putting up strong numbers in the second half of the season
- He is 1-0 with a 3.12 ERA, .254 opponents' batting average and 14 strikeouts in 17.1 innings pitched over 12 relief appearances in 2023.
- In his last seven outings, he has allowed eight hits and no runs with nine strikeouts in 10.1 innings pitched.

- Sophomore righthander Casey Tallent has been a consistent long reliever in 2023.
- He is 1-0 with a save, 2.35 ERA, .237 opponents' batting average and 14 strikeouts in 15.1 innings pitched over 10 appearances in 2023.
- He is holding opponents to .105 with runners in scoring position.
- In his nine relief appearances, he is 1-0 with a 1.46 ERA in 12.1 innings pitched.
- He missed four weeks due to injury from late March to early April.
- In his career, he is 2-0 with a save, 3.26 ERA, .241 opponents' batting average and 36 strikeouts in 38.2 innings pitched over 25 outings.

TAYLOR FINDING HIS BASEBALL RHYTHM

- Sophomore outfielder Will Taylor is healthy after an injury-plagued freshman season.
- The wide receiver on the Tiger football team has found his rhythm in left field in 2023.
- He is hitting .320 with 13 doubles, two triples, two homers, 34 RBIs, 41 runs, a .451 on-base percentage and six steals in 44 games in 2023.
- He has 16 multiple-hit games and 10 multiple-RBI games.
- He had multiple hits in six consecutive games in March.
- In his career, he is hitting .305 with 13 doubles, two triples, three homers, 38 RBIs, a .438 on-base % and seven steals in 57 games.

WRIGHT WHERE HE LEFT OFF

- Junior infielder Blake Wright has picked up right in 2023 where he left off during his stellar 2023 sophomore season
- He is hitting .263 with eight doubles, five homers, 33 RBIs, 26 runs and five steals in 42 games in 2023.
- He went 4-for-4 with two homers, three RBIs, three runs, a walk and three steals on opening day against Binghamton on Feb. 17.
- In his career, he is hitting .293 with 18 doubles, 17 homers, 78 RBIs, 59 runs and a .354 on-base percentage in 98 games (91 starts).

THREE TIGERS IN THE MAJORS IN 2023

- Brad Miller, Spencer Strider and Eli White have played in an MLB game in 2023.
- Miller, the 2011 ACC Player-of-the-Year, hit .339 with 36 doubles, eight triples, 16 homers, 135 RBIs and 46 steals in 191 games as a Tiger.
- Strider, who had a 5-2 record in his two active seasons (2018,20) at Clemson, made his MLB debut with the Atlanta Braves in 2021.
- White, who hit .275 with 104 runs and 36 steals at Clemson from 2014-16, made his MLB debut with the Texas Rangers on Sept. 1, 2020.
- Every Tiger team from 1974 to 2020 had at least one future major leaguer on its roster.
- Clemson has had at least one former Tiger play in an MLB game each of the last 68 years (streak started in 1956)
- Clemson has had multiple former Tigers play in an MLB game each of the last 50 years (streak started in 1974).
- Clemson set a school record with 12 former Tigers in the majors in 2021, breaking the previous record of eight.
